2005-06 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: March 14, 2006

PLAYOFF TIME: #18 St. Cloud State (20-15-4, 13-13-2 WCHA) will open the 2005-06 Red Baron WCHA Final Five with a game against #5 seed Minnesota Duluth (11-24-4, 6-19-3 WCHA) on Thursday, March 16 at 7:37 p.m. Of note, SCSU is the tourney's #4 seed. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.9 out of St. Cloud and SCSU's KVSC 88.1 FM. You can watch the game live on Fox Sports Net North, which is available in the St. Cloud area on Charter Cable channel 28. The game will also be available over the web at the WCHA website (www.wcha.com) via a live webcast. The winner of this game will advance to play #1 seed Minnesota (27-6-5, 20-5-3 WCHA) on Friday, March 17 at 7:37 p.m. at the Xcel Energy Center. #2 seed Wisconsin (25-9-3) will battle #3 seed North Dakota (25-15-1) at 2:37 p.m. on March 17. The winners on Friday will play for the Broadmoor Trophy and the Final Five title on Saturday, March 18 at 7:37 p.m. The third-place game will take place at 2:37 p.m. on March 18.

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 20-15-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (20-15-4, 13-13-2 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach

Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator and travel coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

OLYMPIC GLORY: Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97 and Bret Hedican (1988-91) were members of the USA Men's Olympic hockey team at the 2006 Winter Olympics. Former Husky Matt Cullen (1995-97) was also a member of the Team USA "taxi squad." Cullen travelled to Torino, Italy along with Parrish, Hedican and the rest of Team USA for this year's Olympics. This was the first Olympic experience for both Parrish and Cullen, while Hedican was a member of the 1992 USA hockey team at the Olympics in Albertville, France.

HUSKIES AT #18: SCSU moved to #18 in the USCHO.com poll this week. The Huskies also received votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey poll this week. SCSU was ranked #17 in this week's INCH poll. The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked teams this season including Wisconsin, Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College, Denver and North Dakota.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH: SCSU punched its ticket to the WCHA Final Five with a 3-1 win at Colorado College on March 12. Junior Nate Raduns gained the game winner with an unassisted rebound goal against CC at 6:50 of the third period. The goal broke a 1-1 tie, which was set up by a SCSU second period goal by Dan Kronick (assists went to Aaron Brocklehurst and Konrad Reeder) and a third period CC goal by Brett Sterling. To ice the game, Matt Stephenson scored SCSU's third goal at 15:29 of the third with assists from Nate Dey and Justin Fletcher. SCSU was outshot 32-25, but senior Bobby Goepfert was impressive with 31 saves in the game...in game two at CC, the Huskies suffered a 3-2 loss on March 11. SCSU gained a 2-0 lead with goals by Matt Hartman (8:37 of the first) and Brocklehurst (5:14 of the second), before CC posted three unanswered goals by Brian Salcido and Sterling in the second and Sterling in the third. CC outshot the Huskies 36-31 in the game, as Goepfert had 33 saves in the contest...SCSU got off to a strong start in the series with a 2-1 win over #9 ranked CC on March 10. CC gained a 1-0 lead at 6:10 of the first with a goal by Jimmy Kilpatrick. Reeder tied the game for SCSU with a goal at 9:06 of the first with assists going to Kronick and Brock Hooton. The game winner was marked at 1:27 of the second period when Michael Olson scored a shorthanded goal for SCSU. Raduns provided the assist on the play. The Huskies outshot CC in the match 34-26, as Goepfert made 25 saves in the game. Of note, SCSU was 1-of-13 on the power play in the three games, while CC was 2-of-13 on the advantage.

FINAL FIVE FACTS: The Huskies come into the WCHA Final Five at St. Paul with a 20-15-3 overall record. This marks the first time that SCSU has gained 20-plus wins since the Huskies notched a 29-11-2 in 2001-02. SCSU has charted 20-plus wins seven times since going to the Division I level in 1987-88, and the Huskies' best season record was a 31-9-1 run in 2000-01 – the lone season that SCSU has posted 30-plus wins in a season...the Huskies will be making their first appearance at the WCHA Final Five since the 2001-02 season. SCSU won the WCHA Final Five title in 2001, with a 6-5 OT win over North Dakota at the Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul. Former SCSU standout and current NHLer Tyler Arnason was the Final Five MVP that year...SCSU's first trip to the WCHA Final Five came in 1993-94, where they lost in the title game to Minnesota by a 3-2 score in OT. The Huskies have also advanced to the Final Five in 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2002...in the Final Five, the Huskies own a 5-10 overall record...this will mark Bob Motzko's first appearance at the Final Five, and the first appearance at the Final Five for any of the SCSU players or coaches currently on the Huskies' roster in 2005-06. In 15 games at the Final Five, SCSU has played in five overtime games. The Huskies have advanced to the championship game of the Final Five twice since 1994. The Huskies have made it to the third place game three times and in 2000, SCSU gained a 6-4 win over Minnesota in the third place game at the WCHA Final Five. The victory helped the Huskies secure its second-ever NCAA bid that season

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THE GOEPFERT WATCH: Bobby Goepfert is on track to set a few records this season between the pipes. He currently owns a 2.02 GAA and a .928 save rate. The team's current season record for GAA is 2.22, and that was set by Dean Weasler in 2001-02. Scott Meyer owns the team's save rate record of .926, which he hit in 2000-01.

