## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**LAST YEAR:** The Huskies (15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA) placed eighth in the WCHA regular season standings. In first round play of the WCHA play-offs last year, the Huskies were eliminated in two games at Minnesota Duluth on March 11-12...SCSU received votes in the final USCHO.com Division I national poll of the 2010-11 season.

**POLL POSITION:** Here are the current national rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - Received votes, USA Today/USAH Hockey: did not receive votes...SCSU earned a 7th place ranking in the 2011-12 WCHA preseason media poll and WCHA coaches' preseason poll.

**THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show will broadcast live from the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud. Fans are encouraged to attend this show live at the Green Mill and admission is FREE. You can also listen to the show live on the web at [www.knsi1450.com](http://www.knsi1450.com)



**ON THE AIR:** All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans were able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at [www.knsi1450.com](http://www.knsi1450.com). Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 ([www.kvsc.org](http://www.kvsc.org)) in 2011-12. KVSC's crew will be led by sports directors Dave Overlund and Zack Fisch.

**LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD:** All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (St. Cloud Charter Cable Channel 87 in stunning HD). A select number of home games are slated to be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2011-12. Jim Rich and Tom Saterdalen will be making the call from the NHC this season.

**WATCH ON THE WEB:** Once again in 2011-12, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. To learn more about this pay-per-view web service, please check out the Audio/Video link on the Husky Home Page.

**COACHING STAFF:** SCSU will be led this season by seventh-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include five-year veteran Mike Gibbons and second-year coach Steve Johnson and first-year volunteer goalie coach Dave Rogalski. Matt Chapman will serve as the team's coordinator of hockey and video operations and Jeremiah Minkel is back once again as the team's equipment manager in 2011-12.

**THE NATIONAL:** St. Cloud State University will join the National Collegiate Hockey Conference in 2013-14. The Huskies accepted the invitation to join The National on Sept. 22, and they will join Colorado College, University of Denver, University of Minnesota Duluth, University of Nebraska Omaha, Miami University, University of North Dakota and Western Michigan as members of the new league. SCSU will remain as a member of the WCHA until the 2013-14 season. The Huskies became an NCAA Division I affiliate in 1987-88 and they joined the WCHA in 1990-91.

**TOUGH SCHEDULE:** SCSU was recognized as having one of the toughest schedules in all of Division I hockey latest season. The upcoming schedule appears to be just as strong. In 2011-12, the Huskies are scheduled to play 11 opponents (out of 15) that are ranked or received votes in this year's preseason polls. Top 10 ranked opponents for SCSU this winter include Denver, North Dakota, Colorado College and Minnesota Duluth. Bemidji State is not ranked in the national polls this week.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**ONE IN OMAHA:** The Huskies avoid a sweep at UNO with a 2-2 tie on Nov. 27. SCSU opened the series on Nov. 26 with a 4-3 loss at UNO. Travis Novak charted four assists in the two games, including an assist on Ben Hanowski's game-tying goal at 18:53 of the 2nd period on Nov. 27. Novak now has 4g/7a this season. Hanowski also had one goal on Nov. 26 along with Cory Thorson and Cam Reid. SCSU's first goal of the day on Nov. 27 was tallied by rookie forward Brooks Bertsch, his second of the season. Goalie Ryan Faragher saw action in both games with 34 saves on Nov. 26 and 26 saves on Nov. 27. Faragher played a key role in preserving the tie as he had 14 saves in the third period and one save in the OT session on Nov. 27. The Huskies hit a season game-low with only one penalty for two minutes on Nov. 27. SCSU only took three penalties in the two games at UNO.

**HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS:** Much like the old seasonal standard, the St. Cloud State University men's hockey team will be heading back home for the holidays. After playing 11 of its first 16 games on the road, the Huskies will finish out the 2011 portion of its schedule with three series on home ice. SCSU starts the homestand with a pair of dates against Bemidji State on Dec. 2-3. The Huskies will then enjoy a bye week before returning to action with home games against Denver on Dec. 16-17. To complete the homestand, SCSU will host non-conference rival Western Michigan on Dec. 29-30...the Huskies have enjoyed their home cooking with a 3-0-2 record at the NHC in 2011-12.

**RANDOM NOTES:** Ben Hanowski posted goals in both games at Omaha on Nov. 26-27. Hanowski continues to lead the Huskies this year in goals (10) and points (18)...senior forward Jared Festler, a high school teammate of Hanowski's at nearby Little Falls H.S., paces the Huskies this winter with a +9 on the plus/minus. Festler added one assist this weekend at UNO and now ranks second on the club with 13 points (7g/6a)...sophomore Cam Reid also ranks second on the team this year with 13 points through 16 games. Reid posted one goal this weekend and now has 5g/8a in 2011-12.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Huskies have been racking up the travel miles in the early portion of the 2011-12 season, SCSU's schedule will see the Huskies on the road for 11 of its first 16 games of the 2011-12 season...On Nov. 26-27, the Huskies will travel to Nebraska-Omaha for a pair of games.

**THE MIGHTY THOR(SON):** Sophomore Cory Thorson only notched one assist in 12 games played as a rookie in 2010-11 at SCSU. He has enjoyed a breakout season in 2011-12 with four goals and three assists in 16 games played...freshman netminder Ryan Faragher carded 26 saves in SCSU's 2-2 tie at UNO on Nov. 27. He was impressive down the stretch in the contest with 14 saves in the third period and one save in the OT session against the Mavs. Faragher has notched 30-plus saves in six games this season and currently has compiled 339 saves in 662:19 minutes of play. His goals against average is 2.81 and his saves rate stands at .916.

**WHERE THEY RANK:** Ben Hanowski ranks fourth in the WCHA (league games only) with eight goals to his credit...Ryan Faragher's 319 saves ranks 1st best among WCHA goalies this season (league games only). Faragher ranks 4th in the league with a .919 save rate and fifth with a 2.78 GAA in league play...the Huskies rank second in the WCHA with 168 penalty minutes in 2011-12 (16.8 minutes per game) - SCSU only had 6 PIM in the two games at UNO this past weekend to move out of the top spot. UAA now ranks 1st in the WCHA with 186 PIM (18.6 PIM/G).

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** SCSU team captains for the 2011-12 season will be senior Drew LeBlanc, a forward from Hermantown; junior Ben Hanowski, a forward from Little Falls; and junior Mike Lee, a goalie from Roseau, Minn.

**BSU CONNECTION:** BSU head coach Tom Serratore served as an assistant coach at SCSU during the 1990s for head coach Craig Dahl...SCSU assistant coach Mike Gibbons played college hockey at BSU and later served as the Beavers' assistant and head coach in the early 1980s...SCSU TV color analyst Tom Saterdalen is a BSU graduate and played hockey at BSU and was a team captain in 1963-64. Both Gibbons and Saterdalen are members of the BSU Athletic Hall of Fame.

### The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season seven with the Huskies in 2011-12. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. Motzko has charted an impressive 126-99-32 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional. Last year, Motzko led SCSU to a 15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA record.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United States Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**MOTZKO'S STAFF:** Motzko will be assisted this winter by Mike Gibbons, Steve Johnson and Dave Rogalski. SCSU's support staff features equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and Coordinator of Hockey and Video Operations Matt Chapman.
