HUSKIES AT WISCONSIN: #19 St. Cloud State (18-12-4, 13-11-2 WCHA) will travel to #5/6 Wisconsin (21-9-3, 15-8-3 WCHA) on Friday, March 3 and Saturday, March 4 for a pair of 7:07 p.m. games at the Kohl Center (cap. 15,237/200x97) in Madison, Wis. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.9 out of St. Cloud and also on KVSC FM 88.1. The game on March 3 will be televised on Fox Sports North (Wisconsin) and on March 4, the game will be available live over the Internet at the Wisconsin website (www.uwbadgers.com). This marks the first time since 2003-04 that SCSU has played in Madison. Earlier this season, SCSU tied Wisconsin 202 on Oct. 21 and lost 3-1 on Oct. 22 at the NHC.

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 18-12-4, 13-11-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (18-10-4, 13-9-2 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach

Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator and travel coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

OLYMPIC GLORY: Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97 and Bret Hedican (1988-91) were members of the USA Men's Olympic hockey team at the 2006 Winter Olympics. Former Husky Matt Cullen (1995-97) was also a member of the Team USA "taxi squad." Cullen travelled to Torino, Italy along with Parrish, Hedican and the rest of Team USA for this year's Olympics. This was the first Olympic experience for both Parrish and Cullen, while Hedican was a member of the 1992 USA hockey team at the Olympics in Albertville, France.

HUSKY HOCKEY ON THE AIR: Once again in 2005-06, KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.59 will carry SCSU hockey live over the radio (and on the web at www.1450knsi.com). Don Lyons will call the play-by-play with color commentary provided by SCSU All-American Dave Reichel..home and away games will also be broadcast live on KVSC 88.1. You can also pick up KVSC on the web at www.kvsc.org

HUSKIES HOLD AT #19: SCSU held at #19 in the USCHO.com poll this week. The Huskies received six votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey poll this week. SCSU was ranked #15 in this week's INCH poll. The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked teams this season including Wisconsin, Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College, Denver and North Dakota.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

GORDON SCORES THREE: Sophomore Andrew Gordon scored his first collegiate hat trick in a 6-1 win over Michigan Tech on Feb. 24 at the NHC. Junior Dan Kronick broke the ice for SCSU in the game with his power play goal at 5:34 of the first, before Gordon scored the game-winner on a SHG at 15:06 of the first. This was Gordon's second SHG of the season, and SCSU first SHG since Dec. 18. Gordon posted his second goal at 17:45 of the first with assists from Justin Fletcher and Matt Stephenson. In the second, MTU's Chris Conner scored a SHG at 10:16, but Kronick silenced the comeback with a goal at 18:46 with assists from Konrad Reeder and David Carlisle. In the third period, senior Brock Hooton notched his third goal of the season at 13:50 with help from Aaron Brocklehurst and Fletcher. To end the night, Gordon got his hat trick with a power play goal at 17:08. Brocklehurst and Matt Hartman had assists on the play. In the nets, Bobby Goepfert was the goalie of record with 22 saves. He was relieved in the third by Jason Montgomery, who made four saves in 6:10 minutes of play. SCSU outshot MTU 29-27 and the Huskies were 2-of-5 on the PP...to complete the weekend, SCSU and MTU skated to a 2-2 tie on Feb. 25. Nate Dey started the scoring with a goal at 9:45, as TJ McElroy and Billy Hengen had assists. MTU tied the game at 13:36 with a second period goal by Brandon Schwartz. Stephenson marked the second Husky goal with a tally at 15:35 of the second. Dey and Hooton had assists on the play. MTU knotted the score at :20 of the third with a goal by Tyler Shelast. SCSU was 0-of-5 on the PP and it outshot the Huskies 42-29 in the game. Goepfert made 27 saves in the contest.

