#8 HUSKIES TO HOST COLGATE: The #8 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (8-3-3, 6-3-3 WCHA) will return home for a two-game set against non-conference rival Colgate University (7-8-2, 3-4-1 ECAC) on Friday and Saturday, Dec. 8-9. Game time both nights at the National Hockey Center is slated for 7:07 p.m. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. The games will also be televised live in the St. Cloud region by SCSU's Husky Productions on Charter Cable Channel 14. Rob Hudson and Jeff Saterdalen will provide on-air coverage of the games for Husky Productions on Charter Cable Channel 14.

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 8-3-3, 6-3-3 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

20TH SEASON TRIVIA: This week's Husky Hockey Trivia question: Name the first Husky to gain All-WCHA honors? The answer is below.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies currently rank #8 in the most recent USCHO.com poll. In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 8th and SCSU was ranked 9th in the Inside College Hockey poll. SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 18 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006. This marks the highest poll position for the Huskies since they hit #8 on Feb. 16 in the USCHO.com poll. The previous best was 10th hit last week and on Feb. 23, 2004 in the USCHO.com poll...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

THE ANSWER: This week's trivia answer is: Bret Hedican earned SCSU's first All-WCHA (1st Team) award for his play in 1990-91.

THE DQ CUP: The quest for the 2006-07 DQ Cup continues this week. The DQ Cup recognizes the WCHA team with the best record against other Minnesota schools each season. All games that SCSU plays this season against MSU, UMD and UM will count in the DQ Cup standings. SCSU's "DQ Cup Shoot to Win" promotion night is slated for Jan. 20 vs. UMD.

Husky Headliners:

- SCSU received its best national poll position since Feb. 16, 2004, with a #8 ranking in both the USCHO.com and USA Hockey polls this week.
- The Huskies are in the midst of a nine-game undefeated string, dating back to Nov. 4 at North Dakota. This is the longest unbeaten string since a nine-game run to start the 2003-04 season. One more tie or win will tie the team unbeaten record of 10 games set in 1999-00.
- Ryan Lasch became just the second SCSU player to gain National Rookie of the Month honors in November. He was honored by GSTV/HCA for his work last month, which included 5g/7a..
- Hot netminder Bobby Goepfert continues to improve this season. He has moved into the nation's top 25 with a 2.44 GAA and top 16 with a .920 save rate. He is 5-0-3 since Nov. 4.
- SCSU's young guns Andreas Nodl (1.43 ppg) and Ryan Lasch (1.33 ppg) rank first and third respectively among the nation's top rookie scorers this season
- SCSU will meet up with Colgate for third time in their series this weekend at the NHC. SCSU leads the series 1-0-1.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

SCSU TAGS HUSKIES WITH SWEEP:

For the third consecutive weekend, the Huskies notched a series sweep. On Dec. 1, SCSU carded a 4-1 win at MTU and on Dec. 2, the SCSU Huskies beat the MTU Huskies by a 3-2 tally in OT. Andrew Gordon was the hero with the game winner 4:49 of the OT session on Dec. 2. Junior Marty Mjelleli scored his first two goals of the season in the game to boost the Husky offense. Matt Hartman also had a pair of assists on Mjelleli's goals, while Michael Olson grabbed his first point of the season with an assist on Mjelleli's second goal. To cap the attack, Matt Stephenson chalked up two assists in the game. Bobby Goepfert was stellar with 35 saves to his credit - all of which were critical as MTU outshot SCSU 37-23...the weekend in Houghton started with a 4-1 win, as Ryan Lasch coined two goals - including the game winner at 17:33 of the first period. He later added a PPG at 7:23 of the third stanza to ice the game. Andreas Nodl started the offense with a goal at 4:36 of the first period and senior defender Justin Fletcher snapped a five-game goal scoring drought with a goal at 4:15 of the third. Nodl and Fletcher also added assists in the contest along with Nate Dey and Dan Kronick. Once again, Stephenson was a force at the blueline with two dishes in his cabinet. Goepfert allowed just one goal as he was worthy for 25 saves. MTU outshot the Huskies 26-21. Of note, SCSU was perfect on the penalty kill this weekend going 0-8 on Dec. 1 and 0-2 on Dec. 2.

ROLLING ALONG: The nine-game unbeaten string is the longest unbeaten stretch for the Huskies since opening the 2003-04 season with a 8-0-1 record. The Huskies are 6-0-3 since Nov. 4, which includes ties against #1 Minnesota and North Dakota plus wins over Clarkson, UMD and MTU.

