## 2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: March 19, 2007

**ON THE ROAD TO ROCHESTER:** The #7 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (22-10-7, 14-7-7 WCHA) will open play in the 2007 NCAA Division I men's ice hockey tournament on Friday, March 23, with a 6 p.m. game (Eastern Time) against #14 University of Maine (21-14-2). This East Regional game will be played at the SMG/Blue Cross Arena in downtown Rochester, N.Y. SCSU is the #2 seed in the regional, while Maine is #3. In the first game of the day at the East Regional, #1 seed Clarkson University (25-8-5) will battle #4 seed University of Massachusetts (20-12-5) at 2:30 p.m. Clarkson is currently ranked third in the nation, while UMass is #12.

The winners of game one and game two will face off in the Regional title match on Saturday, March 24 at 6 p.m. (Eastern Time) at the SMG/Blue Cross Arena in Rochester. For more information about tickets, please call 585-758-5382. SCSU fans interested in travelling to the games, should call Bursch Travel in St. Cloud at 320-251-3180 or 1-800-645-2331 for fan travel package information.

All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots. You can listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at [www.lite999.com](http://www.lite999.com). The Husky games are also slated to be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 ([www.kvsc.org](http://www.kvsc.org)). All games from the regional will be televised on ESPNU, and Fox Sports North will televise the March 23 game live between Maine and SCSU. FSN is also slated to carry the regional title game on a live/tape delayed basis.

**2006-07 SCSU RECORD:** #7 SCSU is 22-10-7, 14-7-7 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

**20-YEARS AT DI:** The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

**HUSKIES #7:** The Huskies currently rank #7 in the most recent USCHO.com poll (as of 3/19/07). In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 7th (3/19/07) and SCSU was ranked 7th in the respected Inside College Hockey poll (3/19/2007). SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 32 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006...of note, the #2 ranking (on 2/28) equals the best ranking the Huskies have hit this season. SCSU has been ranked #4 or higher in the past six polls this season. The last time SCSU was higher in the polls, was a second place ranking on Feb. 25, 2002... in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

### Husky Headliners:

- SCSU will be making its sixth appearance in the NCAA championships this season. The Huskies' last trip to the NCAA tournament was in 2003.
- #2 seed SCSU will travel to the East Regional for a March 23 date with the #3 seed University of Maine. #1 seed Clarkson will battle #4 seed UMass in the other regional game. SCSU was one of three WCHA squads selected for NCAA play this season.
- SCSU had a busy day on March 15 at the WCHA Award Ceremony. Huskies honored this year included WCHA Coach of the Year Bob Motzko, WCHA Rookie of the Year Andreas Nodl, All-WCHA selections Andrew Gordon, Bobby Goepfert and Andreas Nodl; and WCHA All-Rookie picks Ryan Lasch and Nodl.
- Senior netminder became the second SCSU player selected as a Hobey Baker top 10 finalist on March 15.
- Andrew Gordon scored his 100th career point on March 16. He completed his WCHA Final Five weekend with 1g/2a, and his career numbers now stand at 51g/51a. He is the 20th player in SCSU history (DI level) to chart 100 career points.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

**NCAA FACTS:** The Huskies will be making their sixth trip to the NCAA championships in 2007, and their first trip since 2003. SCSU's first NCAA bid was received in 1989, and the Huskies have also made NCAA appearances in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003. The Huskies are 0-6 in NCAA tournament play since 1989. This will mark the first time that SCSU has faced Maine in the NCAA tournament. Other Hockey East teams that SCSU has played in the NCAA Regionals include Boston University (a 5-3 loss in 2000 at Albany, N.Y.) and New Hampshire (a 5-2 loss at Worcester, Mass. in 2003).

