## **2005-06 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS**

Release Date: Oct. 24, 2005

**HUSKIES ENTER BYE WEEK, HEAD TO MADISON IN TWO WEEKS:** The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (2-4-0 overall, 2-4-0 WCHA) will take a week off following a two-game sweep of Bemidji State at the NHC. The Huskies will get back on the ice in two weeks (Nov. 4-5) as they take on the Badgers of Wisconsin in Madison.

**LAST WEEKEND FOR THE HUSKIES:** The SCSU women's hockey team swept Bemidji State 6-2 and 4-1 for the first sweep since they swept BSU back on Nov. 26-27, 2004 in Bemidji. The 6-2 win Friday night snapped a seven-game losing streak leading back to last season for the Huskies. Junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba) scored a goal and two assists in addition to a +5 performance in the victory for the Huskies, while sophomore forward Laura Fast (Calgary, Alb.) and first year forward Amy Currier (Fargo, N.D.) added a goal and an assist each. Each of the Stewart sisters (Toronto, Ont.), Ashley and Kelly, scored a goal and senior forward Kristy Oonincx (Moose Jaw, Sask.) added two assists. Junior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) made 19 saves to record her first win of the 2005-06 season. Both junior Hailey Clarkson (Winnipegosis, Mant.) and Ashley Stewart recorded playmakers in the 4-1 win over BSU Saturday afternoon to complete the series sweep. Clarkson and Fast also recorded goals in the win, while Oonincx lit the lamp twice. Sophomore goaltender Kendall Newell (Phoenix, Ariz.) made 12 saves to record her first win of the season.

**SCSU HEAD COACH JASON LESTEBERG:** Jason Lesteberg begins his fourth season (54-99-14 overall/4<sup>th</sup> season at SCSU: 29-73-5) with the Huskies after he joined the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team as the program's second head coach in July, 2002.



Lesteberg was the head women's hockey coach at Bemidji State University in 2001-02, where he led the Beavers to the most successful campaign in their brief history.

In addition, the Beavers earned a berth in the WCHA Final Five and Lesteberg was an NCAA Division I Coach of the Year finalist.

Prior to becoming the head coach at Bemidji State, Lesteberg served as women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2000 to 2001. He led the Pointers to a 13-13-1 record in their inaugural season of varsity women's ice hockey competition. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year and was an NCAA Division III Coach of the Year Finalist.

A 1996 graduate of Gustavus Adolphus College, Lesteberg, a Burnsville, Minn., native, was a first team All-American, College Hockey Player of the Year Finalist, NCAA Division III Player of the Year Finalist, Conference Player of the Year, two-time first team All-Conference, and a two-time conference scoring champion for the hockey team.



**MORE HUSKY NEWS AND NOTES...**

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:**

**JEFF GIESEN:** Jeff "Goose" Giesen, a former assistant coach at Saint John's University in Collegetown, Minn., begins his third season as a full-time assistant to head women's hockey coach Jason Lesteberg. Giesen's primary duties are to work with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. Giesen was an assistant coach at Saint John's University from 1992-98 and was an associate head coach at SJU from 1998-2003. In addition to his experience at Saint John's, Giesen has worked extensively with the USA Hockey Development program. The most recent program was with the girls 15/16 camp in Lake Placid this past summer. In the past, Giesen has also worked with the girls' 17/18 camp in Lake Placid, along with numerous USA Hockey boys' programs. Giesen was also the assistant coach for the WCHA All-Stars prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

**LAURA SLOMINSKI:** Laura Slominski joins the staff at SCSU after serving as the head girl's hockey coach at Bloomington-Kennedy High School in 2004-05. Prior to her tenure at Kennedy H.S., Slominski served as an assistant coach for the women's hockey program at St. Olaf College under head coach Tom Osiecki from 2002 through 2004. A 2003 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Slominski played for the Golden Gophers from 1998-2002. A team captain in 2001-02, Slominski helped lead Minnesota to WCHA titles in 2001 and 2002, and a national AWCHA crown in 2000. As a player, Slominski was invited to participate in the 2005 USA Hockey National Women's Festival.

**OONINCX, CLARKSON KEEP STREAKS ALIVE:** Senior forward Kristy Oonincx (Moose Jaw, Sask.) has scored a point in four consecutive games (2g/6a), while junior forward Hailey Clarkson has scored a point in three consecutive games (2g/4a). Sophomore Laura Fast (Calgary, Alb.) started a streak of her own over the weekend, scoring a goal in two consecutive games (1g/2a).

**LINE UP WITH FAST, OONINCX AND MAGUET:** Senior forward Kristy Oonincx (Moose Jaw, Sask.), sophomore forward Laura Fast (Calgary, Alb.) and junior forward Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Mant.) are in the black when it comes to +/- in their respective careers. Fast is currently at +3 on the season and a +5 for her career in 41 games played, while Maguet adds a +4 on the season and a +6 for her career in 38 games played. Oonincx currently possesses a +5 on the season for a +1 in 39 games played as a Husky.

