2006-07 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: Final Release 2006-07

SEASON WRAP-UP: The #7/8 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team completed its season with a 22-11-7, 14-7-7 WCHA record. The Huskies placed second in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (14-7-7 WCHA), which equals the team's best-ever finish in the regular season standings of the WCHA since SCSU joined the league in 1990-91. SCSU advanced to the 2007 WCHA Final Five for the second consecutive season (10th time in team history), thanks to first round playoff wins over Minnesota Duluth (SCSU won the series 2-1). To complete the season, the Huskies gained their first NCAA Division I tournament bid since 2003. This marked the sixth NCAA bid for the Huskies since 1989. SCSU lost in first round play at the 2007 NCAA East Regional by a score of 4-1 against Maine in Rochester, N.Y. The Huskies were the #2 seed at the Regional tournament.

All SCSU games were broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons calling the shots this season. Fans were able to listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. Selected Husky games were broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org). All SCSU home games this season (with the exception of the Minnesota games) were televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network, with Rob Hudson calling the shots. SCSU was also featured during live telecasts on Fox Sports North, Fox Sports Rocky Mountain, Duluth's WDIO TV and ESPN2 during the course of the season. To complete the media coverage, fans were able to tap into the home hockey games over the web through a new connection with B2 Networks.

2006-07 SCSU RECORD: #7/8 SCSU ended the year at 22-11-7, 14-7-7 WCHA in 2006-07. The Huskies were 22-16-4, 13-13-2 WCHA in 2005-06. The Huskies finished the season last year ranked #14/15 in the Division I national polls.

20-YEARS AT DI: The Huskies will be celebrating their 20th season of men's hockey play at the NCAA Division I level in 2006-07. The Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. SCSU's first year of "organized" hockey came in 1931-32 and in SCSU's last season at the Division II/III level in 1986-87, the Huskies placed first in the AHCA and placed third at the NCAA championships that year under the leadership of Coach Herb Brooks.

HUSKIES #7/8: The Huskies ended the season ranked 7th in the final USCHO.com poll and 8th in the final USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll. In the Inside College Hockey poll, the Huskies were ranked 10th in that final poll. SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 33 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006...of note, the #2 ranking (on 2/28) equals the best ranking the Huskies hit this season. The last time SCSU was higher in the polls, was a second place ranking on Feb. 25, 2002... in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a fifth place ranking for 2006-07. SCSU finished the 2005-06 season ranked #14 in the USCHO.com and #15 on the USA Today/USA Hockey national Division I poll. SCSU was ranked #16 in the final Inside College Hockey.com poll. This marked the first time since 2002-03, that SCSU was ranked in the final national polls of the season.

Husky Headliners:

- SCSU made its sixth appearance in the NCAA championships with a trip to the East Regional in 2007. The Huskies' last trip to the NCAA tournament was in 2003.
- SCSU's Andreas Nodl was named the inaugural HCA Rookie of the Year for Division I. He also received Rookie of the Year honors from CHN and USCHO.com.
- SCSU had a busy day on March 15 at the WCHA Award Ceremony. Huskies honored this year included WCHA Coach of the Year Bob Motzko, WCHA Rookie of the Year Andreas Nodl, All-WCHA selections Andrew Gordon, Bobby Goepfert and Andreas Nodl; and WCHA All-Rookie picks Ryan Lasch and Nodl.
- Senior netminder Bobby Goepfert became the second SCSU player selected as a Hobey Baker top 10 finalist on March 15.
- Bobby Goepfert was selected as a RBK All-America (2nd team West) for the second consecutive season. He was also honored for All-America status by USCHO.com (H.M.), CHN (2nd team), Inside College Hockey (3rd team).



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2006-07. The alternate captains for this winter are junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) and senior defenseman Justin Fletcher (Maryville, Ill.).

