2005-06 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

HUSKIES HOST #1 WISCONSIN: The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (12-13-1 overall, 9-10-1 WCHA: 4th) plays host to #1 University of Wisconsin on Feb. 3-4 after coming off a two-game sweep over #3 Minnesota Duluth this past weekend. Both games are set to begin at 2:07 p.m. in the National Hockey Center.

2005-06 RESULTS: The Huskies are 12-13-1 overall and 9-10-1 in the WCHA in 2005-06 and have moved into fourth place in the WCHA rankings. The SCSU women's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 9-22-4 overall record and a sixth place finish in the WCHA with a 7-18-3 record.

WOMEN'S HOCKEY MAKES HISTORY, SWEEPS #3 MINNESOTA DULUTH: The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (12-13-1, 9-10-1 WCHA) etched itself in the record books last weekend after sweeping the University of Minnesota Duluth Bulldogs for the first time in school history. On Friday, Jan. 27, the Huskies earned a 2-1 victory and backed that win up with a 3-1 victory on Saturday, Jan. 28 in the National Hockey Center. The sweep over UMD marked the first sweep in school history over a ranked team, and also marked the fourth WCHA sweep this season.

OONINCX AND ST. JACQUES EARN USCHO.COM PLAYERS OF THE WEEK HONORS:

SCSU'S senior forward Kristy Oonincx (Moose Jaw, Sask.) and junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) both earned USCHO.com player of the week honors for their contributions in the sweep over #3 Minnesota Duluth on Jan. 27-28. Oonincx was named the USCHO.com Offensive Player of the Week after scoring four points against UMD, including both game-winning goals. St. Jacques, who played in both games against the Bulldogs, tallied 81 saves between the pipes and helped lead her team to its first sweep over UMD in school history.



SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG:

Jason Lesteberg is coaching in his fourth season (64-108-15 overall/4th season at SCSU: 39-82-6) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist. Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior defender Randie Jelinski, a resident of Regina, Sask., is serving as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba).

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., is in his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

LAURA SLOMINSKI: Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

OONINCX ON A ROLL: SCSU's senior forward Kristy Oonincx is on a roll this season, and her scoring contributions couldn't be coming at a better time. This past weekend against #3 Minnesota Duluth, Oonincx tallied four points, including both game-winning goals in the first sweep over the Bulldogs in school history. In the WCHA, Oonincx ranks third in scoring (15-19-34), seventh in goal scoring (15), fourth in assists (19) and is tied for first in power play points with 16 (8-8-16). Also ranking first in the WCHA in power play goals with eight, Oonincx has found herself ranked nationally as well. Currently, she ranks tied for sixth in scoring with 34 points and is tied for first in the nation with 8 power play goals. Leading the Huskies with 15 goals and 19 assists in 2005-06, Oonincx has a .139 shooting percentage and is second on the team with a +10 +/-.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

#1 UNIVERSITY of WISCONSIN (Feb. 3-4, 2006):

SCSU'S women's hockey team (12-13-1 overall, 9-10-1 WCHA: 4th), is coming off its biggest sweep in school history as the Huskies swept the #3 Minnesota Duluth Bulldogs on Jan. 27-28 (2-1, 3-1)...this weekend SCSU plays host to the #1 ranked Wisconsin Badgers for a conference series on Feb. 3-4...UW is 23-2-1 overall and leads the WCHA with an 18-1-1 record...As a team, Wisconsin is leading the WCHA in six of nine team categories...UW ranks first in power play percentage (21.6%), just ahead of second ranked SCSU (19.8)...the Badgers lead the overall series 15-3-0...under the helm of UW's head coach Mark Johnson, the Badgers lead the Huskies 12-1-0...the last time SCSU beat UW was Nov. 9, 2002 with a 5-3 victory...earlier this season, the Huskies dropped a two game series to UW on Nov. 4-5 (5-2, 3-1)...Wisconsin is on a nine-game winning streak and swept Bemidji State last weekend (4-2, 3-1)...in the nation, UW's Sara Bauer ranks tied for first in scoring with 42 points in 24 games and is second in assists with 23 on the season.



