The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (15-16-5, 11-13-4 WCHA) will travel to #11 Minnesota Duluth (20-9-6, 15-8-5 WCHA) for the best-of-three WCHA Final Five first round series. The games will be held at 7:07 p.m. each night at AMSOIL Arena (6,732 cap./200x85) in Duluth, Minn. The winner of this series will then advance to the 2011 WCHA Final Five at the Xcel Energy Center in downtown St. Paul, Minn. on March 17-19. KCML FM 99.9 (www.lite999.com) will cover the game live with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the plays. SCSU BY THE NUMBERS

2007 SCSU junior scoring leader Drew LeBlanc helped lead Hermantown, a suburb of Duluth, to the 2007 MSHSL Class A hockey title as a prep hockey player. LeBlanc currently paces the Huskies with 39 points, 13 goals and 26 assists this winter. Of note, He is tied for the team's goal scoring lead with sophomore Ben Hanowski (13 goals apiece).

62 Sophomore goalie Mike Lee gained WCHA Player of the Week honors after making a total of 62 saves in a weekend split at #5/6 Denver on March 4-5. Lee leads the Huskies in net with a 12-12-4 record and a solid 2.79 goals against average this season. He is a resident of Roseau.

12 The Huskies have advanced out the WCHA first round 12 times since joining the league in 1990-91.

6 The Huskies own a six-game unbeaten streak against Minnesota Duluth, which dates back to a 5-1 loss on Nov. 29 at the DECC. Earlier this year, SCSU posted an 8-2 and 3-3 weekend at the AMSOIL on Feb. 11-12.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (24-15-5) placed third in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (15-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies won the first round of the WCHA playoffs vs. Minnesota State, and then placed 2nd at the WCHA Final Five. In NCAA tournament play, the Huskies scored a 4-3 double OT win vs. Northern Michigan at the West Regional, and then lost to Wisconsin by a 5-3 tally in the regional final. This was the 14th time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have finished above .500, and the 10th time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have finished above .500. This also marked the ninth time since 1993-94 that the Huskies have won 20-plus games.

POLL POSITION: Here are the current rankings for the Huskies: US-CHO.com - received votes, USA Today/USAH Hockey: Not Ranked, INCH: received votes, CHN Preseason: 6th...SCSU was ranked 2nd in the WCHA preseason coaches poll for 2010-11, and the Huskies earned a 3rd place ranking in the 2010-11 WCHA preseason media poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show airs every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show is broadcast live from the Ground Round in St. Cloud.



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans will be able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.lite999.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org).

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Zach Fisch and former Husky legend Mike Doyle will provide play-by-play for Husky Productions this season. A select number of home games will also be televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2010-11. The games include MSU (Jan. 28-29), UND (Feb. 19) and UW (Feb. 25-26).

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2010-11, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) will be available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. COACHING STAFF: SCSU will be led this season by sixth-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches include four-year veteran Mike Gibbons and first-year coach Steve Johnson. Mike Ayers is in his 2nd year as the volunteer goalie coach at SCSU.

NEW FACE ON THE BENCH: Steve Johnson begins his first season at SCSU as an assistant coach. He previously served as head coach at Fargo in the USHL, and also served as head coach at Lincoln and Fargo-Moorhead of the USHL. He played college hockey at North Dakota and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist and was named the WCHA Student Athlete of the Year in 1988. Johnson replaces Eric Rud, who was named the head coach at Green Bay (USHL) during the summer of 2010.

HUSKY FACTS AND TRIVIA: The Huskies currently own a six-game unbeaten streak against UMD, which dates back to a 5-1 loss against the Bulldogs on Nov. 29, 2008...since SCSU's games at the Florida tournament, the Huskies have charted an impressive 10-5-3 record. SCSU has outscored its opponents 63-46 in those 18 games and the Huskies have posted a 22.0% rate on the power play (20 PPGs scored and only 12 PPGs allowed)...in that same stretch, Mike Lee has a dazzling .920 save rate and a 9-5-3 record.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST TIME OUT: At Denver, the Huskies scored a 3-2 win on March 4 and dropped a 3-2 decision on March 5. Aaron Marvin charted the game winner goal on March 4, which was his first GWG of the season and third of his career. Brett Barta and Ben Hanowski also had goals for the Huskies in the contest, as Mike Lee had 32 saves in the win. On March 5, rookie Kevin Gravel tallied his first collegiate goal and Hanowski added his second PPG of the weekend vs. DU. Lee had 30 saves in the loss for SCSU. Of note, the Huskies were a perfect 9-of-9 on the penalty kill in the the two games combined.

WCHA HONORS: Sophomore goalie Mike Lee was named the WCHA Defensive Player of Week on March 7. He gained the honors with his 62 save effort in the two games at Denver. Lee guided the Huskies to a 3-2 win on March 4 and also have 30 saves in the Huskies' 3-2 loss on March 5. Lee is now 12-12-4 with a 2.79 GAA this season. In WCHA action this winter, Lee ranks 3rd in the league with 659 saves and he is 4th in league games with a .915 save rate. At SCSU, Lee has a 24-21-7 career record and his 1,546 saves ranks 8th in the team records.

