The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (7-11-2, 3-8-1 WCHA) will return to action in the WCHA on Jan. 7-8 with a pair of home dates at the NHC against rival Michigan Tech (3-13-2, 1-10-1 WCHA). The games will both start at 7:07 p.m. at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100). KCML FM 99.9 (www.lite999.com) will cover the game live with Don Lyons and David Reichel providing the call. KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org) will also provide coverage of the games for the Huskies. KVSC's Matt Bishop will be a leader on the KVSC broadcast team for these games. SCSU BY THE NUMBERS

1998 was the last time the Huskies lost to Michigan Tech at the NHC. SCSU dropped a 3-2 decision to MTU on Nov. 14, 1998. In the all-time series, SCSU owns a 49-26-5 overall record and SCSU is 49-22-5 in games played at the DI level against the other Huskies from MTU. In the last 10 outings, SCSU is 9-1-0 vs. MTU. SCSU has gone unbeaten in the last 18 games at home against MTU.

21 Junior Drew LeBlanc continues to pace the Huskies this winter with 21 points (7g/14a). LeBlanc will be looking to continue his two-game point streak in the games against MTU. LeBlanc had 4 points in his games at the FCHC.

2 SCSU's Garrett Roe scored his second SHG of the season and his 2nd SHG of his career in the Huskies' 4-3 win over #6 Miami on Dec. 30. Roe now has 157 career points, which includes 99 career assists. He is now tied for 3rd place for career assists along with Tim Hanus (1988-92). His 58 goals puts him in 8th place along with Fred Knipscheer (1990-93).

1 The Huskies were the number one team at the recent 2010 Florida College Hockey Classic on Dec. 29-30 in Estero, Fla. The Huskies gained a 4-3 OT win over Cornell and a 4-3 win over #6 Miami in the title game at the tournament. This marked

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (24-15-5) placed third in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (15-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies won the first round of the WCHA playoffs vs. Minnesota State, and then placed 2nd at the WCHA Final Five. In NCAA tournament play, the Huskies scored a 4-3 double OT win vs. Northern Michigan at the West Regional, and then lost to Wisconsin by a 5-3 tally in the regional final. This was the 14th time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have finished above .500, and the 10th time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have finished above .500. This also marked the ninth time since 1993-94 that the Huskies have won 20-plus games.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - Not ranked, USA Today/USAH Hockey: Not Ranked, INCH: Not Ranked, CHN Preseason: 6th...SCSU was ranked 2nd in the WCHA preseason coaches poll for 2010-11, and the Huskies earned a 3rd place ranking in the 2010-11 WCHA preseason media poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show is broadcast live from the Ground Round in St. Cloud.



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans will be able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.lite999.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org).

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Zach Fisch and former Husky legend Mike Doyle will provide play-by-play for Husky Productions this season. A select number of home games will also be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2010-11. The games include MSU (Jan. 28-29), UND (Feb. 19) and UW (Feb. 25-26).

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2010-11, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by sixth-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include four-year veteran Mike Gibbons and first-year coach Steve Johnson. Mike Ayers is in his 2nd year as the volunteer goalie coach at SCSU.

NEW FACE ON THE BENCH: Steve Johnson begins his first season at SCSU as an assistant coach. He previously served as head coach at Fargo in the USHL, and also served as head coach at Lincoln and Fargo-Moorhead of the USHL. He played college hockey at North Dakota and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist and was named the WCHA Student Athlete of the Year in 1988. Johnson replaces Eric Rud, who was named the head coach at Green Bay (USHL) during the summer of 2010.

DOWD EARNS WCHA AWARD: Nic Dowd became the first Husky in 2010-11 to gain a WCHA weekly award as he was named the league's Rookie of the Week on Jan. 5. Dowd gained the award thanks to his 1g/3a performance at the Florida College Hockey Classic on Dec. 29-30. Dowd scored the game winner for SCSU in the title game against #6 Miami and he also had two helpers in that game. Dowd now has 2g/8a this season for the Huskies for a total of 10 points. He is a resident of Huntsville, Alabama.