NCAA FACTS: The Huskies made their sixth trip to the NCAA championships in 2007, and their first trip since 2003. SCSU's first NCAA bid was received in 1989, and the Huskies have also made NCAA appearances in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003. The Huskies are 0-7 in NCAA tournament play since 1989. This marked the first time that SCSU has faced Maine in the NCAA tournament. Other Hockey East teams that SCSU has played in the NCAA Regionals include Boston University (a 5-3 loss in 2000 at Albany, N.Y.) and New Hampshire (a 5-2 loss at Worcester, Mass. in 2003).

FINAL FIVE FACTS: The Huskies returned to the WCHA Final Five for the second consecutive season in 2007. The second seed in the WCHA post-season, SCSU earned their trip to the WCHA Final Five in St. Paul with a big 2-1 series win against Minnesota Duluth on March 9-11 in St. Cloud. This marked the first time since 2001-02 that the Huskies had home ice in the WCHA tournament. In game one against UMD, the Huskies lost 3-1. In game two, the Huskies posted a 3-2 overtime win over the Bulldogs. In the third game, SCSU won an epic 3-2 triple OT decision against UMD. At 111:33, this was the longest game in team history and the fifth longest game in NCAA Division I ice hockey history.

CLEAN ACT: The Huskies set a team record this winter for fewest penalties at 218 and fewest penalty minutes at 469. The previous low mark for the Huskies was set in 2006 with 248 penalties and 551 PIM.

20-WIN SEASON: This marks the eighth time since joining the Division I ranks in 1987-88, that the Huskies have won 20-plus games in a season.

FIT TO BE TIED: The Huskies set a team record by chalking up seven ties this season, which bypassed the old record of five ties in 1999. The seven ties also tied a league record for most ties in WCHA play. SCSU also set a new team record by participating in 12 OT games this season. SCSU was 3-2-7 in OT games this season.

COACH OF THE YEAR PART II: SCSU coach Bob Motzko was named the WCHA coach of the Year for the second consecutive season. This marks the third time in team history that a SCSU coach has gained WCHA Coach of the Year honors. Motzko was also selected for the second consecutive season as a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the nation's Division I Coach of the Year by the AHCA.

GOEPFERT THE GREAT: SCSU senior goalkeeper Bobby Goepfert (Kings Park, N.Y.) became the first player in team history to gain All-America honors twice during his college career. Goepfert gained All-America status in 2006 and 2007, and was also the first Husky to earn All-WCHA First Team honors (2006 and 2007) twice during his career. A 2007 College Hockey News All-America pick, Goepfert was selected as a Hobey Baker Award Top 10 finalist this winter – making him just the second SCSU player to be picked as a top 10 finalist for this elite national award.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (44-27-11, 27-20-9 WCHA career record) was named as the 2007 and 2006 WCHA

Co-Coach of the Year. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO'S STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by fifth-year veteran **Fred Harbinson** and second-year coach **Eric Rud**, and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 12-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, two-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

ONE FABULOUS FRESHMAN: SCSU freshman Andreas Nodl (Vienna, Austria) was selected as the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year. The team's leading scorer with 46 points (18g/28a), Nodl was recognized as the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year and he also earned All-WCHA Third Team honors and WCHA All-Rookie Team accolades. This was the first year that the National Rookie of the Year award was presented by the Hockey Commissioners' Association. Nodl led the team with 46 points, 28 assists and five game winning goals. The five GWGs this season tied a team record for most game winners in a season. Nodl was the first player in team history to earn WCHA Rookie of the Year honors, and he was the first freshman player at SCSU to be selected for All-WCHA honors. Of note, Nodl was also named to the Inside College Hockey and College Hockey News All-Rookie teams. He was named the HCA Division I Rookie of the Month in January..

100-POINTS AT SCSU: Junior forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, Nova Scotia) was a first team All-WCHA selection in 2007. This marked the first time that two SCSU players (Gordon and Goepfert) both earned All-WCHA First Team honors in the same season. Gordon ranked second on the team with 45 points, and he led the team with 22 goals in 2006-07. Gordon joined SCSU's elite 100-point club this season after just three seasons, and he already has 51g/51a this his credit. Gordon was named to the Academic All-WCHA team for the second consecutive season in 2006-07. A three-time WCHA Player of the Week, Gordon was named the INCH Shop National Player of the Week on Jan. 23, 2007. Gordon recently signed a pro contract with the Washington Capitals (NHL) and will miss his senior season at SCSU.

