The #20 St. Cloud State University (3-4-1, 1-1-0 WCHA) will host new WCHA rival Bemidji State University (0-3-1, 0-3-1 WCHA) on Friday, Nov. 5 and Saturday, Nov. 6 at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100) in St. Cloud, Minn. ## SCSU BY THE NUMBERS

**11** The Huskies own an 11-1-0 record against Bemidji State as an NCAA Division I affiliate. This will mark the first time that SCSU and BSU have played each other as WCHA opponents. The last time SCSU and BSU played in conference games was during the 1986-87 season, when both clubs were members of the NCHA. In its final game as an NCAA Division III affiliate, the Huskies posted a 6-4 victory over Bemidji State in the 3rd place game at the 1987 NCAA DIII championships.

**6** Nov. 6 has been set as SCSU Hockey Alumni Day. All former SCSU men's hockey players (all eras of SCSU hockey) are invited to attend the pre-game social at the Kelly Inn/Green Mill in St. Cloud along with the game that night vs. Bemidji State. # St. Cloud State University Hockey Update

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**LAST YEAR:** The Huskies (24-15-5) placed third in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (15-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies won the first round of the WCHA playoffs vs. Minnesota State, and then placed 2nd at the WCHA Final Five. In NCAA tournament play, the Huskies scored a 4-3 double OT win vs. Northern Michigan at the West Regional, and then lost to Wisconsin by a 5-3 tally in the regional final. This was the 14th time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have finished above .500, and the 10th time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have finished above .500. This also marked the ninth time since 1993-94 that the Huskies have won 20-plus games.

**POLL POSITION:** Here are the current rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - 20th, USA Today/USAH Hockey: Not Ranked, INCH: RV, CHN Preseason: 6th...SCSU was ranked 2nd in the WCHA preseason coaches poll for 2010-11, and the Huskies earned a 3rd place ranking in the 2010-11 WCHA preseason media poll.

**THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show is broadcast live from the Ground Round in St. Cloud.



**ON THE AIR:** All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 ([www.kvsc.org](http://www.kvsc.org)).

**LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD:** All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Zach Fisch and former Husky legend Mike Doyle will provide play-by-play for Husky Productions this season.

**WATCH ON THE WEB:** Once again in 2010-11, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. **COACHING STAFF:** SCSU will be led this season by sixth-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include four-year veteran Mike Gibbons and first-year coach Steve Johnson. Mike Ayers is in his 2nd year as the volunteer goalie coach at SCSU.

**NEW FACE ON THE BENCH:** Steve Johnson begins his first season at SCSU as an assistant coach. He previously served as head coach at Fargo in the USHL, and also served as head coach at Lincoln and Fargo-Moorhead of the USHL. He played college hockey at North Dakota and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist and was named the WCHA Student Athlete of the Year in 1988. Johnson replaces Eric Rud, who was named the head coach at Green Bay (USHL) during the summer of 2010.

**ALUMNI DAY IS NOV. 6:** The St. Cloud State University men's hockey alumni day has been set for Saturday, Nov. 6, when the Huskies host Bemidji State University for a 7:07 p.m. WCHA game at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud. ## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**ABOUT LAST WEEK:** In non-conference action vs. Quinnipiac at the NHC, the Huskies dropped a 4-2 match on Oct. 29 and then rebounded with a big 5-2 win on Oct. 30. In the victory, Drew LeBlanc set a career game-high with 4 assists, including a team record 3 helpers in the third period alone. Aaron Marvin two goals in the contest, while Cam Reid had the game winner in the 3rd period followed by goals from Chris Hepp and Jared Festler. Dan Dunn was the goalie of record with a solid 32 saves in the win. On Oct. 29, Reid and Taylor Johnson both scored on the power play as QU posted three goals in the 3rd to wipe out a 2-1 Husky lead. Mike Lee made 21 saves in the game for the Huskies. SCSU's strong second period was highlighted by the defense allowing QU to just one shot on goal in the period. This marked the first win for QU vs. SCSU, and the all-time series now stands at 3-1-0 in favor of the Huskies.

