## 2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Feb. 6, 2006

**#15 HUSKIES HOST #8 COLORADO COLLEGE:** The #15 ranked St. Cloud State men's hockey team (16-9-3, 11-8-1 WCHA) will put a six-game win streak on the line this weekend as it hosts #8 Colorado College (18-11-1, 10-9-1 WCHA) for games on Friday, Feb. 10 and Saturday, Feb. 11. Both games are slated to start at 7:07 p.m. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.9 out of St. Cloud. The games will be televised live on Charter Communications Cable channel 14 and Astound Cable channel 27 in the St. Cloud region. This will be a key battle in the WCHA as St. Cloud State currently owns a fourth place spot in the league with 23 points, and Colorado College is in sixth place with 21 points. The last time these two teams played, CC swept the series in Colorado Springs on Nov. 4-5 by scores of 4-2 and 3-2 (the lone time this season that SCSU has been swept in a weekend series).

**2005-06 RESULTS:** SCSU is 16-9-3, 11-8-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



**SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO:** Motzko (16-9-3, 11-8-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko

went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator and travel coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Minkel.

**OLYMPIC GLORY:** Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97, will play for Team USA at the upcoming Winter Olympics in Italy. On Feb. 6, Bret Hedican (1988-91) was announced as a squad member of the 2006 USA Olympic Team. He replaces the injured Aaron Miller on the Team USA roster. This mark's Hedican second trip to the Olympics. He also played in the 1992 games in Albertville. Former Husky Matt Cullen (1995-97) was also named as a member of the Team USA "taxi squad," which will travel to Italy and he will serve as a reserve at the Games in case of injury.

**HUSKY HOCKEY ON THE AIR:** Once again in 2005-06, KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.59 will carry SCSU hockey live over the radio (and on the web at www.1450knsi.com). Don Lyons will call the play-by-play with color commentary provided by SCSU All-American Dave Reichel. Home and away games will also be broadcast live on KVSC 88.1. You can also pick up KVSC on the web at www.kvsc.org

**HUSKIES BREAK TOP 15 FOR FIRST TIME IN 2005-06:** SCSU moved up to #15 in the USCHO.com poll this week. This is the first time the Huskies have been placed in the poll's top 15 this season, and the first top 15 national ranking by either poll since a 15th place ranking in both polls on March 8, 2004. The Huskies received 18 votes in the USA Today/American Hockey Magazine poll on Jan. 30. The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked teams this season including Wisconsin, Northern Michigan,



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

**THIRD STRAIGHT SWEEP:** SCSU gained its third consecutive WCHA sweep with a 6-1 victory over Alaska Anchorage on Feb. 4 in St. Cloud. SCSU scored three unanswered points in the first two periods to gain control of the game. SCSU started the scoring at 13:52 of the first period, as Andrew Gordon scored on a brilliant passing play from Brock Hooton. Justin Fletcher gained the second assist on the play. In the second period, SCSU built a 2-0 lead at 3:01 with a power play goal by John Swanson. He was assisted on the play by Konrad Reeder and Grant Clifton. WCHA Player of the Week Matt Hartman scored his third goal of the weekend with a score at 6:36 of the second. He was assisted on the play by Marty Mjelleli and Justin Fletcher.

UAA broke the shutout with a goal on the power play by Chris Tarkir. SCSU stopped the Seawolves' rally at 17:10 with a goal by Billy Hengen. Defender Casey Borer added the assist on the play. In the third period, Swanson collected his second goal of the night with a second power play goal at :56. Aaron Brocklehurst and Clifton gained the assists on the play. To end the attack, Borer carded his second goal of the season at 17:12 with assists from David Carlisle and Gordon. In the game, SCSU outshot UAA 46-23 and it was 2-of-6 on the power play. UAA was 1-of-6 on the power play, as SCSU goalie Bobby Goepfert made 22 saves in the game. On Feb. 3, SCSU gained a 4-2 victory over Alaska Anchorage in St. Cloud. Hartman provided two goals in the contest, as he scored the final goal of the game at 14:42 of the third period with assists from Nate Raduns and Nate Dey. The goal iced the game as UAA had moved within one goal at 6:39 of the second period on a power play tally by Mark Smith - which made it 3-2. Prior to that point, the game was dominated by the Huskies with three first period goals. Michael Olson scored the first goal of the night with his fourth goal of the season at 2:23. Marty Mjelleli and Aaron Brocklehurst each had assists on the play. UAA tied the game at 1-1 as Billy Smith scored unassisted at 4:26. Hartman posted his first goal of the night at 11:42 of the first period, with assists from Mjelleli and Brocklehurst. The eventual game winner was capped by Brocklehurst with a blast from the blueline, as power play assists were credited to Konrad Reeder and Grant Clifton. Brocklehurst's three points in the game are a career best for him at SCSU. In the nets, Bobby Goepfert gained his 13th win of the season with 13 saves. SCSU outshot the Seawolves 36-15 and SCSU was 1-of-6 on the power play. UAA ended at 1-of-2 on the power play.

**AMONG THE BEST:** SCSU has the nation's third longest winning streak at six games...the SCSU penalty kill unit ranks 11th in the nation at 85.7% (120/140)...the power play is 20.0% this season, and it ranks 12th in the nation...SCSU is the second least penalized team in the nation with 14.0 PIM per game...the Huskies rank ninth in the country with a 2.21 goals allowed rate per game...SCSU's Bobby Goepfert ranks sixth in the nation with a .929 save rate. He ranks seventh in the nation with a 1.97 GAA. He ranks second in the WCHA in both categories...Billy Hengen ranks eighth in the WCHA (overall games) with 20 assists this season...Andrew Gordon ranks 16th in the WCHA with 28 points this season...Justin Fletcher ranks 7th among WCHA defenders with 19 points this season.
