### *INAUGURAL WOMEN'S SERIES GOES TO THE WCHA Wisconsin Blanks Providence to Claim Title*

The first WOMEN'S COMMISSIONERS' CUP SERIES is history and the WCHA can claim bragging rights. One game separated all four conferences and it all came down to the last scheduled game, Providence at Wisconsin last Saturday. The Badgers and Lady Friars were scoreless through 22 minutes of play until Jasmine Giles beat PC goalie Danielle Ciarletta at 2:31 of the second. It was the first of five unanswered goals in a 5-0 Wisconsin win. Five different players would score for coach Mark Johnson in this one.

The WCHA finished with the only winning record in the series, 6-5-1. The successful campaign included wins from Bemidji State, Minnesota State, Ohio State, Wisconsin, and two from St. Cloud State. North Dakota contributed a 0-0 tie for a key point. Both the ECACHL and College Hockey America were an even 5-5-2, followed by Hockey East, who finished at 5-6-1.
