ON THE ROAD TO MINNEAPOLIS

The #14/15 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (1-2-1, 0-0-0 WCHA) will open its 2010-11 WCHA campaign with a pair of games at the #20 University of Minnesota (2-2-0, 0-2-0 WCHA) on Oct. 22 and Oct. 24. The games will be played at Mariucci Arena (10,000 cap./200x100 in Minneapolis. The game on Oct. 22 will begin at 7:07 p.m. and the Oct. 24 game will start at 2:07 p.m. KCML FM 99.9 (www.lite999.com) will cover the game live with Don Lyons and the All-American Dave Reichel providing the call from the press box at the NHC. KVSC FM 88.1 will also carry the action live (www.kvsc.org) this weekend for the Huskies. Fans can watch the games live on Fox Sports North (Charter Cable Channel 28 in the St. Cloud area).

THE SCSU TIP SHEET:

■ *Last year, the Huskies posted a 4-3 at the NHC on Jan. 22. To complete the weekend sweep, the Huskies scored a 4-1 win at Minnesota on Jan. 23, 2010. Jared Festler scored 3g/1a in that big series vs. Minnesota last year. SCSU is 2-3-0 in the last five outings against the Gophers, and this will mark the lone regular season meeting between SCSU and UM in 2010-11.*

■ *Junior Drew LeBlanc, who ranked 4th on the team last year with a career season-high of 31 points (6g/25a) is off to a strong start this season with a team-high 4 points (1g/3a). He picked up his first goal of the season vs. Miami on Oct. 15.*

■ *The 1-1 tie on Oct. 16 helped the Huskies avoid being swept in a regular season weekend at home. The last time the Huskies were swept at home was on Dec. 7-8, 2007 with a pair of setbacks against Denver. The last time the Huskies were swept in a regular season weekend series was on Oct. 9-10, 2009, when they lost a pair at Miami U. In WCHA play, SCSU has not suffered a sweep since a pair of defeats against Minnesota on Jan. 16-17, 2009.*

■ *The SCSU Hockey Alumni Day has been set for Nov. 6 vs. Bemidji State. All former SCSU men's hockey players (all eras of SCSU hockey) are invited to attend the pre-game social at the Kelly Inn/Green Mill in St. Cloud along with the game that night vs. Bemidji State. ■ *Coach Bob Motzko served as an assistant head coach at Minnesota from 2001-2005 under Don Lucia.*

■ *Post-season honors candidate Garrett Roe has three assists this season and most recently charted his 90th career assist in the Huskies' game on Oct. 15 vs. Miami. He now ranks 4th in the team records along with Joe Motzko, who also had 90 helpers as a Husky from 1999-2003. Of note, Motzko is now playing pro hockey with Ingolstadt in Germany.*

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (24-15-5) placed third in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (15-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies won the first round of the WCHA playoffs vs. Minnesota State, and then placed 2nd at the WCHA Final Five. In NCAA tournament play, the Huskies scored a 4-3 double OT win vs. Northern Michigan at the West Regional, and then lost to Wisconsin by a 5-3 tally in the regional final. This was the 14th time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have finished above .500, and the 10th time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have finished above .500. This also marked the ninth time since 1993-94 that the Huskies have won 20-plus games.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current rankings for the Huskies: US-CHO.com - 14th, USA Today/USAH Hockey: 15th, INCH: 19th, CHN Pre-season: 6th...SCSU was ranked 2nd in the WCHA preseason coaches poll for 2010-11, and the Huskies earned a 3rd place ranking in the 2010-11 WCHA preseason media poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show is broadcast live from the Ground Round in St. Cloud.



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans will be able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.lite999.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org).

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Zach Fisch and former Husky legend Mike Doyle will provide play-by-play for Husky Productions this season.

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2010-11, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by sixth-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include four-year veteran Mike Gibbons and first-year coach Steve Johnson. Mike Ayers is in his 2nd year as the volunteer goalie coach at SCSU.