**HUSKIES VS. BLACK BEARS:** SCSU is 1-5-1 in against against Maine since moving to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. In regards to the other two opponents at the Rochester Regional, SCSU is 2-0-0 against Umass and it is 4-2-0 against Clarkson. The Huskies notched a 4-0 and 7-2 series sweep against Clarkson at the National Hockey Center on Nov. 17-18 this season. The last time that SCSU and Maine played was on Dec. 28, 2004 in Estero, Florida. SCSU and Maine skated to a 1-1 tie in that game, but the Huskies gained a trip to the finals of the Florida Hockey Classic Tournament with a shootout game-winner by Justin Fletcher, who is a senior alternate captain this season for the Huskies. In other meetings between SCSU and Maine, the Huskies lone win over Maine was in the title game of the Maine Ice Breaker Tournament in 2001-02. The Huskies notched a 6-2 victory that season, after beating Clarkson by a 5-1 tally in the first round game of the Maine Ice Breaker that season. The first meeting between SCSU and Maine was at the Dexter Hockey Classic in Orono, Maine on Dec. 27, 1987. The Huskies lost that game by a 5-3 tally.

**GORDON JOINS THE CLUB:** SCSU junior forward Andrew Gordon notched his 100th career point on March 16, during the Huskies Final Five match against North Dakota. A 2007 All-WCHA First Team selection, Gordon now has 102 career points (51g/51a) and he is the 20th SCSU player at the NCAA Division I level to chart 100 career points. He gained his 100th point with an assist on Andreas Nodl's goal at 4:09 of the second period in play against UND on March 16. Gordon marked his 12th PPG of the season in that UND game, which is second best in team history. Eric Johnson (1994-95) owns the current team record with 14.

**20-WIN SEASON:** This marks the eighth time since joining the Division I ranks in 1987-88, that the Huskies have won 20-plus games in a season.

**SCSU'S HOBEY BAKER FINALIST:** SCSU senior netminder Bobby Goepfert became the second Husky to become a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist. Goepfert is one of 10 players this season selected as a finalist for the Hobey Baker Award. The only other player in SCSU history to earn a top 10 Hobey Baker spot was Mark Hartigan in 2002. Hartigan went on to be part of the Hobey Hat Trick that season. Goepfert will be making a trip back to his home state this weekend, as he is a resident of Kings Park, N.Y. (Long Island area). He is the only resident of New York on the SCSU roster this year.

### The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (44-26-11, 27-20-9 WCHA career record) was named as the 2007 and 2006 WCHA

Go-Coach of the Year. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**MOTZKO'S STAFF:** Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**ROOKIE OF THE YEAR:** SCSU's Andreas Nodl, a resident of Vienna, Austria, became the first Husky to gain WCHA Rookie of the Year honors this season. He was also named to the WCHA All-Rookie team and was an All-WCHA Third Team selection (the first time a SCSU freshman was named to the All-WCHA team. Nodl leads the club with 46 points this season (18g/28a). His point total is the most ever for a SCSU freshman, and he is one assist shy of the SCSU rookie record for helpers that was set by Matt Cullen (29) in 1995-96. Cullen currently plays for the NY Rangers. Nodl's 46 points is the eighth best offensive output for a season in team history, and the most points scored in a season by a Husky since Mark Hartigan set a team record with 75 points in 2001-02.

**COACH OF THE YEAR:** SCSU Coach Bob Motzko was named the WCHA Coach of the Year for the second year in a row. This is the third time that a SCSU coach has been named the league's coach of the year. Motzko has a 44-26-11 career record during his two-year tenure at SCSU. This will be the first time that Motzko has faced Maine. Motzko is 2-0-0 vs. Clarkson during his career and he has never faced Umass as coach at SCSU. Of note, Motzko served as a student assistant coach when Herb Brooks coached the Huskies during their final year of Division III hockey in 1986-87.

**NICE GUYS:** With only 211 penalties for 455 minutes this season, the Huskies are on track to break the team record for fewest penalties. The current record of 248 penalties for 551 minutes was set in 2005-06.

