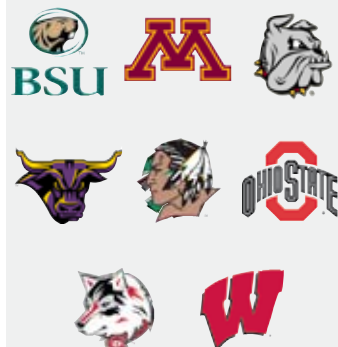

WCHA First Round Playoff Pairings Set; #1 UW Hosts #8 SCSU, #2 UMD Hosts #7 MSU, #3 UM Hosts #6 OSU, #4 UND Hosts #5 BSU Best-of-Three Series Set for Feb. 25, 26 and 27 (if necessary); Tickets Still Available for 2011 WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF Championship, March 4-5 at Ridder Arena in Minneapolis

MADISON, Wis. – The first round of the women's Western Collegiate Hockey Association Playoffs, a best-of-three format, get underway this coming Friday (Feb. 25) at No. 1 tournament seed Wisconsin, No. 2 seed Minnesota Duluth, No. 3 seed Minnesota and No. 4 seed North Dakota. Game twos of each series will be played on Saturday (Feb. 26) and game threes, if necessary, will be contested on Sunday (Feb. 27).

Conference champion and No. 1 seed Wisconsin (30-2-2) will host No. 8 seed St. Cloud State (1-31-1) at Eagles' Nest in Verona, Wis., No. 2 Minnesota Duluth (20-7-3) will host No. 7 Minnesota State (8-23-3) at AMSOIL Arena, No. 3 Minnesota (23-8-2) will entertain No. 6 Ohio State (14-17-3) at Ridder Arena and No. 4 seed North Dakota (18-11-3) will host No. 5 seed Bemidji State (13-15-4) at Purpur Arena in Grand Forks, N.D.

The Bulldogs and Golden Gophers, after tying for the league's regular season title a season ago, tied for second this season. But UMD, by virtue of a 2-1-1 advantage in the four-game head-to-head regular season series, earned the No. 2 seed for the league playoffs.
