## 2005-06 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

**HUSKIES PREPARE FOR #5/6 GOPHERS, RETURN TO WCHA ACTION:** The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (8-11-1 overall, 5-8-1 WCHA: 6th) returns to WCHA action after opening the 2006 year with a non-conference overtime victory against #1 St. Lawrence on Saturday, Jan. 7, in Canton, N.Y. The Huskies are now preparing for the #5/6 ranked Minnesota Gophers (13-6-1, 8-5-1 WCHA). SCSU will play host to Minnesota on Friday, Jan. 13 with a 7:07 p.m. start time in the National Hockey Center. On Saturday, Jan. 14, the Huskies will head to Ridder Arena in Minneapolis for a 4:07 p.m. start time against the Gophers.

**SCSU SPLITS ON ROAD, UPSETS #1 ST. LAWRENCE:** The St. Cloud State women's hockey team earned its first road win of the season and first win against a #1 ranked team in school's history on Saturday, Jan. 7, against #1 St. Lawrence. Junior assistant captain Denelle Maguet scored the game-winning goal and added another assist on the weekend to help in the Huskies success. Senior forward Kristy Ooninx notched a career weekend as she amassed five points in two games, and earned WCHA Offensive Player of the Week recognition for her efforts.

Canton, N.Y.: SCSU's Maguet came through in the clutch for the Huskies in overtime as she connected for the game-winning goal in overtime at 3:51 to give the Huskies their eighth win of the season and end a Saints three-game winning streak on Sat., Jan. 7 in Appleton Arena. Junior Tricia Fast and senior Kristy Ooninx tallied assists on the Maguet goal. The Huskies jumped out to a 1-0 lead at 16:26 in the first period with a power play goal from senior forward Ashley Stewart. This marked A. Stewart's fifth goal of the season as she was assisted by freshman Sammy Nixon and sophomore Marie-Michel Lemieux. Early into the third period, SCSU's Ooninx connected on her 10th goal of the season at 1:05 to boost SCSU's lead to 2-1. Junior Hailey Clarkson tallied her 14th assist of the season on the power play goal and senior A. Stewart tallied her 13th assist of the season on the goal. Just over four minutes later, the Saints fought back with a goal from Lisa Batchelor to tie the game at 2-2. However, it was yet again SCSU's Ooninx stepping up to give her team a 3-2 lead with just two and a half minutes left to play in regulation. Clarkson and senior captain Randie Jelinski connected for assists on the go-ahead goal. With just over a minute to play in the third period, SLU would tie the game and send it into overtime.

On Friday, the Huskies lost 2-3 in overtime to the Saints. On the weekend, Ooninx connected for five points (3 g, 2 a), A. Stewart added two points (1 g, 1 a) and Clarkson tallied three points (1 g, 2 a). In goal for the Huskies on Saturday, Newell finished the game with 25 saves in 63:51 minutes of play as she improved her season record to 5-4-0 overall. SCSU handed SLU's goaltender, Jessica Moffat, her first loss of the season as her record stands at 10-1-0. With the split, the series between the two teams stays dead-locked at 2-2-0.



**SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG:** Jason Lesteberg is coaching in his fourth season (59-106-14 overall/4th season at SCSU: 34-80-5) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist. Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University

of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior defender Randie Jelinski, a resident of Regina, Sask., is serving as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba).

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., is in his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

LAURA SLOMINSKI: Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING: The SCSU women's hockey team made history this past weekend as it upset the #1 ranked St. Lawrence University Saints in overtime on Saturday, Jan. 7, 4-3. This victory marked the first time in school history that a women's hockey team has defeated a #1 ranked team.

Senior forward Kristy Oonincx tallied five points on the weekend with three goals and two assists. Oonincx leads the Huskies in 2005-06 with 27 total points (11 g, 16 a).

The last time the Huskies marked a win against a team ranked three or higher was when SCSU defeated Minnesota-Duluth in the National Hockey Center on February 12, 2005, 4-3. Former forward Carrie Holldorf ('05) had the game-winning goal just 19 seconds before the second intermission in that game. At that time, the Bulldogs were ranked #2.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

#5/6 MINNESOTA (Jan. 13-14)

The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (8-11-1 overall, 5-8-1 WCHA: 6th), after winning five of its last six games, is returning to WCHA action in 2006 with a two-game series against #6 ranked Minnesota (13-6-1, 8-5-1 WCHA) on Jan. 13-14...the Gophers lead the overall series 25-1-0, with UM tallying the last win between the two teams (5-1 on Feb. 5, 2005)... SCSU looks to extend it's one-game winning streak and also to upset another ranked team...the lone win the Huskies have over the Gophers occurred on Feb. 10, 2001...the Gophers split last weekend against Bemidji State (01/06 - W, 7-2; 01/07 - L, 1-2)...UM recently moved from #5 to #6 in the USCHO.com Division I Women's Poll as of Jan. 9, 2006...on Jan. 10, the Gophers earned 5th place rankings in the USA Today/ USA Hockey Magazine poll...Minnesota has one four of its last six games, with one tie against Minnesota State on Dec. 10 (1-1 OT) and a loss to Bemidji State on Jan. 7 (1-2).



