The Huskies won that historic game by a 4-3 tally in double OT. In that contest, Mike Lee was the goalie of record for SCSU with 42 saves, while Travis Novak had a goal and Drew LeBlanc had two assists in that win on March 26, 2010.

Senior team captain and forward Drew LeBlanc needs just 13 more points to join the Huskies' elite 100-point club. LeBlanc has notched 28 goals and 59 assists during his career at SCSU. He would become the 23rd SCSU player (who played all of their games at the DI level) to join the 100 point club. LeBlanc has played in an amazing 121 consecutive games for the Huskies, and he has never missed a game during his entire collegiate career at SCSU.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA) placed eighth in the WCHA regular season standings. In first round play of the WCHA play-offs last year, the Huskies were eliminated in two games at Minnesota Duluth on March 11-12...SCSU received votes in the final USCHO.com Division I national poll of the 2010-11 season.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current national rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - received votes, USA Today/USAH Hockey: Received Votes...SCSU earned a 7th place ranking in the 2011-12 WCHA pre-season media poll and WCHA coaches' preseason poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show will broadcast live from the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud. Fans are encouraged to attend this show live at the Green Mill and admission is FREE. You can also listen to the show live on the web at www.knsi1450.com



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans were able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.knsi1450.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org) in 2011-12. KVSC's crew will be led by sports directors Dave Overlund and Zack Fisch.

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (St. Cloud Charter Cable Channel 87 in stunning HD). A select number of home games are slated to be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2011-12.

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2011-12, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. To learn more about this pay-per-view web service, please check out the Audio/Video link on the Husky Home Page.

COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by seventh-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include five-year veteran Mike Gibbons and second-year coach Steve Johnson. Matt Chapman will serve as the team's coordinator of hockey and video operations and Jeremiah Minkel is back once again as the team's equipment manager in 2011-12.

THE NATIONAL: St. Cloud State University will join the National Collegiate Hockey Conference in 2013-14. The Huskies accepted the invitation to join The National on Sept. 22, and they will join Colorado College, University of Denver, University of Minnesota Duluth, University of Nebraska Omaha, Miami University, University of North Dakota and Western Michigan as members of the new league. SCSU will remain as a member of the WCHA until the 2013-14 season. The Huskies became an NCAA Division I affiliate in 1987-88 and they joined the WCHA in 1990-91.

TOUGH SCHEDULE: SCSU was recognized as having one of the toughest schedules in all of Division I hockey latest season. The upcoming schedule appears to be just as strong. In 2011-12, the Huskies are scheduled to play 11 opponents (out of 15) that are ranked or received votes in this year's preseason polls. Top 10 ranked opponents for SCSU this winter include Denver, North Dakota, Colorado College and Minnesota Duluth. Northern Michigan received votes in the polls this week.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TOURNAMENT TIME: Junior netminder Mike Lee, senior forward Jared Festler and senior forward Travis Novak all earned All-Tournament honors at the Kendall Hockey Classic in Alaska last weekend. The Huskies posted a 1-1 record at the tournament, which included a 4-1 win over Alaska and a 4-3 OT loss against host Alaska Anchorage. Novak scored the game winner against UAF, while Festler had one goal and three assists over the weekend. Mike Lee allowed 5 goals in the two games and he had 51 saves to his credit. In his senior season at SCSU, Festler now has 31 goals and 38 assists in his career

FIRST TIMER: SCSU freshman defender Jarrob Rabey scored his first collegiate point with an assist on sophomore Nic Dowd's goal against Alaska Fairbanks on Oct. 7. Newcomers Jarrod Rabey, Joey Holka, Nick Oliver, Andrew Prochno and Garrett Milan all saw their first action as college hockey players at the Kendall Hockey Classic in Oct. 7-8

I AM IRONMAN: Senior captain Drew LeBlanc has played in 121 consecutive games as a Husky ... He has never missed a game during his entire collegiate career ... The current team record for consecutive games played at SCSU is 161 by Ryan Lasch from 2006-10 ... In those 121 games, LeBlanc has scored 28 goals and 59 assists ... He needs 13 more points this season to join the Husky 100-point club. LeBlanc earn All-WCHA notice as a junior and is a two-time All-WCHA Academic Award Winner. He was recently named as a candidate for the 2012 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award.

