## 2005-06 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: March 6, 2006

**PLAYOFF TIME:** #20 St. Cloud State (18-14-4, 13-13-2 WCHA) will open the 2005-06 Red Baron WCHA Final Five playoffs with first round games at #9 Colorado College (23-13-2, 15-11-2 WCHA). The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.9 out of St. Cloud. The best-of-three series will be played on March 10-12 at the World Arena in Colorado Springs, Colo. Game time on March 10 is 8:37 p.m. (CT) and the games on March 11 and March 12 (if needed) would take place at 8:07 p.m. (CT). The winner of this best-of-three series will advance to the WCHA Final Five on March 16-18, at the Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul, Minn. This marks the second consecutive season that SCSU will travel to CC for first round play in the WCHA post-season tournament.

**2005-06 RESULTS:** SCSU is 18-14-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



**SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO:** Motzko (18-14-4, 13-13-2 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator and travel coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

**OLYMPIC GLORY:** Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97 and Bret Hedican (1988-91) were members of the USA Men's Olympic hockey team at the 2006 Winter Olympics. Former Husky Matt Cullen (1995-97) was also a member of the Team USA "taxi squad." Cullen travelled to Torino, Italy along with Parrish, Hedican and the rest of Team USA for this year's Olympics. This was the first Olympic experience for both Parrish and Cullen, while Hedican was a member of the 1992 USA hockey team at the Olympics in Albertville, France.

**HUSKY HOCKEY ON THE AIR:** Once again in 2005-06, KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.9 will carry SCSU hockey live over the radio (and on the web at www.1450knsi.com). Don Lyons will call the play-by-play with color commentary provided by SCSU All-American Dave Reichel..home and away games will also be broadcast live on KVSC 88.1. You can also pick up KVSC on the web at www.kvsc.org

**HUSKIES AT #20:** SCSU moved to #20 in the USCHO.com poll this week. The Huskies also received votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey poll this week. SCSU was ranked #19 in this week's INCH poll. The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked teams this season including Wisconsin, Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College, Denver and North Dakota.



**MORE NEWS AND NOTES...**

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

**TWO SETBACKS IN MADISON:** On March 4, SCSU lost a tough 3-1 decision against host #5/6 Wisconsin. Wisconsin gained the game's early lead with a goal at :51 of the first period by Joe Pavelski. Much like the opening period, Wisconsin posted a quick goal to start the second period. At the :12 mark of the second period, UW's Tom Gilbert notched an unassisted goal against SCSU. The score gave UW a 2-0 lead. The Huskies broke the shutout in the game at the :42 of the third period with a goal by sophomore forward Andrew Gordon. He was assisted on the play by senior forward Billy Hengen and Joe Jensen. The goal was Gordon's team-leading 18th of the season.

Wisconsin regained its momentum at 2:40 of the third period with a goal by Ryan McCurphy.... a third period goal by Wisconsin spelled a 1-0 loss for the #19 St. Cloud State on Friday, March 3 in Madison, Wis. In the first period, SCSU collected 12 shots on goal and the Huskies were 0-of-3 on the power play. UW had 11 shots on the net and was 0-of-1 on the power play. In the second period, the duel between the league's top two netminders continued as the Badgers outshot the Huskies 9-6. SCSU's Bobby Goepfert had 20 saves in the first two periods, while Brian Elliot had 18 saves for UW. In the third period, Wisconsin finally broke the shutout with a goal at 3:41 by Robbie Earl. He was assisted by Joe Pavelski and Adam Burish. In the contest, SCSU outshot the Badgers 27-26, as Goepfert had 25 saves in the game. On the power play, SCSU was 0-of-7 and UW was 0-of-4.

**TOUGH D:** The St. Cloud State defense ranks sixth in the nation and second in the WCHA with a 2.25 goals allowed per game rate in 2005-06. Of noter, upcoming opponent CC ranks fifth in the nation (and 2nd) in the WCHA) on offense with 3.58 goals per game. SCSU ranks 25th in the nation with an average of 3.08 goals per game...SCSU is the least penalized team in the nation with only 13.4 PIM per game. When the Huskies take a penalty, they have been tough on the PK, with an 11th place national ranking of .860 on the penalty kill...the man behind the mask, Bobby Goepfert ranks third in the WCHA and seventh in the nation with a .926 save rate. He is second in the league and sixth in the nation with a 2.06 GAA rate...Andrew Gordon ranks eighth in the league with 18 goals this season...Gordon and Dan Kronick both rank 11th in the league with seven PPG this season...Joe Jensen's four GWG ranks fourth best in the league this year...Justin Fletcher ranks seventh among WCHA blueliners with 25 points this season.

