The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (12-14-4, 8-11-3 WCHA) will host #2 University of North Dakota (21-8-2, 16-6-0 WCHA) for a pair of WCHA games at the National Hockey Center (5,371,200x100) in St. Cloud, Minn. on Friday, Feb. 18 and Saturday, Feb. 19. Both games will begin at 7:07 p.m. in St. Cloud, Minn. KCML FM 99.9 (www.lite999.com) will cover the game live with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel providing the call. MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (24-15-5) placed third in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (15-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies won the first round of the WCHA playoffs vs. Minnesota State, and then placed 2nd at the WCHA Final Five. In NCAA tournament play, the Huskies scored a 4-3 double OT win vs. Northern Michigan at the West Regional, and then lost to Wisconsin by a 5-3 tally in the regional final. This was the 14th time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have finished above .500, and the 10th time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have finished above .500. This also marked the ninth time since 1993-94 that the Huskies have won 20-plus games.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - not ranked, USA Today/USAH Hockey: Not Ranked, INCH: Not Ranked, CHN Preseason: 6th...SCSU was ranked 2nd in the WCHA preseason coaches poll for 2010-11, and the Huskies earned a 3rd place ranking in the 2010-11 WCHA preseason media poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show is broadcast live from the Ground Round in St. Cloud.



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans will be able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.lite999.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org).

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Zach Fisch and former Husky legend Mike Doyle will provide play-by-play for Husky Productions this season. A select number of home games will also be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2010-11. The games include MSU (Jan. 28-29), UND (Feb. 19) and UW (Feb. 25-26).

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2010-11, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by sixth-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include four-year veteran Mike Gibbons and first-year coach Steve Johnson. Mike Ayers is in his 2nd year as the volunteer goalie coach at SCSU.

NEW FACE ON THE BENCH: Steve Johnson begins his first season at SCSU as an assistant coach. He previously served as head coach at Fargo in the USHL, and also served as head coach at Lincoln and Fargo-Moorhead of the USHL. He played college hockey at North Dakota and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist and was named the WCHA Student Athlete of the Year in 1988. Johnson replaces Eric Rud, who was named the head coach at Green Bay (USHL) during the summer of 2010.

HUSKY FACTS AND TRIVIA: Get the puck to Nic Dowd! The Huskies are 5-0-0 this season when rookie forward Nic Dowd scores a goal... SCSU will host #2 ranked North Dakota this weekend. MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST TIME OUT: The SCSU men's hockey team enjoyed success in its debut at the AMSOIL Arena in Duluth on Feb. 11-12. The Huskies opened the weekend with a huge 8-2 victory over #3 ranked Minnesota Duluth on Feb. 11. To complete the weekend in the Twin Ports, SCSU tallied a 3-3 tie against UMD on Feb. 12. The 8-2 win on Feb. 11 marked the most goals scored by the Huskies in a game since an 8-7 win over Minnesota at the WCHA Final Five on March 17, 2006 at the Xcel Center in St. Paul. The game was also the largest margin of victory for the Huskies since a 6-0 win over UAA on Feb. 6, 2010. This was also the most goals and biggest margin of victory over the Bulldogs since an 8-0 win at UMD on Jan. 28, 2000.

POINTS GALORE: Five players posted multi-point nights in the Huskies' 8-2 win on Feb. 11 at UMD. SCSU players with three points in the victory included Ben Hanowski, Oliver Lauridsen, Garrett Roe and Nick Jensen. Roe and Drew LeBlanc are tied for the team lead this season with 11 multi-point games apiece.

WCHA AWARD WINNER: Freshman defender Nick Jensen (a Detroit draft pick) earned the WCHA Rookie of the Week award on Feb. 15. Jensen was honored for his 1g/2a effort against UMD on Feb. 11-12. Jensen leads SCSU blueliners this winter with 16 points (5g/11a). He hails from nearby Rogers, Minn.

GOALIE ASSIST: Sophomore goalie Mike Lee scored his first collegiate point on Feb. 11 with an assist on Mitch MacMillan's goal at 17:45 of the second period. Lee is 10-10-3 this season for the Huskies and has started in the last 12 games for the Huskies. He owns a 2.83 GAA and a .905 save rate this winter. He currently ranks 8th in the team record with 1,399 saves during his career at SCSU.

NOW AT 170: Senior Garrett Roe scored his 170th career point on Feb. 11. He already owns the team's career assist record with 109, and he is now 13 points away from the team scoring record of 183 points set by Ryan Lasch from 2006-10.

BACK HOME: Drew LeBlanc enjoyed his homecoming at UMD on Feb. 11-12. A graduate of Hermantown H.S. (a suburb of Duluth), LeBlanc posted his team-leading 12th goal of the season on Feb. 11. He also leads the club this winter with 23 assists and 35 points.

TEAM NOTES: Junior Jared Festler enjoyed a strong weekend at UMD with two power play goals, one game winner and one assist to his credit. Festler's game winner came on the advantage at 19:14 of the first period on Feb. 11. He now has 11 goals this season and leads the Huskies with 6 power play goals in 2010-11... Senior Nick Oslund returned to the goal scoring column on Feb. 11 with his tally against UMD. This was Oslund's first goal since the Huskies' season-opener vs. RIT at the UNO tournament on Oct. 8... Junior Travis Novak also returned to the goal sheet on Feb. 12, with his first period goal against UMD. This was Novak's fourth goal of the season and his first since Dec. 4 against UND. Novak finished the game with an assist on Aaron Marvin's goal in the second period... Sophomore Ben Hanowski notched two goals and one assist on Feb. 11, to help lift the Huskies past #3 UMD. Hanowski has scored five of his 10 goals this season in just two games. He had two vs. UMD on Feb. 11 and three vs. BSU on Nov. 5... SCSU likes to play in new rinks. The Huskies are 3-0-1 this season in games played at the new rinks at Bemidji State and Minnesota Duluth in 2010-11.

ON DECK: The Huskies will return to the NHC on Feb. 25-26 for a pair of home dates against the University of Wisconsin. It will be SCSU Senior Night on Feb. 26 and it will also be SCSU Throwback Jersey night, when the Huskies will wear a special retro jersey from the 1960s. The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season six with the Huskies in 2010-11. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. In five seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 117-88-28 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fourth-year coach Mike Gibbons, 1st year coach Steve Johnson, and 2nd-year volunteer goalie coach Kevin Ayers. SCSU's support staff features tested veteran equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and Coordinator of Business and Hockey Operations Matt Chapman.