GOEPFERT TOPS IN WCHA: Bobby Goepfert allowed just three goals this weekend in play against MTU. He ranks seventh in the nation with a 2.06 goals against rate and sixth in the nation with a .927 save rate (tops in the WCHA). As a team, SCSU ranks seventh in the nation with a 2.26 goals allowed rate this winter. Of note, UW is the top WCHA team with a 2.12 goals allowed rate, so it should prove to be a true defensive battle this weekend at the Kohl...SCSU still owns the distinction of being the least penalized team in the nation with just 13.6 PIM per game this season. SCSU also ranks ninth in the nation with a penalty kill rate of 86.0%...Andrew Gordon ranks 14th in the WCHA with 11 goals (league games only) and 17th with 23 points... Justin Fletcher ranks 5th in the WCHA for defenseman scoring with 18 points (league games only). Fletcher ranks 15th among NCAA DI defender with 25 points this season.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzkko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Allenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

HUSKIES SECURE TOP 6 FINISH: SCSU will finish no lower than sixth place in the WCHA regular season standings thanks to a 2-2 tie against MTU on Feb. 25 at the NHC. The Huskies' first round playoff location will be determined after the final weekend of play in the WCHA. Just as a reminder...the WCHA pre-season poll picked SCSU to finish ninth in the WCHA this season.

GORDON CRAFTS HAT TRICK: Andrew Gordon becomes the third SCSU player to post a hat trick this season, and he is the first Nova Scotia resident to score a hat trick for St. Cloud State during the NCAA Division I era. The trio of goals pushes Gordon's team leading goal total this season to 17. He also has 17 assists this year for a team leading 34 points. His season's point and goal totals are the most by a SCSU since the 2002-03 season.

KRONICK ATTACKS: Junior forward Dan Kronick scored his ninth and 10th goals of the season during SCSU's win over MTU on Feb. 24. At 18 points this season (10g/8a), Kronick is one of 16 Huskies who have 10-or-more points scored in 2005-06.

A NEW DEY AT SCSU: Sophomore Nate Dey snapped a 10-game goal scoring drought with his goal in the first period against MTU on Feb. 25. The last time that Dey had scored a goal for the Huskies was on Jan. 20 against Minnesota Duluth at the NHC. Dey also posted an assist on Matt Stephenson's second period goal in the contest. The goal was the second of the season for Stephenson, a sophomore from Midland, Ontario. Both Stephenson and junior Nate Raduns were honored by the WCHA for their academic excellence between periods on Feb. 25.

DEFENSE PROVIDES OFFENSE: Junior Justin Fletcher charted two assists on Feb. 24. Fletcher ranks second on the team with 20 assists this season, and he continues to build on his team-leading plus/minus ranking at +21. His 20 assists this season ranks sixth best in the team records for defensemen. Bret Hedican, who skated for the USA Olympic team this winter in Torino, is SCSU's recordholder for assists in a season by a defender with 30. Current Columbia Bluejackets blueliner Duvie Westcott is the last SCSU defender to post more than 20 assists in a season with 24 in 2000-01.

MOST OT SESSIONS: The Huskies played in their ninth overtime game of the season on Feb. 25. SCSU is 2-3-4 in those games, which marks the second most OT games for the Huskies in a single-season. The team record for OT games in a season is 10, which the Huskies hit in 1999-00. SCSU posted a 3-4-3 record during that season. SCSU also had nine OT games during the 2002-03 season (2-2-5).

HUSKY FACTS: Billy Hengen ranks second on the team this season with 27 points. He leads the squad with 21 assists this season. He ranks 24th in the team records with 53 career assists...Andrew Gordon had a shorthanded goal on Feb. 24. This marks Gordon's second SHG of the season...SCSU has five players with over 20 points this season. He also had one against Brown this season on Nov. 26. The last time a SCSU player scored a SHG was one by Joe Jensen on Dec. 18 against Robert Morris...SCSU is 12-2-1 when its opponent fails to convert on the power play this season...SCSU is 17-2-2 this season when it holds its opponent to two-or-less goals this season...who's hot at SCSU? In the last 10 games, Andrew Gordon is the teams scoring leader with 6g/3a. Defenders Aaron Brocklehurst and Justin Fletcher both have 1g/7a, while Brock Hooton continues to impress with his post-Christmas surge of 1g/6a in the last 10 games. Grant Clifton also has seven assists in the last 10 games...since Jan. 1, Fletcher leads the team with 16 pts. (3g/13a), while Gordon (10g/4a) and Brocklehurst (3g/11a) each have 14 points.
