SCSU ADVANCES TO WCHA PLAYOFF CHAMPIONSHIPS: The No. 4 seeded St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (18-17-1) will head to Ridder Arena in Minneapolis on March 11-12 to face No. 1 seeded Wisconsin (31-4-1) in the first game of the semi-final round of the WCHA Playoff Championships on March 11. Game time is slated for 1:07 p.m. CT.

2005-06 RESULTS: The Huskies are 18-17-1 overall and finished in fourth place in the WCHA with a 13-14-1 conference record. The SCSU women's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 9-22-4 overall record and a sixth place finish in the WCHA with a 7-18-3 record.

HUSKIES WIN TWO STRAIGHT OVER BUCKEYES IN FIRST ROUND OF PLAYOFFS:

SCSU defeated The Ohio State University in two straight games in the first round of the WCHA Playoffs on March 3-4 to advance to the WCHA Playoff Championships on March 11-12. On Friday, March 3, senior forward Ashley Stewart notched the game-winning goal just 50 seconds into overtime to boost the Huskies with the 2-1 victory in the National Hockey Center. The following day, on Saturday, March 4, sophomore forward Laura Fast tallied the first goal of the game, along with three assists, to lead SCSU to a 6-3 victory over OSU and a berth to the WCHA Playoff Championships.

IN THE POLLS: The SCSU women's hockey team was recently ranked #10 in the USCHO.com poll on March 6, 2006. In the USA Today/American Hockey women's poll, the Huskies earned five votes as of Feb. 28, 2006.

SEMIFINAL PLAYOFF GAME HEARD LIVE ON KVSC:

On Saturday, March 11, the #10 ranked St. Cloud State University women's hockey game against the #3 ranked University of Wisconsin in the first semifinal game of the WCHA Playoff Championships can be heard live on KVSC 88.1 FM. The game will also be streamed live on the Internet at: www.kvsc.org, with the pregame show beginning at 12:55 p.m.

WCHA PLAYOFF CHAMPIONSHIPS AND TICKET INFORMATION:

The game times and ticket information for the WCHA Playoff Championships involving the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team have been announced. The No. 4 seed St. Cloud State (18-17-1) will play No. 1 seed Wisconsin (34-4-1) in the first semifinal game at 1:07 p.m. on Saturday, March 11 at the Ridder Arena. The winner will advance to the 1:07 p.m. CT Championship game on Sunday, March 12. An All-Tournament pass is on sale for \$20 and a single game ticket is \$15. For ticket purchases and information call 1-800-U-GOPHER.



SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG: Jason Lesteberg is coaching in his fourth season (70-112-15 overall/4th season at SCSU: 45-86-6) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist. Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., is in his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

LAURA SLOMINSKI: Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national ACHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

#3 WISCONSIN (Mar. 11, 2006):

The No. 4 seeded SCSU women's hockey team will face No. 1 seeded Wisconsin (34-4-1) in the semifinals of the WCHA Playoff Championships on Saturday, March 11... UW is 31-4-1 overall and are the WCHA regular season conference champions...under the helm of Coach Johnson, UW leads the overall series with SCSU 13-2-0... on Feb. 4, 2005, SCSU upset the then ranked #1 Badgers by a score of 1-0 in the National Hockey Center...of note, that shutout marked the lone shutout suffered by Wisconsin all season...prior to the win in February, the last time the Huskies had beaten the Badgers was on Nov. 9, 2002, with a 5-3 victory...the Badgers bring a seven-game winning streak into the semifinals of the WCHA Playoff Championships.



BAUER IS BADGER LEADER: Junior forward and Top 10 Finalist for the Patty Kazmaier Award, Sara Bauer has been a consistent leader for UW all season. Bauer currently ranks sixth in the nation with 48 points (21 g, 27a) and ranks 10th with 27 assists. In the WCHA, Bauer ranks second with 1.41 points per game and four short-handed points (3g, 1a). Sharon Cole, a senior forward, is second on the team with 37 points (14g, 22a). Cole has notched three power play goals and ranks ninth in the WCHA with 1.03 points per game. Leading the team with eight power play goals is sophomore Jinnelle Zaugg. In goal for the Badgers has been senior Meghan Horras. Horras has played 1067:30 minutes in her final season, and has backstopped 347 saves with a .925 save percentage. Horras leads her #3 ranked Badgers with a 15-2-1 season record and ranks second in the WCHA with a .861 winning percentage.

