2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: Nov. 6, 2006

HUSKIES-GOPHERS PART I: The #16 St. Cloud State men's hockey team (2-3-1, 2-3-1 WHCA) will battle #2 Minnesota (8-1-0, 4-0-0 WCHA) this weekend. On Friday, Nov. 10, the Huskies will travel to Mariucci Arena (10,000 cap./200x100) for a 7:07 p.m. game. On Saturday, Nov. 11, the Huskies will host #2 Minnesota at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100) in St. Cloud, for a 7:07 p.m. game. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and former SCSU All-American Dave Reichel calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. The games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org)...the games will be televised live on Fox Sports North out of Minneapolis. In the St. Cloud area, Fox Sports North is on Charter Cable channel 28.

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 2-3-1, 2-3-1 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating its 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

20TH SEASON TRIVIA: This week's Husky Hockey Trivia question: Which SCSU player holds the team record for most career goals? The answer is below.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies currently rank #16 in the most recent USCHO.com poll. In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies received votes but were not ranked in the top 15...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

THE ANSWER: This week's trivia answer is: Mark Hartigan. He scored 86 goals during his career from 1999-02 at SCSU.

THE DQ CUP: The quest for the 2006-07 DQ Cup continues this week. The DQ Cup recognizes the WCHA team with the best record against other Minnesota schools each season. All games that SCSU plays this season against MSU, UMD and UM will count in the DQ Cup standings. SCSU's "DQ Cup Shoot to Win" promotion night is slated for Jan. 20 vs. UMD at the NHC.

Husky Headliners:

- First meeting between #2 Minnesota and #17 SCSU since the classic showdown in the WCHA Final Five semi-final game in 2006, which SCSU won 8-7 in OT on March 17, 2006 before 19,353 fans at the Xcel Energy Center.
- Last year, the Huskies charted a 3-2 win over UM and suffered a 3-1 loss at the NHC. This weekend marks SCSU first trip to UM since a 5-4 setback on Feb. 25, 2005.
- The Huskies are 2-3-0 in the last five outings against UM.
- SCSU coach Bob Motzko is 2-1-0 during his college coaching career against Minnesota. Motzko served as an assistant at Minnesota from 2001-05.
- Freshman forward Ryan Lasch posted two goals and one assist this past weekend in play against #6/8 North Dakota. He is second on the team this season with seven points (4g/3a). SCSU's top two point producers this year are freshmen.
- The Huskies are 11-14-4 in play against the Gophers at the NHC since 1990. Did you know that 20 of the top 30 attended games in the history of the NHC have been against Minnesota.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

A THRILLER AT UND: SCSU charted a thrilling 2-2 OT tie at #6/8 North Dakota on Nov. 4, before a sellout crowd of 11,597 at the REA. The Huskies' Ryan Lasch added his second goal of the weekend to open the game's offense. Lasch carded the power play goal at 10:40 of the first period with assists from linemates Dan Kronick and John Swanson. North Dakota tied the game up with a 4x4 goal at 13:51 with a tally by Robbie Bina. The Huskies regained the lead with a goal at 14:38 of the first period by Kronick. This was Kronick's second goal of the season and he was assisted on the play by Lasch. The game was deadlocked once more by North Dakota, which scored a power play goal at 10:24 of the second period, as Chris Porter scored. UND

outshot the Huskies 42-28 but senior netminder Bobby Goepfert stood tall with 40 saves to his credit. Grieco had 26 saves for UND. On the power play, SCSU was 1-of-4 and UND was 1-of-7... SCSU dropped a 3-1 decision at #6/8 North Dakota on Nov. 3. North Dakota opened the scoring in the game at 2:13 of the second period with a power play goal by Taylor Chorney. Lasch (Lake Forest, Calif.) scored his third goal of the season at 14:08 of the second period to make the score 1-1. Lasch stole the puck from UND's Jonathan Toews at the SCSU blueline. He then went to the UND net and beat Anthony Grieco on the high right side for the unassisted goal. UND regained the lead in the early seconds of the third period with an unassisted goal by Chris Porter at the :28 mark. UND extended its lead to 3-1 at 13:05 of the third with a goal by T.J. Oshie. The Huskies outshot UND 28-22, but they were 0-of-8 on the power play. UND (6-3-0, 4-1-0 WCHA) was 1-of-6 on the advantage in the game. SCSU's Bobby Goepfert had 19 saves in the game and Anthony Grieco had 27 saves.

AS SEEN ON TV: Husky fans may want to note that both of the games against Minnesota will be available to watch live on Fox Sports North out of the Twin Cities. The Nov. 11 game at the NHC will only be available on FSN and not on Charter Cable's Mainstreet Channel. FSN in the St. Cloud area is available on Charter Cable's Channel 28.

