2011-12 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS RELEASE DATE: January 11, 2012

THE MATCHUP: The Huskies will travel to Mankato to take on the Mavericks of Minnesota State on January 13th and 14th at All Seasons Arena. Friday's game will start at 7:07 PM and Saturday's is set for a 3:07 PM start.

MINNESOTA STATE BRIEFLY

Series: Minnesota State leads the all time series with SCSU 26-24-5.

THE RECORD: SCSU currently holds a 3-17-2 record and are 2-14 in the WCHA.

LAST TIME OUT VERSUS MSU: The Huskies hosted Minnesota State on December 9-10 at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud. In the first game it was all Minnesota State as they defeated SCSU 6-0. St. Cloud State responded in the second game and won 2-1 to pick up their first WCHA points on the season. Sophomore Sydney Burghardt scored a goal and Alex Nelson scored the game winner in the victory. Julie Friend had a big series against the Mavericks the first time out as she stopped 40 shots and only allowed two goals in just over 91 minutes of play. She was named WCHA Rookie of the Week following the series with MSU.

HUSKIES EARN SPLIT WITH BUCKEYES: St. Cloud State hosted Ohio State this past weekend at the National Hockey Center in what was their first games in nearly a month. On Friday night it was the Buckeyes coming out on top 2-0. Saturday afternoon it was the Huskies edging OSU 4-3. For the Huskies it was their second conference win of the season.

GIESEN VS. MSU: SCSU head coach Jeff Giesen holds a 9-14-2 career record versus Minnesota State with five of those games being decided in OT.

ANOTHER STRONG SERIES FOR FRIEND: Freshman goaltender Julie Friend got the start between the pipes both nights against Ohio State and had a total of 64 saves over the weekend. On Friday night she stopped 23 Buckeye shot attempts and on Saturday she denied 41.

COACH FETTER WINS GOLD: St. Cloud State assistant coach Jim Fetter helped lead Team Canada to the gold medal at the IIHF U18 Women's World Championships that were held last week in the Czech Republic. Fetter served as an assistant coach for Team Canada who cruised through the tournament on their way to the gold medal. In their three preliminary matchups Canada defeated Switzerland, Germany, and Finland by a combined score of 26-1. In the semi-final game against Sweden they were winners by a score of 7-0. In the finals they matched up with Team USA, who had also been cruising through the tournament up to that point by winning their first four games by a combined score of 35-2. In the final it was Team Canada and coach Fetter coming out on top and winning the gold as they shutout Team USA 3-0.

TOOR NETS GAME WINNER: Senior forward Brittany Toor put home the game winning goal Saturday afternoon at the 14:20 mark of the third period. It was Toor's fourth goal of the season and 13th of her career. She also had an assist on an earlier goal giving her a team-leading 11 points this season, a career high for Toor.

SCORING ATTACK: St. Cloud State saw many different players contributing to their scoring attack Saturday afternoon. Scoring first was senior Jaclyn Daggit, her first of the season. It was only the fourth game Daggit has participated in this season which has been limited by injuries. Junior Lisa Martinson picked up her fourth assist of the season on the Daggit goal and sophomore Amanda Monkman picked her first. Sophomore Molli Mott added to her team lead in goals scored when she recorded her seventh of the season halfway through the first period Saturday. Toor and sophomore Cari Coen had assists on the goal. The Huskies went up 3-0 late in the first period as junior Alex Nelson found the back of the net for her fourth goal of the season after being set up by junior Haylea Schmid and Julia Gilbert. For Schmid it was her third helper of the season and it was Gilbert's fourth. On the game winner from Toor she was assisted by freshman Abby Ness and junior Katie Allen. For Ness it was her team-leading eighth assist this season and for Allen it was her first.

HUSKIES DONATE MONEY TO BREAST CANCER EVENT: By selling "Huskies for a Cure" bracelets earlier this season the women's hockey team raised \$500 and donated those earnings to the American Cancer Society's "Making Strides Against Breast Cancer" event held on the St. Cloud State University campus in the fall.

SCSU COACHING STAFF:

HEAD COACH JEFF GIESEN: Jeff Giesen completed his fifth season at the helm of Husky Hockey in 2010-11. The all-time winningest coach in school history,

Giesen is the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen tallied his first career victory against Robert Morris on Sept. 29, 2006, with a 4-0 shutout in the NHC. Giesen's career coaching record stands at 61-98-25 with a 41-81-18 mark in the ever grueling WCHA. A 1993 and 2010 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn., with their two daughters Delaney and Maleah.

ASSISTANT COACH JIM FETTER: Originally from Waterloo, Ont., Jim Fetter comes to St. Cloud State with 25 years of coaching experience. He most recently completed his eighth season as the Wayne State University head women's hockey coach in 2010-11 before the University opted to eliminate its women's hockey program in the spring of 2011. A three-time recipient of the College Hockey America Women's Coach of the Year Award, he was also a finalist for the American Hockey Coaches Association Women's Division I Coach of the Year Award in 2006 before earning the award in 2008. In eight seasons with the Wayne State Warriors, Fetter

amassed a record of 117-123-24 (.489) and 47 College Hockey Association victories.

ASSISTANT COACH BRITA SCHROEDER: Brita Schroeder has now officially been hired at St. Cloud State University after completing her first season as interim assistant coach for women's hockey at St. Cloud State in 2010-11. A familiar face to St. Cloud State women's hockey, Schroeder was a four-year standout on the blue-line for the Huskies from 2005-09. Serving as the team captain for her senior stint in 2008-09, Schroeder charted 29 points (6g, 23a) in the Cardinal and Black and is tied for fifth all-time with 145 career games played. Schroeder served as a student assistant coach for St. Cloud State women's hockey during the 2009-10 season... one of the most successful seasons in school history, finishing third in the WCHA regular

season standings for the first time in school and league history. Schroeder's most recent coaching experience was at Shattuck St. Mary's Prep School during the fall of 2010 in Faribault, Minn., where she served as the assistant girls' hockey coach for the defending national champion U-16 team.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior forward Jocelyn Zabrick (Airdrie, Alberta) will wear the captain's "C" for the 2011-12 season. Senior Brittany Toor (Hartland, Mich.) and junior Alex Nelson (Andover, Minn.) will don the "A" as alternate captains.
