2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: March 13, 2007

BACK IN ST. PAUL: The #4 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (22-8-7, 14-7-7 WCHA) will open play in the 2007 WCHA Final Five at the Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul on Friday, March 16, with a 2:07 p.m. game against #8 ranked North Dakota (21-12-5). The Final Five will start on March 15, with the play-in game between Wisconsin (17-17-4) and Michigan Tech (18-16-5). The winner of that game will advance to play Minnesota at 7:07 p.m. on Friday, March 16. The winners of the games on Friday will advance to the Final Five title game at 7:07 p.m. on March 17, at the Xcel Energy Center, while the two losing squads will battle in the third place game on March 17 at 2:07 p.m. All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots. You can listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. The Husky games are also slated to be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org). All games from the Final Five will be televised live on Fox Sports North, which is available on Charter Cable Channel 28 in the St. Cloud area. For ticket information at the Xcel Energy Center, please call its box office at (651) 989-5151.

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: #4 SCSU is 22-7-7, 14-7-7 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

THE PAIRWISE: On March 13 (2 p.m.), the Huskies were ranked third in the all-important Pairwise Rankings - behind #1 Minnesota and #2 Notre Dame.

HUSKIES #4: The Huskies currently rank #4 in the most recent USCHO.com poll (as of 3/12/07). In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 4th (3/12/07) and SCSU was ranked 3rd in the respected Inside College Hockey poll (3/12/2007). SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 31 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006...of note, the #2 ranking (on 2/28) equals the best ranking the Huskies have hit this season. SCSU has been ranked #4 or higher in the past six polls this season. The last time SCSU was higher in the polls, was a second place ranking on Feb. 25, 2002... in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

Husky Headliners:

- SCSU will be making its 10th trip to the WCHA Final Five this season, and the Huskies second consecutive trip to St. Paul.
- #4 SCSU placed second at the 2006 WCHA Final Five and the Huskies now own a 7-11-0 record in Final Five play. In 2001, the Huskies won the Broadmoor Trophy - their first WCHA title.
- Andreas Nodl scored at 111:33 to end a three OT marathon on March 11 against Minnesota Duluth. This was the longest game in team history and the fifth longest game in NCAA DI hockey history.
- Hobey Baker candidate Bobby Goepfert ranks fourth in the nation with a .932 save percentage. He also ranks sixth in the nation with a 2.08 GAA rate this winter.
- The Huskies will face UND in the semi-finals of the WCHA Final Five on March 16. SCSU is 1-3 in games played against UND at the Final Five. In the title game last year, the Huskies lost 5-3 to UND.
- SCSU is 4-3 in Final Five games played at the Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

FINAL FIVE FACTS: The #2 seed Huskies (22-8-7, 14-7-7 WCHA) will play UND in the semi-finals of the WCHA Final Five on March 16. The Huskies will be making their 10th trip to the WCHA Final Five, and their second consecutive trip to St. Paul ... last year, SCSU placed second in the Final Five after gaining a 5-1 win over Minnesota Duluth and an 8-7 OT win over Minnesota in the semi-finals ... the 2006 title game, SCSU lost a 5-3 decision to North Dakota ... SCSU is 7-11-0 in action at the WCHA Final Five since making its first appearance in 1994 ... in 2001, the Huskies won the Broadmoor Trophy with a classic 6-5 OT victory over North Dakota at the Xcel Energy Center ... SCSU will square off against North Dakota on Friday, March 16 in the semi-final game of the WCHA Final Five ... SCSU was 0-2-2 in games against North Dakota this season, and the Huskies are 1-3-0 all-time against UND in games played at the Final Five ... SCSU's first meeting against UND at the Final Five was a 4-3 setback in the semi's on March 20, 1998 ... on March 17, 2000, the Huskies lost a 7-3 match against UND in the Final Five semi's and on March 17, 2001, the Huskies won the Final Five with its 6-5 OT win at the Xcel ... last year, SCSU dropped a 5-3 match against UND on March 18, 2006 in the WCHA title game ... SCSU is now 23-19 in WCHA First Round playoff games, and the Huskies are 30-30 all-time in WCHA playoff games overall since 1990-91. SCSU is 4-3 in Final Five games played at the Xcel Energy Center.

THE LONGEST GAME AT SCSU: The Huskies will be making their 10th appearance in the WCHA Final Five thanks to a classic three-game series win over Minnesota Duluth on March 9-11 ... the Huskies lost the first game of the series against UMD by a 3-1 tally on March 9 ... SCSU bounced back on March 10 and March 11 with a pair of overtime wins to clinch a spot in the Final Five ... the triple overtime 3-2 win on March 11, finished at 111:33 minutes ... this is the longest game in team history and the fifth longest game in NCAA Division I men's hockey history ... this was also the second longest game in WCHA history, as it only trails a WCHA playoff game between Wisconsin and Colorado College on March 8, 1997 which went 129:30 ... SCSU assistant coach Eric Rud has the unique distinction of taking part in both of these games – as he was a player for Colorado College during that game in 1997.

