**#4 HUSKIES vs. MAVERICKS:** The #4 St. Cloud State University Huskies (14-3-3, 8-3-3 WCHA) will return to WCHA play this weekend as they host the Minnesota State Mankato University (6-14-3, 4-10-2 WCHA) on Friday, Jan. 12 at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100) in St. Cloud. The game is slated to start at 7:07 p.m. On Jan. 13, the Huskies will travel to Minnesota State Mankato for a 7:07 p.m. game at the Midwest Wireless Civic Center in downtown Mankato. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots. You can listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at [www.lite999.com](http://www.lite999.com). The Jan. 12 game will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 ([www.kvsc.org](http://www.kvsc.org)). On television, the games will both be televised live on the Charter Cable Mainstreet Network (channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Rob Hudson will offer the play-by-play with color commentary by Paul Osen on Jan. 12. Charter Channel 14 will pick up the feed from Mankato on Jan. 13. **2006-07 SCSU RECORD:** SCSU is 14-3-3, 8-3-3 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

**20-YEARS AT DI:** The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

**POLL POSITION:** The Huskies currently rank #4 in the most recent USCHO.com poll (as of 1/8/07). In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 4th (1/8/07) and SCSU was ranked 3rd in the respected Inside College Hockey poll (1/8/2007). SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 22 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006. This marks the highest poll position for the Huskies since they hit #4 on March 11, 2002 in the USCHO.com poll...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

## Husky Headliners:

- SCSU received its best national poll position since March 11, 2002, with a #4 ranking in both the USCHO.com poll this week.
- The Huskies are in the midst of an 15-game undefeated string, dating back to Nov. 4 at North Dakota. This is the longest unbeaten string in history during the DI era. SCSU has also won 12-games in a row, which is the longest in team history at the DI level. SCSU owns the longest active win streak in the nation at the DI level at 12 games.
- SCSU junior Andrew Gordon was named WCHA Offensive Player of the Week on Jan. 9 for his 3g/1a weekend against UAA.
- Senior goalie Bobby Goepfert was an honorable mention selection for the HCA Division I National Player of the Month award in December, 2006.
- Andrew Gordon and Andreas Nodl lead all WCHA players in scoring this winter at 1.35 ppg.
- The Huskies will be looking to break a four-game losing skid to the Mavericks at the National Hockey Center this weekend. SCSU last win over MSU at the NHC was an 8-5 decision on Jan. 23, 2004.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

**HUSKIES SWEEP UAA:** It was another WCHA sweep for the Huskies, as they charted a 4-2 and 4-1 wins over visiting Alaska Anchorage on Jan. 5-6. UAA jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the first period on Jan. 5, by the Huskies tied the game in the second with a goal by Ryan Lasch. UAA charged back with a 2-1 lead, but a power play goal by Andrew Gordon tied the game at 16:58 of the second. In the final period, SCSU took command with the game winning goal at 15:50 by John Swanson. Dan Kronick iced the result with his ninth goal of the season at 18:21 of the third period. In the game, Bobby Goepfert had a workout with 35 saves to his credit as the Seawolves outshot SCSU 37-33...to complete the weekend, SCSU used a pair of goals by Gordon to defeat UAA 4-1 on Jan. 6. Gordon scored at 11:49 of the first period to give the Huskies an early lead. UAA tied the game early in the second, before Nate Dey notched game winner at 18:22 of the period. In the third period, Swanson and Gordon added insurance goals to seal the Huskies 12th consecutive victory. Frosh goalie Jase Weslosky maintained his 1.00 GAA this season with 20 saves and one goal allowed in the game. He is now 4-0-0 this season. SCSU outshot the Seawolves 38-21.

**TWO MORE FOR SCSU:** The 15-game unbeaten string is the longest unbeaten stretch for the Huskies in team history at the DI level (since 1987-88). The Huskies are 12-0-3 since Nov. 4, which includes ties against #1 Minnesota and North Dakota plus wins over Clarkson, UMD, MTU, Colgate, Union, Vermont and UAA. SCSU has also won 12 consecutive games, which is also the longest winning streak in team history at the NCAA Division I level. Did you know that SCSU went undefeated in 1961-62 with a 11-0-0 record and also won 23 games in a row during the 1959-61 seasons.

