## 2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: Oct. 30, 2006

**READY FOR UND:** The #17 St. Cloud State men's hockey team (2-2-0, 2-2-0 WCHA) will travel to Grand Forks, N.D. for a pair of games at the #6/8 University of North Dakota (5-3, 3-1 WCHA) on Nov. 3-4. On Friday, Nov. 3, the Huskies and UND will face-off at 7:37 p.m. On Saturday, Nov. 4, the game will start at 7:07 p.m. Both games will be played at the Ralph Engelstad Arena (11,406/200x85) in Grand Forks, N.D. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at [www.lite999.com](http://www.lite999.com).

**2006-07 SCSU RECORD:** SCSU is 2-2-0, 2-2-0 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

**20-YEARS AT DI:** The Huskies will be celebrating its 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

**20TH SEASON TRIVIA:** This week's Husky Hockey Trivia question: Which SCSU player scored three shorthanded goals in one game? The answer is below.

**POLL POSITION:** The Huskies currently rank #17 in the most recent USCHO.com poll. In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies received votes but were not ranked in the top 15. In the respected Inside College Hockey Power Rankings poll, the Huskies impressed with a #17 national ranking on Oct. 24...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

**THE ANSWER:** This week's trivia answer is: George Awada. He scored three shorthanded goals in a game against Michigan Tech University on Feb. 14, 1998.

**DQ CUP BEGINS:** The quest for the 2006-07 DQ Cup started on Oct. 20-21, with the SCSU-MSU series. The DQ Cup recognizes the WCHA team with the best record against other Minnesota schools each season. All games that SCSU plays this season against MSU, UMD and UM will count in the DQ Cup standings. SCSU's "DQ Cup Shoot to Win" promotion night is slated for Jan. 20 vs. UMD at the NHC.

### Husky Headliners:

- First meeting between #6/8 UND and #17 SCSU since the classic showdown in the WCHA Final Five championship game in 2006, which UND won 5-3 on March 18, 2006 before 19,282 fans at the Xcel Energy Center.
- SCSU collected two 2-1 wins at the Ralph Engelstad Arena in 2005-06. Defender Matt Stephenson's OT game winner on Jan. 28, 2006 at UND was his first collegiate goal.
- The Huskies are 3-2 in the last five outings against UND, which includes a 3-2 win and a 3-2 loss at the NHC last year against UND.
- SCSU coach Bob Motzko is 3-2-0 during his college coaching career against North Dakota.
- Freshman forward Andreas Nodl has a four-game point scoring streak and is off to one of the best starts in team history with eight points after four games.
- SCSU junior Andrew Gordon has scored four goals in four games this year. He has 33 career goals at SCSU and needs 38 points to reach 100 points in his career.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

**A MAVERICK SPLIT:** SCSU relied on its special team play to gain a big 4-2 win at Minnesota State Mankato Oct. 20. The game featured six power play goals, as the Huskies tied a team record with three power play goals in the first period. SCSU broke the ice in the contest at 7:19 of the first period with a 5x3 power play goal by Andreas Nodl. He was assisted on the play by Aaron Brocklehurst and Justin Fletcher. SCSU pushed the score to 2-0 with a marker by Dan Kronick at 8:33 of the first. He was assisted on the power play goal by Nodl and Ryan Lasch. To cap the first period, Andrew Gordon posted the team's third power play goal at 19:28 of the first period. He was assisted by Nodl and Nate Dey. In the second period, Mankato's Travis Morin broke the shutout with a power play goal at 1:02. The fire was quickly doused by Lasch, who charted his second goal of the season with a power play tally at 17:32. Grant Clifton and Kronick each had an assist on the play. The PPGs continued to flow in the game as Mankato's Kevin Huck scored on the advantage at 5:06 of the third period, which cut the lead to 4-2. MSU pulled its goalie late in the game, but rookie netminder Jase Weslosky stood tall with 28 saves to his credit in his first college start... SCSU failed to gain at weekend sweep over Minnesota State Mankato as the Huskies suffered a tough Homecoming loss to the Mavericks by a 4-2 score on Oct. 21, at the NHC. Gordon put the Huskies up on the scoreboard first with his fourth goal of the season at 3:39 of the first period. He was assisted on the play by Dey and Nodl. MSU tied the score at 13:01 with a power play goal by Joel Hanson. SCSU's Nate Raduns helped the Huskies regain the lead at 16:06 of the second period with his second collegiate shorthanded goal - and the Huskies' first SHG of the season. Matt Stephenson carded the assist on the play. MSU tied the game again at 17:29 of the second period with a goal by Mick Berge. Matt Tyree posted the game winner at 3:59 of the third period, before Berge netted the insurance tally at 4:36 of the third. In the nets, Bobby Goepfert had 24 saves for SCSU. Dan Tormey was the goalie of record for MSU with 25 saves.