**GOPHER SPOTLIGHT:** After losing Krissy Wendell, the 2004-05 Patty Kazmaier recipient, from last year's roster, the Gophers have been led by two sophomores and one freshman in the scoring category. Sophomore Erica McKenzie (Hastings) leads UM with 25 points (14 g, 11 a) and sophomore forward Bobbi Ross (Verwood, Sask.) is at a close second with 24 points this season (14 g, 10 a). Freshman forward Gigi Marvin (Warroad, Minn.) has sparked the Gophers with five goals and 18 assists in her rookie season. Between the pipes, UM had been led by freshman Brittany Chartier. Chartier has started in 15 games and has accumulated a 9-5-1 record. She leads the team with 851:06 minutes played and 295 saves. Another freshman goaltender, Kim Hanlon (Ham Lake, Minn.), has notched a 4-1-0 record and leads the team with a .961 saves percentage and a 0.72 GAA.

**MINNESOTA GOPHER'S HEAD COACH LAURA HALLDORSON** (Princeton): In eight years, head coach Laura Halldorson has won back-to-back national championships in 2003-04 and 2004-05, and three overall at Minnesota. Last season, the Gopher coaching staff led the team to a dominating 36-2-2 overall record and a 25-1-2 mark in the WCHA. This marked the most wins in a season and in conference action since the inaugural school season in 1997-98. Halldorson also was voted WCHA Coach of the Year last season, and has received the award three times in five years. Halldorson has established herself as one of the premier women's hockey coaches in the country.

**SCSU'S THREE STOOGES:** St. Cloud State's top line continues to lead the Huskies in 2005-06. This past weekend the trio of Kristy Oonincx, Hailey Clarkson and Denelle maguet scored 10 of SCSU's 17 points (58.8%) against #1 St. Lawrence and finished with a combined +/- of +8. Oonincx is on a three-game scoring streak (seven points) and Clarkson is on a five-game scoring streak with 10 points scored. Assistant captain Maguet leads the team in shooting percentage, scoring nine goals in 64 attempts (.141).

#### OOININCX BECOMES FOURTH HUSKY TO BE NAMED WCHA P.O.W. IN 2005-06:

Senior forward Kristy Oonincx (11 g/16 a) was recently named the WCHA Offensive Player of the Week for games played Jan. 6-7. Oonincx scored five points in the two-game non-conference weekend series against #1 St. Lawrence. Oonincx is the fourth Husky to earn a WCHA Player of the Week award this season and it marks the third straight weekend that an SCSU player has won the award. Other Huskies to accomplish this were; Randie Jelinski (11/14/05 - Defensive), Denelle Maguet (12/5/05 - Offensive) and Hailey Clarkson (12/12/05 - Offensive).

Individually in the WCHA, Oonincx is tied for third in scoring (11-16-27, 1.35 ppg), ranks fourth in assists (16, .80 apg) and eighth in goals scored (11, .55 gpg). Junior Hailey Clarkson sits at the top of the WCHA in power play points with 14 on the season (5-9-14) and senior forwards Ashely Stewart (2-11-13) and Oonincx (6-7-13) are tied for second in WCHA power play points. On the defensive side of the puck, senior captain Randie Jelinski is ranked #8 in defensive scoring with nine points (2-7-9) and sophomore defender Brittni Kuyper ranks ninth with eight points scored (1-7-8).

As a team, the Huskies are third in the power play a 20.2 scoring percentage. The team also ranks third in special teams with a +2 net.

#### NEWELL CONTRIBUTES IN NET:

Sophomore Kendall Newell (Phoenix, Ariz.) earned one of her most important career victories this weekend against #1 St. Lawrence on Jan. 7. A nominee for the WCHA Defensive Player of the Week, Newell notched 25 saves and 63:51 minutes of play in the 4-3 overtime win. On the season, Newell has amassed a 5-4-0 record, 242 saves and a team-leading 2.32 GAA. Last season, Newell went 4-5-1 with a .896 save percentage, 276 saves, a 3.00 GAA and one shutout in 12 games as a freshman.
