MINNESOTA DULUTH IN THE HOUSE: The #6 St. Cloud State University Huskies (14-4-4, 8-4-4 WCHA) will return to WCHA play this weekend as they host the Minnesota Duluth (8-14-3, 5-11-2 WCHA) on Friday, Jan. 19 and Saturday, Jan. 20, at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100) in St. Cloud. The games are slated to start at 7:07 p.m. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots. You can listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. The games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org). On television, the games will both be televised live on the Charter Cable Mainstreet Network (channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Rob Hudson will offer the play-by-play with color commentary by Paul Osen on both nights. Fans can now access **LIVE VIDEO STREAMING** of these games through a new partnership with B2 Networks. 2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 14-4-4, 8-4-4 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies currently rank #6 in the most recent USCHO.com poll (as of 1/15/07). In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 6th (1/15/07) and SCSU was ranked 4th in the respected Inside College Hockey poll (1/15/2007). SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 23 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

Husky Headliners:

- The Huskies will be back at the NHC this weekend for a pair of games against WCHA rival Minnesota Duluth. Earlier this season, SCSU posted a 4-0 and 4-2 series sweep at the DECC.

- The Huskies are ranked sixth in the latest NCAA hockey polls with a 14-4-4 record. SCSU has gained a spot in the nation's top 20 for 23 consecutive weeks - dating back to the 2005-06 season.

- The 0-0 tie at Mankato on Jan. 13, marked the second time in team history that SCSU played to a scoreless draw. The other 0-0 outcome was on Nov. 22, 1997 vs. UAA.

- Junior Andrew Gordon (14g/14a) and freshman Andreas Nodl (10g/18a) share the team scoring lead with 28 points apiece. At 1.27 ppg, Nodl ranks third among the nation's DI rookies for scoring this winter.

- SCSU senior Dan Kronick, a transfer from UMD, has posted big numbers against his former teammates. In five games, Kronick has gained 6g/4a vs. UMD and has been selected as the WCHA Player of the Week twice after his weekend's work against the Bulldogs.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

MANKATO ENDS STREAK: The Huskies saw their school record (DI era) 12-game winning streak and 15-game unbeaten string end on Jan. 12 with a tough 6-4 loss to Minnesota State Mankato at the NHC. MSU gained a 1-0 lead in the contest, before Michael Olson scored at 15:02 of the first period to tie the game. The Huskies added second period goals by Casey Borer and Andrew Gordon to gain a 3-1 lead. In the final period, SCSU's Aaron Brocklehurst posted a PPG to push the score to 4-1, before MSU staged its comeback with five unanswered goals. In the game, SCSU was outshot 36-27. MSU was 3-of-6 on the power play - marking the first time since Nov. 18 (10 games) that the Huskies had allowed a power play goal. SCSU was 2-of-9 on the power play in the game as Bobby Goepfert had 30 saves in the match...to end the weekend, the Huskies salvaged a point with a 0-0 tie at Mankato. A defensive masterpiece between Goepfert and MSU netminder Mike Zacharias, the Huskies outshot MSU 29-23 in the match. SCSU was 0-of-7 on the advantage and MSU was 0-of-4. This was the second time in team history (DI era) that SCSU recorded a 0-0 tie. Of note, the shutout was Goepfert's fifth career shutout as a Husky (and second shutout of the season).

THE LAST TIME: Prior to the loss to MSU on Jan. 12, the last time SCSU allowed more than six goals in a game was its 8-7 OT win over Minnesota at the 2006 WCHA Final Five...the last time SCSU has lost a game prior to Jan. 12, was a 3-1 setback at UND on Nov. 3. The last home loss for the Huskies was a 4-2 decision against MSU on Oct. 21.

STILL PRETTY GOOD: SCSU's win streak may have ended, but the Huskies are still doing pretty well in 2006-07. In the last 14 games, SCSU has outscored its opponents 52-22 and its has allowed just four power play goals. Senior netminder Bobby Goepfert has posted a 1.71 GAA and a .944 save rate during that stretch and Andrew Gordon has notched 10g and 10a during the run.

FIRST POINT: Freshman forward A.J. Gale carded his first collegiate point at SCSU with an assist on sophomore Michael Olson's goal against Mankato on Jan. 12. The goal was Olson's first goal of the 2006-07 season. He now has 1g/1a this season for the Huskies...in the MSU game on Jan. 12, senior defender Casey Borer scored his first goal of the season with an unassisted marker in the second period. Borer has one goal and four assists this season. In his career at SCSU, Borer has scored four goals.

A WEEKEND TO NOTE: Senior goalie Bobby Goepfert charted his fifth SCSU shutout with the 0-0 OT decision at MSU on Jan. 13. This was the first time since Nov. 22, 1997 at the NHC against UAA, that SCSU had been involved in a 0-0 game. Brian Leitz was the goalie of record for the Huskies in that match. Goepfert had 23 saves in the match with his first shutout of the 2006-07 season coming at UMD on Nov. 24. Goepfert added to his legend at SCSU with two assists in the game on Jan. 12, as he charted helpers on power-play goals in the second and third period by Andrew Gordon and Aaron Brocklehurst ... the last time an SCSU goalie had two assists in a game was on Jan. 16, 1998 when Brian Leitz had two assists against Minnesota Duluth.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (36-20-8, 21-17-6 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO's STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

GORDON NEARS 100: Andrew Gordon saw his team-high six game point-scoring streak come to a halt on Jan. 13 ... Gordon now has a team-high 14 goals and 28 points this season ... in his career, Gordon now has 43 goals and 42 assists for 85 points – just 15 points away from SCSU's 100-point club. Gordon (14g/14a) is tied for the team scoring lead with Andreas Nodl (10g/18a), as they both have 28 points. The pair lead the WCHA (overall games played) with 1.27 points per game. Gordon is one of eight players this season to see action in all 22 games for the Huskies. The others on that list include freshmen Andreas Nodl and Ryan Lasch, juniors Nate Dey and Matt Stephenson and seniors Casey Borer, dan Kronick and Nate Raduns.

ODDS AND ENDS: The Huskies are 7-1-3 in games played on Saturday night this season...SCSU is 14-0-2 when they allow two-or-less goals in a game this season. The Huskies are also 0-4-2 when they allow three-or-more goals in a game this season...the Huskies set a new season-best for a period when they allowed only two shots on goal in the first period in the 0-0 tie at Mankato on Jan. 13. The previous period low for shots allowed was four against Colgate on Dec. 8 at the NHC...SCSU is 1-1-4 in OT games this season. Last year, SCSU hit a team record by playing in 10 OT games with a 3-3-4 record in those games during the 2005-06 campaign...at 21.8%, the Huskies' power play currently ranks sixth in the nation among DI teams (and first among WCHA teams)...Detroit Lakes' resident Garrett Raboin posted his fourth assist of the season on Jan. 12...SCSU is 12-1-1 this season when the Huskies hold their opponent scoreless on the power play...the Huskies have notched three shutouts this season. The team record for shutouts in a season is seven in 1999-00...this weekend's game will be important "counter" games in the 2006-07 race for the DQ Cup series - which is awarded each season to the best team from Minnesota in the WCHA...the first meeting between SCSU and UMD occurred in 1946-47, with the Huskies winning an 8-1 decision. The all-time series between UMD and SCSU now stands at 46-32-5 in favor of the Huskies. Of note, SCSU owns a current five-game win streak against the Bulldogs.

LOOKING AHEAD: The Huskies will travel to the University of Denver on Jan. 26-27 for a two-game series against the Pioneers in Denver, Colo. Game times are slated for 8:37 p.m. and 8:07 p.m. Central Time.
