## 2005-06 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS



Release Date: Feb. 7, 2006

**HUSKIES HEAD TO ALL SEASONS ARENA:** The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (13-14-1 overall, 10-11-1 WCHA: 4th) will travel to Minnesota State University for a two-game road series on Friday, Feb. 10 and Saturday, Feb. 11. Friday's game is slated for 7:07 p.m. and Saturday's puck is set to be dropped at 3:07 p.m. with both games being played in the All Seasons Arena in Mankato, Minn.

**2005-06 RESULTS:** The Huskies are 13-14-1 overall and 10-11-1 in the WCHA in 2005-06 and hold fourth place in the WCHA rankings with a two point advantage over fifth place Ohio State. The SCSU women's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 9-22-4 overall record and a sixth place finish in the WCHA with a 7-18-3 record.

**WOMEN'S HOCKEY SPLITS HOME SERIES WITH #1 WISCONSIN:** SCSU continues to make history as it knocked off #1 ranked Wisconsin 1-0 in regulation on Saturday, Feb. 4. This win marked the first time in the history of the women's hockey program that an SCSU team has beaten two different #1 ranked teams in a single season. Junior forward Hailey Clarkson netted the game-winning goal over the Badgers as junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (36 saves) handed the Badgers their first shutout of the season.



### ST. JACQUES IS BACK-TO-BACK WCHA DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

SCSU's junior goaltender and assistant captain Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) was recently named for the second week in a row the WCHA Defensive Player of the Week for her efforts against #1 Wisconsin on Feb. 3-4. St. Jacques amassed 65 saves against the Badgers in the weekend series split and helped keep the Badgers top scoring line scoreless. The Huskies defeated #1 Wisconsin 1-0 on Feb. 4, which marked the first time since Nov. 9, 2002 that SCSU has beaten UW and also the first time that the Badgers have been shutout this season. Of note, this marks the first time in her career that St. Jacques has earned WCHA Defensive P.O.W. honors in consecutive weeks.

**HUSKIES RANKED IN POLLS:** The SCSU women's hockey team made history once again as they became the first team to ever be ranked in the Top Ten USCHO.com poll. The Huskies are tied with Providence for a 10th place ranking in the USCHO.com poll on Feb. 6, 2006.



**SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG:** Jason Lesteberg is coaching in his fourth season (65-109-15 overall/4th season at SCSU: 40-83-6) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist. Prior to becoming the head

coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior defender Randie Jelinski, a resident of Regina, Sask., is serving as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba).

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., is in his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

LAURA SLOMINSKI: Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

WOMEN'S HOCKEY CREEPING IN THE RPI AND PWR: The St. Cloud State women's hockey team, after winning five of its last six WCHA games, continues to be ranked 12th in the Pairwise Rankings (PWR) and has moved up to 11th in the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI). Both the PWR and the RPI are tools used to select teams for the national collegiate women's ice hockey tournament. Only games played against other Division I teams are factored in the rankings. The PWR's factors include: 1) only teams with an RPI at or above .500, 2) records against common opponents, 3) record in last 16 games, 4) head to head competition, 5) record against other teams at or above .500, 6) the overall RPI. With three Division I conferences having three automatic bids into the NCAA Tournament, the RPI and PWR help determine the remaining five teams who gain bids into the NCAA tournament.

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

MINNESOTA STATE (Feb. 10-11, 2006):

Coming off yet another historic weekend after defeating the #1 ranked Wisconsin Badgers 1-0 in regulation, SCSU's women's hockey team (13-14-1, 10-11-1 WCHA) heads to All Seasons Arena in Mankato, Minn, for a two-game series tilt against the Minnesota State Mavericks (11-14-3, 8-12-2 WCHA)...the Mavericks started the season off with a 9-7-2 record with big wins over Ohio State and a four-game winning streak from Nov.

11-Nov. 19, 2005...earlier this season Minnesota State swept the Huskies in the National Hockey Center with two shutouts (Nov. 18, 3-0, Nov. 19, 2-0)...SCSU leads the overall series record 13-10-3 and looks to redeem itself after being shutout earlier this season by MSU...Minnesota State has been ranked as high as #8 this season in the USCHO.com poll on Dec. 12, 2005...in the series history, SCSU holds a 9-game winning streak from Jan. 28, 2000 to Jan. 25, 2002...currently, 4th place SCSU has a three point lead over 6th place MSU in the WCHA...Minnesota State ranks first in the WCHA with 410 penalty minutes...the Mavericks are second in the conference with a 87.3 penalty kill percentage.