BAUER LEADS BADGERS: Wisconsin has been led by junior forward Sara Bauer, who has 19 goals and a team-leading 23 assists on the season. Bauer also ranks #1 in the WCHA in points scored (15-20-35), short-handed goals (3) and game-winning goals (6). Sophomore forward Jinelle Zaugg, who ranks #16 in the nation in points per game (1.23), has been a spark for the UW offense as she has tallied a team-leading 20 goals and also 12 assists in 2005-06. In the WCHA, Zaugg ranks #6 in scoring (11-11-22). Senior goaltender Meghan Horras leads the Badgers with a 12-1-1 overall record this season between the pipes. Her GAA is at 1.74 and she leads the team with 285 saves. Horras ranks #1 in the WCHA with a .950 winning percentage (9-0-1) and is #3 with a GAA of 1.63.

WISCONSIN'S HEAD COACH MARK JOHNSON: Named the 2003 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year and also one of eight finalists for the American Hockey Coaches Association Division I Coach of the Year, Johnson guided Wisconsin to a 22-8-5 overall and 14-6-4 WCHA record that season. Since Johnson took over as head coach in 2002, his team's have set new school records for wins each season (22 in 02-03, 25 in 03-04, 28 in 04-05). This season, Johnson and crew have his team ranked #1 in the nation and have a current record of 23-2-1.

WEEKEND RECAP OF SWEEP OVER #3 MINNESOTA DULUTH:

The Huskies have now won 3 of the last 4 games against UMD in the National Hockey Center after completing the sweep over the Bulldogs this past weekend. On Friday, Jan. 27, SCSU squeaked out a 2-1 victory, after senior forward Kristy Ooninx found the back of the net at 14:33 to notch the game-winning goal. Husky freshman forward Megan McCarthy tallied the first goal of the game at 01:51 in the third period, and sophomore forward Laura Fast and junior forward Hailey Clarkson each notched assists in the game. Although the Huskies were out-shot in the contest 40-23, SCSU's junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques pulled through, collecting 39 saves between the pipes. The following day, Jan. 28, the Huskies had more to prove by completing the sweep...and that's exactly what they did. UMD dropped a 3-1 loss to the Huskies in the National Hockey Center. Almost in déjà vu fashion, McCarthy scored the first goal of the game at 01:51 in the second period, and Ooninx connected for the game-winning goal at 19:33 in the second, along with the third goal of the game at 04:02 in the third period to seal the win. Senior forward Ashley Stewart tallied two assists in the game, and Ooninx, McCarthy, Denelle Maguet and Brittini Kuyper each accounted for one assist on the day. Again, UMD out-shot the Huskies by a margin of 43-24, but with the help of goaltender St. Jacques' 42 saves, SCSU was able to complete the sweep and move into fourth place in the WCHA.

ST. JACQUES AND OONINX NAMED WCHA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

SCSU's senior forward Kristy Ooninx and junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques were both named WCHA Players of the Week for their efforts in the team's sweep over #3 UMD. This marks the second time this season that Ooninx has earned the Offensive POW award and the first time for St. Jacques to earn the Defensive POW. On the season, SCSU has had seven POW recipients.

OONINX CONNECTS ON POWER PLAY:

Kristy Ooninx notched two power play goals in the 3-1 win over UMD on Jan. 28. The last player to score two power play goals in a game was junior assistant captain Denelle Maguet, who did this on Dec. 2, 2005 in a 4-1 win over Niagara at the NHC.

HUSKY DEFENSE PREVAILS: Although the Huskies were out-shot 83-47 against Minnesota Duluth, SCSU's defense pulled through for the weekend sweep. The last time SCSU was out-shot and won was Nov. 12, 2005, when the Huskies defeated North Dakota 5-1 at the National Hockey Center, despite being out-shot 30-28.