ALL-ROOKIE AT SCSU: Freshman Ryan Lasch (Lake Forest, Calif.) gained a spot on the 2007 WCHA All-Rookie Team. Lasch notched 16 goals and 23 assists for 39 points this winter. He was named the HCA Division I Rookie of the Month in November. In WCHA games only, Lasch ranked second in the league in scoring at 1.14 ppg.

CLASS ACT: Senior forward Nate Raduns (Sauk Rapids, Minn.) was selected as a finalist for the Lowe's Senior Class Award and the Hockey Humanitarian Award this season. Raduns was also named as a 2007 Lowe's All-Senior All-America Second Team award recipient this winter. A WCHA Scholar-Athlete Award winner in 2006 and 2007, Raduns was one of nine Huskies named to the All-WCHA Academic team in 2006-07. Others players named to this honor roll included Casey Borer, Aaron Brocklehurst, David Carlisle, Andrew Gordon, Gary Houseman, Dan Kronick, Marty Mjelleli and Matt Stephenson.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: The Huskies earned WCHA Player of the Week honors 10 times during the 2006-07 season. This equals the most POW award winners for the Huskies in a single-season. They also had 10 WCHA POW's in 2001-02. Andrew Gordon was named Offensive Player of the Week three times, while Bobby Goepfert was named the Defensive Player of the Week twice. Jase Weslosky, Andreas Nodl and Ryan Lasch all gained Rookie of the Week notice in the league, while Justin Fletcher was named Defensive Player of the Week. The group was completed by Dan Kronick being named Offensive Player of the Week on Nov. 28, 2006 - with all nominations being submitted by SCSU Athletic Media Relations official Tom Nelson.

BEST IN THE STATE OF HOCKEY: SCSU won the coveted DQ Cup in 2006-07. This award is sponsored by Dairy Queen, and it is presented to the WCHA team from the state of Minnesota that has the best win-loss record in action against other WCHA teams from the state of Minnesota. SCSU was 7-2-3 this season in WCHA games against Minnesota, Minnesota Duluth and Minnesota State Mankato. The Huskies' win rate of .708 those games aced out second place Minnesota (5-2-3, .650).

OVER-20 IN 2006-07: A total of eight SCSU players posted 20-plus points this season. Those players included Nodl (46), Gordon (45), Lasch (39), Dey (32), Kronick (26), John Swanson (23), Justin Fletcher (24) and Stephenson (24). The 46 points by Nodl was the most charted by a SCSU player since Mark Hartigan set a team record with 75 points in 2001-02. The 46 points by Nodl is the best by a Husky rookie, and the eighth best season total in team history. Nodl broke Matt Cullen's rookie scoring record of 41 points set in 1995-06. Cullen currently plays for the New York Rangers of the NHL.

NO SHG ALLOWED: SCSU allowed no shorthanded goals this season, which marked the first time in team history (DI level) that the Huskies have accomplished this feat. Of note, SCSU scored three SHGs this season and this is equals the fewest SHGs by the Huskies in a season. SCSU also had three shorties in 1987-88.

OVER-20 IN 2006-07 PART II: SCSU charted 20-plus wins in a season for the seventh time in 2006-07 (since going DI in 1987-88). The 22 wins ranks fifth in team history.

GOEPFERT RECORDS: Bobby Goepfert set a team record by posting a 2.24 goals against average during his career with the Huskies. The old record of 2.38 GAA was set by Scott Meyer from 1996-01. Goepfert also broke Meyer's career record for save percentage at .924 for his two years at SCSU. Meyer's old mark was .919. In just two seasons at SCSU, Goepfert had 2,014 saves – which ranks fifth in team history. He had 1,010 saves in 2005-06 and 1,004 saves in 2006-07 – which mark the second and third times in team history that a Husky goalie had 1,000-plus saves in a season. Goepfert's career 27.59 saves per game ranks first in team history. He ranks fifth in team history with 37 wins (37-24-11). A transfer from Providence College, Goepfert set team records this season with seven ties in 2006-07 and he also hit a team career record with 11 from 2005-07.