**THE GOEPFERT WATCH:** Bobby Goepfert is on track to set a few records this season between the pipes. He currently owns a 2.06 GAA and a .926 save rate. The team's current season record for GAA is 2.22, and that was set by Dean Weasler in 2001-02. Scott Meyer owns the team's save rate record of .926, which he hit in 2000-01.

**MORE NEWS AND NOTES...**

**THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzkko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Allenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

**HUSKIES SECURE TOP 6 FINISH:** SCSU completed its 2005-06 regular season with an 18-14-4, 13-13-2 WCHA. SCSU placed sixth with 28 points, which is 11 points better than last year's ninth place finish in the league. Of note, the league's pre-season poll placed the Huskies in ninth place at the beginning of the 2005-06 campaign. Since 1996-97, the Huskies have finished lower than sixth place only twice. SCSU's best league regular season finishes were second place endings in 2001 and 2002.

**WCHA PLAYOFF NOTES:** The SCSU men's hockey team will be back in Colorado Springs for the second year in a row for the first round of the WCHA playoffs. Last year, the Huskies lost an 8-2 and 4-2 pair of games in the first round at CC...SCSU is 19-13-0 in first-round WCHA playoff games since it joined the league in 1990-91 SCSU is 0-2 all-time against CC in the first round of the WCHA playoffs...the Huskies will be looking to gain their first trip to the WCHA Final Five since 2001-02. At the Final Five, the Huskies have qualified eight times and they are 5-10 at the WCHA Final Five. In 2001, the Huskies won the Broadmoor Trophy for the first and only time with a memorable 6-5 OT decision against North Dakota at the Xcel Energy Center.

**TOUGH COMPETITION:** The UW series marked the 10th weekend series of the season that SCSU has played a nationally ranked team. In those contests against nationally ranked squads, SCSU is 8-9-2 this year. SCSU has charted a win or tie against all of its nationally ranked opponents this season, including a 2-2 tie against the Badgers back on Oct. 21 in St. Cloud. The upcoming CC series will be the 11th weekend series this year that SCSU has played a nationally ranked squad.

**JENSEN HAS 93:** Senior forward Joe Jensen gained his 93rd career point in the loss to UW on March 4. He has 45 goals and 48 assists in his sterling career. He is now tied in the records at SCSU along with Peter Szabo, who had 23 goals and 70 assists in his storied career at SCSU from 2001-05. His point snapped a five-game scoreless streak, which wasa Jensen's longest stretch without a point in 2005-06.

**A PPG FOR GORDON:** SCSU wrapped up its 2005-06 regular season with a pair of losses at Wisconsin on March 3-4. SCSU lost by scores of 1-0 and 3-1, as sophomore Andrew Gordon prevented the double shutout on Saturday night with his 18th goal of the season. He leads the Huskies in scoring with 35 points (18g/17a). Gordon's 18 goals is the most posted by a SCSU player since Joe Motzko had 25 goals in 2002-03. Of note, Gordon has 27 goals and 25 assists during his career for 52 points. He also has 11 career power play goals, while Jeff Saterdalen owns the team record for PPG in a career with 40 from 1988-92. Of note, both Joe Jensen and Justin Fletcher are tied for 18th place in the team records with 14 power play goals apiece during their stellar careers at SCSU.

**HENGEN RANKS 24th:** Billy Hengen now has 54 career assists, which places him 24th in the team records. He moves ahead of former NHLer Fred Knipscheer, who had 53 assists from 1990-93.

**HUSKY FACTS:** SCSU's 1-0 setback against UW on March 3 marked the first shutout against the Huskies in 33 outings. The last time SCSU was shutout was on Oct. 14 at NMU...the last time that SCSU was shutout in a WCHA game was on 3/5/2005 at UND...SCSU's first trip to the WCHA Final Five was in 1993-94, when the Huskies advanced to the Final Five title game before losing a 3-2 OT decision to Minnesota. From 1996 to 2002, the Huskies made it to the Final Five seven consecutive seasons.
