2004-05 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Feb. 28, 2005



UND IS BACK IN TOWN: The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (14-20-2, 8-18-0 WCHA) will finish its 2004-05 regular season schedule this weekend with a two-game series against the #15/RV University of North Dakota (17-13-4, 12-12-2 WCHA). On Friday, March 4 and Saturday, March 5, the Huskies will host the UND team at the National Hockey Center (5,763 cap./200x100) at 7:07 p.m. both nights. Fans can listen to the games live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML 99.9 FM with Don Lyons calling the play-by-play (www.1450KNSI.com). KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org) will also carry the games live. Both games will be televised live in the St. Cloud area on Charter Communications Cable Channel 65.

2003-04 RESULTS: The Huskies finished their season with an 18-16-4, 12-12-4 WCHA/6th place). This was the fifth consecutive season that SCSU has finished above the .500 mark.



SCSU COACH CRAIG DAHL: SCSU head coach Craig Dahl is in his 18th season with the Huskies, and has been the team's only head coach since SCSU moved to the DI level in 1987-88. Dahl's record at SCSU is 338-306-51, and his all-time collegiate coaching record is 414-393-53. He will begin his 24th year as a collegiate head coach in 2004-05. Dahl served for one season as an assistant coach to Herb Brooks at SCSU in 1986-87, and prior to that he had head coaching assignments at UW-River Falls and Bethel College. Dahl is a 1976 graduate of Pacific Lutheran University.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Dahl will be assisted in 2004-05 by Brad Willner and Fred Harbinson. Willner, a 1995 graduate of Lake Superior State, will begin his fifth season with the Huskies in 2004-05. Harbinson begins his third season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2004-05. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. SCSU will also enlist the support of goalie coach David Weninger and video coordinator Josh Flynn this season.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

IANNAZZO NETS TWO: The game started out with a quiet first period, but a high octane third period provided some WCHA fireworks as SCSU dropped a tough 5-4 decision at Minnesota on Feb. 25. Both squads skated to a 0-0 deadlock after one period, as the Huskies outshot the Gophers by a 14-13 margin. Minnesota gained the upperhand in the contest with second period goals by Derek Peltier (on the power play) and Tyler Hirsch. Down 2-0 going into the third period, SCSU then took charge in the game. Peter Szabo scored his fifth goal of the season at 1:04 of the third. Dave Iannazzo added the assist on the play. Mike Doyle knotted the game up at 2-2 with a slick goal at 2:20 of the third as assists were issued to Andrew Gordon and Sean Garrity. The Huskies jumped into the lead at 5:42 as Iannazzo scored with an assist from Grant Clifton. UM got back onto the board at 9:00 of the third period with a goal by Alex Goligoski. Minnesota regained its lead at 11:42 of the third with a power play goal by Goligoski. Minnesota needed an empty net goal by Ryan Potulny at the 19:18 mark to collect the game winner. Although the ENG provided UM with a 5-3 lead, the Huskies charged back at 19:56 with another goal by Iannazzo. Casey Borer was credited with the assist on the play. The Huskies outshot the Gophers 39-29 in the game, as Tim Boron was the goalie of record for SCSU with 24 saves. Justin Johnson had 35 saves for the Gophers...Minnesota completed a series sweep against SCSU on Feb. 26, with a 4-1 victory before 6,537 fans at the National Hockey Center. The Gophers gained the lead early in the contest as Evan Kaufmann scored in a scrum in front of the SCSU net at 5:24 of the first period. In the second period, UM extended its lead to 2-0 with a tally by Gino Guyer at 6:11. The Huskies got back into the action with a power play goal by junior forward Joe Jensen at 6:56 of the second, as assists were credited to Nate Dey and Dave Iannazzo. Minnesota completed the second period with a goal by Tyler Hirsch at the 12:46 mark, as Judd Stevens had the single assist. UM's Barry Tallackson iced the game in the third period with a goal at 18:37. In the game, UM outshot the Huskies 29-24, as Jason Montgomery was the goalie of record for the Huskies with 25 saves to his credit.

