2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

#6 HUSKIES TO PLAY IN CATAMOUNT CUP: The #6 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (10-3-3, 6-3-3 WCHA) will travel to the University of Vermont Catamount Cup Tournament on Friday, Dec. 29 and Saturday, Dec. 30 in Burlington, Vermont. The Huskies will open tournament play on Dec. 29, with a 3 p.m. (Central Time) game against Union College. Vermont and RPI will square off in the other first round match at 6 p.m. (Central Time). To complete the weekend in New England, the championship (6 p.m. CT) and consolation games (6 p.m. CT) will be played on Dec. 30. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com.

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 10-3-3, 6-3-3 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

20TH SEASON TRIVIA: This week's Husky Hockey Trivia question: Name the first Husky at the Division I level to chart a shutout in goal? The answer is below.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies currently rank #6 in the most recent USCHO.com poll. In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 6th and SCSU was ranked 6th in the Inside College Hockey poll. SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 19 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006. This marks the highest poll position for the Huskies since they hit #7 on Jan. 19, 2004 in the USCHO.com poll... in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

THE DQ CUP: The quest for the 2006-07 DQ Cup continues this week. The DQ Cup recognizes the WCHA team with the best record against other Minnesota schools each season. All games that SCSU plays this season against MSU, UMD and UM will count in the DQ Cup standings. SCSU's "DQ Cup Shoot to Win" promotion night is slated for Jan. 20 vs. UMD. the NHC.

Husky Headliners:

- SCSU received its best national poll position since Jan. 19, 2004, with a #6 ranking in both the USCHO.com and USA Hockey polls this week.
- The Huskies are in the midst of an 11-game undefeated string, dating back to Nov. 4 at North Dakota. This is the longest unbeaten string in history during the DI era. The previous best of 10 games was set in 1999-00.
- The Huskies will travel to Vermont's Catamount Cup on Dec. 29-30 in Burlington, VT. This marks the fourth time that SCSU has participated in a holiday tournament, and the first time since 1999-00 that the Huskies have played at Vermont.
- All-America netminder Bobby Goepfert is 6-0 in his last six starts. In those games, Goepfert has one shutout, a 1.32 GAA and a .959 save rate.
- Andreas Nodl leads DI rookies with 1.44 ppg this season. He has notched 6g/8a in his last eight games for the Huskies and leads the team with 10g and 23 points this season.
- Dan Kronick is on fire in his last six outings. In those games, he has notched five goals for the #6 Huskies.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

SCSU ADDS ANOTHER SWEEP: For the fourth consecutive weekend, the Huskies charted a weekend sweep. This ties a team record for most consecutive weekend sweeps in team DI history. On Dec. 8-9, SCSU posted a pair of 3-1 wins over Colgate at the NHC. On Dec. 8, Andreas Nodl carded a pair of PPGs and Dan Kronick added the game winner to chart the win. Frosh netminder Jase Weslosky had 26 saves in the game, as his record this season improved to 3-0-0 with a 1.00 GAA. SCSU outshot Colgate 41-27, which included a dominating 15-4 shot advantage in the first period...to complete the weekend, Kronick scored twice in the third period to break-up a 1-1 tie on Dec. 9. SCSU's first goal of the night was scored by junior Andrew Gordon, which was his eighth goal of the season. Colgate outshot the Huskies 32-29 in the match but goalie Bobby Goepfert proved capable with 31 saves on the way to his seventh win of the season. SCSU also maintained its six-game string of games where its opponent did not score on the power play. SCSU's penalty kill stands at 22-for-22 during that six-game run.

A NEW STANDARD HAS BEEN SET: The 11-game unbeaten string is the longest unbeaten stretch in the team's DI history (since 1987-88). The previous best was nine-games set most recently in 2003-04. The Huskies are 8-0-3 since Nov. 4, which includes ties against #1 Minnesota and North Dakota plus wins over Colgate, Clarkson, UMD and MTU. SCSU has now won eight-consecutive games, and the Huskies are just one-game shy of the team DI era record of nine consecutive wins set in 2000-01 and 2001-02. Before 1987-88, SCSU's longest win streak was 18-games spanning the 1959-60 and 1960-61 seasons.

