2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

DOGFIGHT IN ST. CLOUD: St. Cloud State men's hockey team (17-12-3, 12-11-1 WCHA) will host WCHA rival Michigan Tech University (7-20-5, 6-13-5 WCHA) on Friday, Feb. 24 and Saturday, Feb. 25 at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud. Both games are slated to begin at 7:07 p.m. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.9 out of St. Cloud and also on KVSC FM 88.1. The games will be televised live on Charter Communications Cable channel 14 and Astound Cable channel 27 in the St. Cloud region. The game on Friday, Feb. 24 is slated to be Nies Financial Group player card night and the game on Saturday, Feb. 25 will be Senior Salute night at SCSU. These games mark the final regular season home games for the Huskies of SCSU.

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 17-12-3, 12-11-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (17-10-3, 12-9-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach

Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator and travel coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

OLYMPIC GLORY: Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97, will play for Team USA at the upcoming Winter Olympics in Italy. On Feb. 6, Bret Hedican (1988-91) was announced as a squad member of the 2006 USA Olympic Team. He replaces the injured Aaron Miller on the Team USA roster. This marks Hedican's second trip to the Olympics. He also played in the 1992 games in Albertville. Former Husky Matt Cullen (1995-97) was also named as a member of the Team USA "taxi squad," which will travel to Italy and he will serve as a reserve at the Games in case of injury.

HUSKY HOCKEY ON THE AIR: Once again in 2005-06, KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.59 will carry SCSU hockey live over the radio (and on the web at www.1450knsi.com). Don Lyons will call the play-by-play with color commentary provided by SCSU All-American Dave Reichel. Home and away games will also be broadcast live on KVSC 88.1. You can also pick up KVSC on the web at www.kvsc.org

HUSKIES HOLD AT #19: SCSU moved to #19 in the USCHO.com poll this week. The Huskies did not receive any votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey poll this week. SCSU was ranked #16 in this week's INCH poll. The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked teams this season including Wisconsin, Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College, Denver and North Dakota.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

TWO OT SETBACKS AT MSU: For the second consecutive night, SCSU lost in overtime with a 3-2 loss at Minnesota State Mankato on Feb. 18. The game winner for the Mavericks was posted at 1:51 of the OT session as Brock Becker scored with assists from David Backes and Travis Morin. MSU opened the game's scoring at 2:25 of the first period with a goal by Travis Morin. He was assisted on the scoring play by Brent Cummings and Jon Kalinski. The Huskies tied the game at 6:59 of the first period with a goal by Sauk Rapids native Nate Raduns.

The goal was assisted by Nate Dey and Dan Kronick. This was Raduns fourth goal of the 2005-06 season, and his 12th career goal as a Husky. SCSU notched a 2-1 lead at 12:01 of the second period, when Michael Olson scored his fifth goal of the season. He was assisted on the play by junior defender Casey Borer. MSU tied the game at 2-2 in the closing seconds of the second period with a power play goal at 19:56 by defender Steve Wagner. He was assisted on the play by Brock Becker and Rob Rankin. SCSU outshot the Mavericks 48-29, and the Huskies were 0-of-9 on the power play in the game. MSU was 1-of-5 on the advantage, as Dan Tormey made 46 saves in the game for MSU. Bobby Goepfert made 36 saves for SCSU... Mankato, Minn...An overtime goal at 4:23 by Rob Rankin lifted Minnesota State Mankato to a 2-1 win over SCSU on Friday, Feb. 17 in Mankato. Minnesota State got onto the board first in the game with a goal by Jon Kalinski at 3:14 of the first period. He was assisted on the play by Kevin Huck and Lucas Fransen. The Huskies charged back and tied the game at 9:21 of the first period with a goal by Justin Fletcher. He was assisted on the scoring play by fellow defender Aaron Brocklehurst and Goepfert. This was Goepfert's second assist of the season. In the game, Goepfert had 24 saves and Zacharias had 33 saves. In the third period, SCSU outshot MSU 8-2, and the Huskies outshot the Mavs 34-26 in the game. In the OT session, Rankin scored the game winner on the power play. In the game, SCSU was 0-of-6 on the power play and MSU was 1-of-4 on the advantage.

