2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: Oct. 9, 2006

2006-07 SEASON OPENER: The #16 St. Cloud State men's hockey team will kick-off its 2006-07 regular season and WCHA campaign with a weekend series against the #11/12 University of Denver (1-1-0, 0-0-0 WCHA) on Oct. 13 and Oct. 14. Game time both nights at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100) in St. Cloud is slated for 7:07 p.m. The game will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and former SCSU All-American Dave Reichel calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.1450knsi.com. KVSC FM 88.1 will also broadcast the games live from the NHC, with the web stream available at www.kvsc.org. The game will also be televised live on Charter Channel Mainstreet Network (Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). SCSU grad and KARE 11 TV personality Rob Hudson and former SCSU standout Jeff Saterdalen will provide the play-by-play. .

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 0-0-0, 0-0-0 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies posted an 8-2 win over Lethbridge in an exhibition game on Oct. 6.



WCHA COACH OF THE YEAR: Bob Motzko (22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. This marks the first time since 1998 that SCSU has brought home the prestigious WCHA Coach of the Year award. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating its 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

20TH SEASON TRIVIA: This week's Husky Hockey Trivia question: Name the Huskies' career scoring land assist leader, who is in his first season as the team's television color commentator in 2006-07? The answer is below.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies were ranked 16th in the recent USCHO.com pre-season poll, while they received votes in the 2006-07 recent poll released by USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

LORD STANLEY: Former SCSU players Bret Hedican and Matt Cullen were both members of the 2005-06 Carolina Hurricanes that won the Stanley Cup in June 2006. This marks the first time a former SCSU player had his name etched on the cup since Frank Brimsek led the Boston Bruins to two Stanley Cup titles in 1939 and 1941. Hedican brought the Cup back to the NHC in August for SCSU's first-ever Stanley Cup Festival at the NHC, which also included an appearance by Cullen in front a packed crowd in the NHC. Hedican played with the Huskies from 1988-91, while Cullen played here from 1995-97. Hedican will skate with the Hurricanes once more this year, while Cullen will play for the New York Rangers. The Cup capped a big year for former Huskies, as Hedican Cullen and fellow Husky Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97 were members of the USA Men's Olympic hockey team at the 2006 Winter Olympics. Last year, a total of eight former SCSU players suited up for NHL games.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

HUSKIES WHIP PRONGHORNS: SCSU charted a big 8-2 win over Lethbridge on Oct. 6, in an exhibition game at the NHC. Junior forward Nate Dey scored two goals and one assist in SCSU's win over Lethbridge, while newcomer Andreas Nodl had one goal and two assists in the game. SCSU's top returning scorer Andrew Gordon, a junior from Porters Lake, Nova Scotia, led the Huskies in the exhibition match with one goal and three assists. Gordon notched 20 goals and 20 assists last year for the Huskies...the game against Lethbridge gave coach Bob Motzko, the 2006 WCHA Coach of the Year, ample opportunity to work on his power play combinations. Lethbridge had 54 penalty minutes in the game (16 penalties), as the Huskies went 5-of-14 on the power play...aside from Nodl's solid debut in the cardinal and black, SCSU rookies A.J. Gale (Nanaimo, B.C.) and Ryan Lasch (Lake Forest, Calif.) also posted goals in the win over Lethbridge... in the nets, SCSU All-American senior Bobby Goepfert played one period in the Lethbridge win. He posted two saves in his 20 minutes of work. Freshmen Jase Weslosky, a 2006 draftee of the New York Islanders, and B.J. O'Brien each played one period in the Lethbridge game. Lethbridge finished their trip to Minnesota with a 4-3 OT win at Minnesota State Mankato and a 6-2 loss to Minnesota.

MOST WINS SINCE 2001-02: SCSU ended the year with a 22-16-4 overall record. This marks the first time that SCSU has gained 20-plus wins since the Huskies notched a 29-11-2 in 2001-02. SCSU has charted 20-plus wins seven times since going to the Division I level in 1987-88, and the Huskies' best season record was a 31-9-1 run in 2000-01 – the lone season that SCSU has posted 30-plus wins in a season.

FIRST TEAM ALL-WCHA: Netminder Bobby Goepfert was named to the All-WCHA First Team in 2005-06. He is the first SCSU hockey player to gain All-WCHA honors since 2001-02. He is the first Husky goalie to gain All-WCHA honors since Dean Weasler gained second team accolades in 2001-02. He is the first SCSU goalie to gain first team honors since Scott Meyer was named to the All-WCHA top team in 2000-01. This marks the seventh time that a Husky goalie has gained All-WCHA honors since 1990-91.

WISE GUYS: The Huskies set a team record this season with 16 players named to the All-WCHA Academic team. Those players included: Chris Anderson, Tim Boron, Aaron Brocklehurst, Justin Fletcher, Matt Francis, Andrew Gordon, Matt Hartman, Billy Hengen, Gary Houseman, Joe Jensen, T.J. McElroy, Marty Mjelleli, Nate Raduns, Konrad Reeder, Josh Singer, Matt Stephenson. Both Raduns and Stephenson were also honored as WCHA Scholar-Athletes in 2006.

