FINAL WORD ON 2010-11

The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team completed its 2010-11 season with a 15-18-5 overall record and an 11-13-4 WCHA record. The Huskies tied for 8th place in the regular season WCHA standings. In first round play of the WCHA Final Five playoffs, the Huskies finished the season with a pair of losses to host Minnesota Duluth. On March 11, SCSU lost 4-2 and then dropped a 3-2 triple OT decision at UMD on March 12. SCSU was led this season by head coach Bob Motzko, who completed his sixth season with the Huskies in 2010-11.

SCSU BY THE NUMBERS

101:13 In another epic WCHA playoff showdown against Minnesota Duluth, the Huskies ended their season with a 3-2 triple overtime loss at the AMSOIL Arena on March 12. The game time was 101:13, which is the second longest game in Husky history. What was the longest game you ask? The longest game in Husky history was 111:33, when the Huskies beat UMD in the WCHA playoffs on Mar. 11, 2007 at the NHC. A goal by Andreas Nodl in the third OT session gave the Huskies a 3-2 win in that game.

874 Sophomore goalie Mike Lee posted 874 saves in 2010-11. He ended his year with a .910 save rate and a 2.75 goals against average. In the triple OT session against UMD on March 12, Lee hit a new career game-high with his 60 saves against the Bulldogs. This included 28 saves in three OT periods combined.

178 Senior forward Garrett Roe ended his storied career at SCSU with 178 career points (65g/113a). He ranks 3rd in the team records for career points, and he is the Huskies' all-time assist leader with 113 (the old record of 104 career assists was set by Ryan Lasch from 2006-10). He ranks 7th in team history with 65 goals and 4th with 26 power play goals at SCSU. He also ranks 4th with 11 game winners and third with 156 games played at SCSU.

39 Junior forward Drew LeBlanc led the Huskies in all three offensive categories in 2010-11. LeBlanc topped SCSU's point leaderboard with 39 points. He also led the team with 13 goals and 26 assists. For goals, LeBlanc was tied for the team goal scoring lead along with Ben Hanowski at 13 goals apiece. For assists, LeBlanc tied Garrett Roe for the team lead at 26 assists each this winter. LeBlanc is a resident of Hermantown.

14 SCSU placed an impressive total of 14 student-athletes on the 2010-11 All-WCHA Academic team this winter. The Huskies also saw eight of its student-athletes earn WCHA Scholar-Athlete awards win 2010-11. Excellent job HUSKIES!

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (24-15-5) placed third in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (15-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies won the first round of the WCHA playoffs vs. Minnesota State, and then placed 2nd at the WCHA Final Five. In NCAA tournament play, the Huskies scored a 4-3 double OT win vs. Northern Michigan at the West Regional, and then lost to Wisconsin by a 5-3 tally in the regional final. This was the 14th time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have finished above .500, and the 10th time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have finished above .500. This also marked the ninth time since 1993-94 that the Huskies have won 20-plus games.

POLL POSITION: Here are the final rankings for the Huskies: USCHO.com - received votes, USA Today/USAH Hockey: Not Ranked, INCH: received votes, CHN Preseason: 6th...SCSU was ranked 2nd in the WCHA preseason coaches poll for 2010-11, and the Huskies earned a 3rd place ranking in the 2010-11 WCHA preseason media poll.

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show aired every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show was broadcast live from the Ground Round in St. Cloud.



ON THE AIR: All SCSU games were broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans were able to listen to the games on the web by going to this website at www.lite999.com. Selected Husky games were broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org).

LIVE FROM ST. CLOUD: All SCSU home games were televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Zach Fisch and former Husky legend Mike Doyle provided play-by-play for Husky Productions this season. A select number of home games were televised live on Comcast Cable (channel 23 Minneapolis and channel 13 St. Paul) in 2010-11.

WATCH ON THE WEB: Once again in 2010-11, all SCSU home games (and selected road games) were available to watch on the America One Networks (formerly B2 networks) live video streaming service. COACHING STAFF: SCSU was led this season by sixth-season head coach Bob Motzko. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko earned WCHA Coach of the Year notice in 2006 and 2007. The Huskies' assistant coaches included four-year veteran Mike Gibbons and first-year coach Steve Johnson. Mike Ayers is in his 2nd year as the volunteer goalie coach at SCSU.

