## Season in Review

### St. Cloud State University (18-18-1, 13-14-1 WCHA)

Season concluded finishing in 4th place in the WCHA - This marks the highest finish in the WCHA since 2000-2001 and the most total wins in a regular season in school history.

## 2005-06 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: April 3, 2006



**2005-06 RESULTS:** The Huskies completed their season 18-18-1 overall and finished in fourth place in the WCHA with a 13-14-1 conference record. The SCSU women's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 9-22-4 overall record and a sixth place finish in the WCHA with a 7-18-3 record.

### BUCKEYES KNOCK OFF HUSKIES IN THE WCHA SEMIFINALS, END SCSU SEASON:

The No. 1 seeded and #3 ranked Wisconsin Badgers completed SCSU's 2005-06 season on March 11 with a 9-0 shutout in the semifinals of the WHCA Championships in Ridder Arena. The last time SCSU had been shutout was on January 14, 2006, when the Minnesota Gophers handed the Huskies a 5-0 loss at Ridder Arena. UW's Sara Bauer tallied four assists and one goal in the contest as teammate Cyndy Kenyon notched four goals. SCSU's sophomore goaltender Kendall Newell led the Huskies with 20 saves between the pipes. Of note, this was the first time in WCHA history that another team besides Minnesota, Minnesota-Duluth, Wisconsin or Ohio State had made it to the WCHA semifinals.

**PLAYOFF HISTORY:** In playoff action, SCSU has a historical record of 2-4-0, with the most recent loss being suffered to this season's No. 1 seeded Wisconsin Badgers in the WCHA Semifinals on March 11, 2006. Last season, finishing sixth in the WCHA regular season, the Huskies suffered a 3-1 loss to UW on March 4, 2005, in the WCHA one-weekend playoff tournament at Ridder Arena in Minneapolis, Minn. The Huskies gained their first two playoff victories against Ohio State in the first round of the WCHA playoffs on March 3 and 4, 2006, in the National Hockey Center. That weekend also marked the first time in school history that SCSU hosted a playoff game.

**IN THE POLLS:** The SCSU women's hockey team received five votes in the final USCHO.com poll on March 13, 2006. In the final USA Today/American Hockey women's poll, the Huskies earned three votes on March 14, 2006.

**SCSU STUDENT-ATHLETES GAIN WCHA ACADEMIC HONORS:** In February, the WCHA, through Commissioner Bruce M. McLead, Associate Commissioner Sara Martin, University of Wisconsin Faculty Representative Linda Bauman (Chair, men's league) and St. Cloud State University Faculty Representative Bill Hudson (Chair, women's League) announced an inaugural group of 47 WCHA Scholar-Athlete Award recipients, a new honor developed through Association member team Faculty Representatives and approved by the conference membership for this 2005-06 season. This group of elite student-athletes in the WCHA included SCSU women's hockey players junior forward Denelle Maguet (Ste. Rose, Man.), sophomore forward Laura Fast (Calgary, Alberta) and junior forward Bobbie Anderson (Whitehorse, Alberta).




**SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG:** Jason Lesteborg completed his fourth season (70-113-15 overall/4th season at SCSU: 45-87-6) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002. Lesteborg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history. Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteborg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist. A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteborg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.

**2005-06 TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior defender Randie Jelinski, a resident of Regina, Sask., served as the team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter were junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba).

**FIVE SENIORS EXPERIENCE LESTEBERG ERA:** The 2005-2006 senior class, consisting of Randie Jelinski, Kristy Oonincx, Rachel Solgon, and Kelly and Ashley Stewart, was the first class to go through all four years with current SCSU head coach Jason Lesteborg. In the past four years, the seniors posted a 45-87-6 overall record and a 29-70-5 WCHA record.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:**

**JEFF GIESEN:** Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn., completed his third season as a full-time assistant coach on the SCSU women's hockey staff. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

**LAURA SLOMINSKI:** Laura Slominski joined the staff at SCSU this season after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

A SEASON OF FIRSTS: The 2005-2006 SCSU women's hockey campaign gained a list of "firsts" in school history this season. On January 7, 2006, SCSU defeated a #1 ranked team for the first time in school history when they defeated St. Lawrence in overtime, 4-3. The Huskies then went on to defeat another #1 ranked team on February 3, 2006, when they upset UW 1-0 in the National Hockey Center. (Of note, that was the lone shutout that Wisconsin suffered all season).

SCSU won the most games in school history this season after notching 18 wins and finishing the season with an 18-18-1 mark and won the most WCHA games in school history with 13. The Huskies surpassed the 2000-2001 season, which was coached by Kerry Brodt Wethington, when SCSU finished with a 17-16-2 overall record and a 4th place finish in the WCHA with a 12-10-2 record. Of note, the 2005-06 season and the 2000-2001 seasons had the highest finishes in the WCHA with a 4th place finish. No other season has accomplished that.

The Huskies also became the first team besides Minnesota, Minnesota-Duluth, Wisconsin or Ohio State to make an appearance at the WCHA semifinal games. The Huskies lost in the Semis to eventual WCHA Tournament Champions University of Wisconsin on March 11, 2006.

