2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: Oct. 2, 2006

2006-07 SEASON OPENER: The St. Cloud State men's hockey team will kick-off its 2006-07 season with an exhibition game against Lethbridge University on Friday, Oct. 6. Game time at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100) is slated for 7:07 p.m. The game will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and former SCSU All-American Dave Reichel calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.1450knsi.com. The game will also be televised live on Charter Channel 21 in the St. Cloud area only. SCSU grad and KARE 11 TV personality Rob Hudson and former SCSU standout Jeff Saterdalen will provide the play-by-play. Of note, the remainder of the SCSU home games will be televised live on Charter Cable's Main Street Network (channel 14 in the St. Cloud area).

2005-06 SEASON WRAP: The Huskies completed the 2005-06 season with a 22-16-4 overall record and gained a top 15 ranking in the NCAA Division I polls last season. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed sixth in the regular season with a 13-13-2 record. To cap the campaign, the Huskies lit up the post-season with a first round WCHA playoff series win over Colorado College. At the 2006 WCHA Final Five, the Huskies charted a 5-1 victory over Minnesota Duluth in the play-in game on March 16, at the Xcel Energy Center. SCSU continued its roll with a huge 8-7 OT win over Minnesota before a Final Five record crowd of 19,353 on March 17. SCSU completed its run with a tough 5-3 loss to North Dakota in the Final Five title game on March 18.



WCHA COACH OF THE YEAR: Bob Motzko (22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. This marks the first time since 1998 that SCSU has brought home the prestigious WCHA Coach of the Year award. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005.

LORD STANLEY: Former SCSU players Bret Hedican and Matt Cullen were both members of the 2005-06 Carolina Hurricanes that won the Stanley Cup in June 2006. This marks the first time a former SCSU player had his name etched on the cup since Frank Brimsek led the Boston Bruins to two Stanley Cup titles in 1939 and 1941. Hedican brought the Cup back to the NHC in August for SCSU's first-ever Stanley Cup Festival at the NHC, which also included an appearance by Cullen in front a packed crowd in the NHC. Hedican played with the Huskies from 1988-91, while Cullen played here from 1995-97. Hedican will skate with the Hurricanes once more this year, while Cullen will play for the New York Rangers. The Cup capped a big year for former Huskies, as Hedican Cullen and fellow Husky Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97 were members of the USA Men's Olympic hockey team at the 2006 Winter Olympics. Last year, a total of eight former SCSU players suited up for NHL games.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating its 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

POLL POSITION: SCSU finished the season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season. To kick-off the 2006-07 season, the Huskies were ranked 16th in the USCHO.com pre-season poll, while they received votes in the 2006-07 pre-season poll released by USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter is junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and the second alternate will be named this week.

FINAL FIVE FACTS: The Huskies advanced to the championship game of the WCHA Final Five for the third time in team history in 2006. SCSU is now 7-11 in games played at the Final Five since 1994...this marked the first time SCSU qualified for the Final Five since an appearance in 2001-02, and the first time since winning the Final Five in 2001, that the Huskies have made it to the title game...this marked the first time since 1996 that the winner of the play-in game advanced to the championship game at the Final Five... the 15 goals scored by SCSU and UM in the semi-finals on March 17 was the most ever for a WCHA Final Five game (in the tournament's current format since 1988)...SCSU and UM set a new WCHA single-game attendance record at the Final Five with a crowd of 19,353 at the Xcel Energy Center on March 17. The Huskies also packed 19,282 for the title game against UND on March 18. These marked the two largest crowds to ever watch SCSU play a men's hockey game since moving to the DI level in 1987-88...in the WCHA post-season playoffs since 1990-91, SCSU owns a 29-29 overall record. In first-round play, SCSU is 22-18 overall...SCSU won the WCHA Final Five title in 2001, with a 6-5 OT win over North Dakota at the Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul. Former SCSU standout and current NHLer Tyler Arnason was the Final Five MVP that year...SCSU's first trip to the WCHA Final Five came in 1993-94, where they lost in the title game to Minnesota by a 3-2 score in OT. The Huskies have also advanced to the Final Five in 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2002.

MOST WINS SINCE 2001-02: SCSU ended the year with a 22-16-4 overall record. This marks the first time that SCSU has gained 20-plus wins since the Huskies notched a 29-11-2 in 2001-02. SCSU has charted 20-plus wins seven times since going to the Division I level in 1987-88, and the Huskies' best season record was a 31-9-1 run in 2000-01 – the lone season that SCSU has posted 30-plus wins in a season.

FIRST TEAM ALL-WCHA: Netminder Bobby Goepfert was named to the All-WCHA First Team in 2005-06. He is the first SCSU hockey player to gain All-WCHA honors since 2001-02. He is the first Husky goalie to gain All-WCHA honors since Dean Weasler gained second team accolades in 2001-02. He is the first SCSU goalie to gain first team honors since Scott Meyer was named to the All-WCHA top team in 2000-01. This marks the seventh time that a Husky goalie has gained All-WCHA honors since 1990-91.

WISE GUYS: The Huskies set a team record this season with 16 players named to the All-WCHA Academic team. Those players included: Chris Anderson, Tim Boron, Aaron Brocklehurst, Justin Fletcher, Matt Francis, Andrew Gordon, Matt Hartman, Billy Hengen, Gary Houseman, Joe Jensen, T.J. McElroy, Marty Mjelleli, Nate Raduns, Konrad Reeder, Josh Singer, Matt Stephenson. Both Raduns and Stephenson were also honored as WCHA Scholar-Athletes in 2006.