GOEPFERT COLLECTS ANOTHER WIN: Senior goalie Bobby Goepfert posted his sixth consecutive win on Dec. 9. He had 31 saves on Dec. 9. His numbers continue to drop as his wins continue to climb. Since starting the year at 1-3-3, Goepfert improved to 7-3-3 after the Colgate win. His GAA at one time this season dropped to 3.33 after a home loss to Mankato. Since that point, Goepfert has improved his GAA to 2.44. His save percentage fell to .877 after a loss at UND on Nov. 3. Since that time, Goepfert has recharged his save percentage to a solid .924. He is 6-0-0 in his last six starts for the Huskies, and last year he gained both All-WCHA and All-America notice.

NODL NUMBER ONE: Andreas Nodl is the top scoring resident of Austria in the history of the SCSU men's ice hockey program. He is also the nation's top rookie this season for scoring with 1.44 points per game (10g/13a). Amongst all DI players, Nodl ranks 14th in the nation for points per game. He leads SCSU this season with 10 goals and 23 points scored. Freshman teammate Ryan Lasch is sixth among DI rookies with 1.19 points per game (9g/10a).

IT'S A GREAT DEY FOR HOCKEY: Junior Nate Dey added two assists in action against Colgate to boost his team leading total to 14 assists this winter - which is a career season-high. Dey ranks 20th in the nation with .88 assists per game this season. This has been a banner campaign for Dey, who also had four goals and 18 points for the Huskies in 2006-07.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (32-19-7, 19-16-5 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

KRONICK IN THE SPOTLIGHT: After a quiet start in 2006-07, senior Dan Kronick has been lighting the lamp for SCSU in recent games. On Dec. 8-9, Kronick chalked up the game winning goal in both game against Colgate. He also had a late goal for the Huskies in the Dec. 9, which iced the game at 3-1. He started the season with just two goals and two assists in his first 10 games. In the last six games, Kronick has marked five goals and three assists to bring his season totals to seven goals and five assists for 12 points.

A DEFINITE PLUS FOR THE HUSKIES: Senior defender Justin Fletcher notched pushed his team leading in the plus/minus category to +11 with his efforts in the Colgate sweep. Fletcher also had a pair of assists in the two games against Colgate. He now has 10 points this season (2g/8a). Fletcher now has 72 points in his career and he ranks fourth for career scoring in the SCSU records for defenseman behind Bret Hedican (77 - 1988-91), Taj Melson (87 - 1992-96) and Kelly Hultgren (107 - 1991-95).

BELIEVE IT OR NOT: Although there is no official listing in the Husky media guide, SCSU probably set a team record when it posted seven shots that hit a pipe in the 3-1 win over Colgate on Dec. 8. Justin Fletcher led the way with four pipe shots that night.

ODDS AND ENDS: SCSU is the second least penalized team in the nation with a low total of 11.2 PIM...SCSU's recent success on the penalty kill has them ranked 11th in the nation (3rd in the WCHA) with a PK rate of 87.% this season...SCSU's power play has shown improvement this season and is ranked seventh in the nation (fourth in the WCHA) at 22.9%...SCSU ranks fifth in the nation (2nd in the WCHA) with a scoring margin of 1.44 gpg. SCSU's offense is 13th (3rd in the WCHA) in the country at 3.56 gpg and its defense is 8th in the nation (2nd in the WCHA) at 2.12 goals allowed per game. Of note, Vermont is second in the nation on defense at 1.67 goals allowed per game this season...at 2.33, Bobby Goepfert's GAA ranks 19th in the nation and his .924 save rate ranks 13th in the nation among DI goalies...two rookies lead the WCHA this season in scoring, and one of those is SCSU's Andreas Nodl. He is tops in the league with a 1.44 ppg scoring rate and is tied for the points lead with UM's Kyle Okposo. Both have 23 points this season, although Okposo has played in two more games this season than Nodl...Nate Dey ranks fourth in the league with 14 assists this season...Nodl and Dan Kronick both rank second in the WCHA with three GWG apiece this season...Goepfert's save percentage this season of .924 ranks second best in the WCHA behind DU's Glenn Fisher (.928). Goepfert now has 1,385 saves in just two seasons at SCSU, and that total places him sixth for career saves in the SCSU record...Andrew Gordon now has 76 points in his career and needs just 24 points to join the 100-point club at SCSU. On that same topic, Justin Fletcher has 72 career points...SCSU is 13-13-1 all-time at the DI level against Hockey East teams, and 22-11-3 against ECAC teams.

LOOKING AHEAD: SCSU will return to action in the WCHA on Jan. 5-6, with a pair of games at the National Hockey Center against Alaska Anchorage. Game time both nights in St. Cloud is slated for 7:07 p.m..