NEW FACE ON THE BENCH: Steve Johnson began his first season at SCSU as an assistant coach. He previously served as head coach at Fargo in the USHL, and also served as head coach at Lincoln and Fargo-Moorhead of the USHL. He played college hockey at North Dakota and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist and was named the WCHA Student Athlete of the Year in 1988. Johnson replaced Eric Rud, who was named the head coach at Green Bay (USHL) during the summer of 2010.

HUSKY FACTS AND TRIVIA: The Huskies captured their first-ever championship at the Florida College Hockey Classic in 2010. SCSU has appeared at the FCHC three times (2004, 2007 and 2010). Nic Dowd was named the FCHC Shawn Walsh Award winner (MVP), while Mike Lee, Drew LeBlanc and Brett Barta were all named to the All-Tournament team in 2010...here is a breakdown of scoring by class for the Huskies in 2010-11: Seniors (30g, 52a, 82pts), Juniors (35g/62a, 97 pts), Sophomores (24g, 25a, 49 pts) and Freshman (23g, 60a, 83 pts).

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

AWARD WINNER: SCSU junior Drew LeBlanc was named to the 2011 All-WCHA Third Team. This marks the 45th time a SCSU player has earned All-WCHA status since the Huskies joined the league in 1990-91. In WCHA play this winter, LeBlanc ranked 10th in the league for scoring with 28 points (along with teammate Garrett Roe) in 28 games. LeBlanc led the Huskies this season with 39 points (13g/26a). This marks the first All-WCHA award for LeBlanc.

GET SMART: The Huskies placed 7 student-athletes on the WCHA Scholar-Athlete list in 2011. This group included two-time recipients Drew LeBlanc, Jordy Christian, Travis Novak and Brian Volpei. First time recipients included Oliver Lauridsen, Aaron Marvin and Mike Lee. Huskies named to the 2011 All-WCHA Academic squad were Brett Barta, Christian, Jared Festler, Ben Hanowski, Lauridsen, LeBlanc, Lee, Marvin, Nick Olsund, Novak, Nic Rioux, Garrett Roe, Volpei and Sam Zabkowicz.

GREAT EFFORT: SCSU finished its season with a pair of setbacks at UMD on March 11-12 in the first round of the WCHA playoffs. The Huskies lost 4-2 on March 11 and then lost in triple overtime on March 12 by a 3-2 tally. The overtime game was the second longest in team history at 101:13. SCSU goalie Mike Lee was incredible in the game with 60 saves to his credit (2nd most saves in a game in team history). He made 15 saves alone in the first OT session and also had 28 saves in the three OT periods combined. Lee established himself as SCSU's starting goalie midway through the season in 2010-11. He now has 1,632 career saves, which ranks 8th in team history. At this point of his career, Lee is averaging 28.14 saves per game (tops on the SCSU career charts). The previous saves per game leader was Bobby Goepfert at 27.59 from 2005-07.

HOW WE FINISHED: The Huskies' goals against average of 2.83 for 2010-11 ranks 9th best in team history...SCSU's team save percentage of .907 ranks 10th best in team history...SCSU's 28.11 saves per game rate in 2010-11 ranks 8th best in team history...SCSU's total of 1,068 saves ranks 15th in the team records....the five tie games in 2010-11 is tied for second for most ties in a season by the Huskies (SCSU set a record with 7 ties in 2006-07)...SCSU posted its second fewest penalties in a season with 211 in 2010-11. The Huskies' penalty minute total of 466 is the second fewest number of PIMs in a season. The team low for penalties was set in 2007-08 at 194-437...Cam Reid's four game winning goals in 2010-11 is tied for 7th in the team records...Mike Lee's average of 29.15 saves per game in 2010-11 ranks 2nd in the team records behind Jake Moreland's 29.19 saves per game in 2002-03.

HISTORIC HUSKY: SCSU senior Garrett Roe leaves the Granite City as the team's all-time career assist leader with 113 in 156 games. He ranked third in team history with 178 career points, 4th with 26 career power play goals, 4th with 11 game winners and 7th with 65 career goals. He is one of only three Huskies to earn All-WCHA honors three times during his career and he served as a team alternate captain in 2010-11. A draft pick of Los Angeles, Roe played in 156 games at SCSU - which ranks 3rd in team history.