UNDERCLASSMEN LEAD MAVERICK ATTACK: Freshman forward Maggie Fisher is leading the Maverick offense attack in her rookie season with a team-leading 14 goals and six assists. Fisher ranks 8th in the WCHA with 14 goals scored, is 3rd in the WCHA with three short-handed points, and ranks 5th in freshman scoring with 20 points. Two sophomores have chipped in for second and third place scoring on the team this season. Forwards Kristina Bunker (8-7-15) and Amanda Stohr (6-8-14) have scored 29 points collectively. Between the pipes in 2005-06 for the Mavericks has been sophomore Britni Kehler. Kehler has backstopped 625 saves in 21 games played and has earned a season record of 10-9-2. Kehler ranks 3rd in the WCHA with a .934 save percentage. Her back up this season has been junior goaltender Laura Brennan, who has a record of 1-5-1 with 188 saves and a GAA of 3.25.

MINNESOTA STATE'S HEAD COACH JEFF VIZENOR: Coach Vizenor joined the Maverick staff in 2001 and has steadily improved the win column for the program. The Mavericks posted the first winning season in school history in 2003-2004 with a 16-14-4 overall record, including wins over top-ranked Minnesota and Minnesota Duluth, and made their first-ever appearance in the WCHA Final Five and NCAA Division I national rankings. Vizenor also mentored the program's first Jofa Division I All-American and Patty Kazmaier finalist in goaltender Shari Vogt. Following the season, he was honored by his peers with WCHA Coach of the Year distinction. His career mark now stands at 75-88-17 overall and 41-75-12 at MSU.

More News and Notes

A TEAM OF "FIRSTS": The 2005-2006 SCSU women's hockey team continues to make history and has become the team to accomplish many "firsts". After defeating a #1 ranked team for the first time in school history (St. Lawrence on Jan. 7, 4-3 OT), the Huskies swept #3 Minnesota Duluth in the NHC for the first time in school history. The Huskies weren't satisfied, as they defeated yet again another #1 ranked team (Wisconsin on Feb. 4, 1-0), which marked the first time in school history that a women's hockey team has defeated two different #1 ranked teams in a single season. The icing to the cake came this week as USCHO.com released its weekly poll and the Huskies found themselves ranked tied for 10th with Providence. Although SCSU women's hockey teams have earned votes in the national polls, this week's ranking marks the first time in school history that an SCSU women's hockey team has gained Top Ten recognition.

HUSKIES AT THE TOP OF THE WCHA POWER PLAY:

Leading the power play in the WCHA, the Huskies are 30/143 and have a 21.0 completion percentage. Both goals scored against Wisconsin this past weekend were on the power play. Sophomore Marie-Michel Lemieux notched the lone goal for the Huskies in the 3-1 loss on Feb. 3, and junior forward Hailey Clarkson connected on the game-winning power play goal on Feb. 4. Individually for SCSU, senior forwards Kristy Oonincx and Ashley Stewart, along with Clarkson hold the top three spots in the WCHA power play list. Oonincx ranks #1 with 17 pp points (8g,9a). Stewart (2g,14a) and Clarkson (6g,10a) are tied for second, each with 16 pp points.

OONINCX CLIMBS THE CHARTS:

SCSU's Kristy Oonincx is climbing the WCHA and national charts during her senior season. This year she has scored 35 points (15g, 20a), which is just three points shy of her highest scoring season, which occurred in 2001-2002 during her freshman year at Minnesota (17g, 21a). Currently, Oonincx ranks third in the WCHA scoring, fourth in assist scoring, first in power play points and seventh with four game-winning goals. In the nation, she is tied for eighth with 35 points, is in ninth place in assists scored and continues to be tied for first with eight power play goals.

ST. JACQUES RECORDS FIRST SHUTOUT OF SEASON:

SCSU's junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques is in a world of her own, as she has amassed 146 saves in the last four games, backstopping her team to three wins in the last four games at home. This past weekend against #1 Wisconsin, St. Jacques tallied her first shutout of the season as SCSU defeated UW 1-0. The last time the Huskies shutout a team was on Dec. 3, 2004, when St. Jacques had 23 saves in a 2-0 win over St. Lawrence at the NHC.

SCSU scored with a pulled goalie/extra skater: Jan. 14, 2005. Kristy Oonincx scored with 00:26 remaining to tie the game at 4-4 versus Bemidji State at the NHC. Ended as a tie.

SCSU was out-shot and won: Feb. 4, 2006. SCSU was out-shot 36-12, yet upset #1 Wisconsin 1-0 at the NHC.

SCSU outshot the opponent and lost: Nov. 18, 2005. SCSU outshot MSU 30-21 but was shutout 3-0 at the NHC.

SCSU OUT-SHOT AND STILL VICTORIOUS: Although #1 Wisconsin out-shot the Huskies 68-41 on Feb. 3-4, SCSU found a way to win on Feb. 4, 1-0. The last time SCSU was out-shot and won was the prior weekend against #3 Minnesota Duluth, when the Huskies swept the Bulldogs 2-1 and 3-1 on Jan. 27-28, despite being out-shot 83-47 on the weekend.