KILLING TIME: The SCSU penalty kill was a perfect 9-of-9 against Denver last weekend. In the last three games, SCSU has not allowed a power play goal and the Huskies are 18-of-21 on the penalty kill in the last five games. In the WCHA, SCSU ranked 3rd in the league with an 84.4 percent PK rate, and the 20 power play goals allowed this season is 3rd best in the league.

PLAYOFF TIME: In the WCHA playoffs, the Huskies own a 25-21-0 record in first round games played since SCSU joined the league in 1990-91. SCSU is 9-16-0 in first round games played on the road and the Huskies have posted an 18-6-0 record in first round games played at the NHC. In the last five years, SCSU has been on the road twice for WCHA First Round games. In first round series played on the road, the Huskies have advance to the Final Five three times in 1996, 1999 and 2005. The last time the Huskies advanced to the Final Five during a road series in the first round was in 2006 with a 2-1 series edge at Colorado College in Coach Bob Motzko's first season with the Huskies.

MORE PLAYOFF NOTES: SCSU has advanced to the Final Five 12 times since 1994. Last year, the Huskies scored a 2-0 win over Wisconsin in the semi-finals of the Final Five and then lost a 5-3 decision against North Dakota in the battle for the Broadmoor Trophy on March 20, 2010.

AGAINST THE BULLDOGS: In first round playoff action against Minnesota Duluth, the Huskies own a 9-4 edge. History was made the last time SCSU and UMD met in the WCHA First Round at the NHC in 2007. UMD gained a 3-1 win in game one on March 9, 2007. In game two, the Huskies stayed alive with a 3-2 OT victory. To clinch the trip to St. Paul, the Huskies survived an epic triple OT game that ended with the game winner by Andreas Nodl to give the Huskies a 3-2 win. The game set a team record for longest game played at 111:33 and the legendary Bobby Goepfert made a team record 67 saves in the contest that ended at 11:23 p.m. That night in St. Cloud.

IN THE TWIN PORTS: The last time that SCSU and UMD played a first round series in Duluth, the Huskies lost the series 2-1 in 2003. In game one, UMD posted a 5-4 win on March 14, 2003. SCSU replied with a 3-2 OT win on March 15, 2003 before falling 7-3 in game three of the series. SCSU and UMD have met five times in the WCHA first round, which is the most of any WCHA rival for the Huskies.

MORE NOTES: Ben Hanowski added two goals in the series at Denver on March 4-5. He is now tied for the team's goal scoring lead this winter along with Drew LeBlanc with 13 goal apiece. Hanowski also has seven helpers this season for a total of 20 points this winter. LeBlanc continues to lead the Huskies with 39 points and 26 assists in 2010-11... Garrett Roe now has 65 goals, 112 assists and 177 career points with the Huskies. He needs three points to move ahead of Jeff Saterdalen (179 points from 1988-92) into second place on the Huskies' all-time point leader list. Ryan Lasch is SCSU's all-time point leader with 184 points from 2006-10...Kevin Gravel scored his first goal as a Husky on March 5 at Denver. Gravel's Dad Jim Gravel played for the Huskies from 1977-81 along with current SCSU radio color commentator Dave Reichel.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season six with the Huskies in 2010-11. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. In five seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 120-90-29 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fourth-year coach Mike Gibbons, 1st year coach Steve Johnson, and 2nd-year volunteer goalie coach Kevin Ayers. SCSU's support staff features tested veteran equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and Coordinator of Business and Hockey Operations Matt Chapman.

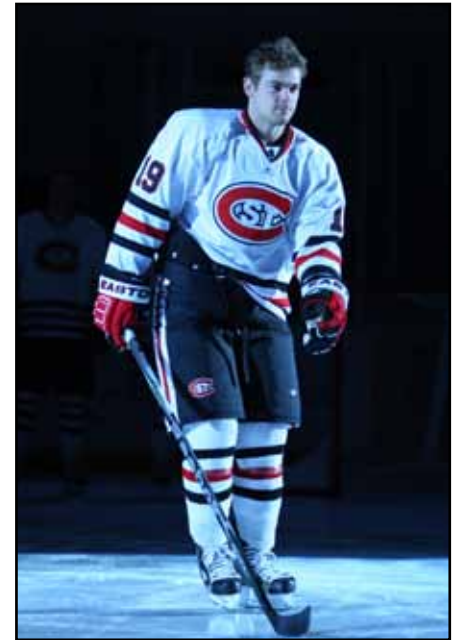

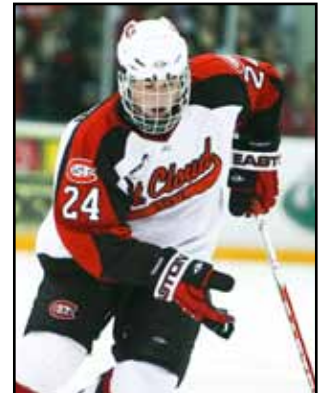