HUSKY HIGHLIGHTS: SCSU was 20-3-2 when its allowed two or less goals in a game last season...Andrew Gordon now has 57 career points, which puts him on track to join SCSU's 100-point club...SCSU outshot its opponents 1414-1233 last season, and the team outscored its opponents 134-99...SCSU was +112 as a team.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features long-time veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

FOR THE RECORD: Bobby Goepfert broke a team season record in 2005-06 with a 2.20 goals against average last season. The old record of 2.22 GAA was held by Dean Weasler in 2001-02. Goepfert's .924 save percentage ranks second best in team history behind Scott Meyer's .926 save percentage in 2000-01. Of note, Goepfert is just the second goalie in team history to post 1,000 saves in a season. The goaltender from Long Island had 1,010 saves in 2005-06. Brian Leitza is the team save record holder with 1,041 in 1997-98. An ironman between the pipes, Goepfert set a team record this season with 2264:29 minutes played. He saw action in 38 of SCSU's 42 games played this season. The old record of 2237:53 minutes played was set by Brian Leitza in 1997-98.

HUSKIES SECURE TOP 6 FINISH: SCSU completed its 2005-06 regular season with a 13-13-2 WCHA finish. SCSU placed sixth with 28 points, which is 11 points better than last year's ninth place finish in the league. Of note, the league's pre-season poll placed the Huskies in ninth place at the beginning of the 2005-06 campaign. Since 1996-97, the Huskies have finished lower than sixth place only twice. SCSU's best league regular season finishes were second place endings in 2001 and 2002.

OUT OF THE BOX: SCSU set a new team season standard for the least amount of penalty minutes in a season. SCSU only had 248 penalties for 551 PIM last season. The previous team low was 559 PIM on 251 penalties in 2003-04. SCSU was the nation's least penalized team in 2005-06....SCSU's 30 power play goals allowed this season is the fourth lowest amount of PPG in a season for the Huskies in team history. SCSU's fewest PPG in a season allowed was 26 in 1999-00, 28 in 2003-04 and 29 in 2000-01.

SHUT'EM DOWN: The Huskies' defense was tough in 2005-06. SCSU allowed just 97 goals in 42 games, which breaks down to 2.27 goals allowed per game. This was the second fewest goals allowed by SCSU in a season and only the third time that SCSU has allowed under 100 goals in a season. The team record for fewest goals allowed in a season was 92 in 2000-01. SCSU allowed 97 goals in 2001-02.

RUGGED SCHEDULE: The 2006 Final Five marked yet another weekend when SCSU squared off against nationally ranked teams. In those contests against nationally ranked squads, SCSU was 11-12-2 last year. SCSU charted a win or tie against all of its nationally ranked opponents last season. SCSU's win over #1 ranked Minnesota on March 17, marked the first time since Nov. 14, 2003 (2-1 win at North Dakota) that the Huskies have gained a win over a #1 ranked team. In the 2006-07 pre-season polls, the WCHA is well-represented with Minnesota, Wisconsin, North Dakota, Denver and Colorado College all ranked among the nation's top 15 teams. Of teams listed on SCSU's schedule this season, the Huskies are schedule to play 24 games against teams ranked (or received votes) in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine pre-season poll for 2006-07. The Huskies are also slated to play at the Vermont Tournament this year, which features RPI, Union and Vermont. The Catamounts also received votes in the latest USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll.

TIED RECORD: SCSU goalie Bobby Goepfert has already tied a team record in 2005-06 with four ties to his credit last winter. Other SCSU goalies to post four ties in a season were Jason Montgomery in 2002-03, Dean Weasler in 1998-99, Mike O'Hara in 1990-91 and Brian Leitza in 1995-96. SCSU's 10 overtime games this season equals a team high for OT games in a season. SCSU also had 10 OT games in 1999-00.

NANAIMO FLAVOR: The Huskies will feature several players with ties to Nanaimo, B.C. Players that hail from Nanaimo include junior defender/forward Aaron Brocklehurst and freshman A.J. Gale. Brocklehurst played junior hockey for Victoria (BCHL), while Gale played for Nanaimo in the BCHL. Others players who played junior hockey for Nanaimo (BCHL) include sophomore Michael Olson (Tisdale, Sask.) and freshman defender Craig Gaudet (Tisdale, Sask.). The trend was started by former Husky Brock Hooton, who is from the Nanaimo area and played junior hockey with Quesnel (BCHL) before playing at SCSU from 2002-06. Last year, Hooton gained WCHA Final Five All-Tournament honors and is now in the San Jose (NHL) system.

INCH HONORS SCSU: Inside College Hockey listed the Huskies as having the seventh best "freshman class" among the nation's Division I men's ice hockey programs this fall. Individually, SCSU first year goaltender Jase Weslosky was ranked fourth in Inside College Hockey's listing of top 10 freshman goalies in Division I this season. SCSU's Andreas Nodl, a freshman forward from Vienna, Austria and recent draft choice of the Philadelphia Flyers, was listed as Inside College Hockey's sixth best freshman forward in 2006-07.

MORE PRE-SEASON NOTICE: Goalie Bobby Goepfert and forward Andrew Gordon were both listed as "players to watch" by College Hockey News on its 2006-07 preseason All-America team.

TEAM IMPROVEMENT: The Huskies scored 134 goals in 2005-06, which was a 25 goal improvement from 2004-05, when they posted a program-low 109 goals. SCSU also charted 41 power play goals this season, which is 11 more than last year's 30 PPG. SCSU had a +112 on the plus/minus this season, while it posted a -33 as a team in 2004-05. Of note, Justin Fletcher and Andrew Gordon led the club at +19 this year. In 2004-05, Fletcher was -6 and Gordon was -6.
