2011-12 WCHA OPENER

The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (2-3-1, 0-0-0 WCHA) will open its 2011-12 season this weekend with a pair of dates at the University of North Dakota (2-3-1, 0-2-0 WCHA) on Oct. 28 (7:37 p.m.) and Oct. 29 (7:07 p.m.). Both games will be played at the Ralph Engelstad Arena (11,634 cap./200x100) in Grand Forks, N.D...Fans can listen to the games live on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com) with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel making the call from the Ralph...SCSU fans can also listen to the games live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org) with Zack Fisch and Dave Overlund calling the shots...the games will be televised live on Fox College Sports (channel 416 on Charter Cable in St. Cloud and 617 on DirectTV). You can also pick up a PPV webstream from the UND Athletics website.

SCSU BY THE NUMBERS

1947

The series between UND and SCSU started way back on Jan. 6, 1947, when Coach George Lynch and the Huskies posted an 8-1 win in Grand Forks. UND currently leads the all-time series by a 56-29-11 margin. Last year, the Huskies were 0-3-1 against UND, with SCSU falling 3-1 and 6-2 at the Ralph on Dec. 3-4, 2010. Back at the NHC, the Huskies posted a 3-3 tie on Feb. 18, 2011 and lost 3-2 on Feb. 19, 2011 at the NHC. UND will travel to SCSU during the 2011-12 season on Jan. 20-21. Both SCSU and UND will join the National Collegiate Hockey Conference in 2013-14.

Senior team captain and forward Drew LeBlanc leads the Huskies this season with 10 points and 8 assists. He enjoyed a big weekend vs. New Hampshire with 1g/4a to his credit and he now needs just 5 more points to join the Huskies' elite 100-point club. LeBlanc has notched 29 goals and 66 assists during his career at SCSU. He would become the 23rd SCSU player (who played all of their games at the DI level) to join the 100 point club. LeBlanc has played in an amazing 125 consecutive games for the Huskies, and he has never missed a game during his entire collegiate career at SCSU. LeBlanc also owns a 6-game point streak heading into this weekend.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA) placed eighth in the WCHA regular season standings. In first round play of the WCHA play-offs last year, the Huskies were eliminated in two games at Minnesota Duluth on March 11-12...SCSU received votes in the final USCHO.com Division I national poll of the 2010-11 season.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current national rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - Received votes, USA Today/USAH Hockey: did not receive votes...SCSU earned a 7th place ranking in the 2011-12 WCHA preseason media poll and WCHA coaches' preseason poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show will broadcast live from the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud. Fans are encouraged to attend this show live at the Green Mill and admission is FREE. You can also listen to the show live on the web at www.knsi1450.com



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans were able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.knsi1450.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org) in 2011-12. KVSC's crew will be led by sports directors Dave Overlund and Zack Fisch.

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (St. Cloud Charter Cable Channel 87 in stunning HD). A select number of home games are slated to be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2011-12. Jim Rich and Tom Satterdalen will be making the call from the NHC this season.

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2011-12, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. To learn more about this pay-per-view web service, please check out the Audio/Video link on the Husky Home Page.

COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by seventh-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include five-year veteran Mike Gibbons and second-year coach Steve Johnson and first-year volunteer goalie coach Dave Rogalski. Matt Chapman will serve as the team's coordinator of hockey and video operations and Jeremiah Minkel is back once again as the team's equipment manager in 2011-12.

THE NATIONAL: St. Cloud State University will join the National Collegiate Hockey Conference in 2013-14. The Huskies accepted the invitation to join The National on Sept. 22, and they will join Colorado College, University of Denver, University of Minnesota Duluth, University of Nebraska Omaha, Miami University, University of North Dakota and Western Michigan as members of the new league. SCSU will remain as a member of the WCHA until the 2013-14 season. The Huskies became an NCAA Division I affiliate in 1987-88 and they joined the WCHA in 1990-91.

TOUGH SCHEDULE: SCSU was recognized as having one of the toughest schedules in all of Division I hockey latest season. The upcoming schedule appears to be just as strong. In 2011-12, the Huskies are scheduled to play 11 opponents (out of 15) that are ranked or received votes in this year's preseason polls. Top 10 ranked opponents for SCSU this winter include Denver, North Dakota, Colorado College and Minnesota Duluth. UND is ranked #12/13 in this week's national polls.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

GOOD SHOWING: On Oct. 21-22, the Huskies earned a 7-5 win and a 3-3 tie against visiting New Hampshire. These games marked the home opener for the Huskies, and they also snapped a three-game losing streak for SCSU...these two games marked the first time New Hampshire has played at SCSU and it also marked the first time the Huskies have earned a win against UNH. The all-time series now stands at 1-1-1 against UNH... the Huskies broke open their offense on Oct. 21 with a 7-goal output, which included four power play goals. This was the most power play goals in a game since they charted four against Mercyhurst in 2008-09.