VERMONT FOR THE HOLIDAYS: The Huskies won the 2006 University of Vermont Catamount Cup tournament on Dec. 29-30, 2006 in Burlington, Vermont. SCSU opened tournament play with a 4-2 win over Union and then brought home the hardware with a 4-2 win over host Vermont. IN COMPARISON: How does the rookie duo of Nodl and Lasch stack up in comparison to other SCSU freshmen. Nodl and Lasch combined for 85 points this season (34g/51a). In comparison, future NHLers Matt Cullen and Mark Parrish combined for 71 points (27g/44a) during their frosh season at SCSU in 1995-96. In 2001-02, WCHA All-Rookie award winners Mike Doyle and Peter Szabo 24g/41a for a total of 65 points.

HOW THE HUSKIES STACKED UP: In comparison this season: SCSU scored 126 goals and allowed 99 goals. SCSU had 43 power play goals and allowed 35. SCSU had 1,200 shots on goal and it allowed 1,246 shots this season.

NATIONAL RANKINGS: At 2.48 goals allowed per game, the Huskies ranked 13th in the nation on defense (99 goals allowed). SCSU's .70 scoring margin this season was 12th in the nation among DI teams. The Huskies had the third least number of penalty minutes in DI hockey this season at 11.7 PIM per game. SCSU's .638 win percentage was 10th best in DI hockey this season.

THE STREAK: SCSU set a team record by winning 12 games in a row. The streak started on Nov. 17, 2006 with a 4-0 win over Clarkson. The streak ended on Jan. 12, 2007 with a tough 6-4 loss at home against Minnesota State Mankato. SCSU also set a team record with its 15-game unbeaten streak from Nov. 4, 2006 to Jan. 12, 2007. Of note, SCSU was 9-7-5 against nationally ranked teams this season and that included wins over Minnesota, Clarkson, Denver, Vermont and Colorado College.

THE HOUSE WAS A ROCKING: The Huskies averaged 5,971 fans at their home games in 2006-07, which equals a total of 125,396 fans at 21 games this season. This marks the 11th consecutive season that SCSU has drawn over 100,000 fans to its home games and it is the second largest number of fans for a single-season of SCSU hockey. The team's single-season attendance record of 128,641 fans was set in 1997-98 (23 games).

THE HOUSE WAS A ROCKING: Bobby Goepfert's .924 save rate ranked eighth in the nation this season, and his GAA rate of 2.29 was 16th in the nation. At 1.15 points per game, Andreas Nodl ranked second among NCAA Division I rookies for scoring, while Ryan Lasch ranked 12th at .97 ppg. Nodl ranked eighth in the nation with five GWGs in 2006-07. Andrew Gordon ranked third in the nation with 12 PPGs this season. Nodl (1.15 ppg) and Gordon (1.12 ppg) ranked 25th and 30th respectively among NCAA Division I players this winter.

SENIOR SALUTE: Seniors departing the squad this season include captain defender Casey Borer, alternate captain defender Justin Fletcher, defender Grant Clafton, goalie Bobby Goepfert, forward Gary Houseman, forward Nate Raduns and forward Dan Kronick. The group of seniors accounted for 93 points this season. Fletcher leaves campus as the team's leading career power play goal producer by a defenseman with 18 during his tenure in the Granite City. Fletcher had 86 career points, which ranks third among SCSU defenders in the record books behind Kelly Hultgren (107 from 1991-95) and Taj Melson (87 from 1992-96). The Huskies senior class ushered in the Bob Motzko era at SCSU, and they charted a 76-66-18 record during their four years in St. Cloud. This group played in two WCHA Final Five and one NCAA tournament game, and they helped turn around the Huskies' program - going 14-23-3 in 2004-05 and then going 22-16-4 and 22-11-7 during their last two seasons.
