## 2004-05 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Final 2004-05



**THE FINAL RESULTS:** The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05. In the first round of the WCHA finals this season, the Huskies were seeded ninth and lost a pair of games at Colorado College on March Fans can listen to the SCSU games in Colorado live on KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.9, with Don Lyons calling the play-by-play from the Springs.

**2003-04 RESULTS:** The Huskies finished their season with an 18-16-4, 12-12-4 WCHA/6th place). This was the fifth consecutive season that SCSU has finished above the .500 mark.



**SCSU COACH CRAIG DAHL:** SCSU head coach Craig Dahl is in his 18th season with the Huskies, and has been the team's only head coach since SCSU moved to the DI level in 1987-88. Dahl's record at SCSU is 338-309-52, and his all-time collegiate coaching record is 414-396-54. He will begin his 24th year as a collegiate head coach in 2004-05. Dahl served for one season as an assistant coach to Herb Brooks at SCSU in 1986-87, and prior to that he had head coaching assignments at UW-River Falls and Bethel College. Dahl is a 1976 graduate of Pacific Lutheran University.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Dahl was assisted in 2004-05 by Brad Willner and Fred Harbinson. Willner, a 1995 graduate of Lake Superior State, finished his fifth season with the Huskies in 2004-05. Harbinson finished his third season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2004-05. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. SCSU also enlisted the support of video coordinator Josh Flynn this season.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**HUSKIES END SEASON AT CC:** St. Cloud State ended its 2004-05 season on March 11-12, with a pair of losses at the World Arena against #2 seed Colorado College. The Huskies entered the WCHA playoffs as the #9 seed, and lost on March 11 by an 8-2 margin against the Tigers. On March 12, the Huskies lost a tough 4-2 match against Colorado College. On the first night at CC, Nate Raduns scored in the first period and Billy Hengen added a goal in the second, but it wasn't enough to offset CC's scoring blitz - that included for goals in the first period. In total, CC posted 45 shots on goal and SCSU had 31 in the game. On the second night, the offense cooled a bit as the Huskies gained an early lead with a first period marker by Konrad Reeder. CC tied the score at 1-1, before SCSU gained a 2-1 lead going into the final period. CC charged back to gain the win with three goals in the final period. In the game, Tim Boron had 27 saves for the Huskies...of note, this marked the first time SCSU and CC had met in first round play in the WCHA tournament. SCSU is now 19-15-0 in first round action in the WCHA tournament and this was only the seventh time that SCSU had gone on the road for the first round of the WCHA tournament, which was won by Denver this year.

**THE LEADER BOARD:** Senior Dave Iannazzo led the club this season with 16 goals, 16 assists and 32 points. This marked the second consecutive season that Iannazzo has led the team in scoring...on the all-important plus/minus rankings, freshman defender Chris Anderson proved to be a fast learner as he led the club with a +10, while senior defender Matt Gens was second at +8...junior Joe Jensen ranked second on the squad with 12 goals and 26 points. Jensen, who was third on the team with 14 assists, also led the team this year with 130 shots on goal and three game winners (tied with Grant Clifton)...sophomore Justin Fletcher led the crew this winter with six power play goals and also led the team with 39 penalties and 86 penalty minutes...Jensen, Gens and rookie forward Nate Dey played in all 40 games for the Huskies this season...Tim Boron was SCSU's top netminder this year. He played in 1812:26 minutes and notched 855 saves. He also had a .904 save rate and a 3.01 goals against average. Junior goalie Jason Montgomery played in 616:17 minutes this season and was tops on the team with a 2.92 goals against rate. His save percentage in 2004-05 was .886...Fletcher was SCSU's top defensive scorer with 8g/14a for 22 points...Andrew Gordon brought home SCSU's freshmen scoring leader title with 9g/8a for 17 points...Iannazzo led the team with two SHGs this season.

### MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**SENIOR SALUTE:** The seniors on this year's squad included forward Mike Doyle (Anchorage, Alaska), Matt Gens (Baudette, Minn.), Dave Iannazzo (Maple Grove, Minn.) and Peter Szabo (Nitra, Slovakia). Iannazzo and Gens both served as team captains this season.

**ON A ROLL:** Dave Iannazzo led the team this season with a season-high nine game scoring streak. Iannazzo started his roll on Jan. 28 with a goal against Sacred Heart and then rattled off 14 points in his next eight games. An injury late in the season curtailed his streak.

**TOP DOGS:** Billy Hengen set a team-high this season with five points in SCSU's win over Princeton on Oct. 29. SCSU had a player score two goals in a game 10 times this season (which was a team-high). Dave Iannazzo scored two goals in four games this season (Minnesota on Feb. 25, MSU on Feb. 18, MTU on Nov. 13 and Yale on Oct. 30). Joe Jensen scored two goals in two games this season (SHU on Jan. 28 and MTU on Nov. 13). Hengen was the team's leader for assists in a game with four against Princeton on Oct. 29. Jensen hit a team-high with eight shots in a game against UMD on Jan. 14 and Nov. 26. Tim Boron's top save effort this year was 42 vs. Boston College on Dec. 29. T.J. McElroy led SCSU with five penalties vs. UMD on Jan. 15. The five penalties for McElroy ties a team record for most penalties in a game by a defenseman. Ryan LaMere also had five penalties in SCSU's game vs. MSU on Oct. 26, 2001.