DI ROOKIE OF THE MONTH: Ryan Lasch was named the CSTV/HCA DI Rookie of the Month for November. He is the first Husky to gain this honor since Joe Jensen gained the award back in 2002-03. Lasch posted 5g/7a during his play in November. He currently leads the club with nine goals this season and is second in team scoring at 18 (9g/9a). He is third in the nation for DI rookie scoring at 1.29 ppg. Lasch tops the WCHA at present with 1.42 ppg this season (9g/8a) while Andreas Nodl ranks second in the WCHA with 14 points (6g/8a).

GOEPFERT SHINES: Senior goalie Bobby Goepfert posted his fifth consecutive win on Dec. 2. He had 25 saves on Dec. 1 and 35 saves on Dec. 2, for a weekend total of 60 saves at MTU. His numbers continue to drop as his wins continue to climb. Since starting the year at 1-3-3, Goepfert improved to 6-3-3 after a pair of wins at MTU. His GAA at one time this season dropped to 3.33 after a home loss to Mankato. Since that point, Goepfert has improved his GAA to 2.44. His save percentage fell to .877 after a loss at UND on Nov. 3. Since that time, Goepfert has recharged his save percentage to a solid .920.

STILL ON TOP: Freshman forward Andreas Nodl moved into the team's (and WCHA) scoring lead with 20 points this winter ... Nodl and Lasch rank #1 and #3 in the nation for DI rookies at 1.43 ppg and 1.29 ppg respectively. Nodl had one goal and one assist at MTU, and he now is tied for the team lead in assists with 12. Nate Dey, who also had a dish at MTU, is tied for the team lead with 12 assists.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (30-19-7, 19-16-5 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

MJELLELI TIME: Junior forward Marty Mjelleli decided to break into the scoring at the right time for the Huskies on Dec. 2. Mjelleli, who had been held scoreless in his first 8 games this season, post two 3rd period goals for the Huskies at MTU. The first goal tied the game at 1-1, while the second goal gave SCSU a brief 2-1 lead (and also forced the OT session). Mjelleli now has six goals and 10 assists in his career with the Huskies... sophomore forward Michael Olson also climbed onto the scoring chart for the first time this season in that Dec. 2 game. Olson was credited with the second assist on Mjelleli's second goal.

DEFENSE ON THE OFFENSE: Matt Stephenson had a major weekend at MTU. He gained two assists on both nights of the series in Houghton - including an assist on Andrew Gordon's OT game winner. Stephenson now has seven assists this season and one goal. Last year, Stephenson had a career-high 16 points (3g/9a). Of note, Stephenson also had a career-best two assists in play at Michigan Tech on Nov. 12, 2005...Stephenson's blueline partner Justin Fletcher also enjoyed his weekend in the U.P. Fletcher notched his second goal of the season on Dec. 1 and also had an assist on both nights. He now has 8 points this season (2g/6a). Fletcher now has 70 points in his career and he ranks fourth for career scoring in the SCSU records for defenseman behind Bret Hedican (77 - 1988-91), Taj Melson (87 - 1992-96) and Kelly Hultgren (107 - 1991-95).

ODDS AND ENDS: The Huskies have outscored their opponents 51-32 this season...of note, SCSU has been outshot by its opponents this season, 428-404... Justin Fletcher has moved into the plus/minus lead this season with a +11. Fletcher was +5 on the weekend at MTU...at 11.5 PIM per game, the Huskies rank second in the nation for fewest penalty minutes per game this season...at 22.1%, the Huskies rank 11th in the nation on the power play and 16th on the penalty kill at 86.2%. The Huskies have been a perfect 16-of-16 on the penalty kill over the past four games...SCSU's nine-game unbeaten string is third best in DI hockey, behind Minnesota (16) and New Hampshire (10)...SCSU's 1.36 scoring margin is currently fifth best in the country this season... Ryan Lasch ranks fifth in the WCHA with nine goals this season...Andreas Nodl and Nate Dey rank fourth in the league with 12 assists apiece this winter...Andreas Nodl ranks first in the WCHA this season with three GWG to his credit...Bobby Goepfert's save rate of .920 ranks third in the rugged WCHA, while his goals against average of 2.44 ranks seventh in the league...the Huskies ranks second in the league in scoring as a team with 3.64 goals per game and fourth on defense at 2.29 goals allowed per game...SCSU's 22.1% power play rate is fifth in the league and its penalty kill rate of 86.2% is fourth in the league.

LOOKING AHEAD: The Huskies will play next on Dec. 29-30 at the Vermont Caramount Cup Tournament in Burlington, Vermont. SCSU is slated to play Union in the first round on Dec. 29 at 4 p.m. (ET). Vermont and RPI will play in the other first round match up at 7 p.m. (ET). The weekend will conclude in Burlington, Vermont with the consolation game at 4 p.m. (ET) and the title game at 7 p.m. (ET).
