2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: Feb. 21, 2007

MINNESOTA SHOWDOWN: The #4/5 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (18-6-6, 12-6-6 WCHA) will play an important home-home series against #2 Minnesota (25-5-3, 17-4-3 WCHA) on Friday, Feb. 23 and Saturday, Feb. 24. On Feb. 23, the Huskies will host the Gophers at 7:07 p.m., at the National Hockey Center (cap. 5,371/200x100) in St. Cloud. On Saturday, Feb. 24, the Huskies will travel to Mariucci Arena (10,000/200x100) in Minneapolis for a 7:07 p.m. start. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots. You can listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. The games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 out of St. Cloud (www.kvsc.org). Both games will be televised live on Fox Sports North, which is available on Charter Cable in the St. Cloud area.

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: SCSU is 18-6-6, 12-6-6 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

THE PAIRWISE: On Feb. 21 (2 p.m.), the Huskies were ranked fourth in the all-important Pairwise Rankings - behind #1 Minnesota, #2 New Hampshire and #3 Notre Dame.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies currently rank #4 in the most recent USCHO.com poll (as of 2/21/07). In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 5th (2/21/07) and SCSU was ranked 5th in the respected Inside College Hockey poll (2/21/2007). SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 28 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006...of note, the #4 ranking equals the best ranking the Huskies have hit this season. SCSU has been ranked #4 in the past five polls this season. The last time SCSU was higher in the polls, was a second place ranking on Feb. 25, 2002...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

Husky Headliners:

- The Feb. 23 game at SCSU is a complete sellout, with no standing room tickets available. #4/5 SCSU owns a 20-41-11 all-time record against #2 Minnesota.
- This weekend series will determine the winner of the coveted DQ Cup, which is awarded to the top WCHA team in the state of Minnesota each year.
- Earlier this season, the Huskies and Gophers skated to a pair of ties on Nov. 10 (5-5 at UM) and Nov. 11 (3-3 at SCSU). Of note, the Huskies have already set a team record this season with six ties to their credit in 2006-07.
- Hobey Baker candidate Bobby Goepfert currently ranks fourth in the nation with a .929 save rate this season. He has 30-plus saves in 13 games this season, and he is 8-2-3 in those games.
- Hobey Baker and postseason honors candidate Andrew Gordon needs four points this weekend to join the Huskies' 100-point club. He ranks second in the country with 11 PPG this winter, and he is 12th in the nation with 1.30 ppg (19g/20a for 39 points).



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

NEWS FROM MADISON: St. Cloud State maintained its hold on second place in the WCHA, as the Huskies brought home one point from their recent weekend trip to Wisconsin's Kohl Center. The Huskies fell 3-1 in the Friday meeting against defending national champion Wisconsin. On Saturday, SCSU rebounded with a 2-2 tie before a sellout crowd in Madison. SCSU now has 30 points in the WCHA race, and sits in second place behind Minnesota with 37 points. Denver now has 27 points, while Colorado College and North Dakota rank fourth in the league with 26 points. Nate Dey scored SCSU's lone goal on Feb. 16 with a SHG, while Andreas Nodl and Justin Fletcher had goals in the tie. Bobby Goepfert was the goalie of record both nights with 59 saves.

GOEPFERT HITS RECORD: Hobey Baker Award candidate Bobby Goepfert added to his growing list of SCSU record by charting his sixth tie game of the season and 10th career tie game in the nets. Goepfert had 33 saves in the 2-2 tie at Wisconsin this past weekend. He now leads the WCHA with a .929 save rate (4th in the country), which includes 711 saves. He also has a 2.12 goals against average, which ranks ninth in the nation. He is on track to set new team records for career and season goals against average and save percentage.

MARCH TO 100: SCSU junior Hobey Baker candidate Andrew Gordon continued his march toward the 100-point club with an assist on Andreas Nodl's goal at UW. Gordon now has 48g/48a for 96 points in his stellar career with the Huskies. He would become the 20th player all games at the NCAA Division I level to join the 100-point club at SCSU. Joe Jensen was the last Husky to join the 100-point club in 2005-06. This season, Gordon now has a team-leading 19 goals. He also has 20 assists and 11 power play goals (which is sixth best in team history for PPGs in a season). He now needs just one more point this season to equal his career season-high of 40 points set in 2005-06.