**FIRST ONE:** Rookie forward Cam Reid scored his first collegiate goal on Oct. 29 with a power play tally vs. Quinnipiac. Reid then added his first game-winner on Oct. 30 with a goal at 6:39 of the third period vs. Quinnipiac. Reid completed the weekend with an assist on Chris Hepp's goal. He now has 2g/2a this year.

**IN A GROOVE:** Senior defender Chris Hepp (Savage) is enjoying an offensive surge in 2010-11. After posting just 2 assists in 42 games last year, Hepp already has 3 points to his credit in 8 games this season. On Oct. 30, Hepp added his first goal of the campaign vs. Quinnipiac. This marked the first goal for Hepp since he scored one against Robert Morris on Nov. 8, 2008 at the NHC.

**POWER ON:** Senior Aaron Marvin broke into the SCSU scoring column this weekend with an assist on Oct. 29, and two goals on Oct. 30. Marvin scored the first two goals of the game in SCSU's win on Oct. 30, and he now has 59 points (20g/29a) in 124 career games as a Husky. Marvin also serves as a Husky team captain in 2010-11.

**TEAM NOTES:** Rookie defender Nick Jensen (Rogers) ranks second this season for SCSU with 7 points (1g/6a). He continued his rookie year barrage with three assists in play against Quinnipiac...senior goalie Dan Dunn (Oshawa, Ont.) collected his first win of the season with a 32 save effort against Quinnipiac on Oct. 30. Dunn now has a 2.51 GAA and a .919 save rate this winter...sophomore defender Taylor Johnson (Hugo) added his first goal of the season on Oct. 29.

**ON TARGET UPDATE:** Senior Garrett Roe now has 148 career points thanks to his 1g/2a vs. Minnesota. He now ranks 5th in the team charts for career points. Roe needs 35 points this winter to tie the team's all-time career point record of 183 set by Ryan Lasch from 2006-10. He is the 5th SCSU player to score 90 assists in a career and he ranks 4th on the all-time assist list with 92.

**BEMIDJI STATE 101:** The the last time BSU and SCSU played, the Huskies split in Bemidji with a 4-2 loss on Nov. 24, 2008 and a 5-3 win on Nov. 25, 2008...the last time the Huskies played BSU in St. Cloud, SCSU charted a 2-1, 6-1 sweep on Oct. 26-27, 2007...in their final game as an NCAA Division III affiliate, the Huskies posted a 6-4 win over Bemidji State in the consolation game at the 1987 NCAA DIII championships...in four games played against the Beavers during his career, SCSU senior Garrett Roe has posted 4g/3a for 7 points.

**ON DECK:** The six-game home stand, the longest of the 2010-11 season, will continue on Nov. 12-13 with two conference home dates against league newcomer Nebraska Omaha. The games at the NHC will start at 7:07 p.m. each night. Call 1-877-SCSUTIX or 320-308-2137 for all the details on tickets for these big games.

### The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season six with the Huskies in 2010-11. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. In five seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 108-78-25 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

Home ice was kind to the Huskies last winter, as they owned a 12-4-5 record in 2009-10 at the NHC. The Huskies are 242-128-42 since the doors opened at the NHC in 1989. SCSU is 1-2-1 at the NHC in 2010-11.

The SCSU captain for 2010-11 will be senior forward Aaron Marvin. He is the grandson of U.S. Hockey Hall of Famer Cal Marvin and the brother of Gigi Marvin, a member of the 2010 USA Olympic women's hockey team. The SCSU alternate captains in 2010-11 will be senior forward Garrett Roe and senior defender Chris Hepp. Of note, Hepp played his first year of college hockey at Air Force before making the transfer to SCSU.

Last year marked the 8th time in team history that the Huskies have gained an NCAA tournament bid. This was also the third bid for the Huskies during the Bob Motzko era, and the Huskies' 7th NCAA trip since 2000. Last year, the Huskies advanced to the NCAA quarterfinals thanks to a 2OT victory over Northern Michigan (4-3) in first round play at the Xcel EC.
