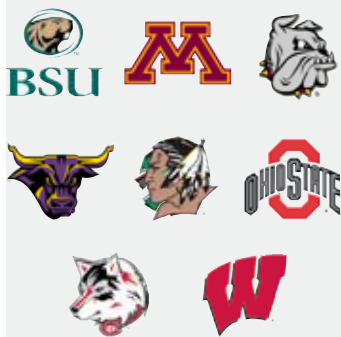

WISCONSIN, MINNESOTA RUN 1-2 IN WCHA AND NATIONAL RANKINGS AT HOLIDAY BREAK; ON-ICE PLAY TO RESUME JAN. 2

NO. 4 MINNESOTA DULUTH SPLITS WITH PRINCETON, BULLDOGS LEAD NORTH DAKOTA, ST. CLOUD STATE IN BATTLE FOR THIRD PLACE; THREE WCHA TEAMS AMONG TOP 10 IN NATIONAL POLLS ... WISCONSIN NO. 1, MINNESOTA NO. 2, MINNESOTA DULUTH NO. 4 ... NORTH DAKOTA ALSO RECEIVES VOTES; TICKETS ON SALE NOW FOR 2009 WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF, CHAMPIONSHIP SET FOR MARCH 7-8 AT RIDDER ARENA

MADISON, Wis. – As teams throughout the country break for the holidays the top two teams in the Western Collegiate Hockey Association standings – unbeaten and league-leading Wisconsin and Minnesota – are also the top two women's teams in the latest (Dec. 15) U.S. College Hockey Online's women rankings.

Defending national champions Minnesota Duluth are third in the WCHA standings, but fell a notch in the ratings following a non-conference series split with Princeton at the DECC last weekend, Dec. 13-14. The Bulldogs blanked the Tigers 3-0 in the series finale last Sunday after falling 4-3 in the opener last Saturday.

The top-ranked Badgers, who have a record unbeaten streak of 20 games to start the 2008-09 season, and No. 2 Minnesota, which has won 10 games in a row, have a sizable lead in the race for the league title at the holiday break.

Heading into the halfway mark in the season, Wisconsin (18-0-2 overall, 10-0-2-1 in league play) has 27 points, one more than Minnesota (15-2-1 overall, 12-1-1-0 WCHA). Minnesota Duluth (12-6-2, 7-5-2 WCHA) is third with 16 points, one point ahead of North Dakota (10-7-1, 7-6-1-0 WCHA) and two points ahead of St. Cloud State (9-7-2, 6-7-1-1 WCHA). Ohio State (6-11-1, 4-9-1-1 WCHA) has jumped into sixth place with 10 points, one more than Minnesota State (6-10-2, 3-9-2-1 WCHA). Bemidji State (1-15-2, 0-14-0-0 WCHA) is in eighth place without a point.

There are no games on the schedule for the next two weeks, with non-conference play resuming for WCHA-member teams on the weekend of Jan. 2-4. Ohio State will host Boston University (Fri/Sat) of the Hockey East

WCHA MARKS 10TH SEASON IN 2008-09 LEAGUE HOPES TO DEFEND RECORD RUN OF NINE CONSECUTIVE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS; 2009 WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF MARCH 7-8 AT RIDDER ARENA; WCHA APPROVES SHOOTOUTS TO BREAK TIES

The Western Collegiate Hockey Association, celebrating the 10th season of women's hockey, has plenty of new developments and exciting events that earmark the 2008-09 season.

"We have enjoyed great fortune and success throughout the first nine seasons of WCHA women's hockey," said Sara Martin, WCHA Associate Commissioner, "and we look forward to celebrating our tenth season of play by continuing to develop our sport and expose our student-athletes and coaches to an ever-growing legion of fans. Coming off our ninth consecutive national championship, and based on the continuing emergence of all of our member teams, we're confident the WCHA as a whole will be even more competitive from top to bottom this season."

The battle for the WCHA regular season championship will again consist of a 28-game schedule for each of the league's eight clubs, with each team playing the other seven four times – twice at home and twice on the road. The opening weekend of league competition was Oct. 10-11 with the regular season concluding the weekend of Feb. 20-22.

The conference's post-season championship tournament will open the weekend of Feb. 27-Mar. 1 (Friday, Saturday, Sunday) with a first round, best-of-three series format at campus sites. The No. 1 seeded team will host the No. 8 seed, the No. 2 seed will host the No. 7 seed, the No. 3 seed will host the No. 6 seed, and the No. 4 seed will host the No. 5 seed.

The four first-round winners will then advance to the 2009 WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF at Ridder Arena in Minneapolis, Minn., on Saturday and Sunday, March 7-8. On Saturday, there will be two semi-final match-ups at 1:07 pm CT and 4:07 pm CT, with the playoff championship game set for Sunday at 1:07 pm CT.

Following two weeks of WCHA playoffs, the NCAA Women's Div. 1 championship tournament will commence the weekend of March 13-15 at regional sites (TBA), followed by the 2008 NCAA Women's Frozen Four, to be held March 20-22 at Boston, Mass.

WCHA WOMEN USING SHOOTOUT IN 2008-09

The WCHA is helping to re-introduce the shootout to women's college hockey. A National Hockey League-style three-player shootout is being used to determine a winner for all WCHA regular season games still tied after regulation and the standard five-minute (5:00) overtime.

Thus far this season four games have gone to shootout: SCSU beat UMD Oct. 17 at St. Cloud (SCSU won 2-1 in 3 rounds – Holly Roberts GWG); MSU beat UND Oct. 17 in Grand Forks (MSU won 2-1 in 5 rounds of shootout – Lisa Edman with GWG); UM beat UW Oct. 24 at Madison (UM won 1-0 in 3 rounds of shootout – Sarah Erickson with GWG); UW beat UMD Nov. 1 at Madison (UW won 1-0 in 3 rounds of shootout – Kelly Nash with GWG).

The NCAA has allowed conferences the ability to implement this tie-breaking protocol so that every regular season league game will have a winner while preserving the integrity of the national rankings. Regular season games decided by a shootout will still be considered ties for NCAA purposes so there will be no effect on NCAA records for the purposes of the Pairwise and determining the national tournament field. Bonus points awarded will impact WCHA standings only. The WCHA standings should be read with two points for a win, zero points for losses, one point for a tie and one point for shootout wins.

Toor tallied the first goal of the game for SCSU ... It marked the first of her collegiate career ... Hogan charted her seventh goal of the season in the third and final frame ... sophomore defender Diana Karouzos garnered her first assist of the season on the score, while senior Megan McCarthy chipped in with her 11th assist of the year, extending her season total to a team-leading 18 points (7g, 11a) ... McCarthy sits in a two-way tie for 15th in the league in scoring ...
