SCSU BY THE NUMBERS

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**LAST YEAR:** The Huskies (24-15-5) placed third in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (15-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies won the first round of the WCHA playoffs vs. Minnesota State, and then placed 2nd at the WCHA Final Five. In NCAA tournament play, the Huskies scored a 4-3 double OT win vs. Northern Michigan at the West Regional, and then lost to Wisconsin by a 5-3 tally in the regional final. This was the 14th time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have finished above .500, and the 10th time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have finished above .500. This also marked the ninth time since 1993-94 that the Huskies have won 20-plus games.

**POLL POSITION:** Here are the current rankings for the Huskies: US-CHO.com - Not ranked, USA Today/USAH Hockey: Not Ranked, INCH: Not Ranked, CHN Preseason: 6th...SCSU was ranked 2nd in the WCHA preseason coaches poll for 2010-11, and the Huskies earned a 3rd place ranking in the 2010-11 WCHA preseason media poll.

**THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show is broadcast live from the Ground Round in St. Cloud.



**ON THE AIR:** All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans will be able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at [www.lite999.com](http://www.lite999.com). Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 ([www.kvsc.org](http://www.kvsc.org)).

**LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD:** All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Zach Fisch and former Husky legend Mike Doyle will provide play-by-play for Husky Productions this season. A select number of home games will also be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2010-11. The games include MSU (Jan. 28-29), UND (Feb. 19) and UW (Feb. 25-26).

**WATCH ON THE WEB:** Once again in 2010-11, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. **COACHING STAFF:** SCSU will be led this season by sixth-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include four-year veteran Mike Gibbons and first-year coach Steve Johnson. Mike Ayers is in his 2nd year as the volunteer goalie coach at SCSU.

**NEW FACE ON THE BENCH:** Steve Johnson begins his first season at SCSU as an assistant coach. He previously served as head coach at Fargo in the USHL, and also served as head coach at Lincoln and Fargo-Moorhead of the USHL. He played college hockey at North Dakota and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist and was named the WCHA Student Athlete of the Year in 1988. Johnson replaces Eric Rud, who was named the head coach at Green Bay (USHL) during the summer of 2010.

**FACTS AND FIGURES:** Tony Mosey and Jared Festler each lead the Huskies this season with three power play goals apiece...SCSU is 4-4-1 this year when the Huskies score on the power play. SCSU was 0-of-6 on the PP during the weekend at UND...SCSU is 4-0-1 when the Huskies 4-or-more goals this season...Bob Motzko is 8-8-3 in games played against Colorado College during his career at SCSU...Drew LeBlanc leads the Huskies with five multi-point games this season.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Huskies suffered a pair of losses at #7 North Dakota last weekend. On Dec. 3, the Huskies gave up two third period goals in a 3-1 loss vs. UND. To complete the weekend, SCSU dropped a 6-2 decision at UND on Dec. 4. Drew LeBlanc scored SCSU's lone goal on Dec. 3, with an assist from Brett Barta at 13:53 of the first period. UND tied the game in the second period and added two more in the third. Mike Lee charted 31 saves in the game for the Huskies...on Dec. 4, UND charged to a 5-0 lead in the first period before the Huskies' Mitch MacMillan broke the shutout at 3:58 of the third period. Brian Volpei and Nick Jensen posted assists on the play. The other SCSU goal in the contest was charted by Travis Novak at 12:35 of the third with helpers from Taylor Johnson and Oliver Lauridsen. Dan Dunn was the goalie of record for SCSU with 15 saves, while Lee had 18 saves in a relief effort. Of note, this marked the first time since a pair of losses at Miami on Oct. 9-10, 2009 that the Huskies were swept in a weekend series...the one penalty called against UND on Dec. 3 marked the fewest penalties called against a SCSU opponent since one penalty was called on Feb. 9, 2008 at Colorado College. .