RECORD PACE: SCSU freshman Andreas Nodl continued his strong rookie season this past weekend. Nodl scored a goal and posted one assist in the 2-2 tie on Feb. 10 at UW. Nodl now leads the team with 40 points this season, which includes 15 goals and a team-leading 25 assists. He still leads WCHA and NCAA Division I rookies with 1.33 points per game this season and he ranks second among all WCHA players in points per game. Of note, Nodl needs one more point to tie the team record of 41 for points by a SCSU freshman. Current New York Ranger Matt Cullen set the team's rookie scoring record of 41 in 1995-96. Cullen also owns the team record for most assists by a rookie with 29 in 1995-96.

GREAT SEASON: SCSU's 30 points in the WCHA standings, is the most points charted by the Huskies in the WCHA standings since they hit 40 points in 2001-02. SCSU finished second in the WCHA race that season behind Denver.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (40-22-10, 25-19-8 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO's STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

WORKING OT: The Huskies have already played in eight OT games this season. Last year, the Huskies tied a team record by participating in 10 overtime games - a total they also hit in 1999-00. The six ties this season are a new team record. The team previous high for tie games in a season was five in 1998-99 and 2002-03.

SHG FOR DEY: Junior forward Nate Dey charted his second career shorthanded goal on Feb. 9. The SHG prevented a UW shutout, and it was the Huskies' second SHG of the season. Of note, the Huskies have not allowed a shorthanded goal this season

ODDS AND ENDS: Freshman Ryan Lasch added to his solid rookie season with an assist on Feb. 10 at UW. Lasch now has 19 assists this season and he ranks third on the team in scoring with 30 points... Senior defender Justin Fletcher scored his third power play goal of the season on Feb. 10 at UW. Fletcher now has 18 career power play goals for the Huskies - which is the most in team history for a SCSU defenseman. Fletcher also leads the squad this season with an impressive +23 on the all important plus/minus. In his career, Fletcher is +29....A total of eight Huskies this season have seen ice time in all 30 games played. Those ironmen include freshmen Andreas Nodl and Ryan Lasch, juniors Andrew Gordon, Nate Dey and Matt Stephenson along with seniors Justin Fletcher, Nate Raduns Dan Kronick... Andreas Nodl and Dan Kronick lead the team with four game winners apiece...Huskies slated to sign autographs on Feb. 23, in the Husky Autograph Den include Dan Kronick and A.J. Gale...when SCSU and UM played each other in November, the Gophers were ranked #2 in the nation, while SCSU was ranked 16th in the USCHO.com poll.

DEFENSE/OFFENSE: SCSU ranks seventh in the nation with a 2.13 goals allowed rate on defense. SCSU will face the nation's second best offense against Minnesota, which is averaging 3.85 gpg. The Huskies rank 13th on offense this season with 3.30 gpg to their credit. Of note, Minnesota ranks sixth in the nation on defense at 2.12 goals allowed per game. In other stat news, the Huskies rank 11th in the nation on the power play at 20.4%. SCSU ranks fifth in the nation with a .700 winning rate this winter at 18-6-6.

CLASS ACT: Senior Nate Raduns has been named a WCHA Scholar Athlete for the second consecutive season in 2006-07. A two-time All-WCHA Academic Award winner, Raduns has been selected the squad's Vernie and Brendan McDonald Award (team's top scholar athlete) winner in 2005 and 2006

LOOKING AHEAD: The Huskies will complete regular season play on March 2-3 with a pair of home games against North Dakota. Game time both nights is slated for 7:07 p.m. at the National Hockey Center. Of note, SCSU students will need to pick up their tickets in advance for this game at the National Hockey Center ticket office prior to the games. BOBBY GOEPFERT HIGHLIGHTS:

- A three-time WCHA Defensive Player of the Week selection during his two years at SCSU, including his selection on Nov. 28, 2006.
- Goepfert has led SCSU to its best start in several seasons, which includes a 18-6-6 overall record (12-6-6 WCHA) as of Feb. 19, 2007. His work in the nets has helped the Huskies gain a consistent spot in the nation's top 10 polls (SCSU was ranked 4/5th in the latest college polls released on Feb. 19, 2007).

ANDREW GORDON HIGHLIGHTS:

- A three-time WCHA Offensive Player of the Week during the 2006-07 season for his play in games against Minnesota Duluth, Clarkson and Alaska Anchorage.
- 2006-07 Alternate Captain at SCSU.
