Last Meeting Justin Schultz scored with the UW goalie pulled for an extra attacker at 19:20 of the third period to get the Badgers a 3-3 tie in St. Cloud after the UW fell, 7-2, to the Huskies to open the Nov. 4-5 weekend series.

Series Notes The games will mark the 83rd and 84th meetings in the series ... only two of the last 16 games in the series between the two schools have been played in Madison ... the teams split those games ... the Badgers are 9-1-4 over the last 14 games of the series played at the Kohl Center and 8-1-3 at the Kohl Center against SCSU under Mike Eaves' direction ... Eaves spent the 1987-88 season as an assistant coach at St. Cloud State ... senior defenseman Sam Zabkovicz, from Greendale, is the only SCSU player from Wisconsin

Key Notes to Consider

- ▶ Wisconsin (12-12-2, 7-11-2 WCHA) plays host to St. Cloud State (10-14-4, 7-10-3 WCHA) for a Friday and Saturday series at the Kohl Center. Friday's game is 7 p.m., while Saturday's contest is an 8 p.m. start.
The Badgers sit one point behind the Huskies for eighth place in the WCHA.
- ▶ Both teams were swept last weekend, with the Badgers falling 5-3 and 4-2 at North Dakota and St. Cloud State dropping 2-1 and 3-2 decisions to Minnesota.
- ▶ Mike Eaves is set to coach in his 399th and 400th games as head coach of Wisconsin this weekend. Eaves is currently 204-150-44 (.568 winning percentage) in 398 games for his alma mater.
- ▶ Junior defenseman John Ramage (St. Louis) scored his second goal of the season last Saturday against North Dakota. The goal was his first in 19 games and the fifth in the 104 games of his career.
- ▶ Sophomore forward Keegan Meuer (Madison, Wis.) had the highest goal-scoring weekend of his career last weekend at North Dakota, tallying in both games. The goals marked the first time he scored two goals on a weekend and the first time he posted points in consecutive games. He had a goal and an assist in UW's weekend sweep of RIT earlier this year.
Meuer ranks fifth on the Badgers with six goals in 26 games played. He has nine points on the season after collecting three points in his rookie season.

► Sophomore forward Michael Mersch (Park Ridge, Ill.) scored twice last Friday against North Dakota for his second multi-goal game of the season and the fourth of his career. Mersch put a third puck in the net, but it was disallowed after it was ruled the puck was kicked in.

Mersch is tied for second on the Badgers with 10 goals and ranks third with 22 points. The multi-point game was his sixth of the season, which is good for third on the team this year.

► The Badgers proved a resilient group last weekend despite losing twice at North Dakota. UW went down 2-0 in the first five minutes last Friday, before tying the game by the 13:34 of the first period. UW fell behind 3-2 in the second, but tied the game a second time.

On Saturday, UW trailed 1-0 and 2-1, before tying the game.

► Sophomore forward Mark Zengerle (Rochester, N.Y.) was held without a point for just the third game this season on Saturday at North Dakota. The Badgers are 0-3-0 when Zengerle fails to score a point.

Junior defenseman Justin Schultz (West Kelowna, British Columbia) went scoreless last Friday and the Badgers are 2-4-0 when the All-American fails to record a point.

► Wisconsin sits in ninth place in the WCHA standings with 16 points through 20 games of the league schedule, one point shy of St. Cloud State and five points behind Nebraska Omaha's total of 21, which is the current total for the sixth and final WCHA first round WCHA playoff series hosting position.

Schultz for Hobey

► Insidecollegehockey.com listed Justin Schultz among its three-member "Big Board" on its Hobey Tracker last week. A 2010 Hobey Baker Memorial Award top-10 finalist, Schultz leads the nation's defensemen with 12 goals and 38 points, ranking sixth among all skaters with a 1.46 points-per-game scoring average.

► Junior defenseman Justin Schultz became the first Badger defenseman to reach 100 career points since Brian Rafalski in 1994-95 with a four-point effort on Jan. 6 against RIT. Schultz' 35th career goal got him to 100 points. Schultz, who now has 107 points to rank ninth all-time for UW defensemen and 36 career goals, which ranks tied for third in UW history for defensemen.

Schultz is the 12th UW defenseman to reach 100 career points and the sixth to do so in three seasons or less (Craig Norwich, Sean Hill, Bruce Driver, Tim Thomas, Theran Welsh - two seasons). He's the 70th Badger all-time to reach 100 points.