HUSKIES SECURE TOP 6 FINISH: SCSU completed its 2005-06 regular season with an 18-14-4, 13-13-2 WCHA. SCSU placed sixth with 28 points, which is 11 points better than last year's ninth place finish in the league. Of note, the league's pre-season poll placed the Huskies in ninth place at the beginning of the 2005-06 campaign. Since 1996-97, the Huskies have finished lower than sixth place only twice. SCSU's best league regular season finishes were second place endings in 2001 and 2002.

RECORD PACE: The Huskies are on the verge of setting a new standard for team defense in 2005-06. This season, SCSU owns a 2.21 goals allowed rate. The team record for lowest goals allowed rate for SCSU was 2.22 in 2000-01 with 92 goals allowed. This season, SCSU has allowed 86 goals...the nation's leading team for the least amount of penalty minutes this winter, SCSU is also on the verge of setting a team season standard for the least amount of penalty minutes in a season. SCSU's current season total for PIM is 527 on 236 penalties. The previous team low was 559 PIM on 251 penalties in 2003-04...SCSU is tied with a team record this season for the fewest number of power play goals allowed in a season with 26. SCSU also allowed 26 power play goals in 1999-00.

TOUGH COMPETITION: The CC series marked the 11th week-end series of the season that SCSU has played a nationally ranked team. In those contests against nationally ranked squads, SCSU is 10-11-2 this year. SCSU has charted a win or tie against all of its nationally ranked opponents this season.

KRONICK PAIN FOR UMD: Dan Kronick, Konrad Reeder and Nate Raduns all have three game point scoring streaks going into the WCHA Final Five. On the subject of Kronick, he had four goals and two assists against his old teammates at UMD on Jan. 20-21 - which included a hat trick and one assist on Jan. 21. A transfer from UMD in 2004-05, Kronick is in his first season at SCSU. This past weekend, Kronick had one goal and three assists at CC. As a prep player at Holy Angels Academy, Kronick scored six goals in the MSHSL state class AA tournament at the Xcel as he captained his team to a state crown in 2002.

TIED RECORD: SCSU goalie Bobby Goepfert has already tied a team record in 2005-06 with four ties to his credit this winter. Other SCSU goalies to post four ties in a season were Jason Montgomery in 2002-03, Dean Weasler in 1998-99, Mike O'Hara in 1990-91 and Brian Leitza in 1995-96. Goepfert's 906 Saves this season ranks fourth best in team history. Brian Leitza set the team save record in a season with 1,041 saves in 1997-98. In the nation, Goepfert ranks fifth this season with a 2.02 GAA (2nd in the WCHA) and fifth with a .928 save rate (3rd in the WCHA).

AMONG THE BEST: SCSU ranks sixth in the nation and 2nd in the WCHA with a 2.21 goals allowed per game rate...the Huskies' penalty kill rate of 85.9% is 11th best in the nation and second best in the WCHA...SCSU has the least number of penalty minutes among NCAA squads this season at 13.5 PIM per game...Joe Jensen ranks sixth in the league with four game winning goals...Justin Fletcher ranks seventh among league defenders with 26 points (5g/21a)...Andrew Gordon, who leads SCSU in scoring with 35 points, ranks 11th in the WCHA this season with 18 goals...SCSU's top assist man is Billy Hengen, who ranks 16th in the WCHA with 22 assists this winter.

A RARE PENALTY SHOT: Michael Olson's penalty shot vs. CC on March 10, was the first penalty shot by a Husky since March 15, 1998, when Rob Klasnick missed on a penalty shot against MTU's Dave Wenniger at 19:41 of the third period. Olson's attempt at 11:14 of the third period was wide against CC's Matt Zaba.

In 1998, UMD lost to SCSU in the Thursday game by a 4-3 score at the Bradley Center in Milwaukee...Tim Stapleton leads the Bulldogs with 29 points (13g/16a), while Mason Raymond has 28 points (11g/17a)...the Bulldogs upset #2 seed Denver in the first round with a 3-2 OT win in game one and a 5-2 win in game three at DU. In game two, DU won 3-2...the Huskies posted a 4-2 and 6-3 win over the Bulldogs on Jan. 20-21 at the NHC - in the only meeting between these two teams in 2005-06...UMD is 4-14 in its last 18 outings this season and the win at DU on March 10 snapped a six-game losing skid for the Bulldogs...SCSU forward Dan Kronick is a transfer from UMD...SCSU leads the all-time series against the Bulldogs by a 43-32-5 margin. The first time these two ever played, the Huskies marked an 8-1 win in 1946-47.
