## 2005-06 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

**HUSKIES HEAD TO ST. LAWRENCE AFTER WINTER BREAK:** The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (7-10-1 overall, 5-8-1 WCHA: 6th) returns to action after the winter break with a non-conference two-game series against St. Lawrence on Friday, Jan. 6 at 6:05 p.m. CT and on Saturday, Jan. 7 at 3:05 p.m. CT. Both games will be played at the Appleton Arena in Canton, N.Y. The Huskies split with the Saints last season with a 2-0 win on Dec. 3, 2004 and a 0-3 loss on Dec. 4, 2004.

**LAST CONFERENCE SERIES FOR THE HUSKIES:** The St. Cloud State women's hockey team swept visiting Ohio State 4-3 and 5-3 on Dec. 9-10 at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud, Minn. Sophomore defender Brittni Kuyper scored the game-winning goal and added two assists to lead the Huskies over Ohio State on Friday, Dec. 9, 4-3. Kuper's game-winning goal marked the first of her career at SCSU. By adding an assist on Dec. 10, Kuyper extended her points-streak to four games (1 g/6 a). Junior forward Hailey Clarkson notched five points over the weekend series with OSU (3 g/2 a) while senior forward Ashely Stewart added three points (1 g/2 a).

The weekend yielded a number of firsts for a handful of Huskies. Sophomore defender, Stacy Dey, scored her first goal/point of the season on Dec. 9, first-year defender Brita Schroeder collected her first career assist/point on Dec. 10, and first-year forward Sammy Nixon recorded her first career assist on Dec. 10. Sophomore forward Laura Fast and junior forward Jackie Jensen each tallied a goal and an assist over the weekend. Junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques accumulated 28 saves to collect her third win of the season on Dec. 9, while sophomore goaltender Kendall Newell made 29 saves in the win over OSU on Dec. 10, to even her season record at 4-4-0. The 4-3 come-from-behind victory on Dec. 9 marked just the third come-from-behind victory in SCSU's women's hockey history after being down through two periods. The win on Dec. 9 also marked the first win in SCSU history when the shots-on-goal have been even (1-7-0). Leading up to the game on Dec. 9, the Huskies were 0-of-4 in one-goal game decisions. Currently, the Huskies are now 7-2-1 at home on the season.



**SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG:** Jason Lesteberg is coaching in his fourth season (58-105-14 overall/4th season at SCSU: 33-79-5) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist. Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior defender Randie Jelinski, a resident of Regina, Sask., is serving as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba).

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., is in his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

LAURA SLOMINSKI: Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

A WEEKEND OF CAREER FIRSTS:

Sophomore defender Brittni Kuyper (Eden Prairie, Minn.) scored her first career goal amid the first three-point performance (1 g/2 a) of her career to lead the Husies past Ohio State 4-3 on Friday, Dec. 9. Kuyper's power play goal was also the game-winner. The following day, Kuyper tallied two assists in the 5-3 victory over OSU on Dec. 10. Kuyper is on a four-game scoring streak (1 g/6 a).

Sophomore defender Stacy Dey (Maplewood, Minn.) scored her first goal/point of the season on Friday, Dec. 9, and first-year defender Brita Schroeder (Big Lake, Minn.) collected her first career assist/point on Saturday, Dec. 10. SCSU's first-year forward, Sammy Nixon (Blaine, Minn.), also tallied her first career assist on Saturday, Dec. 10.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

#1 ST. LAWRENCE (Jan. 6-7)

The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (7-10-1 overall, 5-8-1 WCHA: 6th), after taking a four-game winning streak into the winter break, is returning to action in 2005 for a two-game non-conference series against #1 ranked St. Lawrence (14-1-2, 5-1-2 ECACHL) on Jan. 6-7... the overall schools' history series between the Huskies and the Saints is tied 1-1-0, with SLU tallying the last win between the two teams (3-0 on Dec. 4, 2004)... SCSU looks to earn its first road win of the season...since 1999, the Huskies are 2-5-0 in first games played after the winter break...head coach Jason Lesteberg is 1-1-0 against SLU and has not yet played SLU on the road...the Saints are coming off their winter break as well, being ranked #1 in the USCHO.com Division I Women's Poll as of Dec. 12, 2005... SLU shut out Union on Dec. 9-10 with two victories (10-0, 7-0).