► Schultz leads the Badgers with 12 goals. A defenseman has never led the Badgers in goal-scoring for a season.

► Schultz has been on the ice for 57 of Wisconsin's 81 goals, 21 of the UW's 26 power-play goals and nine of the squad's 12 game-winning tallies.

► Wisconsin returns its leading scorer in junior defenseman Justin Schultz (West Kelowna, British Columbia). Schultz, a top-10 Hobey Baker Memorial Award finalist in 2010-11, as well as the WCHA Defensive Player of the Year last season, scored 18 goals and 47 points to lead all defensemen in the country.

Schultz is the first non-goaltending Badger All-American to return to the UW since defenseman Jeff Dessner and forward Dany Heatley played for the Badgers a season after earning 2000 All-American honors. Goaltenders Brian Elliott (2006-07) and Bernd Brückler (2004-05) returned for their senior seasons after earning first-team All-American honors in 2006 and 2004, respectively.

A defenseman has never led Wisconsin in scoring in consecutive seasons. There have been five seasons in UW history that a defenseman has led the Badgers in scoring, with two of the five coming in the last three seasons.

Zengerle for Hobey too?

► Sophomore forward Mark Zengerle leads the nation with 29 assists and is fifth in the country with a 1.50 points-per-game scoring average. His 39 total points are tied for fourth in the nation, two points off the national scoring lead.

► Zengerle has 29 assists on the season. One more assist and he'll become just the second forward and fourth player in UW history to have at least 30 assists in his first two years as a Badger. Zengerle had 31 assists as a freshman.

► Junior forward Derek Lee (North Vancouver, British Columbia) has points in six of seven games since returning from an 11-game injury absence. Ignoring the absence, Lee has points in nine of his last 10 contests and 11 of 14 games played this season.

Lee has yet to record a multi-point game this season.

Individual Improvement

► Sophomore center Mark Zengerle (Rochester, N.Y.) scored five goals out of 36 points as a rookie, taking a total of 60 shots the entire season. That averaged to just under 1.5 shots per game. Already in 2011-12, Zengerle has fired 68 shots in 26 games, an average of 2.62 shots per game. He is second on the UW in shots on goal so far this season and shares second with 10 goals.

► With Wisconsin relying on new faces for offensive output, it comes as no surprise various Badgers have already surpassed their goal or point totals from 2010-11.

Special Teams

► Wisconsin's penalty kill struggled to start the season, beginning the season at a 67.5 percent clip (27-for-40) in the first nine games, then went on a 12 game stretch that things improved, with the Badgers going 85.7 percent (42-for-49) on the penalty kill, but have gone 64.7 percent on the penalty kill over the past five games (11-for-17).

The Badgers ranks last in the WCHA with a 75.5 percent kill (80-for-106).

The UW kill trails St. Cloud State for 11th in the league rankings. SCSU has allowed one less goal in the same amount of opportunities.

► UW's power play ranks sixth in the WCHA at 21.1 percent (26-for-123) after going 1-for-7 last weekend at North Dakota.

The Badgers have one power-play goal in their last five games, going 1-for-18 during that stretch.

Odds of Winning

► The Badgers have been most successful this season when scoring first (8-1-2), playing at the Kohl Center (11-4-1) and scoring on the power play (9-6-2).

► Scoring four goals is the magic number for Wisconsin. The Badgers are 8-1-0 when reaching the mark and 0-8-0 when allowing four goals in a game.

Scoring at least three goals for the Badgers has been pretty successful, as well. The UW sits 11-2-2 when scoring at least three goals.

The Badgers have won just one game when scoring two goals or less.

Up Next

► Wisconsin takes its last weekend off of the season from games on Feb. 10-11, before skating in its last regular-season home series of the season against Denver on Feb. 17-18 at the Kohl Center.