THE STREAK: Drew LeBlanc owns a six-game point streak headed into the UND series. LeBlanc leads the Huskies this winter with 8 assists and 10 points. In his career, LeBlanc is just five points away from joining SCSU's elite 100-point club. He would become the 23rd member of the 100-point club (all Division I games only) at SCSU. The Huskies' all-time leading scorer is Ryan Lasch, who had 183 points from 2006-10...he has played in 125 consecutive games at SCSU.

FIRST ONE: Rookie defender Andrew Prochno scored his first collegiate point with an assist vs. UNH on Oct. 21. He complete the weekend with another helper in the tie against UNH on Oct. 22. He played junior hockey last year at Sioux Falls in the USHL.

THE HIGH FLYERS: Ben Hanowski and Jared Festler, both grads of nearby Little Falls High School in Little Falls, Minn., rank second on the team with seven points apiece. Festler tops the Huskies this year with four goals. Festler's four-game point streak was halted on Oct. 21 when he was held off the scoresheet by UNH. He returned on Oct. 22 with a perfect one-timer that resulted in his fourth goal of the season vs. UNH.

THE PUCK STOPS HERE: Junior goalie Mike Lee gained the win on Oct. 21 with 28 saves and then was tested on Oct. 22 with 44 saves in the 3-3 tie vs. the Cats. This marked the most saves for Lee in a game since he netted 60 at UMD on March 12, 2011.

HUSKIES v. UND: The St. Cloud State men's hockey team will open play in the WCHA on Oct. 28-29 with a pair of road dates at North Dakota...the Huskies and UND have enjoyed a rich tradition in hockey dating back to an 8-1 win by the Huskies over North Dakota on Jan. 6, 1947 in Grand Forks, N.D...UND currently leads the all-time series by a 56-29-11 margin...last year, the Huskies were 0-3-1 against UND. In games played at the Ralph in 2010-11, the Huskies lost a 3-1 and 6-2 series on Dec. 3-4, 2010. Back at the NHC on Feb. 18, 2011, the Huskies posted a 3-3 tie and then lost 3-2 on Feb. 19, 2011...the last time SCSU charted a win in Grand Forks was a 3-2 victory on Nov. 14, 2009... SCSU is 0-4-1 in the last five games vs. UND and the Huskies are 2-7-1 in the last 10 meetings against UND.

CONNECTIONS: SCSU assistant coach Steve Johnson will enjoy a homecoming this weekend when the Huskies travel to Grand Forks. Johnson is a UND grad and he earned All-WCHA and All-America status during his playing career at UND from 1984 to 1988. Johnson was a Hobey Baker finalist and the WCHA Student-Athlete of the Year in 1988...SCSU sophomore Mitch MacMillan is the brother of UND rookie Mark MacMillan. Both are residents of Penticton, B.C.

TEAM CAPTAINS: SCSU team captains for the 2011-12 season will be senior Drew LeBlanc, a forward from Hermantown; junior Ben Hanowski, a forward from Little Falls; and junior Mike Lee, a goalie from Roseau, Minn.

RANDOM NOTES: Fans can watch these games from UND live on Fox College Sports Central on channel 617 DirecTV or channel 416 Charter Cable in St. Cloud...Travis Novak hit a career game-high with his three points (1g/2a) vs. UNH on Oct. 21...Ben Hanowski also hit a career game-high with his four points vs. UNH on Oct. 21, while Drew LeBlanc tied a career game-high with his 4 pointer vs. UNH on Oct. 21...Mitch MacMillan and Jordy Christian both notched their first points of the season vs. UNH on Oct. 21...SCSU has spread the wealth this season on the advantage with six different players accounting for the six power play goals posted by the Huskies this winter...the games at UND will mark the opening of the Huskies' WCHA season for 2011-12...both UND and SCSU will join the new NCHC in 2013-14...Cam Reid has 3g/3a this season, as he added 2g/2a to his totals last weekend vs. UNH...the Huskies will be back home on Nov. 4-5 for a pair of WCHA matches against Wisconsin.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season seven with the Huskies in 2011-12. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. Motzko has charted an impressive 122-95-30 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional. Last year, Motzko led SCSU to a 15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA record.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United States Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by Mike Gibbons and Steve Johnson. SCSU's support staff features equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and Coordinator of Hockey and Video Operations Matt Chapman.
