2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: March 5, 2007

PLAYOFF TIME: The #3 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (20-7-7, 14-7-7 WCHA) will open play in the 2007 WCHA Playoffs with a best-of-three series at the National Hockey Center (cap. 5,371/200x100) against Minnesota Duluth (12-19-5, 8-16-4 WCHA) on March 9-11. All games are slated to start at 7:07 p.m. The games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots. You can listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. At the time of this release, details for television coverage of these games was still being worked out. Check the Husky Home Page for current details on television coverage of this series. 2006-07 SCSU RECORD: #3 SCSU is 20-7-7, 14-7-7 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

THE PAIRWISE: On March 5 (2 p.m.), the Huskies were ranked fourth in the all-important Pairwise Rankings - behind #1 Minnesota, #2 Notre Dame and #3 New Hampshire.

HUSKIES #3: The Huskies currently rank #3 in the most recent USCHO.com poll (as of 3/5/07). In the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine, the Huskies were ranked 3rd (3/5/07) and SCSU was ranked 3rd in the respected Inside College Hockey poll (3/5/2007). SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 30 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006...of note, the #2 ranking (on 2/28) equals the best ranking the Huskies have hit this season. SCSU has been ranked #4 or higher in the past six polls this season. The last time SCSU was higher in the polls, was a second place ranking on Feb. 25, 2002...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

Husky Headliners:

• SCSU will host first round play in the WCHA playoffs for the first time since 2001-02. The Huskies will entertain UMD at the NHC on March 9-11. All games are slated to start at 7:07 p.m.

• SCSU is 21-18-0 in first round playoff action since 1990-91.

• Rookie Andreas Nodl set a new team record for points by a freshman at SCSU. Nodl had two assists on March 2, which pushes his team record scoring total to 42 (15g/27a). The old record of 41 was set by NHLer Matt Cullen in 1995-96.

• Hobey Baker candidate Bobby Goepfert ranks fourth in the nation with a .930 save percentage.

• Junior post-season honors candidate Andrew Gordon needs just three points this weekend to join the elite 100-point club at SCSU. Gordon has 97 points (49g/48a) and would become the 20th player in the team's DI history to score 100-plus points.

• SCSU tied a WCHA (league games only) record with its seventh tie in conference play on March 2 against UND.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

PLAYOFF TRIVIA: The #2 seed Huskies (20-7-7, 14-7-7 WCHA) will host first round play of the WCHA playoffs on March 9-11 at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud against Minnesota Duluth. This marks the first time since 2001-02 that the Huskies have hosted first round WCHA playoff action at the NHC. Here are a few WCHA playoff facts for the Huskies: SCSU is 21-18-0 in first round playoff action since 1990-91...SCSU is 12-4-0 in first round playoff action at the NHC and this is the eighth time that SCSU has hosted first round play since 1990-91... SCSU has played UMD more times than any other WCHA team in first round action. The Huskies are 7-3 against UMD in those playoff games. The last time SCSU hosted the WCHA first round, the Huskies charted a 5-4 OT, 6-3 series sweep over Minnesota Duluth on March 8-9, 2002.

LAST YEAR: In 2006, the Huskies upset host Colorado College in first round play to advance to the Final Five. SCSU charted a 2-1 win on March 10, followed by a 3-2 loss at CC on March 11. To ice the series, the Huskies collected a big 3-1 victory over CC on March 12. This allowed the Huskies to return to the WCHA Final Five for the ninth time in team history (and the first since 2002). At the 2006 Final Five, SCSU opened with a 5-1 win over Minnesota Duluth in the Thursday game. In semi-final play, the Huskies gained an 8-7 OT win over Minnesota before falling 5-3 to North Dakota in the WCHA Final Five title game at the Xcel Energy Center.

REGULAR SEASON FINALE: The Huskies completed the 2006-07 regular season with a 3-3 tie and a 7-2 loss to North Dakota at the National Hockey Center on March 2-3. The Huskies placed second in the WCHA regular season race, which equals the team's best WCHA finish. SCSU also placed second in the WCHA race in 2000-01 and 2001-02. This was also the eighth time since 1987-88 that the Huskies have charted at least 20 wins in a season.

20-WIN SEASON: This marks the eighth time since joining the Division I ranks in 1987-88, that the Huskies have won 20-plus games in a season.