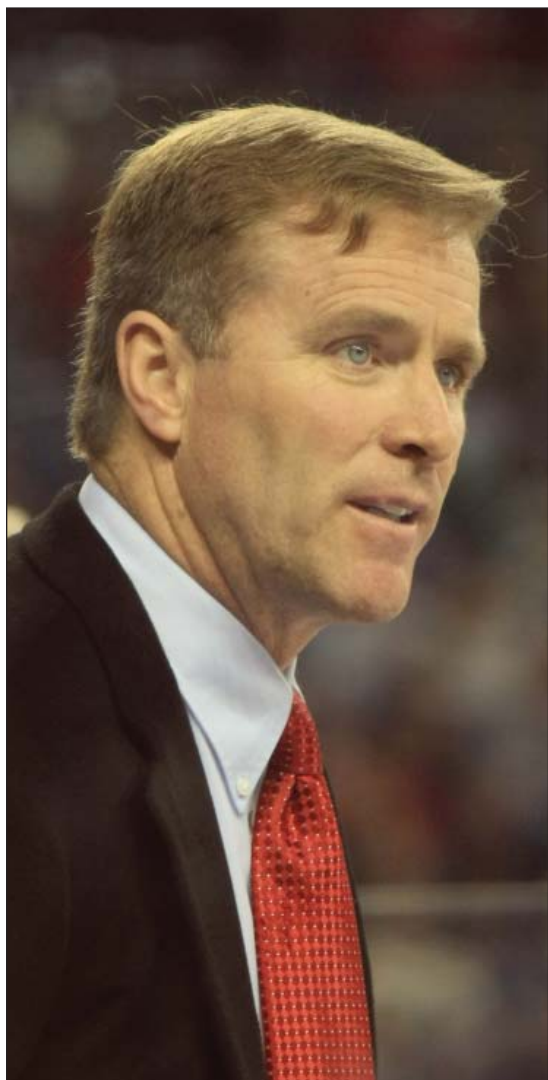

Kohl Center Facts, Folklore and Traditions

- ▶ The Kohl Center, which opened in 1998, is the second-largest on-campus rink in the nation (15,325). The only on-campus facility with a larger capacity is Value City Arena (17,500) in Columbus, Ohio. The building is the third-largest rink played in regularly by college hockey schools, behind Value City Arena and CenturyLink Center Omaha (16,680).
- ▶ Wisconsin has won at least 10 games in a season at the Kohl Center on nine occasions.
- ▶ The Kohl Center played host to NCAA regional action for the first time in 2008 when the 2008 NCAA Midwest Regional took place on March 29-30. The building had previously played host to the 1998 NCAA Women's Volleyball Championships, a 2002 NCAA Men's Basketball Regional and 2007 NCAA Women's Ice Hockey Quarterfinal contest.
- ▶ The Kohl Center cost \$76.4 million to construct and is named after U.S. Senator Herb Kohl, a 1956 UW graduate who donated \$25 million towards the project.
- ▶ The Kohl Center ice sheet is 200 feet long by 97 feet wide.
- ▶ Thirty-five of Wisconsin's 40 Kohl Center sellouts have come after Jan. 1.

La Bahn Arena



On Nov. 17, 2010, the Wisconsin State Building Commission gave final approval to a multi-level, hockey and swimming competition and training facility to be constructed adjacent to the Kohl Center on the UW-Madison campus. La Bahn Arena will be named after Charles (UW-Madison '49) and Mary Ann La Bahn, the lead donors for the project.

"Mary Ann and I are delighted to participate in the funding for this excellent facility for men's and women's hockey and men's and women's swimming," Charles La Bahn said. "The concept is sound and generations of student-athletes will benefit from the comprehensive design and availability of the structure. [UW Director of Athletics] Barry Alvarez and his associates are to be commended for their foresight in planning this much needed facility."

Construction is underway, with the facility set to open in the fall of 2012.

La Bahn Arena will be a tri-level complex that will include, among other items:

- 90' by 200' ice sheet for men's and women's hockey practice and women's competition, with seating for approximately 2,400 spectators
- Men's and women's hockey team locker rooms and a visiting team locker room
- Underground connection to the Kohl Center

The total cost of the project will be \$27.9 million, with two-thirds of that coming from gifts to UW Athletics and the remainder coming from bonding.

"The new rink will be the final jewel in the crown we have here as a hockey program," said Head Coach Mike Eaves. "It will be one-stop shopping. Our Fetzer Center is there for academics, our weight training is there, we have training table there. We'll have everything under one roof.

"The fact that we are moving forward with the project, there are so many people to thank. We've had alumni, businessmen, the general fan step up and want to be a part of the program because Badger hockey has been a big part of their lives in some form or fashion. They've been so gracious and generous in stepping up and helping out financially in a way that has made it possible for us to actually be coming closer to putting a shovel in the ground."