This team also became the first Husky team to sweep the Minnesota-Duluth Bulldogs in a weekend series tilt. On Jan. 27, SCSU defeated UMD 2-1, and completed the series sweep with a 3-1 victory over the Bulldogs in the NHC on Jan. 28.

Senior forward Kristy Ooninx (Moose Jaw, Sask.) led the Huskies with 44 points (15 g, 29 a). The last Husky to score over 40 points in a season was former player Rickie-Lee Doyle, who tallied 62 points in the 2000-2001 campaign after scoring 26 goals and 36 assists. Doyle currently holds the record for most points scored in a season and most goals scored in a season. Former Husky Fiona McLeod also scored over 40 points in the 2000-2001 season after notching 12 goals and 35 assists for 47 points.

The Huskies became the first team to have four individuals score over thirty points individually since the 2000-2001 season. This year Ooninx finished with a team-leading 44 points (15 g, 29 a), junior Hailey Clarkson finished with 38 points (17 g, 21 a), junior assistant captain Denelle Maguet finished with 32 points (14 g, 18 a) and senior forward Ashley Stewart finished with 32 points (11 g, 21 a). In 2000-2001, the Huskies had four individuals score over thirty points apiece. Rickie-Lee Doyle led with 62 points (26 g, 36 a), Fiona McLeod added 47 points (12 g, 35 a), Roxanne Stang tallied 39 points (29 g, 26 a) and Kobi Kawamoto finished with 39 points (17 g, 22 a).

SCSU became the first team in school history to be ranked in the Top 10 of the USCHO.com poll. The Huskies accomplished this feat on Feb. 6, 2006, when SCSU moved up to #10 in the polls after upsetting #1 then-ranked Wisconsin Badgers 1-0 on Feb. 4 in the NHC. The Huskies were ranked as high as #9 in the USCHO.com polls on Feb. 13 and Feb. 20.

STEWART FINISHES CAREER THIRD ON ALL-TIME SCORING LIST:

Senior forward Ashley Stewart completed her standout career ranked third on the all-time SCSU women's hockey scoring list with 98 career points (45g, 53a). Former Husky Roxanne Stang is the lone Husky to reach the prestigious mark of 100 career points. Stang, who played from 2001-2004, totalled 119 points (71g, 48a). Ashley Stewart trails former Husky Kobi Kawamoto (2001-2004), who scored 99 career points (35g, 64a). Ashley Stewart also ranks second

on the all-time goals scored list with 45 and ranks third on the all-time power play goals scored list with 14 in her career. She completes her standout career ranking third on the all-time assists scored list with 53 and is second in school history with 466 shots on goal.

HUSKIES HAVE 13 NAMED ALL-WCHA ACADEMIC: The SCSU women's hockey team posted 13 student-athletes on the 2005-06 WCHA All-Academic Team. SCSU, along with Bemidji State University (13), had the most student-athletes named to the prestigious academic list.

The SCSU WCHA All-Academic Team includes: Bobbie Anderson (Jr., F, Whitecourt, Alberta); Hailey Clarkson (Jr., F, Winnipegosis, Manitoba); Laura Fast (So, F, Calgary, Alberta); Tricia Fast (Jr., D, Calgary, Alberta); Randie Jelinski (Sr., D, Regina, Sask.); Jackie Jensen (Jr., F, Madison, Wis.); Brittini Kuyper (So., D, Eden Prairie, Minn.); Marie-Michel Lemieux (Jr., F, Boisbrand, Quebec); Denelle Maguet (Jr., F, Ste. Rose); Emily Meronyk; Kristy Ooninx (Sr., F, Moose Jaw, Sask.); Lauri St. Jacques (Jr., G, Sturgeon Falls, Ontario); Hilary Spires (So., D, Delta, British Columbia).

To earn a position on the WCHA All-Academic Team, each player must have completed at least one year of eligibility at her present institution, have a current GPA of 3.0 for the two previous semesters and have competed in at least one-half of her institution's varsity intercollegiate ice hockey games during the current season (goalenders must have played in 33 percent of all games).

Of note, senior captain Randie Jelinski is a three-time WCHA All-Academic pick, and Bobbie Anderson, Tricia Fast, and Lauri St. Jacques have each been named to the WCHA All-Academic Team for the second consecutive year.



JELINSKI AND OONINX SELECTED FOR THE FIRST ANNUAL NCAA FROZEN FOUR SKILLS CHALLENGE:

St. Cloud State University women's hockey team captain Randie Jelinski and senior forward Kristy Ooninx have been chosen to participate in the first annual NCAA Frozen Four Skills Challenge on April 7-8, 2006.

The American Hockey Coaches Association and the NCAA together have selected male and female student-athletes for the East and West squads, as well as alternates, for the NCAA Frozen Four Skills Challenge. Ooninx and Jelinski are the lone Huskies to participate in the Skills Challenge on the weekend of the NCAA Men's Hockey Division I Frozen Four in Milwaukee, Wis.

Throughout the weekend, Ooninx and Randie will not only participate in the Skills Challenge on Friday, April 7, but will also take part in the YES Clinic on Saturday, April 8, from 9-11:30 a.m. The YES Clinic is being offered for youth ages 10-18, and will include four, thirty-minute skills sessions.

Jelinski and Ooninx combined for 17 goals and 42 assists during their last seasons.
