NO. 9 HUSKIES WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON AT BEMIDJI STATE: The No. 9 ranked St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (15-16-1 overall, 12-13-1 WCHA: 4th) will complete its regular season against Bemidji State on Feb. 24-25. Friday's game is slated for 7:07 p.m. and Saturday's game is slated for 2:07 p.m. Both games will be played in the John Glas Fieldhouse on the campus of Bemidji State University.

2005-06 RESULTS: The Huskies are 15-16-1 overall and 12-13-1 in the WCHA in 2005-06 and have a two point advantage over fifth place Ohio State for a fourth place standing in the WCHA. The SCSU women's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 9-22-4 overall record and a sixth place finish in the WCHA with a 7-18-3 record.

GOPHERS UPEND HUSKIES: SCSU was swept by the Minnesota Gophers in the second home-and-home series of the season on Feb. 17-18. On Friday, Feb. 17, in the National Hockey Center, UM edged SCSU 3-2 in regulation. The following afternoon in Ridder Arena, the Gophers found a way to win as they defeated the Huskies 4-2 with an empty netter. UM now leads the overall series record with the Huskies 29-1-0.

NINE IS FINE: The SCSU women's hockey team stayed at No. 9 in the USCHO.com poll as of February 20, 2006, for the second week in a row. This is the highest ranking of any SCSU women's hockey team in school history. In the USA Today/American Hockey women's poll, the Huskies earned 11 votes as of Feb. 14, 2006.



WCHA FIRST ROUND PLAYOFF INFORMATION: The first round of the WCHA playoffs will be held on March 3-5. This year marks the first year in conference history that all eight teams will be invited to the tournament. The top four WCHA teams will host the first round in a best of three weekend series. The WCHA Championships will be held on March 11-12, at Ridder Arena. Tickets for the 2006 WCHA Playoff Championships can be purchased by calling 1-800-UGOPHER.



SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG: Jason Lesteberg is coaching in his fourth season (67-111-15 overall/4th season at SCSU: 42-85-6) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist. Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior defender Randie Jelinski, a resident of Regina, Sask., is serving as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba).

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., is in his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

LAURA SLOMINSKI: Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

BEMIDJI STATE (Feb. 24-25, 2006):

The Bemidji State University Beavers (10-20-2, 9-17-0 WCHA) are currently on a four-game winning streak after sweeping North Dakota (Feb. 3-4) and Ohio State (Feb. 10-11)...BSU is coming off their bye week...St. Cloud State leads the overall series 15-12-4...earlier this season the Huskies swept the Beavers at the National Hockey Center on Oct. 21 (6-2) and Oct. 22 (4-1)... the last time BSU defeated SCSU was on Jan. 15, 2005, when BSU shutout SCSU 2-0 in the National Hockey Center...Of note, SCSU's head coach Jason Lesteberg coaches at Bemidji State in 2000-2001 before coming to SCSU in the fall of 2001...Lesteberg led the Beavers to a WCHA Final Five appearance.



BEAVERS ON A ROLL: After winning four straight games and five of its last eight games, the Bemidji State University Beavers have climbed ahead of Minnesota State on the WCHA chart for a tie for sixth place with 18 conference points. BSU is led by junior Kelly Hart (Ajax, Ontario), who has tallied 26 points this season (7g, 19a). Nikki Eckebrecht, a junior forward from Hamilton, Ontario, has connected for 21 points and leads the team with 26/60 PIM. Another junior forward, Helena Tageson (Malmo, Sweden) has contributed 18 points (10g, 8a) on the season along with a team-leading six power play goals. The goaltending duties have ben split between senior Jill Luebke (Neenah, Wis.) and sophomore Emily Brookshaw (Webster, Wis.). Luebke leads the team with a .906 save percentage, a 2.93 GAA and a 6-9-1 season record. Brookshaw has backstopped 496 saves on the season, along with 955:15 minutes of play.

BEMIDJI STATE'S INTERIM CO-HEAD COACHES SIS PAULSEN AND JIMMY INGMAN: Former BSU assistant coaches Jimmy Ingman and Sis Paulsen took over as interim co-head coaches in December of 2005 when former head coach Bruce Olson stepped down from his duties. Since Jimmy and Sis have taken over, the Beavers have gone 6-9-0 and are currently on a four-game winning streak.

More News and Notes

SCSU and UM RILVARY RECAP: The 2005-2006 SCSU women's hockey team was swept by the University of Minnesota Gophers for the second time this season on Feb. 17-18. In the home-and-home series, SCSU dropped a 3-2 loss in the National Hockey Center on Feb. 17, and a 4-2 loss with an empty netter on Feb. 18 in Ridder Arena. Seven different Huskies scored in the series, including senior forward Ashley Stewart, who is now just seven points away from the prestigious 100-Point Career Club. Junior assistant captain Denelle Maguet chipped in two goals on the weekend, as Hailey Clarkson also scored a goal against the Gophers. Senior captain Randie Jelinski, senior forward Kristy Oonincx, and sophomore defenders Brittni Kuyper and Stacy Dey each tallied at least one assist in the home-and-home series. The Huskies are now 1-29-0 against UM in school history.

FIVE SENIORS HONORED: On Friday, Feb. 17, the five Husky seniors were honored for a Senior Night presentation before SCSU played the Minnesota Gophers in the National Hockey Center. The five seniors honored were; team captain Randie Jelinski (Regina, Sask.), Kristy Oonincx (Moose Jaw, Sask.), Rachel Solgon (Tucson, Ariz.) and sisters Ashley and Kelly Stewart (Toronto, Ont.).

HOME ICE HOPES ALIVE: SCSU currently has a two point lead over fifth place Ohio State (23 points) in the WCHA standings with 25 points. With high hopes to host the first round of the WCHA tournament, the Huskies need to earn two crucial WCHA points this weekend against Bemidji State to guarantee a tie with OSU in the WCHA for fourth place. The Buckeyes go head-to-head with WCHA Champions University of Wisconsin on Feb. 24-25.

IT'S ABOUT TEAM: St. Cloud State's two junior assistant captains Denelle Maguet and Lauri St. Jacques gave quite the gesture to four seniors on Feb. 17-18. Being that senior Randie Jelinski is the team captain, Maguet and St. Jacques offered up their "A" stitches to the other four seniors for senior weekend. Twin sisters Kelly and Ashley Stewart wore the "A's" on Friday, Feb. 17, and Rachel Solgon and Kristy Oonincx wore the "A" stitches on Saturday, Feb. 18, against the Gophers.

KUYPER CREEPING ON RECORD BOOK: Sophomore defender Brittni Kuyper (Eden Prairie) has collected 14 assists on the season and is just three assists away from a defense season record. Former Husky Kobi Kawamoto scored 17 assists in 2001-2002.

GOALTENDER GOODS: SCSU's junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques is on pace to set a few school records this season. Already, St. Jacques has tied the school record for most shutouts in a season with two. The last goaltenders to achieve this were Sondra Diaz-Arntzen and Laura Gieselman in 1999-2000. St. Jacques is also on pace to hold the best save percentage and goals against average in a season. Currently, Gieselman holds the record .899 in 2002-03, and St. Jacques has a .922 this season. Gieselman also holds the GAA record of 3.27 in 2002-03, as St. Jacques stands at 2.34 on the season.