HOW WE FINISHED: The Huskies' goals against average of 2.83 for 2010-11 ranks 9th best in team history...SCSU's team save percentage of .907 ranks 10th best in team history...SCSU's 28.11 saves per game rate in 2010-11 ranks 8th best in team history... SCSU's total of 1,068 saves ranks 15th in the team records...the five tie games in 2010-11 is tied for second for most ties in a season by the Huskies (SCSU set a record with 7 ties in 2006-07)...SCSU posted its second fewest penalties in a season with 211 in 2010-11. The Huskies' penalty minute total of 466 is the second fewest number of PIMs in a season. The team low for penalties was set in 2007-08 at 194-437...Cam Reid's four game winning goals in 2010-11 is tied for 7th in the team records...Mike Lee's average of 29.15 saves per game in 2010-11 ranks 2nd in the team records behind Jake Moreland's 29.19 saves per game in 2002-03.

TIME CHANGE FOR 2011-12: A new feature for the Huskies in 2011-12 will be 7:37 pm starts at the NHC on Friday nights ... The only 7:07 pm start on Friday at the NHC in 2011-12 will be on Dec. 30, when the Huskies host Western Michigan during the week between Christmas and New Year's.

HUSKIES v. WILDCATS: The Huskies own a 21-15-1 record against Northern Michigan in the all-time series, which started in 1987-88 ... the last time the Huskies played NMU was at the 2010 NCAA West Regional in St. Paul ... The Huskies earned a 4-3 win in double overtime against NMU, which marked the first victory in NCAA tournament play for St. Cloud State ... the last time SCSU played a series in Marquette, Mich., the two teams split with NMU earning a 3-0 loss on Oct. 14, 2005 and a 3-2 OT win over NMU on Oct. 15, 2005 ... Of note, these were the first two games of Coach Bob Motzko's coaching career at SCSU...the Huskies will continue their hunt for Wildcats on Oct. 21-22, when they host the New Hampshire Wildcats at the NHC.

TEAM CAPTAINS: SCSU team captains for the 2011-12 season will be senior Drew LeBlanc, a forward from Hermantown; junior Ben Hanowski, a forward from Little Falls; and junior Mike Lee, a goalie from Roseau, Minn.

RANDOM NOTES: Mike Lee has made 20 starts in the last 21 games for the Huskies in the nets...Taylor Johnson equalled a career game-high with his two assists against UAA on Oct. 8. Johnson also had two helpers in a game against UND on Feb. 12, 2010... SCSU is now 4-3-0 in season openers during the Bob Motzko era...SCSU will face CCHA opponent Northern Michigan this weekend. The Huskies are 52-63-7 against CCHA clubs...SCSU's top scoring freshman in 2010-11 with 8g/21a, Cam Reid posted his first goal of the season with a PP goal at UAA on Oct. 8...SCSU's **Kevin Gravel** will be back in his home state this weekend. He is the only Husky from the Wolverine State and he hails from Kingsford, Mich. Gravel, the son of former SCSU standout Jim Gravel, played junior hockey with the Marquette Rangers (NAHL) in 2008-09. He is a 2010 draft pick of the Los Angeles Kings.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season seven with the Huskies in 2011-12. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. Motzko has charted an impressive 121-93-29 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional. Last year, Motzko led SCSU to a 15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA record.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United States Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

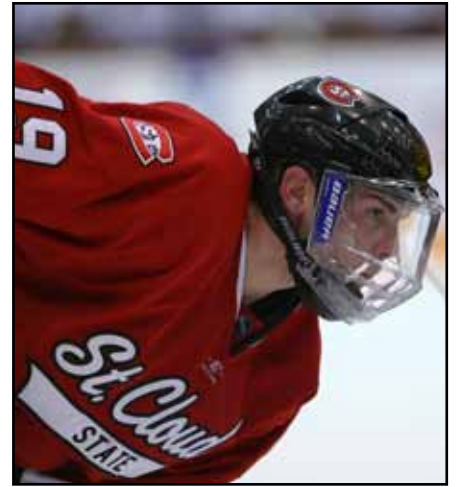