**TEAM LEADER:** Junior Drew LeBlanc scored SCSU's lone goal on Dec. 3, which was 6th goal of the season. LeBlanc leads the team in the top offensive categories this winter with 6 goals (tied with junior forward Jared Festler), 12 assists and 18 points. LeBlanc now has 20 goals and 64 points in his three years at SCSU. A math education major, LeBlanc earned All-WCHA Academic Team honors and WCHA Scholar-Athlete notice in 2010.

**NEW FACES MAKE IMPACT:** Rookie defender Nick Jensen scored his 10th point as a Husky on Dec. 4, with an assist on Mitch MacMillan's goal in the third period. This was Jensen's 8th assist of the season and it was MacMillan's first goal since he scored against Miami on Oct. 15.

**TOUGH COMPETITION:** The Huskies have skated against five opponents ranked among the nation's top 20 teams so far this season (9-of-16 games have been played against ranked teams this winter).

**HUSKY NOTES:** Junior Travis Novak posted his third goal of the season on Dec. 4, while assists on that play were coined by Taylor Johnson and Oliver Lauridsen. The helper snapped a six-game point scoring drought for Lauridsen...the 15 shots on goal posted by SCSU on Dec. 4 at UND were the lowest number of shots for the Huskies in a game since they had 15 shots on goal in a 2-1 loss at home against Wisconsin on Feb. 29, 2008...the five goals allowed by the Huskies in the first period on Dec. 4 were the most allowed by the Huskies in a period since they gave up a team record six goals in the second period against UND on Feb. 13, 2010 at the NHC...senior Garrett Roe leads the team this winter with 51 shots on goal for the Huskies...did you know that Dan Dunn ranks 11th in the team record with 1,037 career saves and Mike Lee ranks 12th with 1,026 saves. Lee ranks 6th in team history with a career save rate of .910, while Dunn ranks 8th at .909 as a Husky...SCSU assistant coach Mike Gibbons served as an assistant coach at Colorado College from 1988-90.

**ON DECK:** SCSU will not play for two weekends after the series against Colorado College. The Huskies will return to the ice on Dec. 29-30, for a pair of games down south at the Florida College Hockey Classic in Estero, Fla. This will mark the Huskies' third trip to the tournament, as the Huskies played in the Florida tournament in 2004-05 and 2008-09. SCSU is 0-2-2 in games played at the tournament. SCSU will open tournament play on Dec. 29 with a game against Cornell. Maine and Miami will complete the tournament field in Florida.

**WATCH IN THE TWIN CITIES:** In an exciting new development, select SCSU men's hockey games on Husky Productions will now be televised live on the Comcast cable systems in the Twin Cities. These games will be available on Channel 23 in the Minneapolis Comcast market and on Channel 13 in the St. Paul Comcast market. The remaining games scheduled to be televised live on Comcast are Minnesota State (Jan. 28-29), North Dakota (Feb. 19) and Wisconsin (Feb. 25-26).

### The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season six with the Huskies in 2010-11. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. In five seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 110-83-26 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

Home ice was kind to the Huskies last winter, as they owned a 12-4-5 record in 2009-10 at the NHC. The Huskies are 243-130-43 since the doors opened at the NHC in 1989. SCSU is 2-4-2 at the NHC in 2010-11.

The SCSU captain for 2010-11 will be senior forward Aaron Marvin. He is the grandson of U.S. Hockey Hall of Famer Cal Marvin and the brother of Gigi Marvin, a member of the 2010 USA Olympic women's hockey team. The SCSU alternate captains in 2010-11 will be senior forward Garrett Roe and senior defender Chris Hepp. Of note, Hepp played his first year of college hockey at Air Force before making the transfer to SCSU.

Last year marked the 8th time in team history that the Huskies have gained an NCAA tournament bid. This was also the third bid for the Huskies during the Bob Motzko era, and the Huskies' 7th NCAA trip since 2000. Last year, the Huskies advanced to the NCAA quarterfinals thanks to a 2OT victory over Northern Michigan (4-3) in first round play at the Xcel EC.
