## 2009-10 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS FINAL RELEASE: April 7, 2010

**HISTORY IN THE MAKING:** The 2009-10 St. Cloud State women's hockey squad completed the season with a 15-14-8 overall record and an 11-11-6 mark in the WCHA, good for third place. This was the first time in school and league history that St. Cloud State finished as one of the top three schools in the league.

**SEASON ENDS IN PLAYOFFS:** The Huskies season was cut short when No. 6 seed Bemidji State edged the No. 3 seed Huskies in the National Hockey Center in the first round of the WCHA Playoffs on Feb. 26-28.

**PLAYOFF MARK:** St. Cloud State is now 7-12 in playoff action and 1-3 in third and decisive playoff games.

**NINE IS FINE:** The Huskies say good-bye to nine seniors this season in; Holly Roberts, Caitlin Hogan, Felicia Nelson, Katie Kemmerer, Kelly Meierhofer, Jeneca Fredheim, Meaghan Pezon, Danielle Hirsch and Ashlan Lambert. Without a doubt, this senior class is the top class to ever don the CST as the nine players combined to score an incredible 539 collegiate points.

**NELSON MAKES HISTORY:** Team captain Felicia Nelson had a banner season. She became the first player in school history to be named a Top-10 Finalist for the 2010 Patty Kazmaier Memorial Award, the most prestigious award presented annually to the top player in NCAA Division I women's ice hockey.

**NATIONAL LEADER:** Felicia Nelson completed the regular season as the nation's goal scoring leader with 30. Her 30 goals led both men and women hockey players at the Division I level. Felicia Nelson ended her senior stint with a total of 31 goals in 34 games played. Minnesota Duluth's Emmanuelle Blais eventually by-passed Nelson as Blais tabbed 32 goals in 41 games played to end the 2009-10 season as the nation's goal scoring leader. Of note, this was the first time in school history that a St. Cloud State women's hockey player led the nation in goals scored during the regular season.

**FELICIA, THE ALL-AMERICAN:** For the first time in school history, St. Cloud State University landed a women's hockey player on an All-American squad. SCSU's team captain Felicia Nelson (St. Paul) was named to the American Hockey Coaches Association Division I All-American Second Team.

**WELCOME TO THE CLUB:** St. Cloud State's senior class had three 100 Point Scorers on the squad this season. Caitlin Hogan (Oakdale) leaves SCSU as the school's leading scorer with 127 points (50g, 77a) in 149 games played. Teammate Holly Roberts (St. Cloud) also joined the elite club this season as she leaves SCSU with 126 points (54g, 72a) in 149 games played, ranking second all-time. Felicia Nelson managed to score 106 points (64g, 42a) during her collegiate tenure with stats combined from both Minnesota State and St. Cloud State (92 at SCSU).

**PLAYER OF THE YEAR:** The Huskies Felicia Nelson was named the WCHA Co-Player of the Year for her efforts in 2009-10. Nelson is the first women's hockey player in school history to gain this prestigious honor from the league.

**HURRAY FOR HOGAN:** Senior center Caitlin Hogan (Oakdale) also made history, being the first St. Cloud State women's hockey player to garner the Turfer Outstanding Student-Athlete of the Year honors.

**ALL-WCHA HONORS:** St. Cloud State also landed three players on the All-WCHA teams. Holly Roberts and Felicia Nelson were named to the All-WCHA Second Team, while Caitlin Hogan etched her name on the All-WCHA Third Team.

**HOGAN THE HELPER:** Hogan leaves St. Cloud State as the all-time assists leader with 77. She was also voted to participate in the 2010 NCAA Frozen Four Skills Challenge in April of 2010. Hogan is the fifth women's hockey player in school history to gain such an honor.

**ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE:** The Husky women's hockey squad posted the largest WCHA Scholar-Athlete team in school history as nine student-athletes landed on the team. Those athletes were Anna Donlan (So., G, Hillsboro, WI); Jeneca Fredheim (Sr., D, Campbell River, BC); Caitlin Hogan (Sr., F, Oakdale, MN); Courtney Josefson (Jr., F, Bemidji, MN); Katie Kemmerer (Sr., F, Anchorage, AK); Ashlan Lambert (Jr., D, Eden Prairie, MN); Kelly Meierhofer (Sr., D, Sauk Rapids, MN); Holly Roberts (Sr., F, St. Cloud, MN) and Brittany Toor (So., F, Hartland, MI).

**LEAGUE ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM:** St. Cloud State also landed 12 student-athletes on the WCHA All-Academic team. Those student-athletes included; Anna Donlan (So., G, Hillsboro, Wis.), Jeneca Fredheim (Sr., F, Campbell River, B.C.), Danielle Hirsch (Sr., D, Bloomington), Caitlin Hogan (Sr., F, Oakdale), Courtney Josefson (Jr., F, Bemidji), Diana Karouzos (Jr., D, Chicago, Ill.), Katie Kemmerer (Sr., F, Anchorage, Alaska), Ashlan Lambert (Sr., F, Eden Prairie), Kelly Meierhofer (Sr., D, Sauk Rapids), Felicia Nelson (Sr., F, St. Paul), Holly Roberts (Sr., F, St. Cloud) and Brittany Toor (So, F, Hartland, Mich.).

**ANOTHER RECORD FALLS:** Hogan and Roberts now hold the school record for most games played in the Cardinal and Black at 149.

**GIESEN AT THE TOP:** Head Coach Jeff Giesen became SCSU's all-time winningest women's hockey coach earlier this season, garnering his 46th career victory on Friday, Oct. 2, against Niagara in the National Hockey Center. Giesen's career mark stands at 60-65-24 overall and 40-54-18 in the ever-grueling WCHA.

**SCSU's HEAD COACH JEFF GIESEN:** Jeff Giesen completed his fourth season at the helm of Husky Hockey in 2009-10 and became SCSU's all-time winningest women's hockey coach this season, garnering his 46th career win on Friday, Oct. 2, against Niagara in the Nat'l Hockey Center. A native of Blaine, Minn., Giesen is the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen tallied his first career victory against Robert Morris on Sept. 29, 2006, with a 4-0 shutout in the NHC. Giesen's career coaching record stands at 60-65-24 with a 40-54-18 mark in the ever grueling WCHA. A 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State University and a true student of the game, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn., with their two daughters Delaney and Maleah.

JASON JOHNSON: Jason Johnson joined the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007-08 after serving as an assistant men's hockey coach at nearby Saint John's University since 2003 under the helm of head coach John Harrington, a former SCSU men's assistant coach and Olympic Gold Medalist. During Johnson's coaching years at SJU, the Johnnies won back-to-back Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. No stranger to the game of hockey, Johnson played four years at Saint John's and tallied 59 points (27g, 32a) in 95 career games played for the Johnnies. His senior season, SJU finished third at the 1997 Division III National Tournament. Johnson's responsibilities at St. Cloud State include recruiting, video breakdown and working with the defensemen. For the past nine years, Johnson has been a first grade teacher at the Albertville Primary School. A resident of St. Michael and 2003 graduate of Hamline University with a master's of arts in education, Johnson and his wife Rachel have two sons, JP and Jack.