WISCONSIN'S HEAD COACH: Named the 2003 WCHA Co-Coach of the year and also one of the eight finalists for the American Hockey Coaches Association Division I Coach of the Year, Johnson guided Wisconsin to a 22-8-5 overall and 14-6-4 WCHA record that season. Since Johnson took over as head coach in 2002, his teams have set new school records for wins each season (22 in 02-03, 25 in 03-04, 28 in 04-05, 31 in 05-06). This season, Johnson and crew have his team ranked #3 in the nation and have a current record of 31-4-1.

More News and Notes

SCSU ADVANCES PAST OSU IN THE FIRST ROUND OF WCHA PLAYOFFS:

Playing in its inaugural home playoff game on Friday, March 3, senior forward Ashley Stewart tallied the game-winning goal to lead the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team to a 2-1 overtime victory over The Ohio State University Buckeyes in the first game of the best-of-three series in the first round of the WCHA Tournament. With the win on Friday, the Huskies tied the school record for the most wins in one season with 17 wins. The following day, sophomore forward Laura Fast tallied four points (1g, 3a) in the SCSU 6-3 victory over the Buckeyes. On the day, A. Stewart tallied two assists, freshman forward Megan McCarthy added one goal and one assist, and junior forward Hailey Clarkson tacked on two more goals. All in all, 11 Huskies notched points on Saturday. In goal, junior assistant captain Lauri St. Jacques backstopped the Huskies with 55 saves on the weekend as she improved her season record to 12-12-1.

PLAYOFF HISTORY: In playoff action, SCSU has a historical record of 2-3-0, with the most recent loss being suffered to this weekend's No. 1 seeded Wisconsin Badgers. Last season, finishing sixth in the WCHA regular season, the Huskies suffered a 3-1 loss to UW on March 4, 2005, in the WCHA one-weekend playoff tournament at Ridder Arena.

STEWART CREEPS ON SCORING LADDER:

Senior forward Ashley Stewart currently ranks third on the all-time SCSU women's hockey scoring list with 98 career points (45g, 53a). Former Husky Roxanne Stang is the lone Husky to reach the prestigious mark of 100 career points. Stang, who played from 2001-2004, totalled 119 points (71g, 48a). Ashley Stewart trails former Husky Kobi Kawamoto (2001-2004), who scored 99 career points (35g, 64a).

SCORING FIRST SPELLS SUCCESS:

The Huskies have a knack for tallying wins after scoring first. This season alone, SCSU is 17-4-1 overall after scoring first and is 70-33-6 historically after scoring first. The same goes for leading in the game heading into the first intermission. The Huskies are 9-2-0 when leading after the first period.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING: After defeating OSU on March 4 and earning its 18th season victory, the SCSU 2005-2006 women's hockey team has become the first team in school history to reach 18 wins in a single season (18-17-1).

OT UPDATES: The last time the SCSU women's hockey team defeated a team in overtime was on Jan. 7, 2006, when the Huskies defeated the then-ranked #1 St. Lawrence, 4-3. This season, the Huskies sport a 2-1-1 record in overtime. The last time SCSU suffered an overtime loss was on Jan. 6, 2006 against #1 St. Lawrence when the Huskies lost 2-3.

L. FAST IS PLAYMAKER: Laura Fast became the most recent Playmaker on the Husky roster after scoring one goal and three assists in the 6-3 victory over OSU in the NHC on March 4, 2006. Teammate Kristy Ooninx was the last Husky to achieve this on Feb. 11, 2006, in a 6-1 victory over Minnesota State at the All Seasons Arena in Mankato, Minn.
