## 2005-06 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Jan. 17, 2006



**HUSKIES HEAD TO NORTH DAKOTA:** The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (8-13-1 overall, 5-10-1 WCHA: 6th) will head to North Dakota for a two-game weekend series on Saturday, Jan. 21- Sunday, Jan. 22. After dropping a two-game conference series to #5/6 Minnesota, the Huskies look to redeem themselves and get back on the winning track. Saturday's game against UND is set to begin at 2:07 p.m. and Sunday's game is set to begin at 3:07 p.m. Both games will be played in the Ralph Engelstad Arena in Grand Forks, N.D.

**2005-06 RESULTS:** The Huskies are 8-13-1 overall and 5-10-1 in the WCHA in 2005-06. The SCSU women's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 9-22-4 overall record and a sixth place finish in the WCHA with a 7-18-3 record.

**SCSU DROPS TWO-GAME SERIES TO MINNESOTA:** The St. Cloud State University women's hockey dropped both games to the #5/6 ranked Minnesota Gophers this past weekend. The Huskies are now 8-13-1 overall and 5-10-1 in the WCHA. On Friday, Jan. 13, SCSU was defeated 2-0 in the National Hockey Center. St. Cloud State junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) recorded 28 saves and senior forward Kristy Ooninx (Moose Jaw, Sask.) had seven shots on goal for the Huskies, including five in the first period. On Saturday, Jan. 14, St. Cloud State sophomore goaltender Kendall Newell collected 31 saves in the 5-0 loss, as Minnesota out shot the Huskies 36-20 in Ridder Arena. Ashley Stewart led the Huskies with four shots on goal.



**SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG:** Jason Lesteberg is coaching in his fourth season (59-108-14 overall/4th season at SCSU: 34-82-5) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist. Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior defender Randie Jelinski, a resident of Regina, Sask., is serving as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba).

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., is in his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

LAURA SLOMINSKI: Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

OONINCX LEADS THE HUSKY

HELM: Oonincx continues to lead the Huskies this season in points scored with 27 (11 g, 16 a). Junior forward Hailey Clarkson is second on the team with 10 goals and 15 assists this season. Junior captain Denelle Maguet has tallied nine goals and 10 assists this year and senior forward Ashley Stewart has notched five goals and 13 assists.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

UNIVERSITY of NORTH DAKOTA (Jan. 21-22):

SCSU'S women's hockey team (8-13-1 overall, 5-10-1 WCHA: 6th), after winning five of its last eight games, is looking for its first WCHA win after the beginning of the new year...this week the Huskies will head to Grand Forks, N.D., for a two-game conference series against the University of North Dakota...UND is currently 5-15-2 overall and 1-13-2 in the WCHA with its lone WCHA win coming against Bemidji State on Dec. 10, 4-0...the Huskies lead the overall series 9-4-1...earlier this season, SCSU tied UND 2-2 in overtime on Nov. 11, and beat UND on Nov. 12, 5-1...North Dakota is coming off a two-game WCHA losing series against Wisconsin...UND's longest winning streak this season is two games, which has happened twice... North Dakota is currently eighth in the WCHA standings.



WHO TO WATCH ON UND'S ROSTER: North Dakota has been led by sophomore forwards/twin sisters Cami and Cara Wooster of Salvador, Sask. all season. Cami leads the team with 11 goals and six assists as Cara is second on the team with seven goals and seven assists. Freshman forwards Samantha Bowers and Melissa Jaques each have tallied 11 points in their rookie seasons. Defensively for UND, senior Jessica Kovacevich ranks 20th in defensive scoring in the WCHA with three points (1-2--3). In goal for UND, seniors Amber Hasbargen and Margaret-Ann Hinkley have been sharing responsibilities. Hasbargen has earned a 3-10-2 overall record, with a GAA of 3.41 and a save percentage of .892. Hinkley has seen 485:23 minutes of playing time, and has amassed a 1-5-0 record, a team best 3.10 GAA and an .892 save percentage.

NORTH DAKOTA'S HEAD COACH SHANTEL RIVARD: Shantel Rivard is in her fourth season as head coach of the Fighting Sioux women's hockey team and will lead the Sioux into their second season in the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in 2005-06. The only head coach the Fighting Sioux women's hockey program has known in its young history, Rivard has guided UND to a 40-66-9 record over the team's first three and a half seasons. Last season Rivard led the Sioux to a 9-23-3 record, including a 6-21-1 WCHA record and seventh place finish in the team's first season as a conference member. In the first postseason game in program history, Rivard and the Sioux nearly upset second-ranked Minnesota Duluth in the WCHA playoff opener before losing a 3-2 overtime heartbreaker.

#### SCSU UPPERCLASSMEN RANK IN WCHA TOP TEN:

Senior forward Kristy Oonincx currently ranks sixth in the WCHA in overall scoring with 27 points (11 g, 16 a). She also ranks eighth in goal scoring with 11 goals and second in power play points with 13. Last, but not least, Oonincx ranks fifth in assist scoring with 16 in 2005-06. Teammate Hailey Clarkson still ranks #1 in the WCHA with 14 power play points on the season. Clarkson also ranks 10th in scoring with 25 points on the season.

Senior forward Ashley Stewart continues to be a constant for the Huskies as she currently ranks second in the WCHA in overall power play points with 13.

**DEFENSIVE SCORING FOR THE HUSKIES:** Senior captain Randie Jelinski ranks eighth in the WCHA in defensive scoring with nine points (2-7--9) and teammate Brittni Kuyper ranks 10th with eight points (1-7--8).

**MAGUET RANKS EIGHTH:** Junior assistant captain Denelle Maguet has three game-winning goals on the season, which is good for an eighth place ranking in the WCHA. Teammate Hailey Clarkson ranks 10th with two game-winning goals this season.

**HUSKIES STAYING OUT OF THE BOX:** SCSU has done a tremendous job of keeping its penalites down in 2005-06. Cuurently, the Huskies rank 7th in the WCHA with just 254 PIM in 22 games played.