**PLENTY OF POWER PLAY GOALS:** The Huskies tied a team period record with three power play goals in the first period on Oct. 20 at MSU. The last time SCSU had three power play goals in a period was during the third period in a game on Dec. 22, 2001 against Minnesota State Mankato at the NHC. SCSU ended the game with four power play goals (4-of-7). The last time SCSU posted that many power play goals in a game was during a 7-0 victory at Michigan Tech on Nov. 12, 2005. In that contest, SCSU was 4-of-10 on the advantage.

**FIRST SCORE IN 2006-07:** Junior forward Dan Kronick (Inver Grove Heights) scored his first points of the new season on Oct. 20. Kronick had a goal and an assist in the win at Mankato. In that same game, junior defender Aaron Brocklehurst (Nanaimo, B.C.) and senior forward Grant Clifton (Grand Rapids) each had their first assists of the new season.

**A SHG FOR RADUNS:** Senior Nate Raduns charted SCSU's first shorthanded goal of the 2006-07 on Oct. 21, with his SHG at 16:06 of the second period against MSU. He was assisted on the play by Matt Stephenson. This was Raduns' second career SHG. Last year, the Huskies carded seven SHGs. The team record for SHGs in a season is 14, set in 1993-94.

### The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (24-18-4, 15-15-2 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**MOTZKO'S STAFF:** Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features long-time veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 ([www.1450knsi.com](http://www.1450knsi.com)). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

**TOP ROOKIE:** After four games this season, Andreas Nodl leads the nation's rookies in scoring with an average of 2.00 points per game. Nodl has three goals and five assists this season. The eight points is one of the best starts in team history after four games. Of note, SCSU legend Ryan Malone had seven points in his first four games as a Husky in 1999-00. Malone currently plays for the Pittsburgh Penguins. In the year that he was a Hobey Baker top three finalist, SCSU's Mark Hartigan also had eight points after his fourth game of the season in 2001-02. Hartigan was a senior with the Huskies that season.

**SECOND WEEK IN A ROW:** A SCSU player earned WCHA Rookie of the Week honors for the second consecutive week on Oct. 24, when freshman netminder Jase Weslosky (St. Albert, Alberta - a suburb of Edmonton) was tabbed for league honors. Weslosky had a stellar debut in the nets on Oct. 20, when he backstopped the Huskies to a 4-2 win at Mankato. He had 28 saves in the game and allowed two goals - both on the power play. Weslosky's play helped the Huskies gain the win despite being outshot 30-19 by MSU. On the previous week, Andreas Nodl gained POW accolades. Weslosky's start marked the end of Bobby Goepfert's 20-game consecutive start streak in the nets for the Huskies.

**STREAKERS:** SCSU's top line of Andrew Gordon, Nate Dey and Andreas Nodl all lead the club with four-game point scoring streaks this season. Nodl leads the team with eight points (3g/5a), while Gordon leads the team with four goals (4g/1a). Dey tops the team with six assists. He had one assist apiece in each game against MSU. Dey is on a roll this season with his six assists, and he only needs three more assists to tie his season output of nine assists last year. In 2004-05, Dey charted seven assists and was named the team's Rookie of the Year that season. Did you know that Dey's younger sister Stacy Dey plays for the SCSU women's hockey team. Last year, Gordon had a four-game point scoring streak and that proved to be the longest point-scoring streak by a SCSU player in 2005-06 - along with a four-game run by Billy Hengen

**CALIFORNIA KID:** Two of SCSU's top scorers are freshmen this season, aside from Nodl's numbers, freshman forward Ryan Lasch (Lake Forest, Calif. - in Orange County) has enjoyed a great start at SCSU. In four games, Lasch has two goals and two assists, and on Oct. 20, Lasch posted his second goal of the season with a power-play marker against the Mavericks. According to the team archives, the only other SCSU player to hail from California at the DI level was goalie Mike O'Hara, who played at SCSU from 1988-92. O'Hara prepped at nearby Edina H.S. but listed Balboa Island, Calif. as his residence in 1991-92.

**2005-06 SEASON WRAP:** The Huskies completed the 2005-06 season with a 22-16-4 overall record and gained a top 15 ranking in the NCAA Division I polls last season. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed sixth in the regular season with a 13-13-2 record. To cap the campaign, the Huskies lit up the post-season with a first round WCHA playoff series win over Colorado College. At the 2006 WCHA Final Five, the Huskies charted a 5-1 victory over Minnesota Duluth in the play-in game on March 16, at the Xcel Energy Center. SCSU continued its roll with a huge 8-7 OT win over Minnesota before a Final Five record crowd of 19,353 on March 17. SCSU completed its run with a tough 5-3 loss to North Dakota in the Final Five title game on March 18.