DEPARTING SENIORS: SCSU will say goodbye to a solid group of senior athletes in 2010-11. This groups includes defenseman Brett Barta, goalie Dan Dunn, forward and team captain Aaron Marvin, forward Nick Oslund, forward/defender Nic Rioux, forward Garrett Roe and forward Brian Volpei. This group helped the Huskies earn NCAA tournament bids in 2008 and 2010, along with WCHA Final Five tickets in 2008 and 2010. The SCSU senior class helped SCSU win 76 games in four seasons and they were part of the 2009-10 team that posted the Huskies' first-ever victory in NCAA tournament competition against Northern Michigan (4-3 OT win at the Xcel Energy Center at the West Regional that season).

EARLY DEPARTURE: Junior defender Oliver Lauridsen signed a professional hockey contract with the Philadelphia Flyers organization at the end of the 2010-11 season. Lauridsen leaves SCSU after three seasons of play with 7 goals and 15 assists in 108 games played as a Husky. Lauridsen (6-6, 230-pounds) was a 2009 draft pick of the Flyers and he hails from Gentofte, Denmark. Lauridsen joined Adirondack of the AHL to finish out the 2010-11 season...in other pro hockey signing news - SCSU senior Aaron Marvin signed a pro contract with the Abbotsford Heat of the AHL at the end of the Huskies' 2010-11 season.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin season six with the Huskies in 2010-11. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to four WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 NCAA Division I tournaments. In five seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 120-92-29 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 71 weeks during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2009-10, SCSU was 24-14-5 and placed 3rd in the WCHA at 15-9-5. SCSU placed 2nd at the 2010 WCHA Final Five and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2010 NCAA tournament thanks to a 4-3 2OT win over Northern Michigan at the NCAA West Regional.

In 2008-09, Motzko led the Huskies to an 18-17-3, 13-13-2 WCHA record. In 2007-08, Motzko led the Huskies to a 19-16-5 overall record and a fourth place finish in the WCHA at 12-12-4. SCSU gained home ice in the WCHA playoffs and earned trips to the 2008 WCHA Final Five and the 2008 NCAA tournament. Ryan Lasch was a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist and an AHCA All-American in 2008. In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Goepfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have gained All-America honors three-times during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United State Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fourth-year coach Mike Gibbons, 1st year coach Steve Johnson, and 2nd-year volunteer goalie coach Kevin Ayers. SCSU's support staff features tested veteran equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and Coordinator of Business and Hockey Operations Matt Chapman.

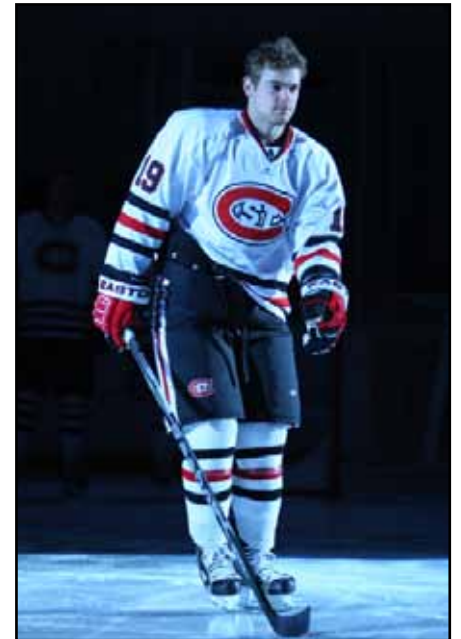

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

WAIT TIL NEXT YEAR: The Huskies have 17 players on their 2010-11 roster at the end of the season who will be eligible to return in 2011-12. The Huskies will return 4 of their top 5 point producers from 2010-11 and they will also be eligible to return 8 of their top 10 points from 2010-11. Tops on that list of possible returners is Drew LeBlanc, who led the Huskies with 39 points, 13 goals and 26 assists in 2010-11. LeBlanc was tied for the team's goal lead along with sophomore forward Ben Hanowski, who is also eligible to skate at SCSU in 2011-12. In fact, three of SCSU's top four goal scorers are slated to be back on the ice at the NHC in 2011-12 - LeBlanc (13 goals), Hanowski (13 goals) and Jared Festler (12 goals)...in fact, SCSU's eligible returning players posted 81 goals, 141 assists and 222 points in 2010-11 (out of a total of 112 goals, 202 assists and 314 points)...in the nets, sophomore Mike Lee is on track to return for his junior campaign in 2011-12. He led SCSU with 874 saves in 1879:40 minutes of play this winter. His GAA was 2.75 and his save rate was .910. Reserve goalie Nate Hardy is also eligible to return for his senior season in 2011-12.