ROUGH ROAD: Minnesota will be the third nationally ranked opponent SCSU has played this season. The Huskies have also played games against Denver (ranked #11/12 at the time they played DU) and North Dakota (ranked #6/8 at the time they played UND). The lone non-ranked team on SCSU's slated so far this season was Minnesota State Mankato. The schedule won't get any easier next week as the Huskies will entertain nationally ranked #11/12 Clarkson at the NHC on Nov. 17-18. This will mark the first non-conference opponent for the Huskies in 2006-07.

YOUNG GUNS: SCSU's top two point producers after six games this year are freshman. Forward Andreas Nodl has notched three goals and five assists, while Lasch has 4g/3a. Nodl posted his points in SCSU's first four games this year, as he was held scoreless in the two games at UND. Junior Nate Dey ranks third on the team with six points (0g/6a) and Andrew Gordon ranks fourth with five points (4g/1a).

BACK ON THE ICE: Sophomore John Swanson returned to the ice last week during SCSU's trip to UND. Swanson responded with one assist on Ryan Lasch's power play goal on Nov. 4. Swanson now has two goals and two assists this season. A native of St. Cloud, Swanson is one of four SCSU players with local ties this season. The others include junior Matt Hartman (St. Cloud), senior Nate Raduns (Sauk Rapids) and freshman Ryan Peckskamp (Sauk Rapids).

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (24-19-5, 15-16-3 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of

the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features long-time veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

MULTI-POINT PERFORMANCE: Junior forward Dan Kronick was a multi-point player on Nov. 4 at UND. Kronick had an assist on Lasch's goal and then posted his second goal of the season at 14:38 of the first period to give the Huskies a 2-1 lead in the game. Kronick now has two goals and two assists this year. This was Kronick's seventh multi-point game as a Husky during his career at SCSU. Kronick now has 13g/14a for 27 points as a Husky. He is a transfer from UMD.

GREAT NIGHT FOR GOEPFERT: Senior netminder Bobby Goepfert, who earned All-America and First Team All-WCHA honors last year, was in top form on Nov. 4, as he collected 40 saves in the 2-2 tie against UND. One of the two goals that he allowed was on the power play. Goepfert has a 2.96 GAA rate this season and has 133 saves to his credit in five games played. In just two seasons at SCSU, Goepfert ranks ninth in the team records with 1,143 career saves. He owns a stellar 2.29 GAA and a .921 save rate during his career at SCSU. Of note, Goepfert is a transfer from Providence College and played his first season with the Huskies in 2005-06.

ODDS AND ENDS: SCSU is 2-1-1 this season when the Huskies are outshot. On the flipside, SCSU is 0-2-0 when the Huskies outshoot their opponent this season...SCSU is undefeated when Dan Kronick scores a goal this season...the trip to UND marked the start of the 2006-07 road season for the Huskies. SCSU was 9-11-1 in road games last season and 2-1-0 on neutral ice last year...so far this season, SCSU is undefeated when they own a lead after the second period...SCSU is 0-1-1 in overtime games this season. Last year, SCSU was 3-3-4 in OT sessions - which tied a team record for most OT sessions in a season.

TEAM LEADERS: Dan Kronick and Andrew Gordon lead the team with 19 shots apiece this season...on the all-important plus/minus, Justin Fletcher leads the team at +2 this season. Fletcher and Gordon both led the club in 2005-06 with a +19...Andreas Nodl, Ryan Lasch and Andrew Gordon all lead the club this season with two power play goals apiece...of note, SCSU is 8-of-41 with a .195 conversion rate on the advantage.

GOPHER NOTES: The last time SCSU and UM played, the Huskies gained an 8-7 OT win in the semi-finals of the 2006 WCHA Final Five on 3/17/06 before a record 19,353 fans at the Xcel Energy Center...Matt Hartman had two goals including the GWG in the game for SCSU...last year, SCSU gained a 3-2 win and a 3-1 loss at the NHC...the last win for the Huskies at Mariucci was a 4-3 decision on Jan. 3, 2003...SCSU is 11-14-4 vs. the Gophers at the NHC, and Bob Motzko is 2-1-0 vs. UM as a head coach.

2005-06 SEASON WRAP: The Huskies completed the 2005-06 season with a 22-16-4 overall record and gained a top 15 ranking in the NCAA Division I polls last season. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed sixth in the regular season with a 13-13-2 record. To cap the campaign, the Huskies lit up the post-season with a first round WCHA playoff series win over Colorado College. At the 2006 WCHA Final Five, the Huskies charted a 5-1 victory over UMD in the play-in game on March 16. SCSU continued its roll with a huge 8-7 OT win over Minnesota before a Final Five record crowd of 19,353 on March 17. SCSU completed its run with a tough 5-3 loss to UND in the Final Five title game on March 18.
