MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA) placed eighth in the WCHA regular season standings. In first round play of the WCHA play-offs last year, the Huskies were eliminated in two games at Minnesota Duluth on March 11-12...SCSU received votes in the final USCHO.com Division I national poll of the 2010-11 season.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current national rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - did not receive votes, USA Today/USAH Hockey: did not receive votes...SCSU earned a 7th place ranking in the 2011-12 WCHA preseason media poll and WCHA coaches' preseason poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show will broadcast live from the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud. Fans are encouraged to attend this show live at the Green Mill and admission is FREE. You can also listen to the show live on the web at www.knsi1450.com



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans were able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.knsi1450.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org) in 2011-12. KVSC's crew will be led by sports directors Dave Overlund and Zack Fisch.

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (St. Cloud Charter Cable Channel 87 in stunning HD). A select number of home games are slated to be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2011-12. Jim Rich and Tom Saterdalen will be making the call from the NHC this season.

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2011-12, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. To learn more about this pay-per-view web service, please check out the Audio/Video link on the Husky Home Page.

COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by seventh-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include five-year veteran Mike Gibbons and second-year coach Steve Johnson and first-year volunteer goalie coach Dave Rogalski. Matt Chapman will serve as the team's coordinator of hockey and video operations and Jeremiah Minkel is back once again as the team's equipment manager in 2011-12.

THE NATIONAL: St. Cloud State University will join the National Collegiate Hockey Conference in 2013-14. The Huskies accepted the invitation to join The National on Sept. 22, and they will join Colorado College, University of Denver, University of Minnesota Duluth, University of Nebraska Omaha, Miami University, University of North Dakota and Western Michigan as members of the new league. SCSU will remain as a member of the WCHA until the 2013-14 season. The Huskies became an NCAA Division I affiliate in 1987-88 and they joined the WCHA in 1990-91.

TOUGH SCHEDULE: SCSU was recognized as having one of the toughest schedules in all of Division I hockey latest season. The upcoming schedule appears to be just as strong. In 2011-12, the Huskies are scheduled to play 11 opponents (out of 15) that are ranked or received votes in this year's preseason polls. Top 10 ranked opponents for SCSU this winter include Denver, North Dakota, Colorado College and Minnesota Duluth. Denver is ranked #13/14 in this week's polls.

YOUTH HOCKEY NIGHTS AT THE NHC: As a special salute to youth hockey, the Huskies will host four Youth Hockey Nights at the NHC on Dec. 16-17 and Dec. 29-30. All youth hockey players who wear their team jersey to the game on those nights will receive free admission when accompanied by a paid adult. LAST TIME OUT: Last weekend, the Huskies enjoyed a bye week on Dec. 9-10. The last time on ice, SCSU skated to a 6-6 tie and a 3-1 loss at home against WCHA foe Bemidji State. In an offensive slugfest, the Huskies notched six goals against BSU on Dec. 2. Ben Hanowski scored two goals, while Travis Novak (1g/2a) and Andrew Prochno (3a) added three point nights for the Huskies. SCSU's other goals were added by Nick Oliver, Taylor Johnson and Jordy Christian. Ryan Faragher made 19 saves in the contest, including five big stops in the OT session to preserve the tie...on Dec. 3, the Huskies outshot the Beavers 34-14 but it wasn't enough to offset Bemidji's three goals. SCSU started the game with a goal by Oliver but BSU charged back with two goals in the first and one in the third to win the game.

FIRST TIME: Nick Oliver earned his first collegiate points in play against BSU. On Dec. 2, Oliver posted his first collegiate goal at 11:31 of the first period. He also added his 2nd collegiate goal in play against BSU on Dec. 3...teammates Taylor Johnson and Jordy Christian also broke into the goal column for the first time this season on Dec. 2. A junior defender, Johnson scored at 15:45 of the first to give the Huskies a 3-1 lead. In the third period, Christian, a senior forward, posted SCSU's 6th goal of the evening with his first marker of the year.

STREAK STOPPER: The Huskies ran to a 3-0-3 record this season at home before suffering their first defeat on the NHC ice on Dec. 3, with a 3-1 setback against BSU. SCSU is now 3-1-3 at the NHC this year and the Huskies are 3-7-1 in games played on the road... here's another odd fact, SCSU is 3-0-0 when they chart 20-or-less shots in a game this year and the Huskies are 2-3-0 when they 30-or-more shots in a game this year.

PLAYMAKER: Freshman Andrew Prochno became the second SCSU player in 2011-12 to earn a Playmaker. Prochno hit a career game-high with his three assists in the 6-6 tie against BSU on Dec. 2. On the season, Prochno is making good strides with 3g/6a for nine points.

CENTER OF ATTENTION: Senior Travis Novak has enjoyed his recent move to the center position. In the last four games, Novak has been on fire. After back-to-back two assist games at Nebraska-Omaha, Novak carded one goal and two assists in the opener against Bemidji State on Dec. 2. He was held off the scoresheet on Dec. 3, but in the last four games, Novak has recorded one goal and six assists for a total of 7 points. On the season, Novak now ranks 2nd on the team with 14 points (5g/9a).

WHERE THEY RANK: Ben Hanowski ranks fifth in the WCHA (league games only) with 10 goals to his credit...Ryan Faragher's 349 saves ranks 4th best among WCHA goalies this season (league games only). Faragher ranks 7th in the league with a .904 save rate and ninth with a 3.05 GAA in league play...the Huskies rank 7th in the WCHA with 180 penalty minutes in 2011-12 (15.0 minutes per game) - SCSU only had 18 PIM in the last four games to move rapidly down after ranking first three weeks ago. Minnesota now ranks 1st in the WCHA with 236 PIM (16.9 PIM/G).

TEAM CAPTAINS: SCSU team captains for the 2011-12 season will be senior Drew LeBlanc, a forward from Hermantown; junior Ben Hanowski, a forward from Little Falls; and junior Mike Lee, a goalie from Roseau, Minn. Senior Jordy Christian has also been designated as an alternate captain for the Huskies in 2011-12.

DENVER CONNECTION: SCSU head coach Bob Motzko and assistant coach Mike Gibbons have both served as assistant coaches at Denver during their college hockey careers. Motzko was an associate head coach at Denver from 1993-94, while Gibbons worked as an assistant for the Pioneers from 1990 to 1994...Denver's veteran sports information director Erich Bacher learned the from the best during his tenure as a graduate assistant in the SCSU Athletic Media Relations department back in the 1990s.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season seven with the Huskies in 2011-12. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. Motzko has charted an impressive 126-100-33 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional. Last year, Motzko led SCSU to a 15-18-5, 11-13-4 WCHA record.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United States Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by Mike Gibbons, Steve Johnson and Dave Rogalski. SCSU's support staff features equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and Coordinator of Hockey and Video Operations Matt Chapman.