RECORD BREAKER: Freshman forward Andreas Nodl broke the team's freshman scoring record on March 2 with a pair of assists. He now has 42 points this season (15g/27a) and has moved past the old record of 41 rookie points set by Matt Cullen in 1995-96. Cullen currently plays for the New York Rangers of the NHL. Nodl still leads all NCAA Division I rookies in scoring with 1.24 ppg this year.

GORDON ON TRACK: Post-season honors candidate Andrew Gordon notched his 20th goal of the season on March 2. This equals his career season-high of 20 goals and 40 points that he hit last year. Gordon now has 97 career points (49g/48a) and is on track to become the 20th player in team history (all games at the DI level) to score 100 points.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (42-23-11, 27-20-9 WCHA career record) was named as the 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year along with Minnesota coach Don Lucia. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.

BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday evenings throughout the 2006-07 season on KNSI AM 1450 (www.1450knsi.com). Coach Motzko will be joined by show host Don Lyons, the voice of SCSU hockey on KCML FM 99.9, and special guest Kevin Allenspach - award winning college hockey scribe for the St. Cloud Times. The first show on Oct. 16 will air live from the KNSI studios, with the remaining shows scheduled to air live at the Green Mill in downtown St. Cloud.

WCHA FINAL FIVE: Season ticket packages for the 2007 Red Baron WCHA Final Five championship tournament, set for March 15-17 at Xcel Energy Center in Saint Paul, Minn., are now on sale to the public through Ticketmaster or in person at the Xcel Energy Center Box Office. GOPEFERT RANKS FOURTH: Hobey Baker Award candidate Bobby Goepfert made 34 save in SCSU 3-3 OT decision against UND on March 2. Goepfert gained 15 saves in the third period and OT session combined to help save the point for the Huskies. Goepfert leads the WCHA (4th in the nation) with a .930 save rate this season. He ranks sixth in the nation and third in the WCHA with a 2.13 GAA this winter. Goepfert got a rare break on March 3, as he gained the ceremonial "senior start" before being replaced by Jase Weslosky at the first whistle. This was Weslosky's first ice time since Jan. 20.

ALL TIED UP: The Huskies' 3-3 tie against UND on March 2, tied a WCHA (league games only) record for most ties in a season. ODDS AND ENDS: Seniors saluted at the March 3 game for the Huskies included Casey Borer, Grant Clifton, Justin Fletcher, Bobby Goepfert, Gary Houseman, Dan Kronick and Nate Raduns...SCSU was selected by Inside College Hockey as its Division I team of the week on Feb. 28...Senior defender Grant Clifton and senior forward Gary Houseman had the two goals in SCSU's 7-2 loss to UND on March 3. The goal was Houseman's fifth of the season, and it was Clifton's second of the season. Clifton's last goal was on Nov. 10 vs. Minnesota...Junior defender Matt Stephenson had a solid weekend at the blueline with three assists in the two games. He now has 19 assists this season and a career season-high 21 points in 2006-07...The Huskies' 3-3 tie against UND on March 2, tied a WCHA (league games only) record for most ties in a season. Of note, SCSU has played in nine overtime games this season with a 1-1-7 record. The team record of 10 OT games in a season was set in 2005-06 and 1999-00. The seven ties this season is also a new team record. The only record of five ties was hit in 1998-99... In two seasons as head coach at his alma mater, Bob Motzko owns a 42-23-11 overall record...Senior defender Justin Fletcher has been selected as an alternative for the upcoming NCAA Skills Competition contest at the 2007 NCAA Frozen Four in St. Louis.

- A four-time WCHA Defensive Player of the Week selection during his two years at SCSU, including his selections on Nov. 28, 2006 & Feb. 27, 2007. Named HCA National Player of the Month Honorable Mention selection for Feb. 2007.
- Goepfert has led SCSU to its best start in several seasons, which includes a 20-7-7 overall record (14-7-7 WCHA) as of March 3, 2007. His work in the nets has helped the Huskies gain a consistent spot in the nation's top 10 polls (SCSU was ranked THIRD in the latest college polls released on March 3, 2007).

- A three-time WCHA Offensive Player of the Week during the 2006-07 season for his play in games against Minnesota Duluth, Clarkson and Alaska Anchorage.