NATION WIDE: Wondered where the Huskies stacked up at the NCAA level in 2010-11? SCORING: 28th (2.95 GPG), SCORING DEFENSE: 35th (2.97 GAPG), PENALTY MINUTES: 43rd (12.0 PIM per game), POWER PLAY PERCENTAGE: 28th (18.3%), PENALTY KILL: 16th (83.9%).

NATIONAL LEADERS: On an individual basis, here are where some of the Huskies rated among the NCAA leaders in 2010-11: POINTS PER GAME - Drew LeBlanc (.50th, 1.03 ppg) & Garrett Roe (69th, 0.95 ppg); ASSISTS PER GAME - Drew LeBlanc & Garrett Roe (38th, 0.68 apg); SHORTHANDED GOALS - Garrett Roe (16th, 2 SHGs); GAME WINNING GOALS: Cam Reid (20th, 4 GWGs); POINTS PER GAME - DEFENSEMAN: Nick Jensen (33rd, 0.61 ppg); POINTS PER GAME - ROOKIE: Cam Reid (20th, .78 ppg); GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE: Mike Lee (41st, 2.75 GAA); SAVE PERCENTAGE: Mike Lee (37th, .910 SV%).

HOW WE FINISHED: The Huskies' goals against average of 2.83 for 2010-11 ranks 9th best in team history...SCSU's team save percentage of .907 ranks 10th best in team history...SCSU's 28.11 saves per game rate in 2010-11 ranks 8th best in team history... SCSU's total of 1,068 saves ranks 15th in the team records...the five tie games in 2010-11 is tied for second for most ties in a season by the Huskies (SCSU set a record with 7 ties in 2006-07)...SCSU posted its second fewest penalties in a season with 211 in 2010-11. The Huskies' penalty minute total of 466 is the second fewest number of PIMs in a season. The team low for penalties was set in 2007-08 at 194-437...Cam Reid's four game winning goals in 2010-11 is tied for 7th in the team records...Mike Lee's average of 29.15 saves per game in 2010-11 ranks 2nd in the team records behind Jake Moreland's 29.19 saves per game in 2002-03.

DEFENSE ON THE OFFENSE: SCSU freshman defender Nick Jensen, a draft pick of the Detroit Red Wings, led the SCSU blueliners this winter with five goals, 18 assists and 23 points. How does this total stack up with some of SCSU's legendary defensive players during their respective rookie seasons? Well, NHL standout Bret Hedican scored 5 goals and 3 assists during his freshman season at SCSU in 1988-89. SCSU's all-time leading defensive for points is Kelly Hultgren (107 points from 1991-95) posted 7 helpers from his blueline location in 1991-92. Another SCSU defense leader Taj Melson had 4g/6a in his first year at SCSU and the notable Justin Fletcher had 6g/7a in his first campaign on the Husky blueline in 2003-04.

THE ROOKIE: Newcomer Cam Reid had 29 points this season for the Huskies (8 goals and 21 assists). This marked the most points for a Husky rookie since Garrett Roe had 45 points during his rookie season in 2007-08 at St. Cloud State.

TEAM NOTES AND TRVIA: SCSU was 11-0-1 in 2010-11 when the Huskies scored 4-or-more goals in a game...SCSU was 10-1-1 when the Huskies limited their opponents to two or less goals in a game during the 2010-11 season...SCSU was 0-9-1 when the Huskies four-or-more goals in a game during the 2010-11 season...SCSU set a team record in 2010-11 for fewest shots on goal in a season at 1,046...the Huskies finished their 24th season as an NCAA Division I affiliate in 2010-11 and their 21st season as a proud member of the always rugged WCHA in 2010-11.

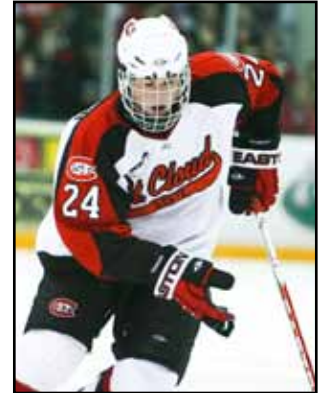