AMONG THE BEST: SCSU's defense ranks ninth in the nation (2nd in the WCHA) with a 2.31 goals allowed average this season...on offense, SCSU ranks 21st in the nation with a 3.19 goals per game average...goalie Bobby Goepfert ranks 11th in the nation with a .925 save rate (3rd in the WCHA) and eighth in the nation (2nd in the rugged WCHA) with a 2.10 goals against average...at 13.4 PIM per game, SCSU is the least penalized team in the nation this season...SCSU's penalty kill rate of 85.9% ranks 11th among DI teams (2nd in the WCHA) and its power play unit ranks 16th in the nation with a 19.0% conversion rate...with 23 points, Justin Fletcher ranks 14th in the nation (7th in the WCHA) for defenseman scoring...Joe Jensen ranks fourth in the WCHA with four game winning goals this season...with 31 points, Andrew Gordon ranks 18th among WCHA players for scoring this winter...Gordon and Jensen rank 12th among WCHA players with 14 goals scored.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzkko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Allenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

SENIOR SALUTE: The St. Cloud State men's hockey team will play its final regular season home games of the 2005-06 season on Feb. 24-25 against Michigan Tech. The games will mark the final regular season home appearances for SCSU seniors forward Joe Jensen (Plymouth), defender T.J. McElroy (Golden Valley), goaltender Jason Montgomery (Blaine, Wash.), forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.), forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.), forward Billy Hengen (Eden Prairie) and forward Josh Singer (Lino Lakes). Jensen leads the senior class with 92 career points and 45 goals. Hengen is the top assist producer in the class with 52 career assists. Hengen (109), Jensen (143), Hooton (131) and McElroy (101) have all played in 100-plus games for the Huskies during their careers. The SCSU seniors have accounted for 93 points this season. The senior class has chalked up 34 goals and 59 assists this season. Overall, SCSU has posted 102 goals this season and 181 assists.

WORKING OVERTIME: SCSU has played in eight overtime games this season. The most OT games played in season by the Huskies was nine OT sessions in 2002-03. In overtime games this season, SCSU is 2-3-3.

MORE ABOUT MSU: The two setbacks at MSU marks only the second time this season that the Huskies have been on the losing side of a weekend series sweep. The only other team to hand the Huskies a pair of losses on the same weekend in 2005-06 is Colorado College way back on Nov. 4-5. Both of SCSU's series setbacks this season have been on the road...the two losses at Mankato marked only the second and third times since 1987-88 that SCSU has suffered losses in the city of Mankato. The previous loss at the MWCC for SCSU occurred on Nov. 15, 2002 with a 7-6 setback...SCSU still owns a 17-6-3 series lead over the Mavericks at the NCAA Division I level...Feb. 17 marked the first time that Minnesota State Mankato defeated the Huskies in an overtime game. In the all-time series at the DI level, SCSU is 1-2-3 in overtime games against the Mavericks.

NEW CAREER SEASON-HIGH: Justin Fletcher's goal on Feb. 17 at MSUM provided him with a career season-high 23 points. He now has 18 assists and five goals this season. Last year he had 22 points (8g/14a). The junior defender also leads the club with a +18 on the plus/minus.

GOEPFERT A THREAT ON BOTH ENDS OF ICE: Goaltender Bobby Goepfert posted an assist on Feb. 17 on Justin Fletcher's goal. The last time Goepfert posted a point was an assist at Michigan Tech on Nov. 12.

HUSKY FACTS: SCSU hit a WCHA season high with 48 shots in the game against Mankato on Feb. 18. The total was second-best for the Huskies this season, with the team's season-high for shots coming against Robert Morris wit 53 shots on Dec. 17... former SCSU skater and current USA Olympic team player Mark Parrish (1995-97) was a featured guest this past weekend on VH-1's Top 20 Video Countdown... Junior forward Nate Raduns, a resident of nearby Sauk Rapids, notched a goal during the Huskies' 3-2 OT loss at Mankato on Feb. 18. This marked the first goal for Raduns since a marker against Colgate on Jan. 6. Raduns now has four goals and seven assists this season... Aaron Brocklehurst has already doubled his 2004-05 season totals this winter. He has 18 points (4g/14a) this year, and last year he had 3g/4a as a rookie blueliner at SCSU... Andrew Gordon still leads the team with 31 points (14g/17a). Joe Jensen is tied for the team's goal scoring lead along with Gordon at 14. Jensen also has 10 assists this season for 24 points. Billy Hengen leads the team in assists with 20 (6g/20a). Konrad Reeder is another +20 man for the Huskies this season with nine goals and 13 assists.
