#5 HUSKIES RETURN TO WCHA PLAY: The #5 St. Cloud State University Huskies (12-3-3, 6-3-3 WCHA) will return to WCHA play this weekend as they host the University of Alaska Anchorage Seawolves (10-8-2, 6-8-0 WCHA) on Friday, Jan. 5 and Saturday, Jan. 6 at the National Hockey Center (5,371 cap./200x100) in St. Cloud. Both games are slated to start at 7:07 p.m. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots. You can listen to the game on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. The game will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org). On television, the games will both be televised live on the Charter Cable Mainstreet Network (channel 14 in the St. Cloud area). Rob Hudson will offer the play-by-play with color commentary by Paul Osen. Fans can now access **LIVE VIDEO STREAMING** of these games through a new partnership with B2 Networks. 2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 12-3-3, 6-3-3 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

20TH SEASON TRIVIA: This week's Husky Hockey Trivia question: Name the Husky that owns the team record for career hat tricks? The answer is below.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies currently rank #5 in the most recent USCHO.com poll (as of 1/2/07). In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 6th (12/18/06) and SCSU was ranked 4th in the Inside College Hockey poll (1/2/2007). SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 21 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006. This marks the highest poll position for the Huskies since they hit #5 on Jan. 12, 2004 in the USCHO.com poll...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. Last year, the Huskies were ranked ninth in the poll but finished the regular season in sixth place and also advanced to the runner-up position at the 2006 WCHA Final Five. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

THE ANSWER: This week's trivia answer is: Mark Parrish, who had four career hat tricks from 1995-97.

Husky Headliners:

- SCSU received its best national poll position since Jan. 12, 2004, with a #5 ranking in both the USCHO.com poll this week.
- The Huskies are in the midst of an 13-game undefeated string, dating back to Nov. 4 at North Dakota. This is the longest unbeaten string in history during the DI era. SCSU has also won 10-games in a row, which is the longest in team history at the DI level. SCSU owns the longest active win streak in the nation at the DI level at 10 games.
- SCSU captured 1st place at the recent Vermont Catamount Cup with a 4-2 win over #13 Vermont. Nate Dey was named the tournament MVP.
- The Huskies will return to WCHA play this week with home games against UAA. SCSU has never lost at the NHC to the Seawolves since the building opened in 1989.
- Andreas Nodl leads all DI rookies and all WCHA players with 1.39 ppg this season. He has 10 goals and 15 assists to his credit this season.
- Senior Bobby Goepfert continues to make a statement in goal with an 8-game win streak and an 11-game unbeaten streak.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

HUSKIES BRING HOME THE CUP:

SCSU enjoyed a wonderful weekend in New England, as the Huskies won the Catamount Cup Tournament with a 4-2 victory over Vermont on Dec. 30. To reach the tournament finals, SCSU posted a 4-2 win over Union in game one on Dec. 29 in Burlington. In the Union game, Andrew Gordon posted the game winner, while Gary Houseman and Dan Kronick added goals. Rookie freshman Craig Gaudet also posted his first collegiate point and goal in the win, as senior netminder Bobby Goepfert earned the win with 26 saves to his credit. Against UVM, the Huskies were led by tournament MVP Nate Dey, who had two goals in the game - including the second period game winner at 18:39. Gordon notched his 10th goal of the season in the match, and Nate Raduns carded an ENG at 19:25 of the third. Of note, Gordon and Andreas Nodl each had two assists in the game. Goepfert maintained his winning ways with a 22 save victory for the Huskies.

STILL ROLLING ALONG: The 13-game unbeaten string is the longest unbeaten stretch for the Huskies in team history at the DI level (since 1987-88). The Huskies are 10-0-3 since Nov. 4, which includes ties against #1 Minnesota and North Dakota plus wins over Clarkson, UMD and MTU. SCSU has also won 10 consecutive games, which is also the longest winning streak in team history at the NCAA Division I level. Before 1987-88, SCSU's longest win streak was 18-games spanning the 1959-60 and 1960-61 seasons.

