2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

HUSKIES VS. HUSKIES: The #10/11 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (6-3-3, 4-3-3 WCHA) will be back on the road this week for a pair of WCHA showdowns at Michigan Tech University in Houghton, Mich. Both games are slated to begin at 6:07 p.m. (Central Time), and they will be played at the MacInnes Ice Arena (4,200/200x85) on the campus of MTU. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com.

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 6-3-3, 4-3-3 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

20TH SEASON TRIVIA: This week's Husky Hockey Trivia question: Name the Husky who scored a shorthanded hat trick? The answer is below.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies currently rank #10 in the most recent USCHO.com poll. In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 11th and SCSU was ranked 13th in the Inside College Hockey poll. SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 17 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006. This marks the highest poll position for the Huskies since they hit #9 on Feb. 23 in the USCHO.com poll. The previous best was 13th hit last week and on March 1, 2004 in the USCHO.com poll...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

THE ANSWER: This week's trivia answer is: George Awada accomplished this amazing feat with three shorties in one game against Michigan Tech on Feb. 14, 1998.

THE DQ CUP: The quest for the 2006-07 DQ Cup continues this week. The DQ Cup recognizes the WCHA team with the best record against other Minnesota schools each season. All games that SCSU plays this season against MSU, UMD and UM will count in the DQ Cup standings. SCSU's "DQ Cup Shoot to Win" promotion night is slated for Jan. 20 vs. UMD at the NHC.

Husky Headliners:

- The Huskies received their first top 10 national poll ranking since Feb. 23, 2004. This week, the Huskies gained a #10 ranking in the USCH. The last time SCSU was ranked higher than 10th place in the USCHO.com poll was a ninth place poll spot on Feb. 23, 2004.
- The Huskies are in the midst of a seven-game undefeated string, dating back to Nov. 4 at North Dakota. This is the longest unbeaten string since a nine-game run to start the 2003-04 season.
- SCSU is 3-1-1 in its last five meetings against MTU, and it is 7-1-2 in the last 10 outings against MTU. SCSU 4-1-0 in the last five meetings at MTU and last year split a series in Houghton, losing 3-2 in OT on Nov. 11, 2005 and winning 7-0 on Nov. 12, 2005. Back at the NHC, SCSU posted a 6-1 win and a 2-2 tie on Feb. 24-25, 2006.
- Dan Kronick and Bobby Goepfert earn WCHA Player of the Week honors on Nov. 28!
- Forward Andreas Nodl leads the WCHA in scoring at 1.50 ppg, while Andrew Gordon is second at 1.42 ppg. Nodl and frosh Ryan Lasch rank 1-2 among the nation's rookies with 1.50 ppg and 1.33 ppg respectively.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

HUSKIES SWEEP UMD: The Huskies gained a league sweep at Minnesota Duluth on Nov. 24 (4-0) and Nov. 25). This was SCSU's second consecutive series sweep of the season, and the first WCHA sweep since a pair of win sover UAA on Feb. 3-4, 2006 at the NHC (and the first road sweep for the Huskies since a pair of wins at UND on Jan. 27-28, 2006). Bobby Goepfert was the star game one at UMD with 31 saves in the shutout. This was his first shutout of the season, and fourth at SCSU. Dan Kronick charted the early game-winner at 15:07 of the second period, with assists from Ryan Lasch and Grant Clifton. Nate Dey scored two unanswered goals for the Huskies, before Matt Hartman ended the contest with an ENG at 18:29 of the third. This was Hartman's first career ENG. Of note, UMD outshot the Huskies 31-29...in game two at UMD, Kronick had more success against his former teammates with a goal and two assists to lead SCSU. Lasch added two goals and one assist in the contest, and Andreas Nodl had the GWG at 8:52 of the third on a power play marker. Lasch's second goal was an ENG, which was his first career ENG at SCSU. In the nets, Goepfert was solid with 33 saves to his credit - as SCSU was outshot again 35-33.

SCSU ON A ROLL: The seven-game unbeaten string is the longest unbeaten stretch for the Huskies since opening the 2003-04 season with a 9-0-1 record. The Huskies completed an impressive month of November with a 4-1-3 record to their credit - including wins in the last four outings.

HOT GOALIE: Senior goalie Bobby Goepfert had a stellar weekend between the pipes for SCSU, as he carded his fourth shutout as a Husky and his seventh career shutout (he played two seasons at Providence before moving to SCSU last year) ... in the two games, Goepfert had a total of 64 saves and lowered his GAA to 2.64 this season ... his saves percentage moved up to .913, and he now owns a 4-3-3 record.

LEADER OF THE PACK: Freshman forward Andreas Nodl moved into the team's (and WCHA) scoring lead with 18 points this winter ... he and freshman forward Ryan Lasch each lead the team with seven goals this year, and Nodl is tied for the team assist lead along with junior forward Nate Dey at 11 ... Nodl has a four-game point scoring streak with nine points in his last four games ... Nodl and Lasch rank #1 and #2 in the nation for DI rookies at 1.50 ppg and 1.33 ppg respectively.