JENNIFER KRANZ: Jennifer Kranz, a native of Waukesha, Wis., completed her fourth season on the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2009-10. Prior to joining the Husky staff in 2006, Kranz served as the assistant girls' prep ice hockey coach at Shattuck-St. Mary's School in Faribault, Minn., since 2004. At SCSU, Kranz's responsibilities include recruiting, working with the forwards and monitoring team academics. No stranger to the game, Kranz was a member of the Providence College women's varsity ice hockey team from 1998-2002. She tallied 22 points (12g, 10a) in 104 career games played with the Friars. After graduating from Providence College with a bachelor's of arts in English in 2002, Kranz joined the Shattuck-St. Mary's School as the assistant coach for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. In 2003, Kranz was promoted to the head coach position for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. Kranz served as the Team Leader at the girls' 15/16's USA Player Development Camp in Lake Placid, NY, in 2005 and in Rochester, NY, in 2006. This past summer, Kranz served as a Team Coach for the girls' 15's USA Player Development camp in St. Cloud, Minn. She has also been actively involved with the Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association since 2000 serving as an evaluator.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**HEARING THE HUSKIES:** SCSU women's hockey action was streamed live at [www.kvsc.org](http://www.kvsc.org) throughout the season, as well as heard live on KVSC 88.1 FM. KVSC's Matt Bishop provided the play-by-play from the National Hockey Center.

**WATCH HOME HOCKEY ON THE WEB:** Husky fans were able to watch live video streaming of SCSU home women's hockey thru a pay-perview partnership with B2 Networks in 2009-10.

**POWER PLAY A PLUS:** The 2009-10 team set a new school record for most power play goals scored in a season with 42. This squad surpassed the 2000-01 team which scored 40 PPG.

**ALL KNOTTED UP:** St. Cloud State's eight ties this season (15-14-8) were also the most ties in a single season at SCSU.

**TEAM BREAKS DECADE LONG RECORD:** Back in 1999-00, just the second season in school history, the Husky squad combined for 1,100 total saves. This year's St. Cloud State (2009-10) team broke that record by 67 saves, totaling 1,167 saves in 37 games played. This year's .919 team save percentage was also a school best.

## "SENIOR CLASS"

- Without question, SCSU's senior class this season is the top class to ever play at St. Cloud State. This 2009-10 senior class has two members among the St. Cloud State 100 Point Club in Caitlin Hogan and Holly Roberts, this class has scored more points than any other class in school history with 525 combined points and this senior class holds 37 individual school records. *Of note, by including Felicia Nelson's career points from Minnesota State, this senior class of nine student-athletes combined for a total of 539 collegiate points.*
- These seniors were members of the 2007-08 squad that tied the school record for most wins in a season with 18. They went 18-15-5 that season, including a big weekend series against the Minnesota Gophers on Oct. 12-13, 2007. That Husky squad became the first SCSU team to go unbeaten against the Gophers in a two-game series. The Huskies tallied their first tie in school history against Minnesota on Oct. 12 at Ridder Arena (4-4 OT) and turned around to beat the then #6-ranked Gophers on Oct. 13 in a 2-1 victory in the National Hockey Center.
- Two seasons later, this season squad helped earn the Huskies their first shootout win in school history over the Minnesota Gophers on Feb. 12 at Ridder Arena. SCSU and Minnesota skated to a 2-2 overtime tie and seniors Holly Roberts and Felicia Nelson connected for goals in the shootout to give SCSU the extra league point. The following night St. Cloud State erupted for a 6-3 victory over the Gophers in the National Hockey Center to become the first team in school history to take four points from the Gophers in a weekend series.
- These seniors have earned home ice for the first round of the WCHA Playoffs the last three-of-four seasons and advanced to the WCHA Final Face-Off in 2007-08.
- These nine seniors have combined to play in 1,034 collegiate career games in the Cardinal and Black.
- During the past four seasons, these seniors have tabbed a 60-65-24 overall record with a 38-54-16 mark in the WCHA.
- This senior class has garnered 30 combined academic awards and nine WCHA Player of the Week accolades.
- These seniors have combined for four All-WCHA individual honors. Felicia Nelson was named the 2009-10 Co-WCHA Player of the Year and landed on the 2009-10 All-WCHA Second Team. Holly Roberts was named to the 2006-07 All-WCHA Rookie Team and 2009-10 All-WCHA Second Team while Caitlin Hogan etched her name on the 2009-10 All-WCHA Third Team.

## When Was The Last Time...