DEFENSIVE POWER: SCSU's defense has been tough as nails in recent weeks. The Huskies allowed only nine goals during the month of December, and they have not allowed a power play goal since Nov. 18 against Clarkson (SCSU now owns an eight-game string with a perfect PK effort). SCSU has outscored its opponents 65-38 this season - and 22-9 on the power play. The Huskies currently rank sixth in the nation on the penalty kill at 88.9%, fourth in the nation on the power play at 23.4%, seventh in the nation on defense at 2.11 goals allowed per game and 12th in the nation on offense at 3.61 ppg.

TOUGH TO BEAT: Senior goalie Bobby Goepfert owns a 9-3-3 record this season, which includes an 11-game unbeaten streak and an eight-game winning streak. In those eight games, Goepfert has been awesome with a 1.49 GAA and a .951 save percentage. In his career at SCSU, Goepfert ranks sixth in the team charts with 1,433 saves and is on track to set a team goals against average record (he currently owns a 2.22 career GAA with the Huskies). His career save percentage at .924, would also be a new team record for the Huskies. Of note, Goepfert was recently recognized by Star Tribune columnist Patrick Reusse as one of his top 10 people who will have the most impact on whether the "state's sports scene will be less dreary in the year ahead than it was in 2006."

NODL STILL LEADS THE PACK: Freshman Andreas Nodl still owns the point scoring lead among NCAA Division I rookies in 2006-07, with 1.39 points per game. Freshman forward Ryan Lasch is also among the nation's best newcomers with 1.11 ppg and a ninth place national ranking this week. Nodl's 1.39 ppg this season, also leads all WCHA players this season.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (34-19-7, 19-16-5 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of

the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

GAUDET GETS A GOAL: Freshman defender Craig Gaudet broke into the scoring charts this season with a goal in the win over Union. This was his first SCSU goal and first collegiate point. He is a resident of Redvers, Sask. Of note, junior Marty Mjelleli also gained his first assist of the season on Gary Houseman's goal in the first against Union.

HOT HANDS AT SCSU: Senior forward Dan Kronick has picked up the pace in recent games with four goals in his last four outings. He had one goal in the Union win...Matt Stephenson (7 assists) and Andreas Nodl (3g/4a) were the team's December scoring leaders with seven points apiece...Andrew Gordon owns a team-high three game point scoring streak. He has 3g/2a during those games...Justin Fletcher saw his point scoring streak snapped at five-games on Dec. 29, but he got back into the saddle on Dec. 30 with an assist vs. UVM.

ODDS AND ENDS: Andrew Gordon now has 80 points (39g/41a) in his career. He is on track to become the 20th member of the SCSU 100-point Club (all points scored at the DI level)...on the subject of career points, Justin Fletcher now has 73 career points (22g/51a). He ranks fourth among SCSU defenders for most career points, as he trails former SCSU standout Bret Hedican, who had 77 points (27g/50a) during his career from 1988-91. Fletcher's 51 assists now places him third among SCSU defenders in the career lists, as he moves past Hedican and Derek Eastman, who also had 50 assists from 1999-03...did you know that former SCSU standout Steve Martinson (1977-81) is the head coach and general manager of the Rockford Ice-Hogs (UHL). He most recently signed former SCSU netminder Jake Moreland (1999-03) to play for the IceHogs this winter. He joins former Huskies Matt Gens and Mike Doyle on the roster at Rockford...with 11.3 penalty minutes per game, SCSU is the second least penalized team in the nation...at 3.61 goals per game, SCSU ranks second in the WCHA this season on offense...SCSU ranks third in the league with a defensive average of 2.11 goals per game allowed. SCSU's 38 goals allowed this season is the lowest number of goals allowed by a WCHA team this winter...SCSU ranks second on the power play in the WCHA with a 23.4% rate this winter...SCSU is 14-13-1 all-time at the DI level against Hockey East teams, and 23-11-3 against ECAC teams.