**THIRD IN THE NATION:** A tough team on the penalty kill, SCSU has not allowed a power play goal since Nov. 18, and the Huskies have gone 38-of-38 on the penalty kill during this amazing run. At present, the Huskies are ranked third in the nation on the penalty kill at 89.7 percent (78-of-87) this season. In other special teams news, SCSU ranks third in the nation on the power play at 23.3 percent (24-of-103).

**TEAM LEADERS:** Junior Andrew Gordon is now tied for the team scoring lead along with freshman Andreas Nodl. The pair have 27 points apiece. Gordon, who had three goals and one assist against UAA, leads the team with 13 goals while Nodl tops the team with 17 assists. The pair lead all WCHA players with 1.35 ppg. Nodl ranks second among Division I rookies at 1.35 ppg and teammate Ryan Lasch is seventh among DI rookies with 1.15 ppg this winter.

**GREAT GOALIES:** SCSU's netminders have been charting impressive numbers this season. Rookie Jase Weslosky improved to 4-0-0 on the season with his 4-1 win over UAA on Jan. 6. He owns a 1.00 GAA and a .961 save percentage. Weslosky has allowed just four goals in 240:00 minutes of play this season. Senior All-American Bobby Goepfert now owns a 2.27 GAA this winter with a 10-3-3 record and a .925 save rate. Goepfert numbers have been stellar during the 15-game unbeaten streak. He is 9-0-3 with a 1.95 GAA and a .938 save rate. In the 12-game winning streak, Goepfert's numbers include a 1.54 GAA and a .950 save rate.

### The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (36-19-7, 21-16-5 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**MOTZKO's STAFF:** Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 ([www.1450knsi.com](http://www.1450knsi.com)). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

**STILL UNBEATEN:** The two wins over Alaska Anchorage extended the Huskies unbeaten streak at the NHC against the Seawolves to 26-0-2. SCSU has never lost to UAA at the NHC since the building opened in 1989-90. The last time SCSU lost a decision to the Seawolves in St. Cloud was a pair of setbacks on Nov. 5-6, 1987 - when the Huskies played their home games at the nearby MAC complex in St. Cloud.

**COULD BE A RECORD:** The Huskies have not allowed a power play goal since Nov. 18, when they gave up one in a win over Clarkson. Since that time, SCSU has been perfect on the penalty kill - marking a 10-game run without allowing a power play goal. The previous longest run without a power play goal allowed was eight games from Oct. 16, 1999 to Nov. 6, 1999. This was the previous best mark dating back to 1993-94. Research is still being done to check back to the start of DI hockey in 1987-88.

**ODDS AND ENDS:** Since Nov. 17, the Huskies have outscored their opponents 48-16, and they have allowed only one power play goal...Bobby Goepfert ranks 15th in the nation among DI goalies with a 2.27 GAA this season...the Huskies' 15-game unbeaten streak is the second longest in DI hockey, and their 12-game winning streak is tops among DI hockey teams this season...the Huskies rank 10th in the nation on offense with an average of 3.65 goals per game...on defense, the Huskies rank sixth in the nation with an average of 2.05 goals allowed per game... at 10.8 PIM per game, the Huskies are the second least penalized team in the nation this season...SCSU is allowing just 2.0 goals per game this season (41 goals in 20 games). Of note, set a team defensive record with only 94 goals allowed during the 2000-01 season (2.29 gpg)...freshman Garrett Raboin had an assist on Jan. 6, and senior Casey Borer had a career high two assists on Jan. 6 vs. UAA. Borer is in his second season as team captain for the Huskies...John Swanson scored his seventh goal of the season on Jan. 6, which is a new career season-high for Swanson. He also has a career season-high 13 points this year...junior Matt Stephenson had a career season-high 11 assists in 2006-07 and Nate Dey has career season-highs this year with seven goals, 15 assists and 22 points. Dey is one of four SCSU players with 20+ points this season. The others include Gordon (27), Nodl (27) and Lasch (23).