**MORE OT:** This past weekend at the WCHA Final Five, the Huskies lost 6-2 against North Dakota in the semi-finals on March 16, at the Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul. On March 17, SCSU lost the consolation game to Wisconsin by a 4-3 decision in overtime. This marked the 12th time this season that SCSU has played an overtime game - which is a team record. SCSU's seven ties this season were also a team record and a WCHA (league games only) record. In OT games this season, SCSU is 3-2-7. On March 11, the Huskies set a team record by playing in the fifth longest game in NCAA history with their 111:33 marathon 3OT win over UMD in the WCHA playoffs.

**ODDS AND ENDS:** On the subject of records, Andreas Nodl tied a team record with five game winning goals this season. He ranks second in the nation among DI rookies with 1.18 points per game and he is tied for the NCAA Division I rookie point lead with 46... SCSU Ryan Lasch gained a spot on the WCHA All-Rookie team this season along with Nodl. Lasch has 16g/23a to his credit for a total of 39 points in 2006-07. In the WCHA (league games only), Lasch ranked second among league players with 32 points (13g/19a). He is a resident of Lake Forest, Calif... on the subject of WCHA awards, Bobby Goepfert earned All-WCHA First Team honors for the second consecutive season in 2006-07. He is on track to break SCSU's career records for both goals against average and save percentage. His career numbers now stand at 2.22 GAA and .925 save percentage. Goepfert is familiar with Hockey East opponents, as he is a transfer from Providence... Junior Nate Dey is also enjoying a career season with 32 points (10g/22a). A former Mr. Hockey award winner in Minnesota, Dey's sister Stacey is a member of the SCSU women's hockey team... Dan Kronick charted two assists on March 17, to push his season totals to a career best 14g/12a and 26 points... SCSU has four local athletes on its roster this year with St. Cloud's Matt Hartman and John Swanson on the list, along with residents of nearby Sauk Rapids: Nate Dey and Ryan Peckskamp.

**UPCOMING ACTION:** The Huskies, if they win two games this weekend, would advance to the 2007 NCAA Division I Frozen Four in St. Louis, Mo. on April 5-7. For complete information, please check out the NCAA website at [www.ncaasports.com](http://www.ncaasports.com)

### BOBBY GOEPFERT HIGHLIGHTS:

- 2007 Hobey Baker Top 10 Finalist - 2nd in team history at SCSU!
- Named All-WCHA First Team in 2007 - for second consecutive season...A four-time WCHA Defensive Player of the Week selection during his two years at SCSU, including his selections on Nov. 28, 2006 & Feb. 27, 2007. Named HCA National Player of the Month Honorable Mention selection for Feb. 2007.
- Goepfert has led SCSU to its best start in several seasons, which includes a 22-10-7 overall record (14-7-7 WCHA) as of March 19, 2007. His work in the nets has helped the Huskies gain a consistent spot in the nation's top 10 polls (SCSU was ranked SEVENTH in the latest college polls released on March 19, 2007). He also brought the Huskies back to the Final Five for the 2nd consecutive season and their first NCAA bid since 2003.
- Goepfert chalked up a 12-game unbeaten streak from Nov. 4, 2006 to Jan. 5, 2007, which also included a nine-game win streak between the pipes for SCSU. Goepfert has already carded over 800 saves and a 15-6-7 record during the 2006-07 season (as of March 3, 2007). Goepfert has ranked among the nation's best goalies in both goals against average and saves percentage this season. All of this has come against the 3rd toughest scheduel in DI hockey this season.
- Set team record with 67 saves in triple OT win over Minnesota Duluth on March 11, which helped bring the Huskies back to the WCHA Final Five.
- In 2006-07, Goepfert has posted wins over nationally ranked Minnesota, Denver, Clarkson and Vermont along with ties against Minnesota and North Dakota. Goepfert backstopped SCSU on its way to a first place finish at the University of Vermont Catamount Cup this season.