YOUTH HOCKEY WEEKEND AT SCSU ON JAN. 7-8: The MTU series for the Huskies on Jan. 7-8 has been designated as Youth Hockey Weekend at the NHC. As a special salute, all youth hockey players (8th grade and under) who wear their team's jersey to the game will be admitted free to the games that weekend with a paid adult. LAST TIME OUT: The St. Cloud State hockey team added another some more hardware to its trophy case with a first place finish at the 2010 Florida College Hockey Classic on Dec. 29-30 in Estero, Fla. The Huskies gained the tournament title for the first time thanks to a 4-3 OT victory over Cornell in the first round match, followed by a 4-3 win over #6 Miami in the championship game on Dec. 30...this marked the third trip to the Florida College Hockey Classic by the Huskies, as the team also participated in the tournament in 2004 and 2008...SCSU athletes named to the All-Tournament team at the FCHC were sophomore goalie Mike Lee, junior forward Drew LeBlanc, senior defender Brett Barta and freshman forward Nic Dowd, who was also named the tournament MVP (see note on Dowd winning WCHA honors)...LeBlanc also had 1g/3a in the series down south, while freshman forward Cam Reid added 2g/2a in the tournament. Reid was credited with the game winning goal in the OT session against Cornell.

BACK ON THE SCORESHEET: Senior forward Garrett Roe snapped a four-game point scoring drought on Dec. 29 with his two helpers against Cornell. Roe finished the tournament with a SHG against Miami, and his career totals now stand at 157 points (5th in the team records), 99 assists (3rd in the team records) and 58 goals (8th in the team records). This was Roe's 2nd SHG of the season and 2nd of his career.

A THREE-WAY TIE: Sophomore forward Ben Hanowski snapped an 8-game goal scoring drought and a five-game point scoring drought with his goal against Colorado College in the first period on Dec. 11. Hanowski is tied for the team's goal scoring lead this winter with 6 goals. Teammates Jared Festler and Drew LeBlanc also have six goals apiece this winter for SCSU.

CENTURY CLUB: LeBlanc played in his 100th career game at SCSU on Dec. 29. He continues to lead the Huskies with 7 goals, 14 assists and 21 points this winter. In three seasons at SCSU, LeBlanc has 21g/46a to his credit.

HUSKIES DOWN #6 MIAMI: The win over #6 Miami was a career first for Bob Motzko, who served as an associate head coach for the RedHawks in the 1990s. The last time the Huskies posted a win over Miami was on Dec. 11, 1998 with a 5-4 decision in Oxford, Ohio...the victory over Cornell was a program first for the Huskies. The other meeting against the Big Red for the Huskies was a 3-2 loss at the FCHC in 2008.

HUSKY NOTES: Goalkeeper Mike Lee gained starts and victories in both games for the Huskies in Florida. He had a total of 50 saves in the tournament. His season GAA now stands at 3.24, which includes 367 saves to his credit...Reid leads the club with a +5 this winter...sophomore Ben Hanowski scored a goal against Cornell on Dec. 29, which pushes his goal total to 7 in 2010-11. He is tied for first on the for goals along with LeBlanc...Oliver Lauridsen added his first goal of the 2010-11 season in the win over Miami. Lauridsen now has 1g/3a this season for the Huskies. Of note, Lauridsen scored his first goal as a collegiate player at Miami on Oct. 9, 2009...the 11 shots on goal vs. Miami were the fewest by the Huskies in a game since posting 9 shots on goal in 3-1 victory at Minnesota on 12/19/97.

WATCH IN THE TWIN CITIES: In an exciting new development, select SCSU men's hockey games on Husky Productions will now be televised live on the Comcast cable systems in the Twin Cities. These games will be available on Channel 23 in the Minneapolis Comcast market and on Channel 13 in the St. Paul Comcast market. The remaining games scheduled to be televised live on Comcast are Minnesota State (Jan. 28-29), North Dakota (Feb. 19) and Wisconsin (Feb. 25-26).

ON DECK: SCSU will enjoy a bye week on Jan. 14-15, before hitting the road for a series at WCHA rival Bemidji State on Jan. 21-22.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season six with the Huskies in 2010-11. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. In five seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 112-85-26 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.