NODL TIES RECORD: Freshman forward Andreas Nodl notched the game-winner in overtime on March 11, with a goal at 11:33 of the third OT session ... this was Nodl's 16th goal of the season and his fifth game-winner of the year ... he is now tied for the team's season record for gamewinning goals at five along with current NHLers Tyler Arnason (2000-01) and Matt Cullen (1996-97). Nodl already owns the team record for points by a rookie with 43 this season.

20-WIN SEASON: This marks the eighth time since joining the Division I ranks in 1987-88, that the Huskies have won 20-plus games in a season.

GORDON NEEDS ONE: Junior Andrew Gordon moved within one point of SCSU's 100-point club on March 10, with an assist and goal. Gordon now has 50 career goals and 49 career assists. He ranks 13th in the team records with 50 career goals, and he will become the 20th player in team history (at the DI level) to score 100-points as a Husky.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (44-24-11, 27-20-9 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of

the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

ONE FOR THE RECORDS: Aside from the longest game in SCSU history (the previous record was 80:59 against Boston College on Dec. 29, 2004), a few other team records fell during the game on March 11 ... SCSU broke its team record for most shots in a game with 65 ... the old record of 56 shots was set against Michigan Tech in 1996-97 ... SCSU also set a record for most shots allowed in a game with 69, as the old mark of 54 shots was hit twice in games against Clarkson and Northern Michigan in 1987-88.

GOPEFERT BREAKS SAVE RECORD: On the subject of records, SCSU senior goaltender and Hobey Baker Memorial Award candidate Bobby Goepfert broke a team record for most saves in a game with 67 during the game on March 11 ... Goepfert allowed only one even-strength goal in 111:23 minutes of play during the game and he collected 12 saves in the third OT session alone... in the two SCSU wins, Goepfert played 188:03 minutes and made 95 saves ... according to the current NCAA recordbook, Goepfert's 67 saves ranks 11th best in Division I history for goalie saves in a game ... according to the WCHA records, Goepfert's 67 saves ranks fifth for most saves in a game – and his effort is the third most saves by a goalie in a WCHA playoff game.

KRONICK TOUGH ON UMD: SCSU senior forward Dan Kronick continued to be a major pain for his former teammates at UMD ... a transfer from Minnesota Duluth after his sophomore season, Kronick completed his final two years at SCSU with eight goals and six assists against UMD in 10 games ... he scored SCSU's lone goal on March 9, and then added one assist apiece in the games on March 10 and March 11 ... in 2006-07, Kronick has 14 goals and 10 assist for a career season-high of 24 points.

ODDS AND ENDS: Junior Nate Dey was the overtime hero on March 10, with the game-winner at 17:01 of the first OT session ... the goal was Dey's 10th of the season, and his 29th point ... SCSU set a new team record on March 11 by playing in its 11th overtime game of the season ... the old record of 10 overtime games in a season was hit in 2005-06 and 1999-00 ... of note, SCSU's seven ties this season is also a team record ... sophomore John Swanson enjoyed a solid playoff weekend with a point each night ... he gained assists on March 9 and March, and then completed the run with the goal that tied the game on March 11 ... Swanson's unassisted goal came at 4:11 of the third period, and it was his eighth goal of the 2006-07 season. Swanson has notched eight points in his last eight games going into the Final Five... Swanson is one of four St. Cloud area resident on the SCSU squad this winter ... at 22-8-7 this season, the Huskies have posted the fourth most wins in team history ... SCSU set a team record with 31 wins in 2000-01, and hit 29 wins in 2001-02 ... in 1996-97 and 1999-00, the Huskies posted 23 wins apiece ... SCSU also had 22 wins in 1997-98 and 2005-06. Of note, the fewest number of losses posted by the Huskies in a season is nine in 2000-01.

UPCOMING ACTION: The Huskies will find out about their placement in the NCAA playoffs on Sunday, March 18. The NCAA selection show is slated to be aired on ESPN2 on Sunday, March 18 at 1:30 p.m. CT. The regionals will be held on March 23-25, at the following sites: Denver, Colo., Grand Rapids, Mich., Rochester, N.Y., Manchester, N.H. BOBBY GOEPFERT HIGHLIGHTS:

- A four-time WCHA Defensive Player of the Week selection during his two years at SCSU, including his selections on Nov. 28, 2006 & Feb. 27, 2007. Named HCA National Player of the Month Honorable Mention selection for Feb. 2007.
- Goepfert has led SCSU to its best start in several seasons, which includes a 22-8-7 overall record (14-7-7 WCHA) as of March 12, 2007. His work in the nets has helped the Huskies gain a consistent spot in the nation's top 10 polls (SCSU was ranked FOURTH in the latest college polls released on March 12, 2007). He has also brought the Huskies back to the Final Five for the 2nd consecutive season.