LOCAL FLAVOR: SCSU continues to build locally as four players from the St. Cloud area are on the team's roster in 2006-07. Those players include St. Cloud residents junior forward Matt Hartman (Apollo H.S.) and sophomore forward John Swanson (Tech H.S.) and Sauk Rapids residents senior forward Nate Raduns (Sauk Rapids-Rice H.S.) and freshman forward Ryan Peckskamp (Sauk Rapids-Rice H.S.). Raduns has posted 13 goals and 25 assists during his career at SCSU.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of

the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO's STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features long-time veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

FOR THE RECORD: Bobby Goepfert broke a team season record in 2005-06 with a 2.20 goals against average last season. The old record of 2.22 GAA was held by Dean Weasler in 2001-02. Goepfert's .924 save percentage ranks second best in team history behind Scott Meyer's .926 save percentage in 2000-01. Of note, Goepfert is just the second goalie in team history to post 1,000 saves in a season. The goaltender from Long Island had 1,010 saves in 2005-06. Brian Leitza is the team save record holder with 1,041 in 1997-98. An ironman between the pipes, Goepfert set a team record this season with 2264:29 minutes played. He saw action in 38 of SCSU's 42 games played this season. The old record of 2237:53 minutes played was set by Brian Leitza in 1997-98.

SKATE WITH THE HUSKIES: The annual Skate With the Huskies program will take place from 6 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 22. Fans will get an opportunity to hit the ice at the National Hockey Center with members of the 2006-07 men's and women's hockey teams from SCSU. This event is open to the public and admission is free.

AUTOGRAPH DEN: After the Oct. 13 game against DU, SCSU players slated to appear in the Husky Autograph Den are senior captain Casey Borer and freshman forward Andreas Nodl. SCSU players available for autographs after the Oct. 14 game are senior forward Nate Raduns and freshman forward Ryan Lasch. Players appearing in the autograph den are subject to change.

CLOSING IN: SCSU senior defender Justin Fletcher owns the team record for power play goals by a defenseman with 15 in his career. He has 20g/42 assists in his sterling career at SCSU, and only needs 38 points to join the Huskies' elite 100-Point Club. Junior forward Andrew Gordon could also reach the 100-Point Club this season, as he currently has 57 points (29g/28a) in his two seasons with the Huskies.

SHUT'EM DOWN: The Huskies' defense was tough in 2005-06. SCSU allowed just 97 goals in 42 games, which breaks down to 2.27 goals allowed per game. This was the second fewest goals allowed by SCSU in a season and only the third time that SCSU has allowed under 100 goals in a season. The team record for fewest goals allowed in a season was 92 in 2000-01. SCSU allowed 97 goals in 2001-02.

ODDS AND ENDS: Andreas Nodl is the second SCSU player from Austria during the DI era. The first Austrian player to suit up with the Huskies was goalie Gert Prohaska, who played here in 1998-99...Andrew Gordon is the first resident of Nova Scotia to play hockey at SCSU during the DI era...Bobby Goepfert ranks ninth in team history with 1,010 career saves...Coach Bob Motzko was a student assistant coach for Herb Brooks with the Huskies in 1986-87. SCSU won the NCHA conference title that season and placed third in the nation at the NCAA Division III championships that season. The season marked the end of the DII/DIII era at SCSU, as the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88... Gordon had 40 points in 2005-06 for the Huskies, the last SCSU player to hit 40 points in a season was Joe Motzko with 42 in 2002-03. Gordon also had 20 goals last year. He is the first SCSU player since Mark Hartigan had 37 in 2001-02, to score 20-or-more goals in a season.

2005-06 SEASON WRAP: The Huskies completed the 2005-06 season with a 22-16-4 overall record and gained a top 15 ranking in the NCAA Division I polls last season. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed sixth in the regular season with a 13-13-2 record. To cap the campaign, the Huskies lit up the post-season with a first round WCHA playoff series win over Colorado College. At the 2006 WCHA Final Five, the Huskies charted a 5-1 victory over Minnesota Duluth in the play-in game on March 16, at the Xcel Energy Center. SCSU continued its roll with a huge 8-7 OT win over Minnesota before a Final Five record crowd of 19,353 on March 17. SCSU completed its run with a tough 5-3 loss to North Dakota in the Final Five title game on March 18.

INCH HONORS SCSU: Inside College Hockey listed the Huskies as having the seventh best "freshman class" among the nation's Division I men's ice hockey programs this fall. Individually, SCSU first year goaltender Jase Weslosky was ranked fourth in Inside College Hockey's listing of top 10 freshman goalies in Division I this season. SCSU's Andreas Nodl, a freshman forward from Vienna, Austria and recent draft choice of the Philadelphia Flyers, was listed as Inside College Hockey's sixth best freshman forward in 2006-07.

MORE PRE-SEASON NOTICE: Goalie Bobby Goepfert and forward Andrew Gordon were both listed as "players to watch" by College Hockey News on its 2006-07 preseason All-America team.

TEAM IMPROVEMENT: The Huskies scored 134 goals in 2005-06, which was a 25 goal improvement from 2004-05, when they posted a program-low 109 goals. SCSU also charted 41 power play goals this season, which is 11 more than last year's 30 PPG. SCSU had a +112 on the plus/minus this season, while it posted a -33 as a team in 2004-05. Of note, Justin Fletcher and Andrew Gordon led the club at +19 this year. In 2004-05, Fletcher was -6 and Gordon was -6.
