2011-12 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS RELEASE DATE: September 28, 2011

NEW SEASON BEGINS: The Huskies will open up their 2011-12 campaign competing in the East/West Showcase hosted by the University of Minnesota at Ridder Arena. SCSU will play Syracuse on Friday and Union on Saturday. Both games are set to begin at 4:07 pm. Minnesota will face Union on Friday and Syracuse on Saturday following the SCSU games.

LAST SEASON: St. Cloud State was 1-33-1 overall in 2010-11 and 1-26-1 in the WCHA, good for 8th place.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior forward Jocelyn Zabrick (Airdrie, Alberta) will wear the captain's "C" for the 2011-12 season. Senior Brittany Toor (Hartland, Mich.) and junior Alex Nelson (Andover, Minn.) will don the "A" as alternate captains.

LOOKING FORWARD: St. Cloud State returns 18 players from last season. A plus for the Huskies is that 70 of its 76 points (31g, 45a) scored last season are returning in 2011-12.

LEADING THE WAY: Sophomore forward Julia Gilbert returns after posting a team-leading 11 points (6g, 5a) as a rookie in 2010-11. Gilbert was followed closely by fellow first year player and now sophomore Molli Mott who had ten points (5g, 5a). Alex Nelson recorded eight points (5g, 3a) last season, while forwards Brittany Toor (4g, 1a), Haylea Schmid (2g, 3a) and Sydney Burghardt (0g, 5a) each had five points.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP: The Huskies hope to get great play and leadership this season out of their senior class which includes Brittany Toor (Hartland, Mich.), Jaclyn Daggitt (St. Paul Park) and Tayler VanDenakker (Winnipeg, Manitoba).

JUNIOR CLASS: The largest class listed on the roster is the junior group which consists of nine student-athletes. Big things will be expected from the junior class this season which includes forwards Alex Nelson (Andover), Kylie Lane (Roseau), Haylea Schmid (Oak Grove), Callie Dahl (Stillwater), Ellie Sitek (Edina) and team captain Jocelyn Zabrick (Airdrie, AB). Returning defensively are Katie Allen (Red Deer, AB) and Lisa Martinson (St. Louis Park). Anna Donlan (Hilsboro, Wis.), who is a two-sport athlete also competing for St. Cloud State volleyball, will return between the pipes.

SOPHOMORES LOOK TO SHINE: With a year of collegiate hockey now under their belts, the sophomores look to step up big for the Huskies in 2011-12. Julia Gilbert (Hermantown), Amy Olson (Roseau), Sydney Burghardt (Medicine Hat, AB) and Molli Mott (Colorado Springs, Colo.) return for their second season on the front line. Returning to defend the blue line are Amanda Monkman (Roseau), Michelle Burke (London, Ontario), and newcomer Cari Coen (Manhattan Beach, Calif.).

NEW FACES: St. Cloud State welcomes five new faces to the team in 2011-12. Sophomore Cari Coen comes in as a transfer after playing last season under assistant coach Jim Fetter at Wayne State (Mich.). Coen was named to the College Hockey America All-Rookie squad after scoring 11 points (2g, 9a) in her first collegiate hockey season. The Huskies also add four first year players including Minnesota's Senior Prep Goalie of the Year in Julie Friend (Minnetonka). Joining Friend defensively will be Audrey Hamner, an All-State defender for Forest Lake. Offensively, the Huskies welcome Amanda Arbogast and Abby Ness. Arbogast, an All-State Honorable Mention, tallied 35 goals and 25 assists in her senior year at Eveleth-Gilbert Area High School. Ness earned All-State honors while playing at Roseau and was a member of the U.S. Women's National Under-18 Team that captured the gold medal at the 2011 International Ice Hockey Federation World Women's U18 Championships in January.

SCSU COACHING STAFF:

HEAD COACH JEFF GIESEN: Jeff Giesen completed his fifth season at the helm of Husky Hockey in 2010-11. The all-time winningest coach in school history, Giesen is the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen tallied his first career victory against Robert Morris on Sept. 29, 2006, with a 4-0 shutout in the NHC. Giesen's career coaching record stands at 61-98-25

with a 41-81-18 mark in the ever grueling WCHA. A 1993 and 2010 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn., with their two daughters Delaney and Maleah.



Fetter

ASSISTANT COACH JIM FETTER: Originally from Waterloo, Ont., Jim Fetter comes to St. Cloud State with 25 years of coaching experience. He most recently completed his eighth season as the Wayne State University head women's hockey coach in 2010-11 before the University opted to eliminate its women's hockey program in the spring of 2011. A three-time recipient of the College Hockey America Women's

Coach of the Year Award, he was also a finalist for the American Hockey Coaches Association Women's Division I Coach of the Year Award in 2006 before earning the award in 2008. In eight seasons with the Wayne State Warriors, Fetter amassed a record of 117-123-24 (.489) and 47 College Hockey Association victories.



Schroeder

ASSISTANT COACH BRITA SCHROEDER: Brita Schroeder has now officially been hired at St. Cloud State University after completing her first season as interim assistant coach for women's hockey at St. Cloud State in 2010-11. A familiar face to St. Cloud State women's hockey, Schroeder was a four-year standout on the blue-line for the Huskies from 2005-09. Serving as the team captain for her senior stint in 2008-09, Schroeder charted 29

points (6g, 23a) in the Cardinal and Black and is tied for fifth all-time with 145 career games played. Schroeder served as a student assistant coach for St. Cloud State women's hockey during the 2009-10 season... one of the most successful seasons in school history, finishing third in the WCHA regular season standings for the first time in school and league history. Schroeder's most recent coaching experience was at Shattuck St. Mary's Prep School this fall in Faribault, Minn., where she served as the assistant girls' hockey coach for the defending national champion U-16 team.