**A TOUGH DRAW:** The Huskies were certainly tested this year. In fact, SCSU played 23 of its 40 games this season against nationally ranked opponents. Included in that batch were a total of 16 games played against the four WCHA team playing in this year's Frozen Four (Minnesota, Colorado College, Denver and North Dakota). Out of the league, SCSU posted an impressive win over Ohio State and tied national power Maine (1-1 with a win in the shoot out) and a 2-1 double OT loss to Boston College (in a game that would have normally ended in a tie if it weren't for the OT format at the the Florida College Hockey Classic).

**HUSKIES ON TV:** SCSU had several of its home games this season televised live by Charter Communication Cable channel 65 in the St. Cloud area during 2004-05. Let's Play Hockey publisher Doug Johnson and Roger Buxton will provide color commentary and play-by-play for all the telecasts this season.

**UP NEXT FOR SCSU:** The 2005-06 season, which include a full-slate of WCHA games, along with scheduled non-conference games at Northern Michigan (Oct. 14-15), Brown (Nov. 25-26), Bemidji (Dec. 16-17), and at Colgate (Jan. 6-7). SCSU is slated to play Minnesota at home on Oct. 28-29 (only one series vs. the Gophers next year) and Wisconsin at home on Oct. 21-22. SCSU will be at CC (Nov. 4-5) and MTU (Nov. 11-12) before returning home for the UND series on Nov. 18-19. The Huskies will play at UAA on Dec. 2-3 and also be at Denver on Jan. 13-14. On Jan. 20-21, the Huskies will host UMD, before travelling to UND on Jan. 27-28. On Feb. 3-4, UAA is back in town and on Feb. 10-11, the Huskies will host CC. On Feb. 17-18, SCSU will be at MSU, Mankato and on Feb. 24-25, the Huskies will host MTU. To end the regular season, SCSU will play at UW on March 3-4. ## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**LOOKING AHEAD TO 2005-06:** The Huskies should be well-stocked for the 2005-06 season, as coach Craig Dahl will welcome back several players next winter - which will be his 19th season as head coach at SCSU and his 20th season overall on campus. Of note, Dahl served as one season as an assistant coach for Herb Brooks at SCSU before being named head coach in 1987-88. Next year, SCSU is slated to return three of its top four scorers - including Joe Jensen (12g/14a), Justin Fletcher (8g/14a) and Billy Hengen (7g/15a). SCSU will also return six of its top 10 scorers from 2004-05. SCSU's junior class accounted for 73 points (31g/42a), while the Husky freshmen had 25g/40a and the sophomores had 20g and 43 assists. Both of SCSU's netminders are eligible to return next winter, including Tim Boron, who had a .904 save percentage and a 3.01 GAA as a sophomore in 2004-05. Boron posted 855 saves this winter, which places him fifth in the team records for most saves in a season. Jason Montgomery was SCSU's second netminder this season with a .886 save percentage and a 2.92 GAA.

**IN THE WCHA:** Dave Iannazzo was 22nd in the league (WCHA games only) with 23 points. He also ranked 16th with 11 goals and 36th with 12 assists. Peter Szabo ranked 30th with 13 assists. Justin Fletcher ranked 17th with four power play goals this year and Iannazzo was tied for fourth in the league with two SHGs to his credit and 10th with two GWG (along with Szabo and Grant Clifton). Fletcher ranked 10th among league defenders with 14 WCHA points and Matt Hartman was 17th among league freshmen with eight WCHA points...SCSU's penalty kill was ranked 7th in the league at .786.

**OTHER FACTS AND FIGURES OF INTEREST:** SCSU played its first-ever games in the state of Florida this season, with its appearance at the Florida College Hockey Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. The Huskies placed second at the tournament, with a 1-1 tie against Maine (advanced to title game with a win in the shootout) and a 2-1 double OT loss to Boston College. At 80:59, the game was the longest hockey game in SCSU's Division I history. Since it was the tournament's title game, play was continued until one team scored a goal...SCSU's 109 goals scored in 2004-05 was the team's lowest goal output as a DI program. The previous season-low was 113 in 2003-04. SCSU's trials on offense were offset by another superb season on defense. The Huskies allowed just 121 goals, which is SCSU's seventh best effort on defense since 1987-88. SCSU's 2.98 goals against average also ranks fifth best in the team's DI history...did you know that Joe Jensen, a junior, has an excellent shot at joining SCSU's 100-point club in 2005-06. Jensen currently has 67 career points (30g/37a) this season and only needs 33 points next year to hit the century mark.