SZABO UPDATE: Senior forward Peter Szabo had one goal over the weekend. Szabo now has 93 career points and is seven points shy of the 100-point club. Szabo has 70 assists and is the team's top active assist producer. He also ranks first on the team this season with 15 assists. On the all-time charts, Szabo ranks 13th along – just one ahead of Jon Cullen's 69 assists from 1999-03. Of note, SCSU has 18 players in its 100-point Club at the NCAA Division I level. Jeff Saterdalen leads the Huskies' career scorers with 179 points from 1988-92. SCSU also had two other players (Vic Brodt and Herm Finnegan) who are 100-point players but they played one season of Husky hockey in 1986-87 at the NCAA Division III level. The last player to join SCSU's 100-point club was Matt Hendricks in 2003-04. Hendricks, who was an ECHL All-Star this season for the Florida Everblades, had 112 points (54g/58a) during his career at SCSU from 2000-04

IZZY CONTINUES TO ROLL: Senior forward Dave Iannazzo notched two goals on Feb. 25, which was his second consecutive Friday night with two goals. He also had two goals in SCSU's 4-3 loss at the NHC on Feb. 18. Iannazzo owns a team-high nine game scoring streak, which also a career-high for him. To complete the weekend, Iannazzo had an assist on Joe Jensen's power play goal at the NHC against the Gophers.. Iannazzo leads the club in goals scored this season with 16 and his 16 assists is also a team-high. His 32 points this season, which is a team-high this year, is also a career-high for Iannazzo. His previous career-high was 27 points in 2003-04, and his 16 goals this season ties a career season-high for Iannazzo, who also had 16 goals in 2003-04...senior Mike Doyle posted his 40th career goal on Feb. 25, and his 89th career point as a Husky. Doyle is the team's top active career goal producer, but Iannazzo is closing ground with 37 career goals to his credit.

SENIOR SALUTE: This weekend will mark the final appearance at the National Hockey Center for SCSU seniors Mike Doyle, Matt Gens, Dave Iannazzo, and Peter Szabo. SCSU's senior class has posted a solid 78-63-13 record over the past four seasons, which includes two NCAA tournament appearances and one trip to the WCHA Final Five. SCSU NOTES: Andrew Gordon is the team's top scoring rookie this year with 16 points. On Feb. 25, Gordon marked his seventh assist of the campaign on Doyle's goal...Casey Borer added an assist on Feb. 25, which is his 10th of the season, which is a career season-high for Borer...SCSU outshot UM last night 39-29 on Friday night at Mariucci Arena, which marked the first time since a 6-3 win at UAA that the Huskies have outshot their opponent. The 39 shots was also the most shots posted by SCSU since a 49 shot outburst against Sacred Heart on Jan. 28...frosh forward Sean Garrity notched his second career assist at SCSU on Feb. 26. He now has 1g/2a in 2004-05...the Huskies packed 6,537 fans into the National Hockey Center on Saturday, Feb. 26, for the game against Minnesota...rookie forward Nate Dey scored his seventh assist of the season with his play on Joe Jensen's power play goal on Feb. 26...Joe Jensen ninth career power play goal on Feb. 26 vs. Minnesota. In his career, Jensen has 29 goals at SCSU and 64 points. He ranks second on the squad this year with 11g/12a for 23 points...Junior goalie Jason Montgomery started the game in the nets for SCSU on Feb. 26. This marked Montgomery's first ice time since a Jan. 21 loss at the NHC to Denver. He had 25 saves in the game against the Gophers...UND owns a three game winning streak against the Huskies, and a five-game unbeaten streak against SCSU. The last time SCSU posted a win over UND at the NHC was a 7-3 decision on Nov. 8, 2002.

HUSKIES ON TV: SCSU will have several of its home games this season televised live by Charter Communication Cable channel 65 in the St. Cloud area during 2004-05. Let's Play Hockey publisher Doug Johnson and Roger Buxton will provide color commentary and play-by-play for all the telecasts this season.