**SAINTS TO WATCH:** Sparked by underclassmen, the Saints scoring leaders consist of two sophomores and two first-year players. SLU is led by sophomore forward Sabrina Harbec, who has tallied 31 points (11 g/20 a) in 17 games played. First-year forward Carson Duggan has notched 25 points (17 g/8 a), sophomore defender Annie Guay has scored 18 points (3 g/15 a) and first-year forward Alison Domenico and accounted for 17 total points (7 g/10 a). Between the pipes, the Saints have been led by senior goaltender Jessica Moffat and sophomore goaltender Meaghan Guckian. Moffat has amassed a 10-0-0 record in 2005-06, along with a 0.95 GAA and 192 saves. Guckian is 4-1-2 on the season with a 0.91 GAA and 117 saves.

**ST. LAWRENCE HEAD COACH PAUL FLANAGAN** (St. Lawrence): Flanagan is in his seventh season as the head coach of the Saint women's hockey team. Since taking the helm in the spring of 1999 as the third coach in the program's history, Flanagan has coached the team to three NCAA Frozen Fours, including back-to-back trips in 2004 and 2005. He has also set school records for wins three times. In 2004-05, the Saints posted a 14-3-3 league record to advance to the ECACHL Playoffs for the fifth consecutive season under Coach Flanagan. His career record stands at 156-61-20 as of Dec. 12, 2005.

**HUSKIES #1 SCORING LINE:** SCSU's first scoring line, consisting of junior assistant captain Denelle Maguet, junior forward Hailey Clarkson and senior forward Kristy Ooninx has accounted for just under half (28-of-55 points, 48%) of SCSU's points during the current four-game winning streak, and 48% (61-of-127 points) of the team's total points thus far in 2005-06.

**LINE UP WITH FAST AND MAGUET:** Sophomore forward Laura Fast (Calgary, Alb.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (Ste. Rose, Mant.) are in the black when it comes to +/- in their respective careers. Maguet adds a +3 on the season and a +5 for her career in 48 games played, while Fast is currently an even on the season and a +2 for her career in 51 games played.

More News and Notes

HUSKIES IN THE WCHA: Senior forward Kristy Oonincx (8 g/14 a) and junior forward Hailey Clarkson (9 g/13 a) are currently tied for eighth place in points with 22 this season. Oonincx is also tied for fifth in assists (14) and tied for second with 12 (5 g/7 a) power play points. Clarkson currently leads the WCHA in power play points with 13 (5 g/ 8 a) and is tied for seventh in assists (13).

Junior forward and assistant captain Denelle Maguet is 14th (8 g/9 a) in points and is tied for 13th in goals scored (8). Senior defender and captain, Randie Jelinski (2 g/6 a), and sophomore Brittni Kuyper (1 g/7 a), are both tied for seventh in defenseman scoring with eight points. In goal, sophomore goaltender Kendall Newell is currently ranked sixth in the WCHA with a 2.26 GAA and is ranked fifth with a .919 save percentage.

As a team, the Huskies are fourth in scoring offense (2.67 gpg) and fifth in scoring defense (2.72 gpg). SCSU's power play has taken big strides this season, and it is currently ranked second in the WCHA with a 20.4 percentage (20-of-98).

BETWEEN THE PIPES: Junior assistant captain Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) went 1-0-0 against Ohio State on Dec. 9, notching her 11th career win. St. Jacques made 28 stops in the 4-3 victory. St. Jacques now has a 11-29-5 career record. Last season, St. Jacques went 5-15-3 with a .892 save percentage and one shutout.

Sophomore Kendall Newell (Phoenix, Ariz.) also went 1-0-0 against Ohio State with a 5-3 victory on Dec. 10. Newell made 29 saves in the win and now has an 8-9-1 career record along with 482 career saves. Last season, Newell went 4-5-1 with a .896 save percentage, 276 saves, a 3.00 GAA and one shutout in 12 games as a freshman.

A. STEWART AND KUYPER EXTEND POINT STREAKS:

Senior forward Ashley Stewart (Toronto, Ont.) returns from the winter break with a 6-game points streak (2 g/6 a), and sophomore defender Brittni Kuyper (Eden Prairie, Minn.) has a four-game points streak of her own (1 g/6 a). Before the break, junior Hailey Clarkson (Winnipegosis, Mant.) scored a point in her last three game for SCSU (4 g/3 a), including two power play goals.
