## 2009-10 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: September 28, 2009

**A NEW SEASON BEGINS:** St. Cloud State hosts Niagara University on Friday and Saturday, Oct. 2-3, to open the 2009-10 season. Friday's game is slated for 7:07 pm in the National Hockey Center, while Saturday's contest will begin at 4:07 pm.

**HUSKY RECORD:** The Huskies completed the 2008-09 season 15-18-4 overall and 11-14-3 in the WCHA (4th).

**GIESEN VERSUS NIAGARA:** This series against Niagara University marks the first time Jeff Giesen has coached against the Purple Eagles.

**THE SERIES:** Niagara leads the all-time series with the Huskies, 3-2-1, dating back to Jan. 5, 2001.

**LAST WEEK'S RESULTS:** Last Saturday, Sept. 26, the Huskies played host to Team USA for an exhibition game in the National Hockey Center. In front of a near record crowd for St. Cloud State University women's hockey, fans were treated to one of the best teams in the world, as Team USA shutout the Huskies 13-0.

**KNOCKING ON THE DOOR:** SCSU's crowd of 1,120 against Team USA on Sept. 26 was the second largest crowd in St. Cloud State University women's hockey history. The announced crowd of 1,120 fell just shy of the record 1,144 set on Nov. 6, 1998 at the National Hockey Center in support of the first game of Division I women's hockey at SCSU against St. Mary's.

**IN THE POLLS:** The Huskies were picked to finish fourth in the 2009 WCHA Coaches' Pre-season poll, released on Sept. 24, 2009.

**WCHA ALL-STARS:** St. Cloud State University's head women's hockey coach Jeff Giesen served as the head coach of the 2009 Western Collegiate Hockey Association All-Star team last Friday, Sept. 25, at the Xcel Energy Center. The Huskies also had four players land on the All-Star roster. Those Husky All-Star players included senior forwards Holly Roberts (St. Cloud) and Caitlin Hogan (Oakdale), senior defender Danielle Hirsch (Bloomington) and junior goaltender Ashley Nixon (Blaine).

**ALL-STAR HONORS:** St. Cloud State's junior goalie Ashley Nixon tabbed the WCHA Player of the Game honors against Team USA on Friday, Sept. 25, after stopping 17-of-18 Team USA shots in the second period.

**CHALK ONE UP FOR ROBERTS:** St. Cloud State's Holly Roberts scored the lone goal for the 2009 WCHA All-Star squad that played against Team USA, on Friday, Sept. 25, at the Xcel Energy Center. Roberts' goal came at the 5:03 mark of the third period on the WCHA All-Star power play.

**LEADING THE HELM:** Felicia Nelson, SCSU's

senior forward, has been named the team captain after serving as an alternate team captain in 2008-09. The St. Paul native played in 33 games last season and scored 21 points (3g, 13a). The trio of seniors Danielle Hirsch, Caitlin Hogan and Holly Roberts will all serve as alternate captains for the 2009-10 season.

**NEW SEASON, NEW FACES:** The Huskies are happy to welcome eight new faces to the squad in 2009-10. The incoming first year players include Canada natives Katherine Allen (Red Deer, Alberta) and Jocelyn Zabrick (Airdrie, Alberta), four-time All-Conference and two-time All-State selection Kylie Lane (Roseau), Minnesota's Ms. Hockey finalist Alexandra Nelson (Andover), All-State forward Callie Dahl (Stillwater), Minnesota Prep Athlete of the Week Haylea Schmid (Oak Grove), All-Classical Lake Conference player Elizabeth Sitek (Edina) and All-North Suburban Conference player Lisa Martinson (St. Louis Park).

**BETWEEN THE PIPES:** Ashley Nixon (Blaine) is back for her junior season and will lead the way in the goaltending category. As a sophomore, Nixon tallied her first career shutout in last year's season opener at Quinpiac on Oct. 3, 2008. A WCHA and USCHO.com Defensive Player of the Week honoree, Nixon led the Huskies with a .909 save percentage, 11 wins and three shutouts last year. Nixon is joined by sophomore net minder Tayler VanDenakker (Winnipeg, Manitoba) and red-shirt first year Anna Donlan (Hillsboro, Wis.). Van Denakker made nine starts during her rookie stint, going 4-4-1 overall and posting a team best 2.76 goals against average.

**SCSU's HEAD COACH JEFF GIESEN:** Jeff "Goose" Giesen begins his fourth season at the helm of Husky Hockey in 2009-10. A native of Blaine, Minn., Giesen is the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen tallied his first career victory against Robert Morris on Sept. 29, 2006, with a 4-0 shutout in the NHC. Giesen's career coaching record stands at 45-51-16 in three seasons along with a 29-43-12 mark in the ever grueling WCHA. A 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State University and a true student of the game, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn. with their daughters Delaney and Maleah.

JASON JOHNSON: Jason Johnson joined the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007-08 after serving as an assistant men's hockey coach at nearby Saint John's University since 2003 under the helm of head coach John Harrington, a former SCSU men's assistant coach and Olympic Gold Medalist. During Johnson's coaching years at SJU, the Johnnies won back-to-back Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. No stranger to the game of hockey, Johnson played four years at Saint John's and tallied 59 points (27g, 32a) in 95 career games played for the Johnnies. His senior season, SJU finished third at the 1997 Division III National Tournament. Johnson's responsibilities at St. Cloud State include recruiting, video breakdown and working with the defensemen. For the past nine years, Johnson has been a first grade teacher at the Albertville Primary School. A resident of St. Michael and 2003 graduate of Hamline University with a master's of arts in education, Johnson and his wife Rachel have two sons, JP and Jack.

JENNIFER KRANZ: Jennifer Kranz, a native of Waukesha, Wis., is in her fourth season on the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2008-09. Prior to joining the Husky staff in 2006, Kranz served as the assistant girls' prep ice hockey coach at Shattuck-St. Mary's School in Faribault, Minn., since 2004. At SCSU, Kranz's responsibilities include recruiting, working with the forwards and monitoring team academics. No stranger to the game, Kranz was a member of the Providence College women's varsity ice hockey team from 1998-2002. She tallied 22 points (12g, 10a) in 104 career games played with the Friars. After graduating from Providence College with a bachelor's of arts in English in 2002, Kranz joined the Shattuck-St. Mary's School as the assistant coach for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. In 2003, Kranz was promoted to the head coach position for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. Kranz served as the Team Leader at the girls' 15/16's USA Player Development Camp in Lake Placid, NY, in 2005 and in Rochester, NY, in 2006. This past summer, Kranz served as a Team Coach for the girls' 15's USA Player Development camp in St. Cloud, Minn. She has also been actively involved with the Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association since 2000 serving as an evaluator.