NEW FACE ON THE BENCH: Steve Johnson begins his first season at SCSU as an assistant coach. He previously served as head coach at Fargo in the USHL, and also served as head coach at Lincoln and Fargo-Moorhead of the USHL. He played college hockey at North Dakota and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist and was named the WCHA Student Athlete of the Year in 1988. Johnson replaces Eric Rud, who was named the head coach at Green Bay (USHL) during the summer of 2010.

ALUMNI DAY IS NOV. 6: The St. Cloud State University men's hockey alumni day has been set for Saturday, Nov. 6, when the Huskies host Bemidji State University for a 7:07 p.m. WCHA game at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud. MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

ABOUT LAST WEEK: In a big early season college hockey showdown, #10/11 St. Cloud State met up with #4 Miami at the National Hockey Center on Oct. 15-16. To open the weekend, the Huskies dropped a 6-3 decision vs. Miami. In that game, Drew LeBlanc gave the Huskies an early 1-0 lead before MU shot back with 6 unanswered goals. The Huskies got back into the game late with a pair of power play markers by rookies Nick Jensen and Mitch MacMillan...SCSU avoided the sweep on Oct. 16, thanks to a 1-1 tie against the RedHawks at the NHC. Miami scored its goal at 12:10 of the second period as Carter Camper broke the ice. SCSU's Jared Festler stepped into the spotlight in the third period with his game-tying goal at 13:38, as the assists were credited to LeBlanc and Jensen. A huge factor in the contest for the Huskies was the sterling play of senior netminder Dan Dunn, who chalked up 38 saves in the game. The tie snapped a six-game losing streak for the Huskies against Miami.

FIRST TIMERS AT SCSU: Husky freshmen Nick Jensen added his first goal as a Husky on Oct. 15 with a power play marker against Miami in the third period. Jensen now has 1g/2a this season and ranks 2nd on the team in scoring...freshman forward Mitch MacMillan also posted his first collegiate goal on Oct. 15 with a third period power play goal for the Huskies. MacMillan played junior hockey with Albemarle Valley of the BCHL...rookie defender Kevin Gravel coined his first collegiate point with a helper on Drew LeBlanc's goal in the first period on Oct. 15. Gravel is the son of Jim Gravel, who played college hockey for the Huskies from 1977-81.

FEW PIMS: The Huskies rank 46th in the nation for the least amount of penalty minutes this season with an average of 9.0 PIM per game.

TEAM NOTES: The Huskies own a two-game winning streak over Minnesota, and last year the Huskies posted a 4-1 win at Mariucci Arena...these mark the only two regular season games vs. the Gophers this season for the Huskies...junior Drew LeBlanc leads the Huskies with 4 points this season (1g/3a). He is trailed on the scoring chart by senior Garrett Roe and freshman Nick Jensen, both with three points...LeBlanc owns a three-game point streak headed into the UM series. LeBlanc hit a career season-high last year with 31 points and 25 assists. He is a graduate of Hermantown H.S. and he was named a 2010 WCHA Scholar-Athlete...Senior Chris Hepp didn't score his first point last year until a Jan. 30 game at Colorado College. Hepp didn't wait so long this season, as he charted an assist on LeBlanc's goal vs. Miami on Oct. 15. Hepp serves as a team alternate captain and he was also a 2010 WCHA Scholar-Athlete...sophomore Oliver Lauridsen added his first point of the new campaign with an assist on Oct. 15.

ON TARGET UPDATE: Senior Garrett Roe now has 145 career points thanks to his 1 assist vs. Miami. He now ranks 5th in the team charts for career points. Roe needs 38 points this winter to tie the team's all-time career point record of 183 set by Ryan Lasch from 2006-10. The assist vs. Miami was Roe's 90th assist as a Husky. He is the 5th SCSU player to score 90 assists in a career and he ranks 4th on the all-time assist list with Joe Motzko (1999-2003).

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season six with the Huskies in 2010-11. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. In five seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 106-76-25 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 69 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.