**MORE HUSKY NEWS AND NOTES...**

THIS WEEKEND'S OPPONENT: **Idle**

**WEEKEND MILESTONES:** Friday's win snapped a seven-game losing streak for the Huskies dating back to SCSU's last victory on Feb. 20 (4-2 win at North Dakota). The last time an SCSU player scored a playmaker came on Nov. 12, 2004 when Hailey Clarkson recorded three assists at home against Wayne State (Mich.). Saturday's occurrence was the fourth time in school history that two players recorded playmakers in the same game, the last occurring on Feb. 15, 2002 at home against Bemidji State (Abby Cooper and Andrea Keller). First year forward Amy Currier (Fargo, N.D.) scored her first collegiate goal/career point and an assist in Friday's 6-2 win over BSU. The goal became the eventual game winner.

**CLIMBING THE CHARTS:** Senior forward Ashley Stewart (Toronto, Ont.) is currently tied for fifth on the SCSU all-time scoring list with 72 points (36g/36a). She needs just one point to move past Carrie Holldorf (2002-05) for fourth place on the scoring list, and three goals to pass Abby Cooper (2000-03) for second place on the all-time goals scored list. Senior Kelly Stewart (Toronto, Ont.; 14g/24a), though 34 points behind her twin sister, needs four points to move into 10<sup>th</sup> on the SCSU all-time scoring list. Senior forward Kristy Ooninx (Moose Jaw, Sask.; 16g/16a) and junior forward Hailey Clarkson (Winnipegosis, Mant.; 7g/22a) are 13<sup>th</sup> and tied for 14<sup>th</sup> on the all-time scoring list, respectively. First year forward Amy Currier (Fargo, N.D.) entered the all-time scoring list for the first time over the weekend. Currier recorded her first career goal/career point and an assist in Friday's 6-2 win over BSU. The goal became the eventual game winner.

**IN THE WCHA:** Senior forward Kristy Ooninx is currently third in the WCHA with 9 points (2g/7a), second in assists (7), and tied for third in power play points with 3 (1g/2a). Junior forward Hailey Clarkson is currently tied for third with 5 assists and fifth in points (2g/5a). Sophomore forward Laura Fast is currently tied for fourth in the WCHA in goals scored with 3. Sophomore goaltender Kendall Newell is currently fifth in the WCHA with a 2.04 GAA and third with a .924 save percentage. As a team, SCSU is third in scoring offense (2.67 goals/game) and fourth in scoring defense (2.83 goals/game). Ooninx ended the 2004-05 WCHA season 26<sup>th</sup> in points (14g/9a), 14<sup>th</sup> in goals scored (14), 21<sup>st</sup> in power-play points (5g/6a), and tied for 15<sup>th</sup> in game-winning goals (2). Senior forward Ashley Stewart also finished 26<sup>th</sup> in scoring (10g/13a), while Clarkson finished 18<sup>th</sup> in assists (18) and tied for 15<sup>th</sup> in game-winning goals (2).

## MORE HUSKY NEWS AND NOTES...

**EMPTY NETTERS:** Ashley Stewart's empty net goal at the 18:57 mark of Friday afternoon's 6-2 victory over BSU was the first empty net goal since Dec. 15, 2002, when who else, Ashley Stewart scored an ENG with 00:16 remaining to seal a 2-0 Husky win at North Dakota. Two empty net goals in the same game is the first of its kind in SCSU women's hockey history. The last time SCSU scored an empty net goal in consecutive games came on Dec. 15-16 when Carrie Holldorf scored an ENG with 00:23 remaining to seal a 4-2 win at North Dakota, and Ashley Stewart scored an ENG with 00:26 remaining in a 2-0 shutout of UND in Grand Forks.

**A GLANCE AT THE GOALIES:** Junior Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Falls, Ont.) went 0-1-0 last weekend against Bemidji State. St. Jacques now has a 9-26-4 career record, .885 career save percentage, 1063 career saves and a 3.56 career GAA. St. Jacques is now 81 saves from tying Ellen Brinkman (2001-04) for second on the all-time career saves list. Laura Gieselman (2000-03) currently holds the school record with 3076 career saves. Last season, St. Jacques went 5-15-3 with a .892 save percentage and one shutout.

Sophomore Kendall Newell (Phoenix, Ariz.) also went 1-0-0 last weekend versus the Beavers, collecting 12 saves in the 4-1 win in game two of the series. Newell now has 5-6-1 career record, .901 career save percentage, 337 career saves and a 2.82 career GAA. Newell is 20 saves away from tying Brie Anderson (2003-04) for fifth on the all-time saves list. Last season, Newell went 4-5-1 with a .896 save percentage, 276 saves, a 3.00 GAA and one shutout in 12 games as a freshman.

**HUSKIES EXCEL IN THE CLASSROOM:** SCSU placed six players on the WCHA All-Academic Team in 2004-05, of which five are returning players: senior defender and captain Randie Jelinski, senior forward Rachel Solgon (Tucson, Ariz.), junior forward Bobbie Anderson (Whitecourt, Alb.), junior forward Tricia Fast (Calgary, Alb.), and junior goaltender and alternate captain Lauri St. Jacques.

**BALANCED AND EXPERIENCED:** SCSU returns 19 players after losing only five from last year's squad. This year's roster includes seven first year players, eight sophomores, seven juniors and five seniors. The 2005-06 Huskies are much more balanced according to grade level and experience than last year's squad, considering there were 17 first year players beginning the season last year.