OPPONENTS FEEL THE LASCH: Ryan Lasch completed an impressive month of November with 12 points (5g,7a) in eight games played ... junior Andrew Gordon has also posted strong numbers in the last few outings. In the month of November, Gordon charted 2 goals and 10 assists for a total of 12 points. He has a four-game point scoring streak and also has nine points in those games. Gordon currently ranks second on the team with 17 points (6g,11a). In his career, Gordon has 74 points (35g,39a).

NATIONAL LEADERS: SCSU ranks third in the nation (second in the WCHA) on the power-play with a 23.9% conversion rate ... SCSU is the nation's second least penalized team with a low average of 11.6 PIM per game. UMass-Lowell is the least penalized team at 11.2 PIM per game ... Andreas Nodl is tied for the nation's game-winning goals lead with three this season ... he had the winner against UMD on Nov. 25.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (28-19-7, 17-16-5 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of

the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO's STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**. and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

A PAIR OF ACES: Forward Dan Kronick repeated his performance from last year by being named the WCHA Offensive Player of the Week on Nov. 28, for his play against UMD. Last year, Kronick also gained league honors after his play against UMD. The Huskies' Bobby Goepfert was also selected as the WCHA Defensive Player of the Week for Nov. 28. This marks the third time Goepfert has earned WCHA POW honors at SCSU. Of note, this is the first time since 2002-03 that the Huskies have gained two Player of the Week honors from the WCHA in the same week. Joe Jensen (Rookie) and Jason Montgomery (Defense) earned league honors vs. Minnesota that season. In 2006-07, the Huskies have earned five WCHA Player of the Week honors so far this season.

A KRONICK PAIN FOR UMD: Forward Dan Kronick, a transfer from Minnesota Duluth, continued his hot hand against his former teammates. Kronick had four goals and two assists in play against UMD last season at the NHC. This year in his first return to the DECC, Kronick ignited the Huskies with the gamewinner on Nov. 24. He also had the first goal of the game on Nov. 25, along with a pair of assists for the Huskies ... in five games against the Bulldogs, Kronick has recorded six goals and four assists since joining the team at SCSU last year.

TOP LINE PRODUCES: SCSU's top line of Andreas Nodl, Nate Dey and Andrew Gordon has been on fire over the past four games. The trio has accounted for an impressive 26 points in the games against Clarkson and UMD. The breakdown is nine goals and 17 assists. SCSU's line of Kronick, Raduns and Lasch also enjoyed their visit to the Twin Ports with 4g/7a to their credit on Nov. 24-25.

A BIG DROP: Bobby Goepfert has lowered his goals against average to 2.64 after three consecutive solid outings. Prior to the Clarkson series, Goepfert's GAA was 3.18 and his save rate was .892. Of note, Goepfert's save rate now stands at .913. Goepfert now has 1,294 saves in his two seasons at SCSU and already ranks sixth in the team career ranks for saves. His next target is Dean Weasler, who ranks fifth with 1,839 saves (1998-02).

ODDS AND ENDS: The Huskies have outscored their opponents 44-29 this season ... of note, SCSU has been outshot by its opponents this season, 365-360... Bobby Goepfert has 284 saves to his credit this winter ... Nodl leads the team at +7, while Andrew Gordon and Justin Fletcher rank second at +6 ... Justin Fletcher has 67 career points (21g/46a)... SCSU ranks 13th among NCAA Division I teams with a 2.42 goals allowed per game average. Michigan Tech ranks third in the nation with a 1.67 goals allowed per game average... on offense, SCSU ranks 10th in the nation with a 3.67 goals scored per game average. Last year, SCSU's scoring rate charted in at 3.14 goals per game, and its defense stood at 2.32 goals allowed per game...SCSU's third ranked power play rate of 23.9% this winter is up from last year's final power play rate of 17.2%...the Huskies are 6-0-1 this season when they score four-or-more goals in a game...more Kronick news, the Huskies are 3-0-1 when Dan Kronick scores a goal this season...SCSU is also 6-0-1 this season when they limit their opponents to less than two goals in a game...the Huskies are 6-0-1 when they carry a lead into the third period...SCSU is 4-1-3 when its opponents outshoot the Huskies this season.

LOOKING AHEAD: The Huskies will return to the National Hockey Center on Dec. 8-9 for a pair of non-conference games against Colgate. Game time both nights is slated for 7:07 p.m. This will mark the final series of 2006 at the NHC, as the Huskies will be off for the next few weekends. SCSU will return to play on Dec. 29-30 at the Vermont Caramount Cup Tournament in Burlington, Vermont.

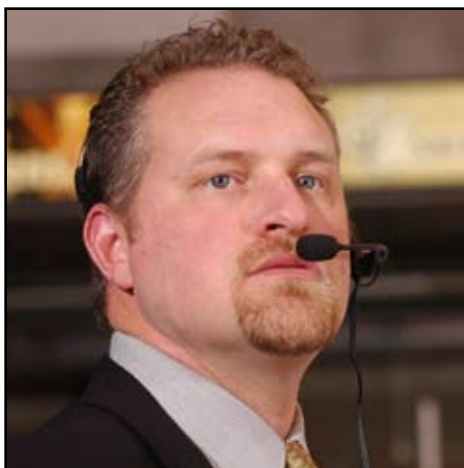
